

1 I think we got served by mail.

2 THE COURT: It was mailed August 14th as the footnote
3 suggests. Mr. Peia says you got it on August 16th or August
4 19th.

5 MR. PEIA: August 19th.

6 MR. LESTER: There's a rule that provides that when a
7 summons and complaint is served along with the acknowledgment of
8 receipt, et cetera, you've got an extra 30 days.

9 THE COURT: No.

10 MR. LESTER: I'm not sure, Your Honor. I'm sorry.
11 I can't directly respond to that. But in any event, a motion
12 was filed long before plaintiff sought a default. So it was too
13 late anyway.

14 THE COURT: All right.

15 MR. LESTER: One other comment in 20 seconds or less.
16 With respect to the plaintiff's allegations against the United
17 States as to Judge Shiff and Judge Trump, as the court ruled or
18 indicated on pages 5 and 6 of the tentative, any actions by
19 Judge Shiff and Judge Trump were done as judicial acts, not
20 administrative acts and were not clearly in excess of the
21 jurisdiction.

22 So as they would be protected by absolute immunity so
23 is the government in an FTCA action under 28 U.S. Code 2674.
