# Baptism Doth Save!

NO!! What it means is that **Jesus is our Savior, but Baptism is** the way, method, or **plan that He uses to do it.** This is why Baptism Saves, because the Savior won't save you unless you follow His plan, and Get Baptized!

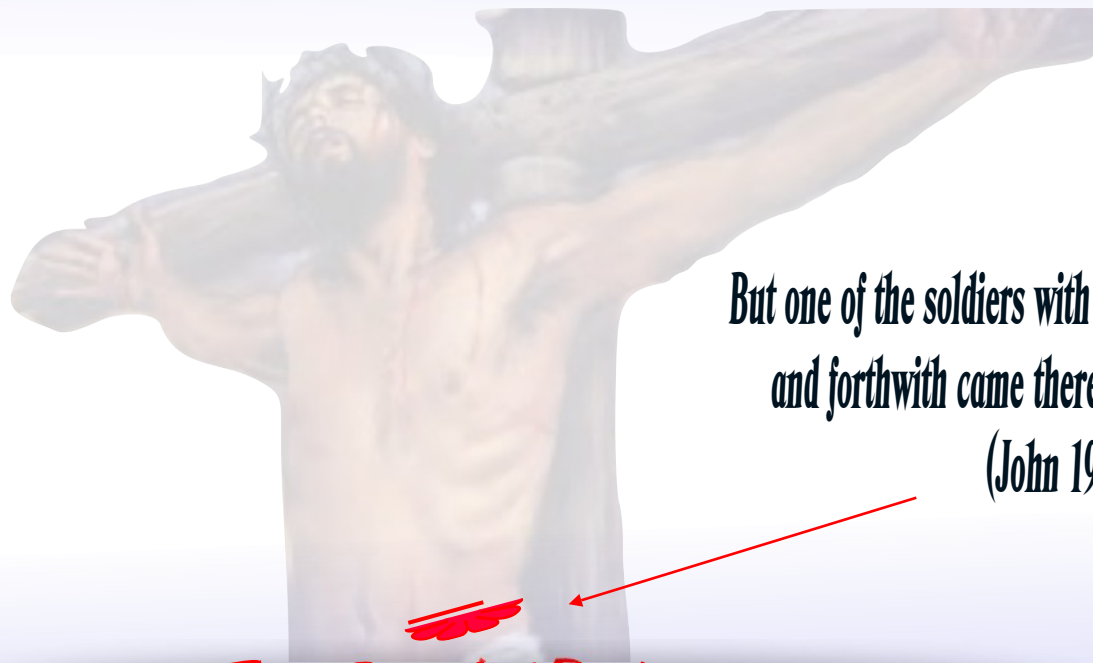

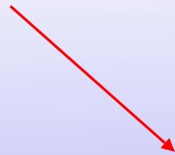

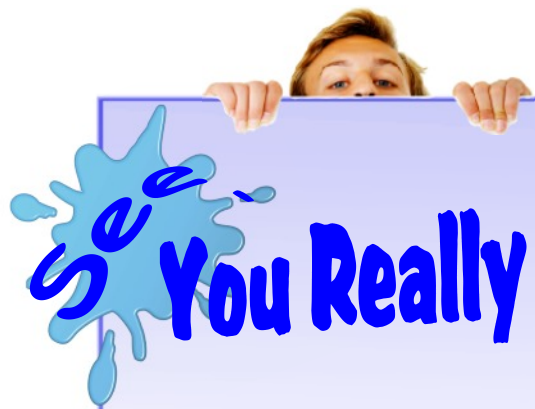

# The Thief On The Cross

## Is Often One To Whom People Go

To Claim That Baptism Is Not Necessary To Be Saved.

(THE STORY IS FOUND IN LUKE 23:32-43)

Rather The Thief On The Cross Was Baptized Or Not  
**Doesn't Even Matter,**

Because The Thief Died Before Christ Ever Gave His Command  
**For The Whole World**

Big Secret: The Thief Can't Save You!

The Biblical Warning To Give To Anyone Focused On The  
Thief On The Cross, Instead Of On Christ
