MEETING RULES

This is not a good sign for a relationship or even marriage, and if marriage should come from it, be reassured that there will be rocky days ahead.

It is important to decide what you want and what you can put up with for the rest of your life. Take a man for example; most men pick women that will or willing to do what the man find interesting So if he likes camping, he definitely wants a woman that can handle herself with or without bug spray, he may be into comic books or even action figures but he wants someone that will appreciate the things he is into. So most of us women will conform to his comic books, water rafting, expensive action figure collections, just in the hopes of getting the ring and the chance to say "I Do". Then suddenly years later you find his comic book collections childish, or his outdoor living a waste of time, remember conformity does not mean permanent so the love of your life may not be what you really thought. Which is why it is really important to have a relationship with someone that you can adjust to in the highs and lows.

So my advice would be when you meet that guy who you have an instant attraction to, don't be so quick to accept his number but do the reverse and take his number. This is important for the beginning of what you want in a relationship and what type of man would be right for you and it allows you to be in control from the beginning to the end.

You might say that doesn't make sense, I have given many guys my number and they have called me, true but do you remember a time when you would come home and check your voicemail, or check your cell phone every five minutes hoping that he called, or get excited

when you see an unidentified number on your phone and you were hoping it was him, only to find out it was the wrong number. If you take the guy number not only are you in control of your emotions but you can call on your time, and you can ponder if this guy is worth going out with. This will also give the guy time to think about you more and to know that you are in control and will decide what is best for you. Many of you will probably for go this advice but those who see the altar at the end of the tunnel or a lasting relationship will be willing to do what it takes to get the right relationship.

Now before you take his number he must qualify to take you out or to see you again, there has to be questions involved, and the questions are totally up to you, you may say I know this but think back when you lost your mind looking into those gorgeous eyes of his or his rock hard body and forgot to ask important questions. I would highly suggest to stick with the basic questions; it safe ground and it is easy to talk about. The must have questions as you know are 1. There are no guarantees but you want to limit yourself from being hurt as much as possible. Newly broken up relationships are a high risk than those who have been out of a relationship more than seven months, if you go with the six month it still a chance that the

two may get back together because it is only half way through the year but if you hit the seven month mark which is closer to a year it may be workable, usually by then the couples have started seeing other people.

Now once you have asked those very few important questions gladly take the number and then you can think on your time if you want to call the guy or not. Is this guy worth your valuable time? It is okay to size the guy up because this is your heart we are talking about here. Also don't feel like you are being desperate by taking the other guy number, if this guy really wants to get to know you chances are they will wait on your call.

FIRST CALL TELL THE GUY WHAT YOU WANT

Now that you have decided to accept the number and pondered about this guy being a possibility of getting to know. It is time to make the call, timing is everything. It seems really silly but men do it all the time (not all men) but most men will call a week or two later as to not to seem desperate, or some will call the very same day or even in the same hour, it just depends on how much they are willing to get to know you. First rule is not to call on the weekend, sure you may say "I don't play games like that, I want somebody who is able to speak whenever", and the truth is all relationships are a game sort of speak. I'll prove it, when you are out with a date and you notice a beautiful woman before your mate spots the guy, you have already built up scenarios in your mind as what you will do if he does or doesn't react, or leaving hints about your birthday wanting the guy to make sure he didn't forget and if he did you have a tongue lashing for guy. errands. Calling in the morning is not good either, this suggest that you have the guy on your mind already and it is only 9: 15 a.m. in the morning. This screams desperation don't do it but calling after five in the late afternoon but not after eight in the evening lets the guy know that one you had respect enough for him to finish out his day, two, that you may have been busy yourself, even if you were not, and three it gives the guy time to actually settle down for the day and have time to talk to you.

Now if the guy does not answer don't panic or assume that the guy is not interested, just leave a message, clearly caller I.D and voicemail will prove that you did call but if the guy picks up the phone; let the questions begin. The most important question that should be asked after you get all the other small questions out the way is, "What type of relationship are you looking for"? This question is the deal breaker. If the response to the question goes something like this "Oh I am just looking to date and see if I can find somebody to hang out with" or my favorite line I laugh at all the time, "I am just looking for a friend right now" news flash! The big red button should be going off right about now. Clearly this guy is not looking for nothing serious, just someone to have fun with and go out for drinks. Now if you think you can handle that and most women truly cannot, bid your farewells. The answer should be along the lines of "I am looking for the right one that I can build a relationship with", "I am looking for someone that I can have a lasting relationship with", "I am looking for someone that I can settle down with", or "I am looking for someone that I can take home to my parents", it doesn't have to be those exact words but the words should state that a long relationship or marriage is in the picture. (Don't worry he must back up those words, we will talk about that later).

Once you have those correct words then you can move forward and let the guy know that you are looking for a long lasting relationship or marriage in the future. This will scare some away but those who are serious will not skip out, this must be discuss to ensure a relationship of truth and possible marriage. Somewhere in your mind you think he has dumped you, so you make yourself believe that he might be in an accident or laying in a hospital wondering why you have not called him, or maybe he had a death in his family and he just was too upset to call you. So you decide to call and all the while in the back of your mind you're saying to yourself "if he is okay I'll kill him". So you call and he answers. There is no trembling in his voice, he doesn't even sound upset or devastated. So why in the world did he not call! Well you can ask him but I am pretty sure you not going to like his answer. He might tell you he had to work overtime for the past week or so, he lost track of time with all the things going on in his life, or my favorite he just haven't gotten around to calling you yet. Whatever the reason, he made a clear cut decision in his mind that you were not top priority, it doesn't mean he doesn't care or he is not interested in you. It just mean that he did not call. So you think now he is cheating, so your mind start to think all types of things.

Listen even if he was cheating or he had a legitimate reason for not calling you for a week or two, the main thing to remember is your still testing this guy out. Your values and integrity are at stake here. It is up to you and your instinct to flip the off switch if you believe he is cheating (follow your instincts).

Don't give yourself headaches arguing and fighting with a guy who may not be worth it. At this stage you are in you are only dating the guy after the initial call. Which brings me to what the values and integrity is all about. Never! Ever! Call the guy. Why you say! Because you will upset yourself and bring confusion to your mind about the guy. Don't interfere in his performance. Let this guy show you who you are to him.

Keep yourself occupied. A guy like to know that a woman has a life outside of him. If your always calling him he is going to start to think that you're crazy about him (most guys get a swell brain from being so vain). Set values for yourself if you can't set values or have integrity to know that you deserve the best then you leave yourself open to allowing the guy to have power over you.

Here is the first rule and it is simply DON'T CALL HIM. Let him do all the calling or communicating. Do not contact him in any form. (There are some shades of gray and I will get to that later). You must stay in control, by doing this you are lessening the hurt that goes with relationships.

- 1. You are allowed to call him once you have decided to invest your time in him.
- 2. Don't kid yourself and communicate with him in any other way, let him do all the communication.
- 3. If he calls and you miss his call, don't panic just wait until he calls you back (he will) This allow the guy to be intrigued on why you have not called back, it will also allow the guy to miss you more, and he will want to spend more time with you.
- 4. Try to end every phone call.
 - We women love to talk for hours to the man of our dreams or at least who we really like but it is important not to be too needy or clingy. Some women are offended when the men decides to get off the phone before the conversation is over and so therefore her feelings are hurt. Her insecurity levels start to drop. Just end the phone call just when the conversation is getting really good. This will have him thinking about you all night, this will peak his curiosity about you even more and he will start to have you on his mind more.
- 5. If his calling waiting comes up and he says "hold on" tell him that he can just call you back later.
 - Now you're saying I have gone too far. Not at all, think about this if you hold on and he does not come back to you in a fair time or forget you all together, guess what, yes ma am you're going to be upset. It's best to have him call you back this will allow him not to be obligated to get back to you right away and you are showing him that he has the freedom to talk to someone else without feeling like he has to talk to you all

- the time. It also help you which is the important thing. It is to allow you to see how he will respond to putting you on hold, and if he calls you back right away. Remember you are looking at his performance to see if he is the one you want to be with. This allows him to see that you are not a clingy person and that you have a life as well and that it is in your best interest that he takes the call because you have other things to do. Now if he insist that you hold but put a limit on it, I say less than two minutes and if he does not come back in that time frame, hang up. He will call you back.
- 6. Now if your call waiting clicks in, then you should ask him if you can call him back or if he can hold. Make sure you ask if you can call him back first. This way you're sending a message that you are entitled to privacy and you do not expect him to hold. You want to send a message to let him know that he is free to say goodbye. Give him that option. You do not want him to feel like you are dominating the conversation.
- 7. Make sure if you are having a good time talking limit the call to 45 minutes, remember you don't want to seem desperate and lonely.
- 8. If the guy starts hold a conversation with other people while he is talking to you, immediately end the phone call. You want this guy to know you will not tolerate being disrespected and ignored. If he wants to talk to other people let this guy do it on his time and not yours.
- 9. DO NOT TAKE EVERY PHONE CALL! DO NOT TAKE EVERY TEXT! Save some mystery about you.
- 10. Do not accept phones calls after 10 p.m. (if it is an emergency he will leave a message) this also let the guy know that you are not going to tolerate being disturbed after hours. Any calls after 10 p.m. are usually booty calls or wet dream reminders (this include texting as well). The key is to have him respect you and know that you have morals and values.
- 11. DO NOT ACCEPT DATES BY TEXT! It is important to keep him respecting you, a text is a sign of informal conversation and you guys are just starting out. Besides you don't know if he sent out a mass text to ten girls to see which one would respond. You are not a number but you want to be admired, respected and treated like a woman, not a chicken in a coop with other chicken.

On your first phone call remember to tell him what you want and what you expect. Maybe you're the type of woman that prefer dating only at night because you work in the day time or you prefer to pay for your own meals on a date. When the guy understand that you mean what you say and you say what you mean, he will be more respectful toward you and will let you know early on whether or not he wants to be bothered with you. The key is to weed out the losers and dead weight.

FIRST STAGE OF DATING RULES/30 DAYS

Now we are getting to the meat and potatoes, you have taken the number and called the right one that you believe will be a long term partner and now it is time for you to start dating the guy. I have a few rules that apply to this as well. The key is to be in control so that it will be less hurtful in case the guy is not the right one and to keep your emotions in check. We don't want you to be crawled up in a corner breathing and sobbing heavy over a guy, now do we.

The rules are very simple in what you expect and will do, old fashion ways still do exist. He must show you respect on your date. Look out for signs of respect such as opening a door for you, maybe pulling out your chair, making sure you are protected by not allowing people to bump into you. I understand that we are in a new age world full of technology but the old fashion stuff still works. When a man respect you he will show it in many ways and it is important to see if he respects you enough to do at least one of those things (among other stuff). A man who is constantly in his cell phone, texting while you're on date with him is trouble from the start. A man who doesn't regard you and walks in front of you or enters in first through the door is not worth your time. If you are giving him respect, why can't he give it to you? Watch were he sits as well, if he sits next to you instead of across from you then this guy is a keeper. Clearly he wants to be close to you. A guy who constantly watches the door of an establishment is looking out for something or someone. So be careful with this guy. It could be a bag of paranoid jitters but whatever it is, keep a close watch on this guy or it could be protection from the unknown. It would be hard to tell on the first date. So keep your eyes open on this one.

I don't know about you but I would prefer for my date to pay, why? I am glad you ask. If you believe that this guy could be the one, then you should allow him to invest his time and money into you. A man that invest his time and money into something is usually wanting to get

something out of it long term. If this guy can pick you up and pull through a drive-thru burger joint and park his car and turn on some music to get what he wants out of you, well then he didn't invest very much and he knows he has you and he knows he won't have to work so hard to keep you or get you. Remember a man that invest his money and time into you is not only expecting some goodies in return but some time from you as well. (Hint a no good guy won't stick around very long, so you'll know in due time).

In the first stage of dating please refrain from going over his house and inviting him to yours. I don't care how good the date is going. Let this guy linger in thought about how good the date was and you should expect his phone call the next day.

I know this might sound silly but let the guy have you in by 10:30 p.m. or 11 p.m. he needs to know that you are a busy woman and that you have a life. This will also let the guy know that you're not with the booty hook-up type. (Trust me it will work)

Please if you decide to go out on a work night; I would suggest a brunch date or a date that ends early, even before 10 p.m. this guy needs to know that your career and life is important and one night date should not change that.

If you are a woman with transportation then I highly suggest that you meet this guy out and not have him pick you up. Only after seven days of dating is it okay. By then you would have some idea if this guy is a creep. If no transportation your first date should be in the day time in a crowd of people, or if at night do a double date or meet him with a group. The key is to make sure you are protected and that you feel safe and comfortable.

This rule is a rule that might be broken on the first or second date but trust me if you follow through he will want you even more. The rule is no kissing on the first date. That sounds simply enough but let me add 29 more days with that. That is correct and 29 is not a typo. Heck! Many women usually give in and give up the goodies on the 30th day. It is important to see rather or not this guy is really into you. If this guy believes that he cannot even get a goodnight kiss on the lips after three dates then this guy won't be able to stick around for the goodies later on. You need to find out as much about this guy as possible. Remember it easy to kiss when both of you guys private parts are working over-time but when ten dates in you find out he has someone else or his moving back to Europe then all that kissing was just to sow your wild sex dreams. If you

guys are dating and he is texting and calling you, there should be some indication if this guy is still a keeper. Now it is okay if the guy kisses you on the cheek or even gives you a hug but when lips and saliva is involved, you might want to wait to make sure you are not dating a pervert.

After the 30 days of waiting if you are still dating and you feel comfortable enough to kiss him, then I would suggest, go for it!

I don't know about you but I have done this because I was bored or just excited to go out with the guy. Well, maybe you haven't did it but I have gone out on dates at the last minute. I have learned this is a big no-no. No woman wants to be on stand-by. You are trying to keep your integrity and values in check. If you accept this date then you might as well have sex with him on the same night (of course not just making a point). You're saying that I am desperate and I have nothing else to do. No one wants to take me out anyway, so why not have a whirl at me. I want you to let this guy appreciate at you and respect you at all times and besides if this guy is calling you up for a date at the last minute, then he might not be worth it after all. It is those thirty days of dating that are very crucial in making a decision to give up the goodies.

Christian women you are not allowed to give up the goodies until marriage but it does not mean that you should go out at the last minute either. Christian women are extra vulnerable to their self because of the waiting that it is involved for her husband, I truly believe it is important for her to take her time and go extra slow. Not only is she looking at losing her integrity and values but her relationship with God. I hate to say it but many Christian women rush in very quickly when it comes to dating. Once she gives her life to God she has decided to give up her old ways of catching a man and she now has to go by the laws of God and stop fornication all together. This is not easy when you are used to fornicating on a regular. So she rushes in and date any Joe and now she has to repent and start her lesson all over again. If she just would slow down and follow the rules of God and wait it out then she would be better off. I will discuss with the Christian woman about dating outside the church. You may be surprised at my recommendation.

Next this goes with the rule above and that is, he must call a day before at least to ask you out on a date. He must recognize that you are to be respected and appreciated and that you have a life as well. (Even if you don't).

As time goes on you will see with the rules that he will even start to ask you out a week in advance. (Sounds exciting doesn't it! But this is no time to be excited this is all about staying in control of your emotions).

Now that you are going on the date at this point he should be asking you what it is that you like to do. Remember he is investing his money and time. So he should be open to your suggestions. If the guy has already pre-planned the date, then you may be in for a little trouble. This guy clearly believes he knows what will make you happy, which suggest he has done this routine before and remember you are not a stand-by type of woman. He needs to respect your choices.

It is important for this guy to get to know you and who you are and if you two will be compatible. This is the crucial time on knowing whether to sex or not to sex. (Not for Christian ladies of course). The guy that plans the date, what meals you will eat, and what movie to see and so on is not interested in what you want only to do the date to get to the goodies but if your that type of girl that like that type of take charge man. Then get ready for the rest of your life to be controlled and manipulated.

Now it would also be a good idea to compromise on what the two of you would like to do at least this way you two can work together and that is what a relationship is all about working together.

Next rule is always mistaken as a sign of being a Bad Boy or a Rough Guy. I would suggest no second date if the guy is forceful during the date. Now if you are acquainted with this on a regular basis. Then I would say go for it. If you know you want a guy to cuddle you and treat you tenderly then don't look back after the first date is over. Dump the guy. This is a sure sign of a couple of things. One he may be physically abusive; this to someone is a sign of taking charge but that is a wrong misconception that we women have had for years. No woman wants to be physically pushed upon, (not a woman with integrity) or treated non-existent or if the guy is forceful it may be a sign that he may be a male chauvinist and believes the woman has a certain place but it is not equal with him. If this is for you again go for it. Don't bend the rules to accommodate a man just because you are attracted to him and you are lonely. Believe me you will be wishing you dump the guy years back.

These last rules are pretty quick to learn and simple enough and that is no second date if he constantly stay in his phone, rather it is texting, talking, or checking his email or Facebook (just

plan rude). It is simply rude and your just a goodie bag he picked up and so he is not looking for long term. No excuses. If he gives you one, then he should had reschedule the date to devote his attention to you. No second date if he is forceful, rude, obnoxious, disrespectful, flirtatious and a pervert.

If you feel offended because of a comment or a gesture no second date, a man generally tells you how he feels by what he does.

If the guy doesn't communicate ABSOLUTELY no second date.

If he talks about himself all during the date without wanting to know you. Cut the date short and no SECOND DATE.

If this guy talks about sex all during the date no second date. This guy clearly is telling you what is on his mind, we women usually just shrug off the comments because we figure that he is just being a man but the truth is a man should have respect for the woman he is dating.

If he receive calls from his ex and you clearly know this because he is so rude to answer the phone in front of you and ruder to tell you that she called. This is a good enough sign that there is no second date at all and to cut the first date short. You may say that this is common sense but I have witnessed and been a victim myself to this type of situation. Until the man is completely over his ex and have his past relationship cut off from the root then there is no need to continue on with him, unless you just play it very slow and I mean very slow to see if the situation gets worse or if it was an isolated incident.

The next is very clear and pertains to the above problem. If your date is constantly talking about his ex and even comparing you to her. Then definitely no second date. He is there to get to know you not to fill you in on his ex's business.

If the guy get wasted (drunk)...please have a little dignity about yourself. The guy showed you who he really is and what the future holds for you and him but if you like getting wasted all the time then PERFECT!

If he is embarrassing you if front of people, friends or family. Then end the date before him. Keep your dignity intact. If he doesn't care about embarrassing you then you should not care about embarrassing him in leaving. (Slam the door hard too) Remember you have morals and values and the right man deserve to have you.

If you have to pick the guy up for your first date, then please don't go. It is the man job to win you over. He must go above and beyond and not take the easy way out. This guy needs to figure out a way to meet you instead of picking him up. It would also be a good idea to find out why this guy has no transportation. If he gives you some excuse such as I believe in saving the environment and he does everything to show you that is not true, then you just go sucker punched. If he says that his car is in the shop, then wait until his car is out. This guy job at the end of the day is to win you over and that mean going above and beyond. If he has to rent horse and carriage to get you across the downtown area, or if he borrow a car, or even rent a car for the date he needs to show you he is willing to do what it takes to have you. You may say what if the guy just doesn't have the money? Well, I would suggest that you meet him and let him catch the bus, why go out of your way and give him help in dating you. That doesn't make sense. He need and must show you he is willing to see you no matter what.

The next two are very important and many women shrug it off their shoulders and come up with many excuses for him. Number one, if he is very late for the date and shows up with some excuse and no text or call to tell you he will be late. You have options here. You can cut the date short and give him an excuse to why you have to leave. (If he wanted to spend time with you he should have made it possible). But what if his poor grandmother was rush to the ER you say. Well like I said you have options. You can 1. Tell him that you're leaving and make arrangements some other time (I say seven days later and you decide what day and time) 2. Cut the date short as I said early 3. Continue the date but no second date for at least two weeks. This guy needs to know that you are not just sitting around and waiting on him at every late excuse. If you are willing to give him a pass on the first date, just what do you think will happen with the other dates?

Next if the guy is a NO SHOW. He doesn't call, no text or any communication at all to let you know that he is not coming. NO SECOND DATE and DO NOT CALL HIM. Well what if something horrible has happened to him. If that is the case missy why in the world would he be taking your call anyway? I would suggest waiting it out. It is that possibility that something could have happened but it is not up to you to find out. Remember you are on your first date not

your 10th year anniversary. If the guy never calls again, I pretty much can tell you that if something did happen, you will probably be informed via Facebook or some other media outlet. If the guy calls you the next day or later. Then you can breathe easy and take his phone call and decide for yourself if you want to be bothered after he gives you an excuse of why he did a no show. If the guy does not have an excuse then cut the conversation short and hang up. You deserve to be treated with respect. Remember it is your emotions that are on the line here and don't give this guy the satisfaction of continue to stay on the phone, if he texts you it still applies.

Any flirtation of any kind is a complete NO SECOND DATE. PERIOD.

Remember when I told you if the guy is cheap and he will not splurge on a nice dinner or lunch, don't waste your time if you prefer to have a man that will wine you and dine you. A man that orders appetizer only may be cheap or may just want the date to end sooner than you want. The only way to know for sure is if the conversation is limited on his end and he seems uncomfortable, irritated or lost in his own world. Please end the date before he do. This is about keeping your emotions in check and not allowing your confidence to be lowered because of a man who is not interested in you.

Lastly if the guy is cheap on the date and you are not into dating cheap guys. Then keep it moving and don't look back. Cheap does not mean bad or a terrible person. It just mean simple he is cheap. This man knows what he wants to do with his money and he is not willing to bend his rules to accommodate you so remember not to bend your rules to accommodate him. If you know you want to be pampered with great dinners and outings then I would suggest no second date but if this does not bother you and you find the guy to be a true gentleman, nice, polite and respectful. I say go for it. Just don't bend the rules to accommodate him either.

ONCE YOU ARE PAST THE SECOND DATE RULE

I know these rules may be somewhat overwhelming but I believe it is because we as women are not use to setting rules for ourselves. We must have boundaries in

order to get what we really want. There are a lot of women who will just settle for someone that pays them the slightest attention. This is very dangerous and I recommend if you are that person or know someone that is, then you should continue to read on. I want you to recognize that you are a woman that deserve good in her life. It doesn't matter if you think you are not as attractive as some other woman, or your weight is not what society says it should be, or if you have been hurt so many times you are just giving up and taking the first snaggle tooth guy that comes along. NO! This is about controlling your emotions enough that you can make an intelligent decision if you want to continue on with the guy you think is right for you. My mother always said "There somebody for everybody." If you wait and follow the rules you may just get the right one.

Let's run through the rules after the second date, I try to make it quick.

- 1. Holding hands is affirmative. It shows the guy that you are interested and do show some physical attraction to him.
- 2. Hugging is okay too.
- 3. Double dating on the second date is allowed if you are still not sure where this guy head is at. Better safe than sorry.
- 4. No out of town dates. This suggest that you are very trusting of him and that your morals and values are few. Give the guy some mystery about you and the trip will be there down the road if he is the one.
- 5. Believe it or not you can do domesticated things. I say it is never too early to find out where this guy is at on living arrangements. How does he handle grocery shopping, laundry or buying things for his place? These things are important to know and you're just knowing a little early.

- 6. Please DO NOT MEET THE PARENTS. It is way too soon to decide if he is the one that you want in his life forever. You have not even had a chance to know him yet, so how will be able to get know the parents.
- 7. Please if this guy has kids and you want to meet them, please wait until after the first kiss. Kids are not leverage but they do have feelings. You have to make sure that this guy is right for you and if he is a perfect fit in your world. Throwing his kids into the relationship to soon can cause chaos and confusion on your feelings about the guy. Because you're no longer thinking logically but now you're thinking domestically. Dreaming of what it would be like to have a family and such. BIG NO! And when do the first kiss come into play. I will get to that soon.
- 8. Sex is a big NO! If you're looking for just a good time. Fine but don't accept flower and candy afterward. Jeez. You just gave up the most powerful weapon to fight with. That is right! Yourself. Okay fine, I will give you the answer. Since you're really wondering when you should have sex. The answer is at least hundred-eighty two days. That is half the year. Oh wow! I can hear the name calling you are giving me right now. Some of you are probably rolling your eyes at me as you are reading this but let me tell you why. First 30 days is not enough time to know someone and if they are capable for you. 60 days you are just finding about his life and his ways. 90 days you are finally meeting family and friends and going on trips or outings together but you are not sure about his other side. What is he like when he gets really angry, how he reacts to hard situations in life? Is there a chance that his ex may come back into his life? You see right now you are in the fun stage. Life is good, you two are hanging out and doing wonderful things together. You are not seeing all his sides and that is the most important thing. If you must have sex and your body is just craving for a slice of a

man I would suggest at least the 90 days but don't say I did not warn you if he flips out on you or decide to get back with his ex. Now Christian women this does not apply to you because you know perfectly well you are supposed to wait until you have sealed the deal with the I do's. Getting an engagement ring is not enough, remember man will go through great lengths at time to have you, no matter the cost. It is your duty to God to make sure it is done the right way. Well you say if I what that long then he might leave. Well he was going to leave anyway after he tap the goods dear. All you did was speed up the process of him leaving anyway. Now if he decides to marry you in six months. This is going to sound crazy and go against what seems like everything I said but GO AHEAD! It is better to marry early than to burn in hell later. NO OFFENSE you non-Christian women but the Christian woman know exactly what I am talking about.

THE 90 DAY LIST OF WHAT TO LOOK FOR

Gather all the data and make your analysis. This time is a crucial time for you to make a decision if this guy is for you or not. If you should have sex or not. So here we go.

- 1. How does he handle his money?
- 2. How does he keep is place?
- 3. What type of work ethics does he have?
- 4. What are his hobbies?
- 5. How does he handle children and do he want any children?
- 6. How does he treat his parents and sibling?
- 7. How does he treat you around his friends?
- 8. How does he treat you in public?
- 9. How does he treat your pets and kids?

- 10. How do he handle his bills?
- 11. How does he maintain his appearance?
- 12. How does he handle baby momma drama?
- 13. HOW DOES HE TREAT YOU?
- 14. How are his dating habits now since he started dating you?
- 15. How does he handle time?

FIRST STAGE OF DATING AND 30 DAYS AFTER THE KISS

Now you have your answer my dear. It will take 30 days before he first kiss. Calm down! I will bend the rules for you if you are hot and heavy lipped. I say 15 days for you who just can't hold your tongue in your mouth. Kissing a guy full tongue throttle is a no-no on the first date and second date period! - 7. Do he believe in marriage?
- 8. For you Christian women. Do he believe in God?
- 9. Do he attend church?

You need to know about his domestic life style and if they are lining up with want you want. Remember this is how two movie stars that will remain nameless got divorce. If only they would have found out before they married.

For example

- 1. What are his values on raising children?
- 2. How does he feel about divorce?
- 3. What are his view on women in the work place and women making more money than men?
- 4. What are his views on politics?
- 5. What are his views on education?
- 6. Does he like pornography?
- 7. What does he believe in various sex acts?
- 8. What are his views on you having male friends?
- 9. What are his views on wife vs. his mother?

You need to know where he sees himself in five years and are you included in that. He should even ask him where does he see himself in ten years and if he is talking as if he is still single in ten years. You may have a problem before the 30 days is out.

Please ask the guy questions it doesn't hurt to ask him about his dreams and goals and if he would like to travel and such. I remember asking a guy some of these questions and you know what the guy was talking only about what he it would be like to do this and that and none of it include a spouse and today the

guy is still single. Now if you want to include some of these questions in the 90 day trial then fine. You and only you know your limitation and what you can handle.

SECOND STAGE OF DATING 180 DAYS/TESTING HIS ABILITIES

Now that you are in the 180 days mark things are looking up and it is a very strong possibility that he may be the one for now! But you must test his abilities. Talk is wasteful but action is gold! It is time for the guy to put his words into action. This is the only way to know if he is telling the truth or not. Men know that women like to hear those good things that would make them drop their underwear and slip under the covers but ladies stop doing that. Words are useless if there is no action behind it. By now you guys should have went on many dates and met friends and family and even each other kids. Now is the time to see if this guy is husband material or co-habitation material.

- ✓ Test the guy on his financial smarts.
- ✓ Test the guy how does he handle kids
- ✓ See how he respond when you're under the weather
- ✓ Is he willing to go to church or church functions
- ✓ See if he will pray with you or for you
- ✓ See if he will come to your rescue if you have car problems or need a item in your house fixed
- ✓ Test his loyalty to you
- ✓ See if he really is supportive of you
- ✓ Test him on his goals
- ✓ See how he acts under pressure
- ✓ See how he acts when he has problems
- ✓ See how he deals with his anger

✓ Test him on his patience
