Atonement

Isaiah 43

[26] Put me in remembrance: let us plead together: declare thou, that thou mayest be justified.

Exodus 34

[6] And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth,

Number 7

[89] And when Moses was gone into the tabernacle of the congregation to speak with him, then he heard the voice of one speaking unto him from off the mercy seat that was upon the ark of testimony, from between the two cherubims: and he spake unto him.

Genesis 18

[23] And Abraham drew near, and said, Wilt thou also destroy the righteous with the wicked?

[24] Peradventure there be fifty righteous within the city: wilt thou also destroy and not spare the place for the fifty righteous that are therein? [25] That be far from thee to do after this manner, to slay the righteous with the wicked: and that the righteous should be as the wicked, that be far from thee: Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?

[26] And the LORD said, If I find in Sodom fifty righteous within the city, then I will spare all the place for their sakes.

[27] And Abraham answered and said, Behold now, I have taken upon me to speak unto the Lord, which am but dust and ashes:

[28] Peradventure there shall lack five of the fifty righteous: wilt thou destroy all the city for lack of five? And he said, If I find there forty and five, I will not destroy it.

[29] And he spake unto him yet again, and said, Peradventure there shall be forty found there. And he said, I will not do it for forty's sake.

[30] And he said unto him, Oh let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak: Peradventure there shall thirty be found there. And he said, I will not do it, if I find thirty there.

[31] And he said, Behold now, I have taken upon me to speak unto the Lord: Peradventure there shall be twenty found there. And he said, I will not destroy it for twenty's sake.

[32] And he said, Oh let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak yet but this once: Peradventure ten shall be found there. And he said, I will not destroy it for ten's sake.

Leviticus 6

[24] And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

[25] Speak unto Aaron and to his sons, saying, This is the law of the sin offering: In the place where the burnt offering is killed shall the sin offering be killed before the LORD: it is most holy.

[26] The priest that offereth it for sin shall eat it: in the holy place shall it be eaten, in the court of the tabernacle of the congregation.

Leviticus 7

[7] As the sin offering is, so is the trespass offering: there is one law for them: the priest that maketh atonement therewith shall have it.

2 Samuel 24

[25] And David built there an altar unto the LORD, and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. So the LORD was intreated for the land, and the plague was stayed from Israel.

Numbers 16

[46] And Moses said unto Aaron, Take a censer, and put fire therein from off the altar, and put on incense, and go quickly unto the congregation, and make an atonement for them: for there is wrath gone out from the LORD; the plague is begun.

[47] And Aaron took as Moses commanded, and ran into the midst of the congregation; and, behold, the plague was begun among the people: and he put on incense, and made an atonement for the people. [48] And he stood between the dead and the living; and the plague was stayed.

1 Kings 8

[35] When heaven is shut up, and there is no rain, because they have sinned against thee; if they pray toward this place, and confess thy name, and turn from their sin, when thou afflictest them:

[36] Then hear thou in heaven, and forgive the sin of thy servants, and of thy people Israel, that thou teach them the good way wherein they should walk, and give rain upon thy land, which thou hast given to thy people for an inheritance.

[37] If there be in the land famine, if there be pestilence, blasting, mildew, locust, or if there be caterpillar; if their enemy besiege them in the land of their cities; whatsoever plague, whatsoever sickness there be;

[38] What prayer and supplication soever be made by any man, or by all thy people Israel, which shall know every man the plague of his own heart, and spread forth his hands toward this house:

[39] Then hear thou in heaven thy dwelling place, and forgive, and do, and give to every man according to his ways, whose heart thou knowest; (for thou, even thou only, knowest the hearts of all the children of men;)

Psalms 69

[30] I will praise the name of God with a song, and will magnify him with thanksgiving.

[31] This also shall please the LORD better than an ox or bullock that hath horns and hoofs.

Psalms 107

[22] And let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare his works with rejoicing.

Hosea 6

[6] For I desired mercy, and not sacrifice; and the knowledge of God more than burnt offerings.

Psalms 86

[5] For thou, Lord, art good, and ready to forgive; and plenteous in mercy unto all them that call upon thee.

Proverbs 28

[13] He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy.

Psalms 51

[16] For thou desirest not sacrifice; else would I give it: thou delightest not in burnt offering.

[17] The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise.

Joel 2

[12] Therefore also now, saith the LORD, turn ye even to me with all your heart, and with fasting, and with weeping, and with mourning: [13] And rend your heart, and not your garments, and turn unto the LORD your God: for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repenteth him of the evil.

[14] Who knoweth if he will return and repent, and leave a blessing behind him; even a meat offering and a drink offering unto the LORD your God?

Isaiah 58

[6] Is not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke?

[7] Is it not to deal thy bread to the hungry, and that thou bring the poor that are cast out to thy house? when thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and that thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh? [8] Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy reward.

2 Chronicles 33

[12] And when he was in affliction, he besought the LORD his God, and humbled himself greatly before the God of his fathers,

[13] And prayed unto him: and he was intreated of him, and heard his supplication, and brought him again to Jerusalem into his kingdom. Then Manasseh knew that the LORD he was God.

Psalms 22

[24] For he hath not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; neither hath he hid his face from him; but when he cried unto him, he heard.

Job 34

[28] So that they cause the cry of the poor to come unto him, and he heareth the cry of the afflicted.

Psalms 107

[17] Fools because of their transgression, and because of their iniquities, are afflicted.

[18] Their soul abhorreth all manner of meat; and they draw near unto the gates of death.

[19] Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and he saveth them out of their distresses.

[20] He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.

Psalms 55

[17] Evening, and morning, and at noon, will I pray, and cry aloud: and he shall hear my voice.

Nehemiah 9

[9] And didst see the affliction of our fathers in Egypt, and heardest their cry by the Red sea;

Psalms 119

[165] Great peace have they which love thy law: and nothing shall offend them.

Psalms 16

[8] I have set the LORD always before me: because he is at my right hand, I shall not be moved.

[9] Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoiceth: my flesh also shall rest in hope.

[10] For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.

Psalms 125

[1] They that trust in the LORD shall be as mount Zion, which cannot be removed, but abideth for ever.

Isaiah 26

[3] Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.

Psalms 91

[9] Because thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation;

[10] There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.

[11] For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.

[12] They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone.

[13] Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet.

2 Chronicles 30

[18] For a multitude of the people, even many of Ephraim, and Manasseh, Issachar, and Zebulun, had not cleansed themselves, yet did they eat the passover otherwise than it was written. But Hezekiah prayed for them, saying, The good LORD pardon every one

[19] That prepareth his heart to seek God, the LORD God of his fathers, though he be not cleansed according to the purification of the sanctuary.

[20] And the LORD hearkened to Hezekiah, and healed the people.

Numbers 11

[1] And when the people complained, it displeased the LORD: and the LORD heard it; and his anger was kindled; and the fire of the LORD burnt among them, and consumed them that were in the uttermost parts of the camp.

[2] And the people cried unto Moses; and when Moses prayed unto the LORD, the fire was quenched.

Job 42

[7] And it was so, that after the LORD had spoken these words unto Job, the LORD said to Eliphaz the Temanite, My wrath is kindled against thee, and against thy two friends: for ye have not spoken of me the thing that is right, as my servant Job hath.

[8] Therefore take unto you now seven bullocks and seven rams, and go to my servant Job, and offer up for yourselves a burnt offering; and my servant Job shall pray for you: for him will I accept: lest I deal with you after your folly, in that ye have not spoken of me the thing which is right, like my servant Job.

Proverbs 14

[22] Do they not err that devise evil? but mercy and truth shall be to them that devise good.

Daniel 4

[27] Wherefore, O king, let my counsel be acceptable unto thee, and break off thy sins by righteousness, and thine iniquities by shewing mercy to the poor; if it may be a lengthening of thy tranquillity.

Isaiah 55

[7] Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the LORD, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon.

Ezekiel 18

[21] But if the wicked will turn from all his sins that he hath committed, and keep all my statutes, and do that which is lawful and right, he shall surely live, he shall not die.

Proverbs 29

[25] The fear of man bringeth a snare: but whoso putteth his trust in the LORD shall be safe.

Proverbs 30

[5] Every word of God is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him.

Psalms 5

[11] But let all those that put their trust in thee rejoice: let them ever shout for joy, because thou defendest them: let them also that love thy name be joyful in thee.

Psalms 22

[4] Our fathers trusted in thee: they trusted, and thou didst deliver them.

[5] They cried unto thee, and were delivered: they trusted in thee, and were not confounded.

Psalms 25

[20] O keep my soul, and deliver me: let me not be ashamed; for I put my trust in thee.

Psalms 34

[22] The LORD redeemeth the soul of his servants: and none of them that trust in him shall be desolate.

Psalms 37

[40] And the LORD shall help them and deliver them: he shall deliver them from the wicked, and save them, because they trust in him.

Psalms 32

[10] Many sorrows shall be to the wicked: but he that trusteth in the LORD, mercy shall compass him about.

Jeremiah 17

[7] Blessed is the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is.

[8] For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and that spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh, but her leaf shall be green; and shall not be careful in the year of drought, neither shall cease from yielding fruit.

Isaiah 26

[4] Trust ye in the LORD for ever: for in the LORD JEHOVAH is everlasting strength:

Proverbs 20

[22] Say not thou, I will recompense evil; but wait on the LORD, and he shall save thee.

Psalms 37

[7] Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for him: fret not thyself because of him who prospereth in his way, because of the man who bringeth wicked devices to pass.

Psalms 25

[3] Yea, let none that wait on thee be ashamed: let them be ashamed which transgress without cause.

Psalms 33

[20] Our soul waiteth for the LORD: he is our help and our shield.

Psalms 27

[14] Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.

Isaiah 40

[31] But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

Lamentations 3

[26] It is good that a man should both hope and quietly wait for the salvation of the LORD.

Micah 7

[7] Therefore I will look unto the LORD; I will wait for the God of my salvation: my God will hear me.

Isaiah 64

[4] For since the beginning of the world men have not heard, nor perceived by the ear, neither hath the eye seen, O God, beside thee, what he hath prepared for him that waiteth for him.

Isaiah 9

[12] The Syrians before, and the Philistines behind; and they shall devour Israel with open mouth. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand is stretched out still.

[13] For the people turneth not unto him that smiteth them, neither do they seek the LORD of hosts.

Lamentations 3

[25] The LORD is good unto them that wait for him, to the soul that seeketh him.

Psalms 9

[10] And they that know thy name will put their trust in thee: for thou, LORD, hast not forsaken them that seek thee.

Psalms 119

[2] Blessed are they that keep his testimonies, and that seek him with the whole heart.

[3] They also do no iniquity: they walk in his ways.

Isaiah 55

[6] Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near:

Nehemiah 5

[9] Also I said, It is not good that ye do: ought ye not to walk in the fear of our God because of the reproach of the heathen our enemies?

Proverbs 16

[6] By mercy and truth iniquity is purged: and by the fear of the LORD men depart from evil.

Malachi 4

[2] But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.

Psalms 145

[19] He will fulfil the desire of them that fear him: he also will hear their cry, and will save them.

Psalms 103

[11] For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him.

Psalms 103

[17] But the mercy of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children's children;

Psalms 118

[4] Let them now that fear the LORD say, that his mercy endureth for ever.

Psalms 103

[13] Like as a father pitieth his children, so the LORD pitieth them that fear him.

Malachi 3

[16] Then they that feared the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name.

[17] And they shall be mine, saith the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him.

Psalms 85

[9] Surely his salvation is nigh them that fear him; that glory may dwell in our land.

Psalms 34

[7] The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them.

Psalms 147

[11] The LORD taketh pleasure in them that fear him, in those that hope in his mercy.

Psalms 31

[19] Oh how great is thy goodness, which thou hast laid up for them that fear thee; which thou hast wrought for them that trust in thee before the sons of men!

[20] Thou shalt hide them in the secret of thy presence from the pride of man: thou shalt keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues.

Eccl 7

[15] All things have I seen in the days of my vanity: there is a just man that perisheth in his righteousness, and there is a wicked man that longeth his life in his wickedness.

[16] Be not righteous over much; neither make thyself over wise: why shouldst thou destroy thyself?

[17] Be not over much wicked, neither be thou foolish: why shouldst thou die before thy time?

[18] It is good that thou shouldst take hold of this; yea, also from this withdraw not thine hand: for he that feareth God shall come forth of them all.

Eccl 8

[12] Though a sinner do evil an hundred times, and his days be prolonged, yet surely I know that it shall be well with them that fear God, which fear before him:

Micah 7

[20] Thou wilt perform the truth to Jacob, and the mercy to Abraham, which thou hast sworn unto our fathers from the days of old.

Psalms 119

[76] Let, I pray thee, thy merciful kindness be for my comfort, according to thy word unto thy servant.

Isaiah 49

[13] Sing, O heavens; and be joyful, O earth; and break forth into singing, O mountains: for the LORD hath comforted his people, and will have mercy upon his afflicted.

Psalms 107

[41] Yet setteth he the poor on high from affliction, and maketh him families like a flock.

Proverbs 3

[11] My son, despise not the chastening of the LORD; neither be weary of his correction:

[12] For whom the LORD loveth he correcteth; even as a father the son in whom he delighteth.

Psalms 62

[12] Also unto thee, O Lord, belongeth mercy: for thou renderest to every man according to his work.

Proverbs 3

[3] Let not mercy and truth forsake thee: bind them about thy neck; write them upon the table of thine heart:

[4] So shalt thou find favour and good understanding in the sight of God and man.

2 Samuel 22

[33] God is my strength and power: and he maketh my way perfect.

1 Samuel 15

[22] And Samuel said, Hath the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams.

Psalms 4

[5] Offer the sacrifices of righteousness, and put your trust in the LORD.

Daniel 9

[4] And I prayed unto the LORD my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God, keeping the covenant and mercy to them that love him, and to them that keep his commandments;

Psalms 25

[10] All the paths of the LORD are mercy and truth unto such as keep his covenant and his testimonies.

Psalms 119

[153] Consider mine affliction, and deliver me: for I do not forget thy law.

Psalms 34

[19] Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but the LORD delivereth him out of them all.

Prevent Death

Psalms 41

[1] Blessed is he that considereth the poor: the LORD will deliver him in time of trouble.

[2] The LORD will preserve him, and keep him alive; and he shall be blessed upon the earth: and thou wilt not deliver him unto the will of his enemies.

Jeremiah 39

[16] Go and speak to Ebed-melech the Ethiopian, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will bring my words upon this city for evil, and not for good; and they shall be accomplished in that day before thee.

[17] But I will deliver thee in that day, saith the LORD: and thou shalt not be given into the hand of the men of whom thou art afraid.

[18] For I will surely deliver thee, and thou shalt not fall by the sword, but thy life shall be for a prey unto thee: because thou hast put thy trust in me, saith the LORD.

Daniel 3

[28] Then Nebuchadnezzar spake, and said, Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-nego, who hath sent his angel, and delivered his servants that trusted in him, and have changed the king's word, and yielded their bodies, that they might not serve nor worship any god, except their own God.

Psalms 33

[18] Behold, the eye of the LORD is upon them that fear him, upon them that hope in his mercy;

[19] To deliver their soul from death, and to keep them alive in famine.

Psalms 91

[14] Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name.

[15] He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.

[16] With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation.

Psalms 145

[20] The LORD preserveth all them that love him: but all the wicked will he destroy.

Blessings

Exodus 20

[24] An altar of earth thou shalt make unto me, and shalt sacrifice thereon thy burnt offerings, and thy peace offerings, thy sheep, and thine oxen: in all places where I record my name I will come unto thee, and I will bless thee.

1 Kings 3

[4] And the king went to Gibeon to sacrifice there; for that was the great high place: a thousand burnt offerings did Solomon offer upon that altar.

[5] In Gibeon the LORD appeared to Solomon in a dream by night: and God said, Ask what I shall give thee.

2 Samuel 7

[1] And it came to pass, when the king sat in his house, and the LORD had given him rest round about from all his enemies;

[2] That the king said unto Nathan the prophet, See now, I dwell in an house of cedar, but the ark of God dwelleth within curtains.

[3] And Nathan said to the king, Go, do all that is in thine heart; for the LORD is with thee.

[4] And it came to pass that night, that the word of the LORD came unto Nathan, saying,

[5] Go and tell my servant David, Thus saith the LORD, Shalt thou build me an house for me to dwell in?

[6] Whereas I have not dwelt in any house since the time that I brought up the children of Israel out of Egypt, even to this day, but have walked in a tent and in a tabernacle.

[7] In all the places wherein I have walked with all the children of Israel spake I a word with any of the tribes of Israel, whom I commanded to feed my people Israel, saying, Why build ye not me an house of cedar?

[8] Now therefore so shalt thou say unto my servant David, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, I took thee from the sheepcote, from following the sheep, to be ruler over my people, over Israel:

[9] And I was with thee whithersoever thou wentest, and have cut off all thine enemies out of thy sight, and have made thee a great name, like unto the name of the great men that are in the earth.

[10] Moreover I will appoint a place for my people Israel, and will plant them, that they may dwell in a place of their own, and move no more; neither shall the children of wickedness afflict them any more, as beforetime,

[11] And as since the time that I commanded judges to be over my people Israel, and have caused thee to rest from all thine enemies. Also the LORD telleth thee that he will make thee an house.

[12] And when thy days be fulfilled, and thou shalt sleep with thy fathers, I will set up thy seed after thee, which shall proceed out of thy bowels, and I will establish his kingdom.

[13] He shall build an house for my name, and I will stablish the throne of his kingdom for ever.

[14] I will be his father, and he shall be my son. If he commit iniquity, I will chasten him with the rod of men, and with the stripes of the children of men:

[15] But my mercy shall not depart away from him, as I took it from Saul, whom I put away before thee.

[16] And thine house and thy kingdom shall be established for ever before thee: thy throne shall be established for ever.

1 Samuel 2

[20] And Eli blessed Elkanah and his wife, and said, The LORD give thee seed of this woman for the loan which is lent to the LORD. And they went unto their own home.

[21] And the LORD visited Hannah, so that she conceived, and bare three sons and two daughters. And the child Samuel grew before the LORD.

Deuteronomy 24

[19] When thou cuttest down thine harvest in thy field, and hast forgot a sheaf in the field, thou shalt not go again to fetch it: it shall be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow: that the LORD thy God may bless thee in all the work of thine hands.

Proverbs 22

[9] He that hath a bountiful eye shall be blessed; for he giveth of his bread to the poor.

Deuteronomy 15

[7] If there be among you a poor man of one of thy brethren within any of thy gates in thy land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not harden thine heart, nor shut thine hand from thy poor brother:

[8] But thou shalt open thine hand wide unto him, and shalt surely lend him sufficient for his need, in that which he wanteth.

[9] Beware that there be not a thought in thy wicked heart, saying, The seventh year, the year of release, is at hand; and thine eye be evil against thy poor brother, and thou givest him nought; and he cry unto the LORD against thee, and it be sin unto thee.

[10] Thou shalt surely give him, and thine heart shall not be grieved when thou givest unto him: because that for this thing the LORD thy God shall bless thee in all thy works, and in all that thou puttest thine hand unto.

[11] For the poor shall never cease out of the land: therefore I command thee, saying, Thou shalt open thine hand wide unto thy brother, to thy poor, and to thy needy, in thy land.

Proverbs 28

[27] He that giveth unto the poor shall not lack: but he that hideth his eyes shall have many a curse.

Isaiah 58

[10] And if thou draw out thy soul to the hungry, and satisfy the afflicted soul; then shall thy light rise in obscurity, and thy darkness be as the noonday:

[11] And the LORD shall guide thee continually, and satisfy thy soul in drought, and make fat thy bones: and thou shalt be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters fail not.

Psalms 84

[11] For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.

Proverbs 3

[33] The curse of the LORD is in the house of the wicked: but he blesseth the habitation of the just.

Proverbs 22

[1] A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, and loving favour rather than silver and gold.

Genesis 30

[13] And Leah said, Happy am I, for the daughters will call me blessed: and she called his name Asher.

2 Samuel 6

[12] And it was told king David, saying, The LORD hath blessed the house of Obed-edom, and all that pertaineth unto him, because of the ark of God. So David went and brought up the ark of God from the house of Obed-edom into the city of David with gladness.

Proverbs 12

[14] A man shall be satisfied with good by the fruit of his mouth: and the recompence of a man's hands shall be rendered unto him.

1 Chronicles 29

[20] And David said to all the congregation, Now bless the LORD your God. And all the congregation blessed the LORD God of their fathers, and bowed down their heads, and worshipped the LORD, and the king.

Job 29

[1] Moreover Job continued his parable, and said,

[2] Oh that I were as in months past, as in the days when God preserved me;

- [3] When his candle shined upon my head, and when by his light I walked through darkness;
- [4] As I was in the days of my youth, when the secret of God was upon my tabernacle;
- [5] When the Almighty was yet with me, when my children were about me;
- [6] When I washed my steps with butter, and the rock poured me out rivers of oil;
- [7] When I went out to the gate through the city, when I prepared my seat in the street!
- [8] The young men saw me, and hid themselves: and the aged arose, and stood up.
- [9] The princes refrained talking, and laid their hand on their mouth.
- [10] The nobles held their peace, and their tongue cleaved to the roof of their mouth.
- [11] When the ear heard me, then it blessed me; and when the eye saw me, it gave witness to me:
- [12] Because I delivered the poor that cried, and the fatherless, and him that had none to help him.
- [13] The blessing of him that was ready to perish came upon me: and I caused the widow's heart to sing for joy.
- [14] I put on righteousness, and it clothed me: my judgment was as a robe and a diadem.
- [15] I was eyes to the blind, and feet was I to the lame.
- [16] I was a father to the poor: and the cause which I knew not I searched out.
- [17] And I brake the jaws of the wicked, and plucked the spoil out of his teeth.
- [18] Then I said, I shall die in my nest, and I shall multiply my days as the sand.

Deuteronomy 33

- [1] And this is the blessing, wherewith Moses the man of God blessed the children of Israel before his death.

Leviticus 9

- [22] And Aaron lifted up his hand toward the people, and blessed them, and came down from offering of the sin offering, and the burnt offering, and peace offerings.

Joshua 22

[6] So Joshua blessed them, and sent them away: and they went unto their tents.

1 Chronicles 16

[2] And when David had made an end of offering the burnt offerings and the peace offerings, he blessed the people in the name of the LORD.

Deuteronomy 21

[5] And the priests the sons of Levi shall come near; for them the LORD thy God hath chosen to minister unto him, and to bless in the name of the LORD; and by their word shall every controversy and every stroke be tried:

2 Chronicles 30

[27] Then the priests the Levites arose and blessed the people: and their voice was heard, and their prayer came up to his holy dwelling place, even unto heaven.

Genesis 27

[24] And he said, Art thou my very son Esau? And he said, I am.

[25] And he said, Bring it near to me, and I will eat of my son's venison, that my soul may bless thee. And he brought it near to him, and he did eat: and he brought him wine, and he drank.

[26] And his father Isaac said unto him, Come near now, and kiss me, my son.

[27] And he came near, and kissed him: and he smelled the smell of his raiment, and blessed him, and said, See, the smell of my son is as the smell of a field which the LORD hath blessed:

[28] Therefore God give thee of the dew of heaven, and the fatness of the earth, and plenty of corn and wine:

[29] Let people serve thee, and nations bow down to thee: be lord over thy brethren, and let thy mother's sons bow down to thee: cursed be every one that curseth thee, and blessed be he that blesseth thee.

Genesis 48

[8] And Israel beheld Joseph's sons, and said, Who are these?

[9] And Joseph said unto his father, They are my sons, whom God hath given me in this place. And he said, Bring them, I pray thee, unto me, and I will bless them.

Genesis 47

[7] And Joseph brought in Jacob his father, and set him before Pharaoh: and Jacob blessed Pharaoh.

Job 31

[19] If I have seen any perish for want of clothing, or any poor without covering;

[20] If his loins have not blessed me, and if he were not warmed with the fleece of my sheep;

1 Samuel 25

[32] And David said to Abigail, Blessed be the LORD God of Israel, which sent thee this day to meet me:

[33] And blessed be thy advice, and blessed be thou, which hast kept me this day from coming to shed blood, and from avenging myself with mine own hand.

Nehemiah 11

[1] And the rulers of the people dwelt at Jerusalem: the rest of the people also cast lots, to bring one of ten to dwell in Jerusalem the holy city, and nine parts to dwell in other cities.

[2] And the people blessed all the men, that willingly offered themselves to dwell at Jerusalem.

2 Samuel 2

[4] And the men of Judah came, and there they anointed David king over the house of Judah. And they told David, saying, That the men of Jabesh-gilead were they that buried Saul.

[5] And David sent messengers unto the men of Jabesh-gilead, and said unto them, Blessed be ye of the LORD, that ye have shewed this kindness unto your lord, even unto Saul, and have buried him.

[6] And now the LORD shew kindness and truth unto you: and I also will requite you this kindness, because ye have done this thing.

Psalms 34

[8] O taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him.

Isaiah 26

[3] Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.

Psalms 125

[1] They that trust in the LORD shall be as mount Zion, which cannot be removed, but abideth for ever.

Proverbs 29

[25] The fear of man bringeth a snare: but whoso putteth his trust in the LORD shall be safe.

Proverbs 30

[5] Every word of God is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him.

Psalms 5

[11] But let all those that put their trust in thee rejoice: let them ever shout for joy, because thou defendest them: let them also that love thy name be joyful in thee.

Psalms 22

[4] Our fathers trusted in thee: they trusted, and thou didst deliver them.

[5] They cried unto thee, and were delivered: they trusted in thee, and were not confounded.

Psalms 37

[40] And the LORD shall help them and deliver them: he shall deliver them from the wicked, and save them, because they trust in him.

Jeremiah 17

[7] Blessed is the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is.

[8] For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and that spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh, but her leaf shall be green; and shall not be careful in the year of drought, neither shall cease from yielding fruit.

Isaiah 26

[4] Trust ye in the LORD for ever: for in the LORD JEHOVAH is everlasting strength:

Psalms 31

[19] Oh how great is thy goodness, which thou hast laid up for them that fear thee; which thou hast wrought for them that trust in thee before the sons of men!

2 Kings 18

[5] He trusted in the LORD God of Israel; so that after him was none like him among all the kings of Judah, nor any that were before him.

Proverbs 22

[19] That thy trust may be in the LORD, I have made known to thee this day, even to thee.

Isaiah 30

[18] And therefore will the LORD wait, that he may be gracious unto you, and therefore will he be exalted, that he may have mercy upon you: for the LORD is a God of judgment: blessed are all they that wait for him.

Psalms 33

[20] Our soul waiteth for the LORD: he is our help and our shield.

Psalms 27

[14] Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.

Isaiah 40

[31] But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

Lamentations 3

[26] It is good that a man should both hope and quietly wait for the salvation of the LORD.

Micah 7

[7] Therefore I will look unto the LORD; I will wait for the God of my salvation: my God will hear me.

Isaiah 64

[4] For since the beginning of the world men have not heard, nor perceived by the ear, neither hath the eye seen, O God, beside thee, what he hath prepared for him that waiteth for him.

Lamentations 3

[25] The LORD is good unto them that wait for him, to the soul that seeketh him.

Psalms 9

[10] And they that know thy name will put their trust in thee: for thou, LORD, hast not forsaken them that seek thee.

Psalms 119

[2] Blessed are they that keep his testimonies, and that seek him with the whole heart.

[3] They also do no iniquity: they walk in his ways.

Psalms 34

[10] The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek the LORD shall not want any good thing.

2 Chronicles 26

[5] And he sought God in the days of Zechariah, who had understanding in the visions of God: and as long as he sought the LORD, God made him to prosper.

2 Chronicles 14

[7] Therefore he said unto Judah, Let us build these cities, and make about them walls, and towers, gates, and bars, while the land is yet before us; because we have sought the LORD our God, we have sought him, and he hath given us rest on every side. So they built and prospered.

Proverbs 28

[5] Evil men understand not judgment: but they that seek the LORD understand all things.

Isaiah 55

[6] Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near:

Psalms 111

[5] He hath given meat unto them that fear him: he will ever be mindful of his covenant.

Psalms 115

[13] He will bless them that fear the LORD, both small and great.

Proverbs 31

[30] Favour is deceitful, and beauty is vain: but a woman that feareth the LORD, she shall be praised.

Nehemiah 7

[2] That I gave my brother Hanani, and Hananiah the ruler of the palace, charge over Jerusalem: for he was a faithful man, and feared God above many.

Exodus 1

[21] And it came to pass, because the midwives feared God, that he made them houses.

Job 1

[1] There was a man in the land of Uz, whose name was Job; and that man was perfect and upright, and one that feared God, and eschewed evil.

Psalms 25

[14] The secret of the LORD is with them that fear him; and he will shew them his covenant.

Psalms 34

[9] O fear the LORD, ye his saints: for there is no want to them that fear him.

Proverbs 3

[7] Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil.

[8] It shall be health to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones.

Proverbs 14

[27] The fear of the LORD is a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death.

Proverbs 13

[13] Whoso despiseth the word shall be destroyed: but he that feareth the commandment shall be rewarded.

Malachi 4

[2] But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.

Proverbs 19

[23] The fear of the LORD tendeth to life: and he that hath it shall abide satisfied; he shall not be visited with evil.

Proverbs 14

[26] In the fear of the LORD is strong confidence: and his children shall have a place of refuge.

Psalms 128

[1] Blessed is every one that feareth the LORD; that walketh in his ways.

[2] For thou shalt eat the labour of thine hands: happy shalt thou be, and it shall be well with thee.

[3] Thy wife shall be as a fruitful vine by the sides of thine house: thy children like olive plants round about thy table.

[4] Behold, that thus shall the man be blessed that feareth the LORD.

[5] The LORD shall bless thee out of Zion: and thou shalt see the good of Jerusalem all the days of thy life.

[6] Yea, thou shalt see thy children's children, and peace upon Israel.

Psalms 112

[1] Praise ye the LORD. Blessed is the man that feareth the LORD, that delighteth greatly in his commandments.

[2] His seed shall be mighty upon earth: the generation of the upright shall be blessed.

Psalms 103

[11] For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him.

Psalms 103

[17] But the mercy of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children's children; [18] To such as keep his covenant, and to those that remember his commandments to do them.

Malachi 3

[16] Then they that feared the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name.

[17] And they shall be mine, saith the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him.

Haggai 1

[12] Then Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, with all the remnant of the people, obeyed the voice of the LORD their God, and the words of Haggai the prophet, as the LORD their God had sent him, and the people did fear before the LORD.

[13] Then spake Haggai the LORD's messenger in the LORD's message unto the people, saying, I am with you, saith the LORD.

Psalms 145

[19] He will fulfil the desire of them that fear him: he also will hear their cry, and will save them.

Psalms 85

[9] Surely his salvation is nigh them that fear him; that glory may dwell in our land.

Psalms 34

[7] The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them.

Isaiah 33

[6] And wisdom and knowledge shall be the stability of thy times, and strength of salvation: the fear of the LORD is his treasure.

Psalms 16

[8] I have set the LORD always before me: because he is at my right hand, I shall not be moved.

[9] Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoiceth: my flesh also shall rest in hope.

[10] For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.

[11] Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence is fulness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore.

Psalms 91

[9] Because thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation;

[10] There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.

[11] For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.

[12] They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone.

[13] Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet.

Psalms 91

[14] Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name.

[15] He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.

[16] With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation.

Isaiah 58

[6] Is not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke?

[7] Is it not to deal thy bread to the hungry, and that thou bring the poor that are cast out to thy house? when thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and that thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh? [8] Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy rereward.

Isaiah 56

[2] Blessed is the man that doeth this, and the son of man that layeth hold on it; that keepeth the sabbath from polluting it, and keepeth his hand from doing any evil.

Proverbs 8

[34] Blessed is the man that heareth me, watching daily at my gates, waiting at the posts of my doors.

[35] For whoso findeth me findeth life, and shall obtain favour of the LORD.

Proverbs 8

[32] Now therefore hearken unto me, O ye children: for blessed are they that keep my ways.

Psalms 94

[12] Blessed is the man whom thou chastenest, O LORD, and teachest him out of thy law;

[13] That thou mayest give him rest from the days of adversity, until the pit be digged for the wicked.

Psalms 1

[1] Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

[2] But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.

[3] And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

Psalms 119

[165] Great peace have they which love thy law: and nothing shall offend them.

Psalms 32

[1] Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.

Psalms 32

[2] Blessed is the man unto whom the LORD imputeth not iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no guile.

Psalms 65

[4] Blessed is the man whom thou chooseth, and causeth to approach unto thee, that he may dwell in thy courts: we shall be satisfied with the goodness of thy house, even of thy holy temple.

Psalms 84

[4] Blessed are they that dwell in thy house: they will be still praising thee. Selah.

Psalms 84

[5] Blessed is the man whose strength is in thee; in whose heart are the ways of them.

[6] Who passing through the valley of Baca make it a well; the rain also filleth the pools.

[7] They go from strength to strength, every one of them in Zion appeareth before God.

Psalms 72

[17] His name shall endure for ever: his name shall be continued as long as the sun: and men shall be blessed in him: all nations shall call him blessed.

Psalms 89

[15] Blessed is the people that know the joyful sound: they shall walk, O LORD, in the light of thy countenance.

[16] In thy name shall they rejoice all the day: and in thy righteousness shall they be exalted.

[17] For thou art the glory of their strength: and in thy favour our horn shall be exalted.

[18] For the LORD is our defence; and the Holy One of Israel is our king.

Psalms 106

[3] Blessed are they that keep judgment, and he that doeth righteousness at all times.

Ecclesiastes 10

[17] Blessed art thou, O land, when thy king is the son of nobles, and thy princes eat in due season, for strength, and not for drunkenness!

Psalms 118

[26] Blessed be he that cometh in the name of the LORD: we have blessed you out of the house of the LORD.

Psalms 92

[4] For thou, LORD, hast made me glad through thy work: I will triumph in the works of thy hands.

Psalms 102

[28] The children of thy servants shall continue, and their seed shall be established before thee.

Isaiah 54

[17] No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is of me, saith the LORD.

Micah 7

[20] Thou wilt perform the truth to Jacob, and the mercy to Abraham, which thou hast sworn unto our fathers from the days of old.

Proverbs 28

[20] A faithful man shall abound with blessings: but he that maketh haste to be rich shall not be innocent.

Genesis 12

[1] Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee:

[2] And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing:

[3] And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.

Deuteronomy 28

[1] And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the LORD thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth:

[2] And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God.

[3] Blessed shalt thou be in the city, and blessed shalt thou be in the field.

[4] Blessed shall be the fruit of thy body, and the fruit of thy ground, and the fruit of thy cattle, the increase of thy kine, and the flocks of thy sheep.

[5] Blessed shall be thy basket and thy store.

[6] Blessed shalt thou be when thou comest in, and blessed shalt thou be when thou goest out.

[7] The LORD shall cause thine enemies that rise up against thee to be smitten before thy face: they shall come out against thee one way, and flee before thee seven ways.

[8] The LORD shall command the blessing upon thee in thy storehouses, and in all that thou settest thine hand unto; and he shall bless thee in the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

[9] The LORD shall establish thee an holy people unto himself, as he hath sworn unto thee, if thou shalt keep the commandments of the LORD thy God, and walk in his ways.

[10] And all people of the earth shall see that thou art called by the name of the LORD; and they shall be afraid of thee.

[11] And the LORD shall make thee plenteous in goods, in the fruit of thy body, and in the fruit of thy cattle, and in the fruit of thy ground, in the land which the LORD sware unto thy fathers to give thee.

[12] The LORD shall open unto thee his good treasure, the heaven to give the rain unto thy land in his season, and to bless all the work of thine hand: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow.

Psalms 119

[1] Blessed are the undefiled in the way, who walk in the law of the LORD.

Psalms 37

[25] I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread.

[26] He is ever merciful, and lendeth; and his seed is blessed.

Proverbs 20

[7] The just man walketh in his integrity: his children are blessed after him.

Proverbs 23

[24] The father of the righteous shall greatly rejoice: and he that begetteth a wise child shall have joy of him.

[25] Thy father and thy mother shall be glad, and she that bare thee shall rejoice.

Psalms 5

[12] For thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield.

Proverbs 11

[19] As righteousness tendeth to life: so he that pursueth evil pursueth it to his own death.

Proverbs 11

[18] The wicked worketh a deceitful work: but to him that soweth righteousness shall be a sure reward.

Psalms 92

[12] The righteous shall flourish like the palm tree: he shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon.

Proverbs 21

[21] He that followeth after righteousness and mercy findeth life, righteousness, and honour.

Psalms 118

[15] The voice of rejoicing and salvation is in the tabernacles of the righteous: the right hand of the LORD doeth valiantly.

Isaiah 32

[17] And the work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance for ever.

Psalms 75

[10] All the horns of the wicked also will I cut off; but the horns of the righteous shall be exalted.

Proverbs 10

[24] The fear of the wicked, it shall come upon him: but the desire of the righteous shall be granted.

Prayers Answered

1 Kings 8

[38] What prayer and supplication soever be made by any man, or by all thy people Israel, which shall know every man the plague of his own heart, and spread forth his hands toward this house:

[39] Then hear thou in heaven thy dwelling place, and forgive, and do, and give to every man according to his ways, whose heart thou knowest; (for thou, even thou only, knowest the hearts of all the children of men;)

2 Samuel 24

[25] And David built there an altar unto the LORD, and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. So the LORD was intreated for the land, and the plague was stayed from Israel.

1 Samuel 7

[9] And Samuel took a sucking lamb, and offered it for a burnt offering wholly unto the LORD: and Samuel cried unto the LORD for Israel; and the LORD heard him.

2 Chronicles 33

[12] And when he was in affliction, he besought the LORD his God, and humbled himself greatly before the God of his fathers,

[13] And prayed unto him: and he was intreated of him, and heard his supplication, and brought him again to Jerusalem into his kingdom. Then Manasseh knew that the LORD he was God.

Psalms 118

[5] I called upon the LORD in distress: the LORD answered me, and set me in a large place.

Psalms 102

[17] He will regard the prayer of the destitute, and not despise their prayer.

Psalms 107

[4] They wandered in the wilderness in a solitary way; they found no city to dwell in.

[5] Hungry and thirsty, their soul fainted in them.

[6] Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and he delivered them out of their distresses.

Psalms 107

[17] Fools because of their transgression, and because of their iniquities, are afflicted.

[18] Their soul abhorreth all manner of meat; and they draw near unto the gates of death.

[19] Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and he saveth them out of their distresses.

[20] He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.

Psalms 55

[17] Evening, and morning, and at noon, will I pray, and cry aloud: and he shall hear my voice.

1 Chronicles 5

[20] And they were helped against them, and the Hagarites were delivered into their hand, and all that were with them: for they cried to God in the battle, and he was intreated of them; because they put their trust in him.

Psalms 37

[5] Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass.

Job 42

[7] And it was so, that after the LORD had spoken these words unto Job, the LORD said to Eliphaz the Temanite, My wrath is kindled against thee, and against thy two friends: for ye have not spoken of me the thing that is right, as my servant Job hath.

[8] Therefore take unto you now seven bullocks and seven rams, and go to my servant Job, and offer up for yourselves a burnt offering; and my servant Job shall pray for you: for him will I accept: lest I deal with you after your folly, in that ye have not spoken of me the thing which is right, like my servant Job.

Genesis 25

[21] And Isaac intreated the LORD for his wife, because she was barren: and the LORD was intreated of him, and Rebekah his wife conceived.

Genesis 20

[17] So Abraham prayed unto God: and God healed Abimelech, and his wife, and his maidservants; and they bare children.

Numbers 11

[1] And when the people complained, it displeased the LORD: and the LORD heard it; and his anger was kindled; and the fire of the LORD burnt among them, and consumed them that were in the uttermost parts of the camp.

[2] And the people cried unto Moses; and when Moses prayed unto the LORD, the fire was quenched.

2 Chronicles 30

[18] For a multitude of the people, even many of Ephraim, and Manasseh, Issachar, and Zebulun, had not cleansed themselves, yet did they eat the passover otherwise than it was written. But Hezekiah prayed for them, saying, The good LORD pardon every one

[19] That prepareth his heart to seek God, the LORD God of his fathers, though he be not cleansed according to the purification of the sanctuary.

[20] And the LORD hearkened to Hezekiah, and healed the people.

Proverbs 15

[29] The LORD is far from the wicked: but he heareth the prayer of the righteous.

Guidance

Psalms 27

[4] One thing have I desired of the LORD, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and to inquire in his temple.

Judges 20

[18] And the children of Israel arose, and went up to the house of God, and asked counsel of God, and said, Which of us shall go up first to the battle against the children of Benjamin? And the LORD said, Judah shall go up first.

Judges 18

[5] And they said unto him, Ask counsel, we pray thee, of God, that we may know whether our way which we go shall be prosperous.

[6] And the priest said unto them, Go in peace: before the LORD is your way wherein ye go.

2 Kings 8

[8] And the king said unto Hazael, Take a present in thine hand, and go, meet the man of God, and inquire of the LORD by him, saying, Shall I recover of this disease?

[10] And if thou draw out thy soul to the hungry, and satisfy the afflicted soul; then shall thy light rise in obscurity, and thy darkness be as the noonday:

[11] And the LORD shall guide thee continually, and satisfy thy soul in drought, and make fat thy bones: and thou shalt be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters fail not.

Proverbs 3

[5] Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.

[6] In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

Genesis 46

[1] And Israel took his journey with all that he had, and came to Beer-sheba, and offered sacrifices unto the God of his father Isaac.

[2] And God spake unto Israel in the visions of the night, and said, Jacob, Jacob. And he said, Here am I.

[3] And he said, I am God, the God of thy father: fear not to go down into Egypt; for I will there make of thee a great nation:

[4] I will go down with thee into Egypt; and I will also surely bring thee up again: and Joseph shall put his hand upon thine eyes.

Numbers 23

[1] And Balaam said unto Balak, Build me here seven altars, and prepare me here seven oxen and seven rams.

[2] And Balak did as Balaam had spoken; and Balak and Balaam offered on every altar a bullock and a ram.

[3] And Balaam said unto Balak, Stand by thy burnt offering, and I will go: peradventure the LORD will come to meet me: and whatsoever he sheweth me I will tell thee. And he went to an high place.

[4] And God met Balaam: and he said unto him, I have prepared seven altars, and I have offered upon every altar a bullock and a ram.

[5] And the LORD put a word in Balaam's mouth, and said, Return unto Balak, and thus thou shalt speak.

2 Kings 3

[11] But Jehoshaphat said, Is there not here a prophet of the LORD, that we may inquire of the LORD by him? And one of the king of Israel's servants answered and said, Here is Elisha the son of Shaphat, which poured water on the hands of Elijah.

1 Samuel 9

[8] And the servant answered Saul again, and said, Behold, I have here at hand the fourth part of a shekel of silver: that will I give to the man of God, to tell us our way.

[9] (Beforetime in Israel, when a man went to inquire of God, thus he spake, Come, and let us go to the seer: for he that is now called a Prophet was beforetime called a Seer.

Benefits of Trusting in the Lord

Isaiah 26

[3] Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.

Psalms 125

[1] They that trust in the LORD shall be as mount Zion, which cannot be removed, but abideth for ever.

Proverbs 29

[25] The fear of man bringeth a snare: but whoso putteth his trust in the LORD shall be safe.

Proverbs 30

[5] Every word of God is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him.

Psalms 5

[11] But let all those that put their trust in thee rejoice: let them ever shout for joy, because thou defendest them: let them also that love thy name be joyful in thee.

Psalms 22

[4] Our fathers trusted in thee: they trusted, and thou didst deliver them.

[5] They cried unto thee, and were delivered: they trusted in thee, and were not confounded.

Psalms 25

[20] O keep my soul, and deliver me: let me not be ashamed; for I put my trust in thee.

Psalms 37

[40] And the LORD shall help them and deliver them: he shall deliver them from the wicked, and save them, because they trust in him.

Psalms 34

[22] The LORD redeemeth the soul of his servants: and none of them that trust in him shall be desolate.

Psalms 32

[10] Many sorrows shall be to the wicked: but he that trusteth in the LORD, mercy shall compass him about.

Jeremiah 17

[7] Blessed is the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is.

[8] For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and that spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh, but her leaf shall be green; and shall not be careful in the year of drought, neither shall cease from yielding fruit.

Isaiah 26

[4] Trust ye in the LORD for ever: for in the LORD JEHOVAH is everlasting strength:

2 Kings 18

[5] He trusted in the LORD God of Israel; so that after him was none like him among all the kings of Judah, nor any that were before him.

Proverbs 22

[19] That thy trust may be in the LORD, I have made known to thee this day, even to thee.

1 Chronicles 5

[20] And they were helped against them, and the Hagarites were delivered into their hand, and all that were with them: for they cried to God in the battle, and he was intreated of them; because they put their trust in him.

Psalms 37

[5] Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass.

Proverbs 3

[5] Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.

[6] In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

2 Chronicles 30

[18] For a multitude of the people, even many of Ephraim, and Manasseh, Issachar, and Zebulun, had not cleansed themselves, yet did they eat the passover otherwise than it was written. But Hezekiah prayed for them, saying, The good LORD pardon every one

[19] That prepareth his heart to seek God, the LORD God of his fathers, though he be not cleansed according to the purification of the sanctuary.

[20] And the LORD hearkened to Hezekiah, and healed the people.

Isaiah 9

[12] The Syrians before, and the Philistines behind; and they shall devour Israel with open mouth. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand is stretched out still.

[13] For the people turneth not unto him that smiteth them, neither do they seek the LORD of hosts.

Lamentations 3

[25] The LORD is good unto them that wait for him, to the soul that seeketh him.

Psalms 9

[10] And they that know thy name will put their trust in thee: for thou, LORD, hast not forsaken them that seek thee.

Psalms 119

[2] Blessed are they that keep his testimonies, and that seek him with the whole heart.

[3] They also do no iniquity: they walk in his ways.

Isaiah 55

[6] Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near:

Psalms 34

[10] The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek the LORD shall not want any good thing.

2 Chronicles 26

[5] And he sought God in the days of Zechariah, who had understanding in the visions of God: and as long as he sought the LORD, God made him to prosper.

2 Chronicles 14

[7] Therefore he said unto Judah, Let us build these cities, and make about them walls, and towers, gates, and bars, while the land is yet before us; because we have sought the LORD our God, we have sought him, and he hath given us rest on every side. So they built and prospered.

Proverbs 28

[5] Evil men understand not judgment: but they that seek the LORD understand all things.

Deuteronomy 4

[29] But if from thence thou shalt seek the LORD thy God, thou shalt find him, if thou seek him with all thy heart and with all thy soul.

Benefits of Waiting on the Lord

Proverbs 20

[22] Say not thou, I will recompense evil; but wait on the LORD, and he shall save thee.

Psalms 37

[7] Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for him: fret not thyself because of him who prospereth in his way, because of the man who bringeth wicked devices to pass.

Psalms 25

[3] Yea, let none that wait on thee be ashamed: let them be ashamed which transgress without cause.

Psalms 33

[20] Our soul waiteth for the LORD: he is our help and our shield.

Psalms 27

[14] Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.

Isaiah 40

[31] But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

Lamentations 3

[26] It is good that a man should both hope and quietly wait for the salvation of the LORD.

Micah 7

[7] Therefore I will look unto the LORD; I will wait for the God of my salvation: my God will hear me.

Isaiah 64

[4] For since the beginning of the world men have not heard, nor perceived by the ear, neither hath the eye seen, O God, beside thee, what he hath prepared for him that waiteth for him.

Isaiah 30

[18] And therefore will the LORD wait, that he may be gracious unto you, and therefore will he be exalted, that he may have mercy upon you: for the LORD is a God of judgment: blessed are all they that wait for him.

[25] The LORD is good unto them that wait for him, to the soul that seeketh him.

Nehemiah 5

[9] Also I said, It is not good that ye do: ought ye not to walk in the fear of our God because of the reproach of the heathen our enemies?

Proverbs 16

[6] By mercy and truth iniquity is purged: and by the fear of the LORD men depart from evil.

Malachi 4

[2] But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.

Psalms 145

[19] He will fulfil the desire of them that fear him: he also will hear their cry, and will save them.

Psalms 103

[11] For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him.

Psalms 103

[17] But the mercy of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children's children;

Psalms 118

[4] Let them now that fear the LORD say, that his mercy endureth for ever.

Psalms 103

[13] Like as a father pitieth his children, so the LORD pitieth them that fear him.

Malachi 3

[16] Then they that feared the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name.

[17] And they shall be mine, saith the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him.

Psalms 85

[9] Surely his salvation is nigh them that fear him; that glory may dwell in our land.

Psalms 34

[7] The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them.

Psalms 147

[11] The LORD taketh pleasure in them that fear him, in those that hope in his mercy.

Psalms 31

[19] Oh how great is thy goodness, which thou hast laid up for them that fear thee; which thou hast wrought for them that trust in thee before the sons of men!

[20] Thou shalt hide them in the secret of thy presence from the pride of man: thou shalt keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues.

Eccl 7

[15] All things have I seen in the days of my vanity: there is a just man that perisheth in his righteousness, and there is a wicked man that prolongeth his life in his wickedness.

[16] Be not righteous over much; neither make thyself over wise: why shouldest thou destroy thyself?

[17] Be not over much wicked, neither be thou foolish: why shouldest thou die before thy time?

[18] It is good that thou shouldest take hold of this; yea, also from this withdraw not thine hand: for he that feareth God shall come forth of them all.

Eccl 8

[12] Though a sinner do evil an hundred times, and his days be prolonged, yet surely I know that it shall be well with them that fear God, which fear before him:

Psalms 111

[5] He hath given meat unto them that fear him: he will ever be mindful of his covenant.

Psalms 115

[13] He will bless them that fear the LORD, both small and great.

Proverbs 31

[30] Favour is deceitful, and beauty is vain: but a woman that feareth the LORD, she shall be praised.

Nehemiahh 7

[2] That I gave my brother Hanani, and Hananiah the ruler of the palace, charge over Jerusalem: for he was a faithful man, and feared God above many.

Exodus 1

[21] And it came to pass, because the midwives feared God, that he made them houses.

Job 1

[1] There was a man in the land of Uz, whose name was Job; and that man was perfect and upright, and one that feared God, and eschewed evil.

Psalms 25

[14] The secret of the LORD is with them that fear him; and he will shew them his covenant.

Psalms 34

[9] O fear the LORD, ye his saints: for there is no want to them that fear him.

Proverbs 3

[7] Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil.

[8] It shall be health to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones.

Proverbs 14

[27] The fear of the LORD is a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death.

[5] The LORD shall bless thee out of Zion: and thou shalt see the good of Jerusalem all the days of thy life.

[6] Yea, thou shalt see thy children's children, and peace upon Israel.

Psalms 112

[1] Praise ye the LORD. Blessed is the man that feareth the LORD, that delighteth greatly in his commandments.

[2] His seed shall be mighty upon earth: the generation of the upright shall be blessed.

Haggai 1

[12] Then Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, with all the remnant of the people, obeyed the voice of the LORD their God, and the words of Haggai the prophet, as the LORD their God had sent him, and the people did fear before the LORD.

[13] Then spake Haggai the LORD's messenger in the LORD's message unto the people, saying, I am with you, saith the LORD.

Isaiah 33

[6] And wisdom and knowledge shall be the stability of thy times, and strength of salvation: the fear of the LORD is his treasure.
