4 STEPS in HEARING GOD's voice and DOING HIS will

1. SEE –

To know Him for who He really is .

2. WORSHIP –


Our recognition for who He really is.

3. **HEAR** – To discern God's voice.

4. **GO** – Doing God's will and GOING wherever He might send us.

You cannot DO God's will if you haven't HEARD His voice, and you cannot hear Him unless you WORSHIP Him in spirit and in truth, and you cannot WORSHIP Him for Who he really is, unless

you KNOW Him for Who He really is.



If you are **NOT DOING** God's will, it means that you haven't heard His voice and you **cannot HEAR** Him unless you live a **LIFE OF WORSHIP** to God, and if you do not live this life then **you DO NOT KNOW GOD** for WHO He really is.

If you SEE, you will WORSHIP , then you will HEAR and then you Can GO and DO whatever HE might ask or command.


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CHAPTER 1 - SEE

TO KNOW HIM FOR WHO HE REALLY IS

The disciples had to know Jesus to recognise Him when they saw Him... although some of them doubted....

Matthew 28:17......¹⁷ And when they saw Him....



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- 1.8 The Names of God as proof of Who He really is.

The first step to hearing what God says and the understanding of WHAT His will might be ... is to SEE HIM for WHO and WHAT HE

REALLY IS.

This illustration described the beginning of a Devine cycle in which we can have constant communion with God, being aware of His will and doing what He ask of us.

1.1 CAN WE SEE GOD?

With the naked eye? No. The Word teaches us that we can't.

1 John 4:20²⁰ If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom **he hath not seen**? (KJV)

1 Pet 1:8 - ⁸ Whom having not seen, ye love; in whom, though **now ye see him not**, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory: (KJV)

Because we cannot see God, we cannot know God, unless He reveals Himself to us. But HOW does God reveal Himself and as WHOM does God reveal Himself? Before we can understand God's Self-revelation, we have to know WHO GOD REALLY is.

1.2 WHO IS GOD?

God is a triune God namely: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. There are a few proofs of this: -

1.2.1 **During the creation** – **Gen 1: 26** ²⁶ *And God said, Let <u>us</u> make man in* <u>*our*</u> *image,* .. (KJV) .This speaks of more than one person involved in the creation of man.

1.2.2 At Jesus' baptism – Luke 3:21-22 ... Son is baptized ...Holy Spirit descends....voice of the Father from heaven.

1.2.3 In heaven – 1John 5:7 ⁷ For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word (Jesus Christ), and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one. (KJV)

1.3 HOW DOES GOD REVEAL HIMSELF TODAY?

We have to distinguish between:

- a) General Revelation e.g. Creation; Bible, Books etc.
- b) Special (Supernatural) Revelation Angels; Audible voice etc.
- c) **Personal Revelation –** the one-on-one encounter with Him

1.3.1 Revelation by the Father.

John 14:6-9 ⁶ Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. ⁷ **If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also**: and from henceforth ye know him, **and have seen him**. ⁸ Philip saith unto him, Lord, shew us the Father, and it sufficient us. ⁹ Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? **he that hath seen me hath seen the Father**; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father? (KJV)

We cannot see the Father with the naked eye. The Father-heart of God is revealed by His Son Jesus Christ.

1.3.2 <u>Revelation by the Son.</u>

Heb 1:1-2 - ¹ God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, ² Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds; (KJV)

You might say, "*I cannot see Jesus either*" and you are right because Jesus after His death And Resurrection, ascended into heaven to sit at the right hand of the Father. Jesus Himself said in: John 14:1-3 - Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God,

believe also in me.² In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. **I go to prepare a place for you.** ³ And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also. (KJV)

Heb 2:9 - ⁹ But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man. (KJV)

This means that we see Jesus with **a spiritual eye**, for WHO He really is...

1.3.3 God's Revelation through the Holy Spirit.

John 14:16-17 ¹⁶ And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; ¹⁷ Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, **because it seeth him not**, neither knoweth him: **but ye know him**; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. (KJV)

We cannot see the Father. That's why Jesus came. He (Jesus) is the personalization of the Father. To know Jesus IS TO KNOW THE FATHER.

But to know Jesus, for who he really is, means to have the HOLY SPIRIT in your life. This happens at REBIRTH(When we are BORN AGAIN). But even then we only know in part. The more the Spirit works in our lives, the more we learn about Jesus. We cannot see the Holy Spirit either because He is Spirit. If we talk about SEEING God, it means that we "**SEE**" **through Spiritual eyes**. It means, "A comprehension formed by the PICTURES IN OUR MINDS" when we talk about God.

1.4 WHY DON'T WE "SEE" GOD?

We ask the Question, "Why can we not "**see**" God for who He really is ?", and here follows a few reasons:

1.4.1 SIN / DISOBEDIENCE / IDOLATRY

Romans 11:8 ⁸ (According as it is written, God hath given **them** the spirit of slumber, **eyes that they should not see**, and ears that they should not hear;) unto this day. (KJV) If we remain in our sin and disobedience, God will eventually be forced to hand us over to our sinful desires. If we love anything more than we love God, we are busy with idolatry.

Also read: Is 42:17-18 ; Is 44:17-18 ; Jer 5:19-20; Ezek 12:2-3

1.4.2 FAITHLESSNESS (LACK OF FAITH)

2 Cor 4:3-4 ³ But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: ⁴ In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them. (KJV)

If we do not believe God according to the way He reveals Himself to us through the Scripture and through personal revelation, we will not be able to see God for whom He really is.

1.4.3 LACK OF KNOWLEDGE

1 Cor 13:12 - ¹² For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: **now I know** *in part*; but then shall I know even as also I am known. (KJV)

1.4.4 LACK OF HOLINESS

Hebrews 12:14 ¹⁴ Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord: (KJV).

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1.5 WE CAN KNOW THE HOLY SPIRIT, ALTHOUGH WE CANNOT SEE HIM.

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

2.1 WHAT IS WORSHIP?:

2.1.1 THE DEFINITION OF WORSHIP

Worship cannot be described in words it can only be experienced. But like every other experience we can endeavor to describe it in words.

a) THE ENGLISH WORD "WORSHIP" is deduced from the Anglo Saxon word "Weorthscipe"

"worth – ship", which is a reaction upon, and indicates the VALUE OF GOD.

b)	HEBREW WORDS	(i) " Shachah " – to bow down
		(ii) "Abodah " – to serve a superior

c)	GREEK WORDS -	(i) "Proskuneo" it means to kiss

WHEN WE LOVE THOSE WHO ARE UNDESERVING ITS AN ACT OF MERCY, BUT LOVING GOD IS AN ACT OF WORSHIP.

Romans 12:1

¹ I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. (KJV)

2.1.1 **THE TWO ELEMENTS OF WORSHIP**:

- 1. **ATTITUDE** of ADORATION
- 2. ACTION OF HUMBLE SERVANTHOOD

2 Pet 1:3 ³ According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, **through the knowledge of him** that hath called us to glory and virtue:

If I know **Him**... I will know His power... and through His power I have received everything needed to live for Him and serve Him... i.e. **A LIFE OF WORSHIP**

2.2 THE ESSENCE OF WORSHIP

Both my **ATTITUDE** of humbleness and my **ACTION** of servanthood is driven by 2 things:

2.2.1 FEAR – (honor and respect)
 Acts 9:31-Church....living in obedience to God
 Acts 13:16 – ...God fearing men....
 Rev 14:7 - ...Fear God.....give Him honour....Worship Him......

2.2.2 THANKFULNESS

Ps 136:1- Oh *Give thanks unto the LORD, for He is good; for His mercy(love) endureth forever..*

Both my FEAR and THANKFULNESS consist of 3 ingredients:

REMEMBRANCE - Looks at the PAST.
 Read: Ps 103:2-3
 For the Jews: Deliverance out of Egypt
 For us: The Death and Ressurection of Jesus and deliverance from sin

(Matt 7:11) As bad as you are, you know how to give good things to your children. How much more, then, will your Father in heaven give good things to those who ask him!(GNB)

3. **EXPECTATION** - Looks forward **For the Jews** – The coming of the Messiah **For us**: - The Second Coming and Heaven. (Isa 62:6) On your walls, Jerusalem, I have placed sentries; They must never be silent day or night. They must remind the LORD of his promises And never let him forget them.(GNB)

2. **APPRECIATION** - Looks at the NOW **For the Jews**: God's providence. **For us**: God's Blessings here and now.

John 14:1-3.....and I am going to prepare a place for you.And after I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to myself, so that you will be where I am.(GNB)

J. Oswald Sanders: Worship is the loving ascription of praise to God for what he is in himself and in his providential dealings. It is the bowing of our innermost spirit before him in deepest humility and reverence. Worship is the adoring contemplation of God as he has been pleased to reveal himself in his son and in the Scriptures.

2.2 WHY DO WE WORSHIP?

Joh 4:23-24²³ But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. ²⁴ God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth. (KJV)

This scripture describes HOW we should worship ... but there is another element which we should take a look at e.g

There comes a time when the TRUE WORSHIPPERS shall worship the Father in Spirit and in truth. Nowhere is it written that God wants worship, what He wants is TRUE WORSHIPPERS.

If we have to ask the question WHY? Then the answer is "BECAUSE GOD DEMANDS IT"... If God only wanted worship (the act per se) then the one or two that do, would satisfy Him.... BUT GOD WANTS TRUE **WORSHIP<u>PERS</u>.(**He wants the people**)**

2.3.1 I was....CREATED TO WORSHIP

Is 43:7 - *Even every one that is called by my name: for I have created him for my glory*, *I have formed him; yea, I have made him.*

2.3.2 I was.....CHOSEN TO WORSHIP

1 Pet 2:9 - The Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations, and to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished:

2.3.3 I was....CALLED TO WORSHIP

Ps 95:6 - *O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker.*

2 Pet 1:3 - According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of **him that hath called us** to glory and virtue:

2.3.4 I am ...COMMANDED TO WORSHIP

Rev 14:6-7 – And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people, Saying with a loud voice, **Fear God, and give glory to Him**; for the hour of his judgment is come: **and worship Him** that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.

Ps 149:2-4 - ² Let Israel rejoice in him that made him: let the children of Zion be joyful in their King. ³ Let them praise his name in the dance: let them sing praises unto him with the timbrel and harp. ⁴ For the LORD taketh pleasure in his people: he will beautify the meek with salvation. (KJV)

WORSHIP IS NOT A PART OF YOUR LIFE;IT IS YOUR LIFE RICK WARREN – A purpose driven Life

2.4 WHO DO WE WORSHIP?

Matthew 4:10 - Then Jesus answered, "Go away, Satan! The scripture says, 'Worship the Lord your God and serve only him!' "

God has the sole right to our worship, but we cannot worship God effectively if we do not know Him. (Look again at page 7-10) We have heard of Samuel that served in the temple... BUT HE DID NOT KNOW GOD.

WE NOT ONLY PRAISE AND WORSHIP HIM FOR WHO HE IS, BUT ALSO FOR WHAT HE'S DONE AND IS STILL DOING

2.5 A WORSHIPPER LIKE JESUS

Jesus Christ was a TRUE WORSHIPPER with the same responsibilities as ours.. e.g: To worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth. **Gal 4:4** describes Jesus as being submitted to the same laws as we are. However there was one difference: HIS ATTITUDE AND ACTIONS (HIS ACTS) were the true expression of what TRUE WORSHIP ought to be:

• Jesus pleased the Father Matt 3:17

 Jesus knew the Father personally and did what He asked. John 8:29 _____

2.6 THE IMAGE OF WORSHIP:

The image of worshipping can be illustrated in the relationship between two loved ones

- a. **UNDIVIDED ATTENTION** Loved ones focus only upon each other. They are only conscious of each other. So too is the worshipper's attention focused only upon God, who He is, what He does, and what more He is capable of.
- b. **EXPRESSION OF FEELINGS** Words such as "**I love you**" or "there is no-one like you". In this way a pledge of love takes place while you are worshipping the Lord.
- c. **EXPRESSION OF COMMITMENT** "I will **ALWAYS** love you" the same way that God binds Himself to us (Mt 28:20) we should also pledge ourselves to Him in undivided trust.
- d. **CONFIRMATION THROUGH DEEDS OF LOVE** e.g. hugs and kisses; being intimate. This is just like our time spent in the presence of the Lord, intimate moments. The word used for worshipping in Greek is "Proskuneo" means literally to kiss the hand.

2.7 HOW DO WE WORSHIP?

John 4:23 - *God is Spirit, and only* **by the power of his Spirit** can people worship him as *He really is." (GNB)*

.....and they that worship him must worship him **in spirit and in truth**.(KJV) Note the two words :

(1) **BY THE POWER OF THE SPIRIT** (GNB) ...**IN SPIRIT** (KJV) it indicates the meeting of our spirit with the Holy Spirit. Many believers do not know what this means because they have never had a true relationship with God and especially His Holy Spirit.

(2) **IN TRUTH** – Indicates integrity before God, no pretence. The truth will set us free.

Robert Baily "Worship is the acknowledgement of God's supreme worth; worship is prayer to, and praise of the almighty God that fills us with joy, at who He is and transforms us into a living fellowship with Him in the very essence of life."

2.8 THE DEFINITION OF PRAISE?

The word "Praise" means **"to commend, to applaud or to magnify."** In other words, to Worship God with expressions of "praise", "applause" and "exaltation". This means that we forget ourselves and concentrate on God with expressions of Love, adoration and thankfulness.TRUE PRAISE brings us into contact with God. It brings us out of the natural into the super-natural and from the flesh into the spirit.

To understand the "HOW TO WORSHIP " a little better we have to understand that there are two phases to our Worship , namely : (1) **PRAISE** and (2) **WORSHIP.** Although it is difficult to differentiate between the two we are going to try our best:

PRAISE = expressions of WHAT God has done – **Ps 28:6 WORSHIP** = expressions of WHO God is. – **Ps 29:2**

PRAISE = TUNING IN to the presence of God – **Ps 16:8 ; Ps 63:1-8 WORSHIP** = REACTION on entering the presence of God – **Deut 16:11 ; Acts 2:28**

PRAISE = To sing ABOUT God (i.e Great and Mighty is the Lord our God) **WORSHIP** = to sing TO God (i.e : You are awesome in this place, Mighty God)

2.8.1 PRAISE INCLUDES EVERYTHING WORSHIP IS ABOUT – namely **ATTITUDE** and **ACTIONS**

Praise consists of more actions like verbal expressions of adoration and thanksgiving, singing, making use of instruments; clapping of hands and dancing. Even this is not supposed to be a show-off. Praise is not the purpose, but the means to a purpose, namely:

COMMUNION WITH GOD.

The charge against the people of God, and still today against the church is :

Matt 15:8 ⁸ This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart is far from me. (KJV)

True PRAISE is a matter of humble and upright commitment to God.

2.8.2 PRAISE AS A WAY OF LIVING

Your THOUGHTS determine your ACTIONS -..... i.e if I start to think the praises of the Lord, I shall not be afraid to praise God in the presence of others.

Your ACTIONS determine your HABITS..... the more I praise, the more I get used to it, and do I fall into a habit of praising the Lord.

Your HABITS determine your VALUESthe moment I'm used to praising God, I will find myself wanting to praise Him and will it become part of my value-system. **Your VALUES determine your DESTINATION** I will be a conquerer through praise in spite of my circumstances . I will not find myself in despair, because I'm a Praiser.

PRAISE is not something I only do in church on Sunday, It must be a WAY OF LIVING. It must be entwined with my daily prayerlife. Wherever I am, I must praise Him, Whenever I can I must praise Himwhether I'm in my car, at home , at work ...ALWAYS AND EVERYWHERE....

Psalm 34:1 – *I will always thank the LORD; I will never stop praising him.*

Heb 13:15 – Let us, then, **always** offer praise to God as our sacrifice through Jesus, which is the offering presented by lips that confess him as Lord.

2.8.3 WHY MUST I PRAISE ?

2.8.3.1 IT IS A COMMAND – and we must obey

Phil 4:4 - *Rejoice in the Lord always. I shall say it again: rejoice!* **Psalm 118:1 -** *Give thanks to the LORD, who is good, whose love endures forever.*

2.8.3.2 IT IS AN EXPRESSION OF FAITH and a DECLARATION of VICTORY Rom 8:28 – We know that in all things God works for good with those who love him, those whom he has called according to his purpose.

James 1:2-3 - *Consider it all joy*, my brothers, when you encounter various trials, for you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance.

Sometimes I have to bring a SACRIFICE of PRAISE, because I might not feel like praising God, but because God is WHO He is and He has done WHAT He's done, I praise Him anyhow.

2.8.3.3 PRAISE MAKES THE ENEMY FLEE

When we start praising God, the devil loses his grip on us. The atmosphere of true praise makes him flee.

See the example of Jehosaphat: (CELLGROUP MATERIAL 5)

2.8.3.4 PRAISE BRINGS GOD'S HAND OF DELIVERANCE INTO MOTION

Psalm 50:23 – "Whoso offereth praise glorifieth me: and to him that ordereth his conversation aright will I show the salvation of God"

See the example of Paul and Silas (CELLGROUP-MATERIAL 6)

2.8.3.5 PRAISE CHANGES MY STATE OF MIND / HEART

Psalm 89:15 – How happy are the people who worship you with songs, who live in the light of your kindness!

2.8.3.6 PRAISE IS A TEACHING TOOL

Col 3:16 – *Christ's message in all its richness must live in your hearts.* **Teach and** *instruct one another with all wisdom.* **Sing psalms, hymns, and sacred songs;** *sing to God with thanksgiving in your hearts.*

Other people are taught to Praise God irrespective of circumstances.

2.8.4 BIBLICAL EXPRESSIONS OF PRAISE

Declaring of thanks (Heb. 13:15) Clapping hands and shouting (Psalms 47:1) Musical instruments and dancing (Psalms 150:4) Singing praise songs (Psalms 9:11) Psalms, hymns, & spiritual songs (Eph. 5:19-20) Making a joyful noise (Psalms 98:4) By lifting our hands (Psalms 134:2) By being still (Psalms 4:3-5, 46:10) By being loud (Psalms 33:3, 95:1-6)

Seven Hebrew Words for Praise

1. <u>Halal</u>

Halal is a primary Hebrew root word for praise. Our word "hallelujah" comes from this base word. It means "to be clear, to shine, to boast, show, to rave, celebrate, to be clamorously foolish."

Ps 113:1-3 - *Praise (halal) ye the Lord, praise (halal) o ye servants of the Lord, praise (halal) the name of the Lord.*

Ps 150:1 - *Praise (halal) the Lord! Praise (halal) God in his sanctuary; Praise (halal) him in his mighty expanse.*

Ps 149:3 - Let them praise (halal) his name in the dance: let them sing praises with the timbrel and harp.

2. <u>Yadah</u>

Read : 2Chr 8:14 ; Ezra 3:10 ; Ps 22:22 ; Ps 63:5 ; Ps 69:30 Yadah is a verb with a root meaning, "the extended hand, to throw out the hand, therefore to worship with extended hand." According to the Lexicon, the opposite meaning is "to bemoan, the wringing of the hands."

2Chr 20:21 - *Give thanks (yadah) to the Lord, for his lovingkindness is everlasting.* **Ps 63:1** - *So I will bless thee as long as I live; I will (yadah) lift up my hands in thy name.* **Ps 107:15** - *Oh that men would praise (yadah) the Lord for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men.*

Other references: Gen 49:8 ; 2Chr 7:6 ; 2Chr 20:21; Isa 12:4; Jer 33:11

3. <u>Towdah</u>

Towdah comes from the same principle root word as yadah, but is used more specifically. Towdah literally means, **"an extension of the hand in adoration, avowal, or acceptance**." By way of application, it is apparant in the Psalms and elsewhere that it is used for **thanking God** for "things not yet received" as well as things already at hand. **Ps 50:14** -Offer unto God praise (towdah) and pay thy vows unto the Most High. **Ps 50:23** - Whoso offereth praise (towdah) glorifieth me: and to him that ordereth his conversation aright will I shew the salvation of God.

Other references: 2Chr 29:31 ; Jer 33:11; Ps 42:4

4. <u>Shabach</u>

Shabach means, "to shout, to address in a loud tone, to command, to triumph." Ps 47:1- O clap your hands, all peoples; shout (shabach) to God with the voice of joy (or triumph).

Ps 145:4 - One generation shall praise (shabach) thy works to another and declare thy mighty acts.

Isa 12:6 - *Cry aloud and shout (shabach) for joy, O inhabitant of Zion, For great in your midst is the Holy One of Israel.*

Other references: Ps 63:1-4;Ps.117:1;Ps 35:27; Ps 106:47

5. <u>Barak</u>

Barak means "to kneel down, to bless God as an act of adoration."

Ps 95:6 -_*O come let us worship and bow down; let us kneel (barak) before the Lord our maker.*

1Chr 29:20 - Then David said to all the assembly, "Now **bless** (barak) the Lord your God." And all the assembly **blessed** (barak) the Lord, the God of their fathers, and bowed low and did homage to the Lord and to the king.

Ps 34:1 - *I will bless* (barak) the Lord at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth.

Other references: Job 1:21 ; Ps 96:2; Ps 103:1-2 ; Ps 18:46

6. <u>Zamar</u>

Zamar means "to pluck the strings of an instrument, to sing, to praise; a musical word which is largely involved with joyful expressions of music with musical instruments."

Ps 21:13 - Be exalted O Lord, in Thine own strength, so will we sing and praise (zamar) Thy power.

1Chr 16:9 - Sing to Him, sing praises (zamar) to Him; speak of all His wonders.

Ps 57:8-9 - Awake my glory; awake harp and lyre, I will awaken the dawn! I will give thanks to Thee, O Lord among the peoples; I will sing praises (zamar) to Thee among the nations.

Other references: Ps 66:2-4 ; Isa 12:5 ; Ps 27:6 ; Ps 149:3; Ps 30:4

7. <u>Tehillah</u>

Tehillah is derived from the word halal and means "the singing of halals, to sing or to laud; perceived to involve music, especially singing; hymns of the Spirit."

Ps 22:3 - Yet Thou art holy, O Thou who art enthroned upon the praises (tehillah) of Israel. **Ps 33:1** - Rejoice in the Lord, o ye righteous, for praise (tehillah) is comely for the upright. **Isa 61:3** - To grant to those who mourn in Zion, Giving them a garland instead of ashes, The oil of gladness instead of mourning, The mantle of praise (tehillah) instead of the spirit of fainting, So they shall be called oaks of righteousness, The planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified.

<u>Other references</u>: Ps 34:1 ;1Chr 16:35; 2Chr 20:22; Deut 10:21; Ex 15:11; Ps 147:1-2

PRAISE creates the atmosphere for an encounter with God. Still we have to ask the following question:

2.9 HOW CAN I ENTER INTO THE PRESENCE OF GOD ?

We have to practise to enter the presence of God !

- (1) Remind yourself continuously of the reality of God's presence and seek after it. Psalm 105:2-5
- (2) Decide to have communion with God regularly If you forget that He is with you or neglect to speak to Him. If you neglect to spend time with Him, just repent and seek the next best opportunity to do so.
 Psalm 44:8 ;Dan 6:10

(3) Do everything AS IF for the Lord. (FOR HIS SAKE)

This is about attitude, it is not about what I can get out of seeking God's presence but more about me pleasing and glorifying God. **Col 3:17**

(4) Take control of your mind and direct your thoughts towards God.

I must not allow anything to distract me. Take special care in not allowing your thoughts to wander. Pray and Worship purposefully.

Read: Col 3:2 ; Phil 4:4-9 Isaiah 55:8Psalms 139:17...

(5) Purpose to have an encounter with God (regularly).


I must have the attitude of Jacob when I want to enter God's presence ...

Gen 32:26 ..." You can't go until you bless me, " Jacob replied.

Just like Moses in **Ex 33:8-10**...we must enter into the Shekinah Glory of God. God is waiting for us to do so.

In **2 Cron 7:2**....the Priests could not stand, so great was His presence. If His presence filled those venues with such Glory how much more will we not receive when we enter into His presence.

I must have the same attitude as queen Esther in **Esther4:16**, she was so determined to enter the presence of the king, she said: *If I must die for doing it, I must die*. (GNB) How much more should we not try and enter the presence of the KING of kings



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INTRODUCTION:

In Hebrew, the words: **'Mishkan'**, which is translated as "Tabernacle", or "Dwellingplace", and **'Beit'** which means "HOUSE" and **'Haikhol**' which means "TEMPLE" are used in differerent contexts in the Old and New Testament. The most important part in understanding the Temple or the Tabernacle is the fact that it is THE HOLY DWELLING PLACE OF GOD. The word '**Shekinah**' refers to the Holy Spirit which manifested in the form of a cloud and that of fire. The word comes from the word '**Shekhan**' which means '**to abide, to stay**, **to dwell or 'to remain**'. This is where we got the word '**Mishkan**', describing God's dwelling place.

THE TABERNACLE CONSISTED OF THE FOLLOWING :

INNERCOURT ;
 HOLY PLACE and
 MOST HOLY

God also created us : (1) Body , (2) Soul and (3) Spirit.

We are SPIRIT: Have a SOUL and live in a BODY.

1 Thess 5:23 teaches us : ²³ And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole **spirit and soul and body** be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. (KJV)

Our Praise and Worship can either be just physical actions (body) or just thoughts and emotions (soul) or it can be IN SPIRIT and IN TRUTH.

<u>2.10.1 THE GATE</u>: Thanksgiving – a willing sacrifice of praise – "TOWDAH" **Psalm 100:4** - Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, And into his courts with praise: Give thanks unto him, and bless his name.

Here the body and the flesh could be involved only. This consists of singing; clapping of hands ; dancing; making use of musical instruments. The person who wants to praise God in this manner only, cannot expect to hear the voice of God.

REMEMBER : PRAISE : Is to PRAISE GOD FOR <u>WHAT</u> HE'S DONE...... WORSHIP : TO PRAISE GOD FOR <u>WHO</u> HE IS....

WORSHIP: speaks of a HEART to HEART REALTIONSHIP with God (i.e Attitude and Action) *PRAISE is the FRUIT of that relationship* .

Psalm 63:4-5 - _____

Also make use of musical instruments . Read: Ps 150: 1-5



2.10.2 IN THE COURTYARD: - (BODY / FLESH)

In the courtyard you used to find 2 things, namely: (1) The altar of sacrifice and (2) The Brass Laver.

a. BRAZIN ALTAR of sacrifice – speaks of "SALVATION", confession and forgiveness of sin.
 Heb 13:15 -

Here I bring my sacrifice of praise, even though I might not feel like praising God. Here at the ALTAR I confess my sins, and remind myself of the salvation brought by the blood of Jesus Christ that flowed for me.

Hebr 10:10¹⁰.... we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. (KJV)

Prayer: Thank you God for sending Jesus, thank you Jesus that you came, thank you for dying on the cross for me. Father I confess my sins, please forgive me my sins and cleanse me according to your word in **1 John 1:9**.

b. BRASS LAVER (WASHBASIN) - speaks of CLEANSING ; Ex 30:18-21 1 John 1:9

James 4:8	 	 	<u> </u>
 Titus 2:14			
2 Cor 7:1 -	 	 	·····

THIS IS A TYPE OF THE BAPTISM - 1 Pet 3:21 ...*a symbol pointing to baptism, which now saves you. It is not the washing off of bodily dirt, but the promise made to God from a good conscience. It saves you through the resurrection of Jesus Christ,*

LET GOD CLEANSE YOU : - your mind / your eyes / your hands / your hands / your body **Prayer :** Thank you Lord that I am washed in your blood. Lord, cleanse my mind to think good thoughts, my eyes from what they might have seen, my ears from what they might have heard, my hands from the wrong I might have done. Thank you Lord that I can be baptised according to **Mark 16:16** and **Acts 2:38**.

2.10.3 THE HOLY PLACE: (SOUL; MIND; EMOTIONS)

This is the place of ACTIONS: Raising of hands ; bowing down ; kneeling.

a. GOLDEN LAMPSTAND (JESUS / HOLY SPIRIT – baptism/ANOINTING) God's instructions to what it should look like we find in Ex 25:31-37
......the oil and the fire are types of THE HOLY SPIRIT ; THE FIRE OF GOD
Ex 25:37 – SEVEN = perfect number ; and the LAMPS refers to JESUS as the LIGHT OF THE WORLD.

Ex 30:7-8 – This was to happen mornings and evenings. So is our worship ; our prayers and supplications suppose to be perpetual before the Lord. Holiness is something I have to strive for continually, daily, morning and evening. I cannot enter the Most holy unless I've been sactified.

When Zacharais in **Luke 1:9** was busy burning incense , an Angel appearred to him. To experience the Lord as I should, I must get rid of all unholiness and **Isaiah 59:2** explains why ^{**} But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear. (KJV)

Phil 4:18 ¹⁸ But I have all, and abound: I am full, having received..... the things which were sent from you, an odour of a sweet smell, a sacrifice acceptable, wellpleasing to God. (KJV)

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Psalms 95:6 _____

The word "BARAK" is demonstrated.

Rev 4:10 _____

Prayer: Lord I want to be holy as You are holy. Let my prayers and my worship be acceptable to you, just like the incense from the altar.

2.10.3 MOST HOLY – WORSHIP IN SPIRIT and IN TRUTH.

Hebr 9:8 - *The Holy Spirit clearly teaches from all these arrangements that the way into the Most Holy Place has not yet been opened as long as the outer tent still stands.*

We cannot enter the MOST HOLY PLACE unless we have dealt with everything that can hinder us from entering God's presence.

1. THE VEIL : Jesus Christ made it possible to enter THE MOST HOLY PLACE and gave us access to the Father . THE VEIL was torn for you and I. **Heb 9:12 ; Mark 15:38;**

2. ARK of the COVENANT – Speaks of GOD's PRESENCE .

The two Cherubims on top speaks of God's Holiness. True worship flows from the knowledge that we are dealing with a HOLY GOD.

Hebrews 9:4⁴ and the ark of the covenant overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the **golden pot that had manna**, and **Aaron's rod** that budded, and **the tables of the covenant**; (KJV)

Inside the ARK were the following:

1. ROD of AARON – which speaks of Godly AUTHORITY and LEADERSHIP. Matt 6:33

Here I pray, NOT MY WILL BE DONE, BUT YOURS BE DONE. Here I ask God's direction. I also seek the ANOINTING and the EQUIPMENT for ministry.

2. MANNA – speaks of GODLY PROVISION Phil 4:19 _____

Here we are not need–conscious but solution-conscious . Here we proclaim the reality of God as Jehovah-Jireh en EL Shaddai.

3. The LAW OF MOSES – God's WORD 2 Tim 3:16-17 _____

Here I experience the LOGOS word becoming a RHEMA WORD and God speaking to me about what it is I am suppose to do. I have SEEN HIM and WORSHIPPED HIM and is ready TO HEAR HIM....

Hearing God's voice



To discern His voice.

Matt 28:17-19 ¹⁷ And when they saw him, they worshipped him: but some doubted. ¹⁸ **And Jesus came and spake unto them**, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

Take Note:

1. And Jesus came...

If we draw nearer to God in prayer and WORSHIP, God draws nearer to us.

James 4:8

2. And spake to them ...

When God draws nearer to us it is either in an SPECIAL REVELATION or in a PERSONAL REVELATION.

We all want to know the will of God and to be within the will of God, but we ask the following questions:

CONTENTS:

- 3.1 What is the will of God?
- 3.2 How can I know the will of God?
- 3.3 What "Potholes" must I avoid?
- 3.4 How can I hear His voice?
- 3.5 How do I discern between the voice of God and that of Satan?
- 3.6 What prevents me from hearing His voice?
- 3.7 WHAT IF I HAVE HEARD HIS VOICE?


3.1 WHAT IS THE WILL OF GOD?

More than anything else, we must realise that God's will and way is the best for us. It is something that we have to hold on to. God wishes us the best and this will never change.

When we want to know what the will of the Lord is, it is important that we are in the right relationship with God. Here are a number of Scriptural principles that can be be used as basic guidelines in almost every situation:

3.1.1. It is God's will that people are saved.

The saving of an individual is more important to God than any other case/task. We must therefore ensure that our relationship with God is right before we ask anything else of the Lord. **In the first and foremost place is Salvation God's will for everyone**



2 Peter 3:9 -⁹ The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that <u>all</u> should come to repentance. (KJV)

When the things we want to do would, for example, hinder the saving of other people, then we must realise that we will be moving outside the will of God.

1 Tim 2:4 ⁴ Who will have <u>all</u> men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth. (KJV)



3.2 HOW CAN "I" KNOW THE WILL OF GOD?

In our search for the will of God we must differentiate between

- 1. The **DIRECT** will of God and
- 2. The **PERMITTED** WILL of God

To become familiar with the will of our Heavenly Father, we must ensure that we comply with certain conditions:

- 1. **Rebirth:** Ensure that you are reborn according to **John.3:3-6 and Acts 2:38** by confessing your sins according to **1 John. 1:9** and accepting Jesus as your personal Saviour according to **John 1:12**.
- 2. **Baptism:** As an act of obedience according to **Acts 2:38 and Matt 28:19.** Many people who have not been baptised have already heard the word of God but still remains disobedient. Disobedience is a sin and sin hinders the work of God in your life.
- Baptised with the Holy Spirit It is a promise from God to every reborn child of God. It is the power that you need AFTER you have HEARD, to be able to DO what God has said. Acts 1:8 ______

Acts 2:38. ____

Study the Word of God – The Holy Spirit will never lead you in a truth apart from the truth of God's word. That is why God wants you to know your bible.
 2 Tim 3:16-17______

Be careful not to apply only certain verses and using them as guidance unless it has been confirmed in other ways.

5. Willingness to subjugate to God 's guidance is a basic necessity. It is no use to ask what is God's will if you are not prepared to do what He asks. Is it indeed your hearts desire to do the will of God? **Choose** with your will to do God's will.

Pray and ask God "Father I choose with my will to do your will"

Matt.6:33.- ³³ But **seek ye first the kingdom** of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. (KJV)

John 4:34-35 - ³⁴ Jesus saith unto them, My meat is **to do the will of him that sent me**, and to finish his work. ..(KJV)

The following guidelines can be applied in seeking the WILL OF GOD:

- When you seek the guidance of God, it is important to stand on neutral ground. It means you have to come to a point where you tell God that you will be willing to do whatever His will may be. You must, as far as it is humanly possible, be neutral and subdue your personal preference before the will of God.
- Live in close communion(fellowship) with God. When you live near God, it is generally easier to know what the will of God is. Be dedicated. Rom 12:1-2 -

3. **Wait upon God**. It means to bring the subject to God in prayer, on a frequent basis, untill He answers. (**Isaiah 28:16**). God has his own particular time. Don't try to move faster than God. God know exactly when to make the answer known to you, trust Him. During this time of waiting upon the Lord, you must examine your own heart whether it is about God or whether it is about you and what you want. God sometimes let us wait to test the inclination of our hearts and to prepare us mentally before He replies. To wait on God does not mean to do nothing. It means that you must be active in: consideration..., reasoning, ... examining,... listening, ... evaluating, and to study the word of God because it is all in the process of waiting upon God.

Read: Isaiah 40:30-31 _

4. **Complete Trust** – Put all your trust in Him **Prov 3:5-6**

James 1:6-8 says the following of someone who prays, but doubts in his heart "_

Pray to God with the trust, that He precisely knows what you need and that He will on his own time disclose His will to you.

- 5. Act according to the green light that you have. This is a very practical hint. Sometimes we first want to know the finest details before we will act. Normally there is a lot that we can do already without knowing precisely what the outcome of God's plan is going to be. (Remember God has the plan, but sometimes all He gives us, is the directions)
- Consider the circumstances. Translate events in a spiritual way. Remember that Satan tries to prevent us from doing God 's will by putting hindrances in our way.
 2 Thess 2:18 ______

God can use circumstances to lead us. You must however not just look at circumstances for guidance.

7. **The hindsight of advisors**. Share the affair with older people that is spiritual connected and in whose opinion you trust. You often get confirmation and guidance by their response or advice.

Prov 12:15 -¹⁵ The way of a fool is right in his own eyes: but he that hearkeneth unto counsel is wise. (KJV)

Prov 11:14 -¹⁴ Where no counsel is, the people fall: but in the multitude of counselors there is safety. (KJV)

Prov 24:6 ⁶ For by wise counsel thou shalt make thy war: and in multitude of counselors there is safety. (KJV)

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8. Ways in which others

were led. Although

everybody is unique, and God's manner in which He works with each of us, is unique, we can still learn form others. Study the Bible, church history and mission-biographies, and the ways in which God guided His servants. Look at the example of **Acts 10**.

9. Put out a small Fleece. When you can't differentiate between personal feelings and confirmation of the Holy Spirit, ask God to do something objective, outside yourself, to give indication of His will. Read Judges 6:37-39 which is about Gideon's Fleece. Be careful that the signs are not dictatorial. The Lord uses this manner of guidance just as an exception to the rule. The Holy Spirit must lead you, otherwise it can happen that you want to "force" God to reply to your wants. Remember that Gideon's Fleece did not operated as a dice. In others words, Gideon has used the fleece only as a confirmation, because God has already explained His will previously.

10. **Compile a balance Sheet.** It helps to write down the advantages and disadvantages of a decision and to weigh it up against each other. When you honestly write down the advantages and disadvantages on paper the answer is sometimes as clear as day.

11. Share with a prayerpartner or group. It is a good idea especially when the decision will have a long term consequences, to stand before God with someone that is in the same faith as you.

12. Be obedient to Spiritual principles. In some situations, a specific guidance is not needed because the matter can be resolved by spiritual principles. **Heb 13:17**

There is a lot of things the Bible is clear about, and we don't have to search what God's will is, it is written clearly in the Bible.

13. Your equipment from God. The gifts of the Holy Spirit works through you and also gives an indication of the work that God wants you to do. Rom 12:6-10

14. **Guidance of the Holy Spirit**. The Holy Spirit confirms to you what God wants you to do, by means of an inner insurance. But be cautious after a decision was taken, that the absence of stress and fear is not mistaken for inner peace given by God. **Read Col 3:15**



3.3 WHAT "POTHOLES" MUST I AVOID ?

1. **Be vigilant of the flesh** – Be vigilant against a decision that goes with abundance, ease and natural desires.

Gal 5:24-25 _____

Do not try and avoid your cross – 1 Pet 3:17_____

The difficult road is usually the right way. God's way is not our way. You must not shrink from degradation and suffering. Be careful for unnecessary masochism or abstention of things. It is not a spiritual law that a Christian must always suffer. **Matt 16:24**

3. Be cautious against falsification. Satan has deceitful spirits. 1 Tim 4:1

The devil can dress himself as a angel of light.

NOT ALL GOOD THINGS ARE GOD THINGS

4. **The world can be misleading**. The world is not a place but rather a system. Be determined that your decision is not influenced by a desire for position, security, progress, a career or by family pressure.

1 John 2:15-17 _____

5. Guard against rational thoughts. It is possible to use natural hindsight to rationalize everything.

Prov 3:5 teaches us : "⁵ Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. (KJV)

God gave us reasoning (thoughts) to use, but our reasoning must still be under the guidance of the Holy Spirit and the authority and truth of the Word of God.

6. Withstand fear. 1 John 4:18

With God as a lovingly, heavenly father, His will is the best thing that can happen to us. We must start fearing if we are out of His security and will. Withstand any fear and disbelief that makes you hastily and impatient.

7. **Weakness does not disqualify**. Christians often resist God's will because they do not feel qualified for which God called them. If God called you, he will qualify you for which He called you.

8. Walk in faith. Be prepared to walk in faith. If you know that God has spoken to you, your only road is to go ahead.

9. Pray and ask God what is His will. Sometimes we will do everything but ask God what His will for us is.

10. **Be vigilant against distractions**. The **good** is often the enemy of the **best**. Be aware of a deflection of a lesser important purpose of that, which is not my calling. Satan may use an emergency situation to distract my attention away from what I must do. **Act 6:1-6**

QUESTIONS TO ASK WHILE SEARCHING FOR THE WILL OF THE LORD

The following questions, with above mentioned directions will assist you by achieving a more clearer answer in various situations.

Answer the following questions one at a time to your self, as well as conducting the instructions. Not all the questions is are applicable to every situation.

- 1) Compile a balance sheet of the positive and negatives aspects pertaining to the matter why you are searching for God's will.
- 2) Are you aware of any sins, not confessed, in your life? If so, cease all other things and ask the Lord for forgiveness and cleansing and repent of those sins.
- 3) Does the bible specify about this specific matter? If so write down the principles which the Bible gives.
- 4) Does your situation give any indication in which direction you must move.
- 5) Have you prepared yourself for the fact, should you know what God's will is, you will have to be obedient to Him, unconditionally.
- 6) Do you stand on neutral ground what your own feelings and will is concerned ?

- 7) What enlightenment do you have up to this point? Write it down and act accordingly, until such times as God's will is made clear to you.
- 8) If you have no green light and there is nothing practical to do in the meantime, then wait upon the Lord for further guidance.
- 9) Are there any reliable fellow believers that you can go to for advice about this situation or maybe someone with whom you can discuss it and who can pray with you about this ?
- 10) Think of the talents and gifts that God has given you, this can give you an indication as to what the will of God is for you.
- 11) Before you come to a final decision you must positively identify whether you have peace over this matter.
- 12) As long as there is any doubt, do not act.
- 13) How do you think Jesus would have acted in this situation? What would He have done?
- 14) Ask yourself what the consequences of your decision will be: Will it spiritually influence others positively or negatively? How will it influence you' spiritually, positively or negatively?
- 15) If you judge this situation in the merits of eternity, will it influence your decision? Will you still feel this way in 50 years time and will it still be as important as to what you are presently thinking?
- 16) Is this about selfish motives? Or is it in reality about the Glory and Honor of the Lord?
- 17) Is there any attempt from you to manipulate God or to dictate to God what you want?
- 18) Will the Lord be honored by your decision or will your decision damage His name?
- 19) Will you be able to say "I am doing it in Jesus name"
- 20) Will it influence you in any way bearing in mind that one day you will be accountable to God?

3.4 HOW CAN I HEAR THE VOICE OF GOD?

Acts 22:14 ¹⁴ And he said, The God of our fathers hath chosen thee, that thou shouldest **know His will,** and **see** that Just One, and shouldest **hear** the voice of his mouth. (KJV)

In other words this was not just allotted to the prophets of old but also for the Apostles and God is not a respector of a person and we should all be able to hear the voice of God. Our biggest problem however is not to hear the voice of the Lord, but to distinguish, "Is it God communicating to me, or who is communicating to me?"

When I try to listen to the voice of God, how do I know if it is God communicating to me, how do I know it is not Satan that I hear or possibly my own voice?

John 10:27 _____

John 8:47 _

To distinguish God's voice should be normal and it should be natural to a Spirit-filled child of God. To hear God's voice indicates a relationship with God. IF YOU **KNOW** HIM..... YOU WILL **WORSHIP** HIM.....AND THEN YOU <u>MUST</u> **HEAR** HIM.....

New converts may possibly find it difficult, because a newborn lamb does not ultimately know the voice of its shepherd. But a sheep that is part of the flock for some time should be able to distinguish the voice of its shepherd.

Seven times Jesus calls out to the seven congregations in Revelations "HE WHO HAS AN EAR, LET HIM HEAR, WHAT THE SPIRIT SAYS TO THE CHURCHES"

As you pray and seek the Lord's thoughts, you will know that you heard the Lord's voice. Not necessarily an audible voice, (exceptional revelation) but the Holy Spirit communicates within your thoughts. (Personal revelation.)

Jer 7:23-24 ²³ But this thing commanded I them, saying, Obey my voice, and I will be your God, and ye shall be my people: and walk ye in all the ways that I have commanded you, that it may be well unto you. ²⁴ But they hearkened not, nor inclined their ear, but walked in the counsels and in the imagination of their evil heart, and went backward, and not forward. (KJV)

We must decide for ourselves, do we really want to hear His voice, because if I know Jesus Christ, I will hear His voice? **We must distinguish between seven different ways God can communicate with me:**

3.4.1 LOUD AUDIBLE VOICE – Like Paul / John (the Revelator)

This is only 5% of the ways in which God communicates with us. 95% of the time God communicates with our heart and soul. All of a 100% is unnatural but this 5% is mostly a personal revelation because when God communicates with us, it is only I that hear His voice. We call this a Special Revelation. **Read Acts 9:1 (Cell group material 15)**

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Deut 4:33 ³³ Did ever people hear the voice of God speaking out of the midst of the fire, as thou hast heard, and live? (KJV)

God spoke **to Moses** this way – **Ex 3:4-21 ; Num 12:8 ; Acts 7:31** As well as to **Isaiah** - **Isa 30:12** ; as well as **Ezekiel - Ezek 2:2** The Father spoke to **Jesus** this way – **John 12:28-30; Luke 3:22** Jesus spoke to **Paul** this way – **Acts 9:4; Acts 22:7; Acts 26:14** God spoke to **Pete**r this way – **Acts 10:13-15** God can also talk **to us** this way – **Heb 3:15** Even the dead is going to hear Him – **John 5:25-28**

3.4.2 A still small voice – Like Elijah

This can also be a audible voice but so soft that is scarcely audible, like a whisper. Like in the case of Elijah in **1 Kings 19:1-13** (Cell group material 16) In this way God could speak to many people without it being noted.

3.4.3 Visions / Dreams – Like Peter

This is the way that God spoke to His people in the Old Testament – **Num 12:6**_____

Hos 12:10_

Examples: Jacob - Gen 46:2 ; **Jeremiah** – Jer 24:1 ; **Ezekiel** – Ezek 1:4; Ezek 8:2; Ezek 11:24 ; Ezek 43:2-3 ; **Daniel** – Dan 2:9 ; 2:28-31 ; 4:13-13 ; 7:2-7 ; 8:1-27 ; 9:21-24 ; Dan 10:1-16 ; 11:14**; Amos** – Amos 1:1 – **Zechariah** – Zech 1:8 ; 1:18 ; 2:1 ; 5:1 ; 6:1 (**See Cell group material 17**)

God promised that this is the way that He will also speak to His children in the future. **Joel 2:28**

Dreams and visions were not just applicable for the time of the Old Testament, but still is a way in which God can communicate with us. **2 Cor 12:2-3**

Even Paul is not certain whether the person had a vision, or a real life experience. **Examples: Zechariah** (Father of John the Baptist) - Luke 1:22 **Peter** – Acts 10:10-17 ; **Paul** – Acts 16:9

3.4.4 Impressions in my spirit - General and Personal Revelations (See Cell Group Material 18)

This is experienced as a little "inner voice" The Spirit leads – Gal 6:1 ; Gal 5:18,25 ; Rom 8:14 ; John 16:13-15 ; Acts 26:25 ; Acts 21:11 ;

1 Thess 5:19-21-¹⁹ Quench not the Spirit. ²⁰ **Despise not prophesyings**. ²¹ Prove all things; hold fast that which is good. (KJV) THIS MEANS THAT WE MUST NOT ACT AS IF PROPHESY HAS NO VALUE TODAY **1 Cor 14:37**_____

The Greek word for **despise** is the word "**exoutheneo**" which means to despise; **to set at nought**, esteem lease; To be contemptible; to make of no account

b. The danger of prophesying:

The dangers of present-day prophecy like in the Old Testament is the human element which is present, namely that the person can bring a message which is not what God has spoken and when it is not fulfilled, people are disappointed in God. **Jer 23:16**

c. Test of Prophecy:

How can I be positively identify that the word I heard came from God (Refer to the passage about "How to distinguish between the voice of God and Satan")

- In line with the scripture All prophecy must be measured according to the Word. The Holy Spirit never speaks against the Word - Gal 1:8-9 ; Act 17:11 ; 2 Tim 3:16-17 ; 1 Cor 14:37-38 ; Mark 7:1-13
- Discernment of spirit (testing the spirit) Rom 12:2 ; 1 John 4:1 ; John 7:17 ; By discernment we mean that it testifies in your heart, and even by confirmation of two and three. Read: 1 Cor 10:15 ; 1 Cor 14:29
- 3. **God does not gossip** God will first communicate with you before He speaks to someone about you.
- 4. **Fruits of the prophets** You test a tree by its fruits, and in this way so a prophet will be known by the fruits he bears forth. **Gal 5:22 ; John 15:5-8 ; Luke 6:43-44**
- Time and Consummation. Only time and the consummation of prophecy will determine if the prophet was truly from God. - 2 Kings 4:16 ; 2 Kings 20:1-6 ; 2 Chron 36:21 ; Matt 24:33

3.6 WHAT PREVENTS ME FROM HEARING HIS VOICE?

If I saw God's revelation and I worship Him for whom He is, what prevents me from hearing His voice? The same potholes that I have to avoid in my search to do the will of the Lord is applicable here, but especially heed the following:

3.6.1 HARDENED HEART -

Heb 3:7-11 -⁷ Wherefore (as the Holy Ghost saith, To day if ye will hear his voice, ⁸

Harden not your hearts, ¹⁰ Wherefore I was grieved with that generation, and said,

They do alway err in their heart; and they have not known my ways. ¹¹ So I sware in my wrath, They shall not enter into my rest.) (KJV)

It is possible for us to harden our hearts. It can however have serious consequences for us, namely that we cannot enter into the rest of God. Israel exchanged "RELATIONSHIP" for "RELIGION" and "SON-SHIP" for "SLAVERY"

Read: Luke 8:5; 12 ; Ps 95:8-9 ; Jer 3:17 ; Heb 3:15 ; Heb 4:7 ; Acts 7:51

3.6.2 UNBELIEF

Hebr 3:12 ¹² *Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of <u>unbelief</u>, in departing from the living God. (KJV)*

The same with disbelieve... the consequences is desertion of God.

Read: James 1:6if we do not believe....we cannot receive Heb 11:1;6 without faith it is impossible to please God Heb 11:27we must be able to SEE the unseen

3.6.3 SINS, TRANSGRESSION AND INIQUITY

Like two microwave towers; any objects between the two signals like a dove, blocks the signals, the sender still sends the signals but the receiver cannot receive because of blockage, The very same with us, God wants to talk to us, but we cannot receive because of the SINS in our lives, or our inability or unwillingness to give it up.

1 John 3:6

There are 3 words in the Old Testament which describes sin:

Psalm 32:1-2 ... Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.² Blessed is the man unto whom the LORD imputeth not **iniguity**, and in whose spirit there is no guile. (KJV)

- 1. TRANSGRESSION (Heb: "pesha") means, "rebel". Rebelliousness or rebellion is the oldest sin that was committed by satan against God and it can bring forth that you do not hear His voice.
- 2. SIN (Heb: "chatah") means "to miss "- To miss God, to miss his purpose, to miss the road, you cannot know His will, you are outside His will.
- 3. **INIQUITY** (Heb: "avon" means "To be bended" This indicates that the sins that prevail over me makes me grow crooked, I am bowed down and bended and that prevents me from hearing the voice of the Lord.

Jesus Christ has actually made is possible for us to be free of all three of these sins. Ps 32:2-5 ; Isa 53:5

BECAUSE WE DO NOT KNOW OUR BIBLES we shall hear God speaking to us, but we will not pay attention to it, because it is contradictory to the way we were brought up, or against my tradition or contradictory to my church policy.

Mark 12:24 Do ye not therefore err, because ye know not the scriptures, neither the power of God?

I will also not be able to hear the input of the Spirit if I do not know what the bible teaches concerning a specific subject whether it is a sin or not. There are certain matters on which the Bible is not specific, but then it is necessary to review the questions. "QUESTIONS TO ASK, TO SEEK THE WILL OF THE LORD"

(Many people ask the question "Is smoking a sin; is dancing a sin? Then my answer is, "if you're in doubt, then rather don't."

If you know your bible you will know what God's Word teaches on diverse matters. Heed on Samuel that heard God's voice, but did not recognizes it, because the word of God was not revealed to Him.

3.6.6 SELF CENTEREDNESS (SEE CELL GROUP MATERIAL 22)

Read 1 Kings 17:1-12 Heed to words like "I"; "us"; "me". This widow has become so selfcentered that she did not hear God's voice, that she had to take care of Elijah. Read further about the miracle if a person does not become self-centered.

3.7 NOW THAT I'VE HEARD HIS VOICE?

Now that I know that I have heard from God I can show **one of 4 reactions**: **Read : Luke 8:5-15**

⁵ A sower went out to sow his seed: and as he sowed, some fell by the way side; and it was trodden down, and the fowls of the air devoured it. ⁶ And some fell upon a rock; and as soon as it was sprung up, it withered away, because it lacked moisture. ⁷ And some fell among thorns; and the thorns sprang up with it, and choked it. ⁸ And other fell on good ground, and sprang up, and bare fruit an hundredfold

Jesus 's admonition: (verse 8-10)

... And when he had said these things, he cried, *He that hath ears to hear, let him hear*. (KJV) Luke 8:9-10 ¹⁰ And he said, Unto you it is given to know the mysteries of the kingdom of God: but to others in parables; that seeing they might not see, and hearing they might not understand. (KJV)

1. Hardened Heart - Verse 12 -

It is people with a heart, which listens to the word of God, by preaching or prophecy or by writing, through the spirit and does not accept it, the devil comes and steals it. **(This person usually has a inclination of – this is not my work.)**

Shallow Heart – Verse 13 – It is the heart that accepts the word with joy, people that wants to do things for God, but with the slightest of resistance their courage abandons them. (This person usually blames other people (circumstances) that he can do nothing for God.}

3. **Stifled Heart** – **Verse 14** – This is a heart with wrong priorities; problems and seductions of the world, stifle the word.

(Every time God addresses this person he feels guilty and makes a decision to do something for God, but groups pressure, friends, family and things of the world convinces him/her quickly otherwise again.)

4. **A good and sincere Heart** – **Verse 15** – This person accepts the word of God, hears the word of God and reacts on it, and hold the promises that God gives, persevere in the faith and carries good fruit.

(This person usually notice a vocation on their lives and has a desire to live-out their ministry. They qualify themselves usually for service work, learn enough knowledge that there faith can amplify and usually develops faster, a spiritual maturity)

3.7.1 KEEP A JOURNAL (Write down)

If you hear from God, make sure you write it down as soon as possible, so that you can recall it again. The longer you take to write it down, the bigger the chance that you can forget some of the "details"

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3.7.2 WAIT ON THE LORD

God does not always talk to us when we want Him to. And we have to wait until He tells us to go. That is why we have *to wait* on Him. God's mandate to his disciples, after they heard His word was to "WAIT UNTIL THEY HAVE RECEIVED STRENGTH"

(Acts 1:8 ; Luke 24:49)

Habakkuk 2:1 -¹ I will stand upon my watch, and set me upon the tower, and will watch to see what he will say unto me, and what I shall answer when I am reproved. (KJV) Psalm 5:3 ³My voice shalt thou hear in the morning, O LORD; in the morning will I direct my prayer unto thee, and will look up. (KJV)

THE VALUE of WAITING UPON THE LORD

EQUIPMENT - The receiving of strength and the gifts to do want God want us to do.
 Luke 24:49 – go and wait... until you received strength...
 Acts 1:8 – you will receive strength....

1 Samuel 9:27 ²⁷ And as they were going down to the end of the city, Samuel said to Saul, Bid the servant pass on before us, (and he passed on,) but **stand thou still a while, that I may shew thee the word of God. (KJV)**

2. **BUILDING CHARACTER** - The receiving of character that is necessary for you to seeing your duty through and not giving in halfway.

3. **SPIRITUAL GROWTH** - The receiving of the word and spiritual maturity to handle each matter and each struggle successfully.

 FORTIFICATION OF STRENGTHS – The receiving of new strength when I get tired. Isaiah 40:31 ³¹ But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint. (KJV)

3.7.3 WAIT ON THE LORD - FASTING AND PRAYING

"Waiting on the Lord", fasting and prayer is not a way to turn God 's arm for us to get what we want, but a way for us to show God how important His will and presence is to us. Read: Matt 17:20-21 ; Isa 58:1-8 ; Luke 22:40-46 ; 1 Cor 7:5

3.7.4 GET CONFIRMATION OUT OF THE WORD

Because the Holy Spirit will never dictate or give contradictory to the word, is it better for own peace of mind to ask confirmation out of the word of God. Ask in prayer for guidance while you read the word.

3.7.5 FOLLOW THE HOLY SPIRIT GUIDANCE

Together with the Word, the peace of God which surpasses all understanding, will overshadow your heart and mind. **(Phil 4:6-8).** NOW THAT YOU'VE LEARNED TO RECOGNISE HIS VOICE, FOLLOW HIS GUIDANCE.



4.1.3 YOUR SPECIFIC ASSIGNMENT

1 Tim 6:13-14 ...¹³ I give thee charge in the sight of God, who quickeneth all things, and before Christ Jesus,¹⁴ **That thou keep this commandment** without spot, unrebukeable, until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ: (KJV)

Have you **seen** God for who He is? Then you have to **WORSHIP** Him for who He is, God is a winning God and He makes you a winner, and you are part of His Kingdom and part of His winning-team.

Just read Jer 29:11 again:

Joshua 1:8....._____

To understand your task at hand, you have to know that there is three different assignments:

a. A long term assignment –

I will have to know **WHAT** it is that God wants me to do. In other words "**MY MINISTRY**" and that includes my **GIFTS** with which I was gifted. Except the work that each believer is called to do, you may also experience a FULLTIME CALLING to work full-time for God. This may entail the following: (a) to be a Pastor or an Evangelist, or (b) it can be that you minister to elderly people; or to Children or to Youth.

I must know **WHERE** it is that God truly wants me to be involved in, i.e **MY PASSION**. The third Facet of my task is **HOW**, and that involves my **personality**.(*for more information on* ' *Discover you MINISTRY* " *please contact KAINOS MINISTRIES*).

b. A short term assignment –

This involves the task that God gave me to do for a period of time so that His kingdom can be expanded. This Short-term task can be taken up in the long-term task. Examples of this is, to be involved with a specific organisation, or to stand in a specific calling, to do a specific job, or to bless a specific community. I MUST BE ABLE TO LISTEN WHERE IT IS THAT GOD WANTS ME TO BE INVOLVED IN. Our community is filled with too many people that doesn't know **what** it is that they must do, they don't know **how** or even if they are **at the right place**.

c. Immediate assignment

This is to hear God's voice as His Spirit unctions you to bring a word, to prophesy or to lay hands on someone who needs the power of God. To contribute something to the service like Interpretation of tongues or Prophesy, or simply to give word of encouragement. – **1 Cor 14:26**

I must be obedient and respond immediately because God's timing is perfect, if I am not obedient then I will miss God's intended time.(Kairos moment) As it was said before "WHAT I MUST DO", is connected to the GIFTS and MINISTRY that I received from God. (**SEE: My Equipment and Authority**)

4.2 HOW TO DO THAT?

God is the one who enables us to do, what we were called to do, you don't have to worry about your ability, God supplies. If we discuss "HOW", then we are talking about......" HOW I MUST GO ABOUT IT". *Take note these are only guidelines , you must listen to what God's specific plans are for your specific calling.*

4.2.1 <u>THE SOIL – "WHERE"?</u>

Although God's commission includes "**the whole world**" we can't always be involved everywhere, but I must be able to know **WHERE** it is that God wants me to be involved in, and **WHAT** precisely it is that He wants me to do. My **Passion** determines the "**SOIL**" **WHERE** I will be involved. Listen to your heart and know what God placed there.

Ask yourself the following questions?

- 1. What makes me " tick"? What motivates me? What makes my heart beat?
- 2. What is my interest or my orientation?
- 3. What would I do without even getting paid for it?
- 4. What do I see that other people don't necessarily see?

Passion is a God given capacity to fervently attach ourselves to an object (people, causes, idea etc) over an extended period of time to meet a need." Aubry Ecclesiastes 9:10 ¹⁰ Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do it with thy might; for there is no work, nor device, nor knowledge, nor wisdom, in the grave, whither thou goest. (KJV)

Col 3:23 ²³ And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men; (KJV)

4 CHARACTERISTIC OF A GODLY PASSION

1.1 IT is supplementary to my **MOTIVATION** pattern.

1.2 IT IS emphasised through my $\underline{\mbox{ GIFTS}}$.

1.3 IT IS strengthened through my **<u>PERSONAL</u>** responsibility and life's-situations.

1.4 IT IS directed by **<u>GOD</u>** for <u>**HIS**</u> wholesome goal.

"What generates Passion & Zeal in you, is a clue to revealing your destiny. What you love is a clue to Something you contain." – <u>Mike Murdock</u>

4.2.1.1 <u>THE PREPARATION</u> (" PLOWING THE GROUND") = "Intercession", Prayerwalks ; etc.

Intercession

If I am through listening to what it is God wants me to do, I must isolate the place WHERE I want to something for God, I must pray WHO it is I must reach, who's life must be changed. I must pray so that I may know exactly WHAT God's assignment for me is. This only applies to short and long term assignments. For an immediate assignment I must ask God for the peace that whatever I'm suppose to do is really from Him.

(*The longer you linger the bigger the chances that you are missing God's "Kairos" moment*).

4.2.1.2 CAIRN THE TERRAIN OF:

Gen 13:14-17...^{14...}.., Lift up now thine eyes, and look from the place where thou art northward, and southward, and eastward, and westward: ¹⁵ For all the land which thou seest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed for ever.¹⁷ Arise, walk through the land in the length of it and in the breadth of it; for I will give it unto thee. (KJV)

Jos 1:3 ³ *Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon*, that have I given unto you, as I said unto Moses. (KJV)

Intercession: "Prayerwalks", etc. Will be necessary BEFORE you begin your MINISTRY. Spiritual warfare might also be needed to cairn off, the "LAND; AREA" where God wants to use you. (**PRAYING WITH INSIGHT ON SITE**)......

2 REASONS WHY I MUST CAIRN MY TERRAIN OF:

1. TO TAKE NEW LAND INTO POSSESSION – maybe a new Sunday School / Children's Church Group, new Youth group, new Cell-group, A New calling, a new congregation, etc .

2. TO REPOSESS YOUR LOST GROUNDS – to win back children or youth, to revive backsliden and luke warm souls for the Kingdom of God. To rejuvenate a Cell-group or a congregation that could not make it.

4.2.1.3 LESSONS TO LEARN FROM JOSHUA: Num 13:18-20

- **a.** WHAT DOES THE AREA LOOK LIKE? What does my calling entail in the area where I must get involved.
- **b. WHAT DOES THE PEOPLE LOOK LIKE?** What type of person will I have to reach and Bless.
- **c. WHAT DOES THE PLACE LOOK LIKE WHERE THEY STAY?** Their social standing will determine how I must handle them.
- **d. WHAT DOES THE SOIL LOOK LIKE?** (FERTILE) How fertile are they for the Gospel , what is their background?

Whether I "soak" my terrain by prayer, in spirit, from a distance or whether I pray on the spot where I must serve, or the place where I must plant a Cell-group or even a Congregation, **I have to Pray**. Intercession is of most importance. BEFORE I even begin with what God has placed on my heart.

Ephesians 6:12 ¹² For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. (KJV)

See the part on "MY EQUIPMENT AND MY AUTHORITY"

BEFORE I CAN SOW I must make sure THAT THE SOIL WHERE I'M ABOUT TO SOW, IS GOOD.

Mark 4:20 ²⁰ And these are they which are sown on good ground; such as hear the word, and receive it, and bring forth fruit, some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some an hundred. (KJV)

4.2.2 SOW THE SEED

Eccl 11:6.....⁶ In the morning **sow thy seed**, and in the evening withhold not thine hand: for thou knowest not whether shall prosper, either this or that, or whether they both shall be alike good. (KJV) One of my branch managers at an Insurance company taught me to be ready "ALWAYS" and "EVERYWHERE"



What the gospel is concerned, we have to be "READY AT ALL TIMES" to spread the GOOD NEWS, we must be sensitive to the Holy Spirit. God's timing is always perfect, therefore we must always make sure that we have heard from Him first, before we make a move .

2 Cor 9:10......¹⁰ Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness;...(KJV)

To be able to sow the seed effectively you must remember 3 things: (1.) **REALISE YOUR PERSONALITY**; (2.) **REALISE YOUR ASSIGNMENT**; (3.) **UNDERSTAND YOUR COMMITMENT**.

(1) REALISE YOUR PERSONALITY: - This will determine HOW you are going to sow. It is now the right time to do a personality-analyses such as the DISC – Profile, then you will know what your own personality entails, as well as other personalities. (See our course – DISCOVER YOUR MINISTRYanother incensitive by KAINOS MINISTRIES).

(2) <u>REALISE YOUR ASSIGNMENT:</u>

1 Cor 3:6 ⁶ I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase. (KJV) We must realise that we will not always see the souls come in, or the fruit on our labour, I must never measure MY SUCCESS to the fruit, GOD BRINGS THE GROWTH, and He chooses the labourer's that will bring in the crop. YOU MUST JUST DO WHAT GOD ASKS YOU TO DO and TRUST HIM for the rest. **GOD KNOWS WHAT HE IS DOING.**

(3) UNDERSTAND YOUR COMMITMENT.

EVERYTHING THAT WE DO IS DIRECTED TOWARDS BUILDING THE KINGDOM, and therefore BUILDING THE CONGREGATION. The sowing process might involve, Sunday School, Welfare, Evangelisation, the leadership of a Cell-group or even Church-planting. I must have an **alliance i.e "belong" to a Congregation or a Church,** I can't expect God to bless me if I am not involved and not committed.

Haggai 1:6 ⁶ Ye have sown much, and bring in little; ye eat, but ye have not enough; ye drink, but ye are not filled with drink; ye clothe you, but there is none warm; and he that earneth wages earneth wages to put it into a bag with holes. (KJV)

EVERYTHING THAT I DO MUST GLORIFY GOD AND BUILD "HIS" KINGDOM, it must not be for myself and "MY" kingdom.

Col 3:23 ²³ And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men; (KJV)

<u>4.2.3 TO WATER –</u>

TO WATER IS TO WORK WHERE OTHERS HAVE ALREADY SOWED, the same principal applies, that **what I do, I do for God,** and NOT for people. **Col 3:23**



1 Corinthians 3:6 ⁶ *I have planted,* **Apollos watered;** but God gave the increase. (KJV)

To water where somebody else have sown, is just as important as the sowing process itself. You're "watering" can be a confirmation to what God gave previously, it can be love where somebody else already started. The "watering" IS WORD IN PRAXIS. People who have not just heard the Word for the first time, it is a day to day demonstration in lives of Children of God.

Maybe you are not "starting" the Sunday School, Children's Church, Cell-group or a Church, but you are "watering" where other's have sowed, and that is just as important because without that, there will be no growth. Even if I don't see any seedling originate, I must still water conscientiously. We need to persist with patience.


Hebrews 10:36 ³⁶ For ye have need of patience, that, **after ye have done the will of God**, ye might **receive** the promise. (KJV)

Just like the one who has sown, you will also receive your reward **. How** God does it and **when** is up to **Him**.

4.2.4 GOD WILL GIVE THE INCREASE -

1 Corinthians 3:6 ⁶ *I have planted, Apollos watered; but* God gave the increase. (KJV)

Mark 4:26-28 ²⁶ And he said, So is the kingdom of God, as if a man should cast seed into the ground; ²⁷ And should sleep, and rise night and day, **and the seed should spring and grow up, he knoweth not how.** ²⁸ For the earth bringeth forth fruit **of herself**; first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear. (KJV) How this happens (we knoweth not how) ONLY GOD KNOWS......



For the earth bringeth forth fruit of herself(AUTOMATIC)....

The word that is used here, is the Greek word **"Automatos"** whereof the word **"Automatic"** is derived from, whereupon NATURAL CHURCH-GROWTH PRINCIPALS are based. The word means: 1) to be moved by one"s own impulse, or acting without the instigation or intervention of another......

GOD DOES NOT NEED OUR HELP WHEN IT COMES TO THE GROWTH.

We must therefore not be concerned over HOW GOD DOES "HIS" WORK, ONLY ON HOW I COMPLETE "MY" ASSIGNMENTS..... Make discipels.....Baptise them..... and teach them......AND GOD WILL MAKE THE GROWTH possible.

1 Corinthians 3:7 ⁷ So then neither is he that planteth any thing, neither he that watereth; **but God that giveth the increase.** (KJV)

WHEN WE TALK ABOUT GROWTH WE MUST DISTINGUISH BETWEEN QUANTITIVE GROWTH and QUALITIVE GROWTH:

4.2.5.1 QUANTITIVE GROWTH -

Acts 2:47⁴⁷ Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And **the Lord added to the church daily** such as should be saved. (KJV)

Acts 5:14¹⁴ And believers were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.) (KJV)

As long as I complete my' assignment, GOD WILL GIVE THE INCREASE, I don't have to take the responsibility for the growth.

4.2.5.2 QUALITIVE GROWTH -

Psalm 92:12-13 ¹² The **righteous shall flourish** like the palm tree: **he shall grow** like a cedar in Lebanon. ¹³ Those that be planted in the house of the LORD **shall flourish** in the courts of our God. (KJV)

Hebrews 5:12-14 ¹² For when for the time **ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again** which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. ¹³ **For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe.** ¹⁴ But strong meat belongeth to them that are of **full age**(mature), even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil. (KJV)

It is important to realise that the obedience to the assignment of God helps to bring the growth to a movement. It is not just expected of me to help the Kingdom expand, but also to help every member entrusted to me, to become an adult Christian.

Ephesians 4:11-15 ¹¹ And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; ¹² For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: ¹³ Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ: (KJV).....¹⁴ That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; ¹⁵ But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ: (KJV)

QUALITIVE GROWTH ENTAILS THE FOLLOWING:


4.2.5 REMOVE THE RUBBLE / WEADS

Because GROWTH is determined by God, and it happens "**AUTOMATICALLY**" (BY ITSELF) , we must remove and get rid of everything which can hinder growth i.e :

4.2.5.1 LACK OF VISION:

Prov 29:18 -Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he. (KJV)

Because we have heard from God, we are diligent to DO HIS WILL, but if I do not remind myself and others what the vision is, we might get discouraged , lose heart and will eventually lose faith, and that will hinder growth.



4.2.5.2 LACK OF KNOWLEDGE

Prov 19:2 -

Rom 10:1-2 _____

Many a times we as TEACHERS; (THE PEOPLE WITH THE ASSIGNMENT), start a work without doing the groundwork properly. We **do not know** "THE LAND", **we do not know** "THE PEOPLE", **we do not know** the circumstances or whether they are ready to receive the Gospel.

When we start the task, how genuine our intentions might be, growth is hindered baie a lack of knowledge and a lack of strategy.

The disciple who is not teachable and does not learn, hinders growth by their unwillingness to be taught and trained. They will never become Spiritually mature.

Matt 11:29 ; ___

John 7:16-17_____

4.2.5.3 LACK OF FAITH

Hebr 11:6 ⁶ But without faith it is impossible to please Him(GOD): for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. (KJV)

James 1:6-7 ⁶ But **let him ask in faith**, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. ⁷ For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord. (KJV)

Sometimes we expect a harvest but does not receive one, because of a lack of faith. A Lack of faith and doubt can hinder growth .

4.2.5.4 BROKEN RELATIONSHIPS:

SIN = broken relationships. Whether we sinned against God or against one another, it not only ruins realtionships but hinders growth as well

Therefore we have to follow **Matt 5:22-24** ... ²² But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire. ²³ Therefore if thou bring thy gift to the altar, and there rememberest that thy brother hath ought against thee; ²⁴ Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift. (KJV)

THE 4 STEP WAY OF SOLVING PROBLEMS: Matt18:15-17

¹⁵ Moreover if thy brother shall trespass against thee :

1. **go and tell him his fault between thee and him alone**: if he shall hear thee, thou hast gained thy brother., ¹⁶ But if he will not hear thee....

2. *then* take with thee one or two more, that in the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established. ¹⁷ And if he shall neglect to hear

3. tell it unto the church: but if he neglect to hear the church

4. ONLY THEN... let him be unto thee as an heathen man and a publican ...

I MUST TRY MY UTMOST TO WIN BACK MY BROTHER /SISTER, if they do want to cooperate, and you have tried the first 3 steps, then only can you treat them as heathens. REALTIONAL PROBLEMS ARE MOSTLY CAUSED BY PERSONAL PROBLEMS. Therefore you and I have to determine our Personalities.

A lack of RELATIONSHIP can hinder growth – one of the biggest reasons why sinners do not come to church is because of "believers" not living in harmony. **Heb 10:24**_____

1 Pet 4:8;

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John 13:35.

Matt 18:18: ¹⁸ Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. (KJV)" BROKEN RELATIONSHIPS CAUSES BONDAGES, TO ME AS WELL AS TO MY BROTHER, I MUST NOT HOLD ANY GRUDGES AGAINST MY BROTHER.

4.2.5.5 INADAPTABILITY - (RESISTANCE TO CHANGE)

We we are not able to adapt to the changes of the ages, it can hinder growth as well. I.e: Today's youth cannot be reached in the same way as Twenty years ago. **Children** are confronted with the latest Playstation-games and are not intersted in the same characters as when we were young. Our congregation-members have become more sophisticated, wiser, more experienced, which means that they are no longer satisfied with the same churches, the same pews or the same manner of worship as before. Even the music differs from that of 10-20 years ago and only a few people is still satisfied with the praise and worship of yesteryear. **Congregations** cannot expect to grow if they do not adapt to the latest Praise and Worship trends. ("RTC – Resistance to Change"; if we want to stay relevant in this day and age, we have to change.)

ADAPTABILITY DOES NOT MEAN COMPROMISE - We do not have to compromise our value system, or the message of the Bible. Our ways in which we portray it, might change.

4.2.5.6 LACK OF PRAYER / INTERCESSION

Is 59:16 - And he saw that there was no man, and wondered that there was **no** intercessor

EVERYONE OF US IS ABLE TO WIN A SOUL FOR THE LORD. We must just make sure that we are tuned into God's voice to hear **when** "the harvest is ready". God can use each one of us, but God has chosen some of us to sow, others to water...and some others to bring in the harvest. That is the reason why only some experience the calling as an Evangelist or Missionary.



Luke 10:2 ² Therefore said he unto them, The harvest truly is great, but the **labourers** are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, **that he would send forth labourers** into his harvest. (KJV)

A FEW THINGS TO CONSIDER WHEN BRINGING IN THE HARVEST

a. THE FULFILLMENT – God's wil (John 4:34)

Our greatest joy and our biggest fulfillment comes from the knowledge that I pleased the Lord by doing what He asked me.

John 4:34 _

b. TIMING – God's timing – (John 4:35)

We must be sensitive to the leading of the Holy Spirit to know God's exact timing (kairos moment). We must not move too early or too late, because that would influence the effectiveness of what it is God wants achieved.

John 4:35 ³⁵ Say not ye, There are yet four months, and then cometh harvest? behold, say unto you, **Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields**; for they are white already to harvest.

c. THE REWARD - SOULS FOR THE KINGDOM (John 4:36)

....³⁶ And he that reapeth **receiveth wages**, and gathereth fruit unto life eternal . God is our rewarder, we must not seek the approval of, or our reward from man. Our reward here on earth is the knowledge that I have been used by God.

Col 3:24 -²⁴ Knowing that **of the Lord ye shall receive the reward** of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ. (KJV)

This reward I do not receive here on earth, but in heaven . **Heb 10:35-36 teaches us:** ³⁵ Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath **great recompence of reward**. ³⁶ For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye **might receive the promise**. (*KJV*).

I must never envy the one who bring in he harvest, and must never fear that my labour was in vain or has not been noticed by God. Whether I sow or water or reap, EVERYONE OF US MUST REJOICE IN EVERY SOUL THAT WAS BROUGHT INTO THE KINGDOM OF GOD.

d. THE GLORY – All GLORY belongs to God.(John 4:38)

The soulwinner must not boast in themselves for bringing in a soul, and must not become proud. All Glory belongs to God. Somebody has sown, someone else watered where we now harvest. All had a part but the Glory belongs to God.

John 4:36 that both he that soweth and he that reapeth may rejoice together. The harvester must always remember : John 4:38- ³⁸ I sent you to reap that whereon ye bestowed no labour: other men laboured, and ye are entered into their labours. (KJV)

2 Cor 10:17 - ¹⁷ But he that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord. (KJV)

All we must be , is obedient then we will all experience the joy of being part of every soul saved.. EVERY WORKER WHETHER THEY WERE PART OF THE PREPARATION, SOWING, WATERING, REMOVAL OF HINDERANCES OR EVEN THE HARVESTING,ALL CAN REJOICE IN THE LORD FOR EVERY SOUL WHICH CAME INTO THE KINGDOM.

4.3 MY EQUIPMENT AND AUTHORITY

Here we must distinguish between (1) **POWER** and (2) **MIGHT**...

- 1. **POWER MY EQUIPMENT** these are the TOOLS and WEAPONS which I received from God to carry out my assignment effectively .
- 2. **MIGHT MY AUTHORITY** this is to make sure that nothing prevents me from carrying out my assignment .

The best example to explain the difference is a TRAFFIC OFFICER. To distinguish between POWER and MIGHT or between EQUIPMENT and AUTHORITY is as follows: If the traffic officer tries to stop an oncoming vehicle in his own power, he wil be flattened. But if he should lift up his hand to indicate to the driver to stop, the vehicle must come to a halt because the traffic officer acts in the AUTHORITY of the TRAFFIC DEPARTMENT and therefore of the GOVERNMENT.

There are certain things that we can do in **POWER** but hat is then the POWER and EQUIPMENT given by GOD. Other things can only be done in the MIGHT and AUTHORITY given by GOD.

The greek word for **POWER** as used in **Acts 1:8**, is the word "**dunamis**" which is translated as : " strength power, ability, power for performing miracles power consisting in or resting upon armies, forces, hosts." This means THE POWER, STRENGTH and ABILITY given by the HOLY SPIRIT to fulfill God's commission.

2 Tim 1:7 _____

The word "MIGHT" is derived from the Greek word " **exousia**" which is translated as w "power of choice, liberty of doing as one pleases ; leave or permission; the power of authority (influence) and of right (privilege); the power of rule or government; jurisdiction." This means the AUTHORITY which I have received TO RULE .(Specially over the works of Satan).

Mark 11:28-29

Ephes 1:18-21 ...; that ye may know the exceeding greatness of his **power(DUNAMIS)** to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his **mighty power**, ²⁰ Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places, ²¹ Far above all **principality**, and **power**, and **might**, and **dominion**, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: (KJV)

Col 2:10 ¹⁰ And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and **power: (EXOUSIA – AUTHORITY)** (KJV)

4.3.1 MY EQUIPMENT (POWER)

Hebr 13:21 – (May God...).²¹ *Make you perfect in every good work* to do His will, working in you that which is wellpleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen. (KJV)

My EQUIPMENT consists of the following : (1) The TOOLS (GIFTS) to do the WORK God has commissioned me to do. As well as (2) the WEAPONS to resist the onslaught of Satan.

I must realise that for every command that God gives me, there is a devil, demon or evil spirit to prevent me from achieving my goal.



The number one question in everyone's life: If God wants us then to understand what His will is, why is it then so difficult to find out what it is? (Discuss)

Let's look first at a few misconceptions: What God's will isn't.

a) God's will is not a **feeling.**

Jer 17:19..."Who can understand the human heart? There is nothing else so deceitful; it is too sick to be healed.

- b) God's will is also not a <u>formula</u>. There is not a ten-step formula to know the will of God.
- c) God's will is a <u>communion</u>.
- d) Not a set of **rules**, but <u>a Relationship</u>.
- e) Not a road map, but a lifestyle.
- f) Not an **agenda**, but an **attitude**.

Discuss for 10 minutes?: **1 Cor 1:9** *God is to be trusted, the God who called you to have fellowship with his Son Jesus Christ, our Lord.*

- a) Don't be <u>fatalistic</u> about the will of God. (**Jn 7:17**) God wants to include my choices in His will.
- b) Don't have any <u>fears</u> about God's will. (**Jer 29:11**) God's will is an expression of His love.
- c) Don't get <u>frustrated</u> about His will. (**Rom 8:28**) God's will is a long-term process that includes **problems** and **pleasure.**

The right attitude = FAITH.

Today it's actually different:- Jn 1:12 - Everyone who believes in Him

What was her answer? <u>V 28</u> On WHAT account did she receive what she asked? <u>Her Testimony</u>.

What was Balaam's relationship with God? Did he know God? Could he hear God's voice? **Num 22:9-10** Living relationships – talk with each other.

What did Balak want from him? ... **Num 22:5-7** <u>King of Moabites – fears – asks – comes to curse the nation – tries to bribe Balaam.</u> Is that not what the devil wants to do with each one of us? The word "integrity" means no compromise.

What did God say? ... v 12 ...what was Balaam's answer? ... v 18

What did God say the second time? ...v 20 ... only what I say may you speak.

The consequences of compromising: (lack of integrity)

- a) Makes God angry ... **v 22**
- b) Blinds us ... v 23
- c) Makes us selfish deceivers ... (**Read: Jude: 10-12**)

What was Balaam's reaction because he could not see? <u>Gets angry; loses temper; lack of self-control...</u> What do we do?

Firstly God must speak to him in supernatural ways – 1. Donkey; 2. Angel; - Could not see – could not worship – only when God spoke supernaturally – he heard.

People only change because:

- a) They have a good enough reason they want to change or
- b) They HURT enough THEY HAVE TO change.

Read: 2 Cor 3:18; Rom 12:2-3

WHAT MUST GOD DO SO THAT WE REMAIN OBEDIENT TO HIS WORD?

Realise that no curse can bring you down if God has chosen to bless you. – Gen 12:2; Gal 3: 13-14; Deut 28:1-14; Prov 10:22; Num 24:9

Paul is born-again at this occasion

- a) He calls Him Lord.
- b) He is called from here to ministry Acts 26: Testifies how God has sent him and God does not send unbelievers.
- c) Ananias calls Him brother.
- d) What happens to his companions? Could they hear His voice? <u>Yes, but they didn't understand</u> **Acts 9:7**

Read Acts 22:7-9 – Does the Word contradicts itself? Discuss

What happened to Judas Iscariot? Look at all the scriptures. Are there contradictions? **Mt 27:5; Acts 1:18** – What did actually happened to him? (It has been said that he hanged himself and that his insides came out.)

What about Cain? ... Where did he get his wife? ... Were there woman we did not know of? **Gen 4:1-2; Gen 4:13**

Acts 9 = heard voice – but didn't see ... Acts 22: = nothing heard –

In Greek the word – "they did not hear" actually means "they did not understand".

That is: they could not discern His voice.

Read: Jn 12:28 What did Jesus hear?

What did His disciples hear?

What did the crowd hear?

OUR SPIRITUAL CONDITION DETERMINES **<u>HOW</u>** WE HEAR GOD'S VOICE.

Isn't it strange how different people hear the same voice differently? Even though it's an audible voice, I must be spiritually TUNED IN to hear the voice.

Must still have FAITH

Must be PREPARED TO hear God's voice.

WHY DO WE SELDOM TODAY HEAR GOD SPEAK OUT ALOUD TO US?

- a) We have the Word **2 Tim 3:16-17**
- b) We have the indwelling Holy Spirit **1 Jn 2:27**
- c) God uses His body Eph 4:11-12
- d) Only if above three don't work!

4. WORKS

Pray for each other that God, in whichever way is needed, will talk to you and that you will know His will and do it.

CELLGROUP MATERIAL 16

1. WELCOME / ICEBREAKER

2. WORSHIP

3. WORD: (STILL SMALL VOICE – LIKE ELIJAH)

Read: 1 Kings 19:11-12 – take note of the ways God reveals himself.

- a) Very strong wind Jn 3:8; Ps 18:10
- b) Earthquake Ps 104:32; Ps 114:7; Jer 10:10; Joel 3:16; Heb 12:26
- c) A fire Heb 12:29; Acts 2:3; Mt 3:11

GOD CAN TALK TO US – He could use the above elements but He could choose other ways and after the fire there was a whispering in the silence ... and after the fire a still small voice. It requires good power of discernment to hear in spite of the noise on the mountain.

Take note of the following:

- a) Firstly he didn't recognize the voice.
- b) But he reacted to that which was recognisable.

1 Kings 19:13...When Elijah heard it; he covered his face with his cloak and went out and stood at the entrance of the cave. A voice said to him, "Elijah, what are you doing here?"

Take note of the two ways God speaks to him – First the whisper then the loud, audible voice.

- a) <u>First voice:</u> Could not make out the words; just remember the voice in spite of all the other voices around him. Enough was the recognition that he reacted to.
- b) <u>Second voice:</u> What are you doing here? Undeniably he could hear the voice and could hear what He was saying.

Will God also speak to us like that? Read: Isaiah 20:21

A few things that we must realize

- a) <u>God speaks inside our frame of reference</u>– Like Samuel who heard the voice but didn't know who was speaking. Sometimes people's voices sound alike, especially over the telephone and then we think it is someone else because it's our frame of reference. What about Elijah? What about John on the Island of Patmos?
- b) We must be in the centre of God's will. Samuel served God. Elisha compromised and his sons strayed totally. Only Samuel heard God's voice. In **Matt 17:6** God talks to His Son for the people it sounded like thunder, because Jesus was in God's will. Others would say it's the angels or your spiritual maturity, which will determine how you hear God's voice.
- c) Your reaction determines whether God will speak to you again.

Samuel reacted immediately – just-wrong person. Elisha came out underneath the tree immediately and found God on the mountain – there he heard God's voice again. Your reactions determine if God will speak to you again. Give honour that you hear God's voice.

Lord, please help us to discern your voice.

Acts 10: 9-18 ... The next day, as they were on their way and coming near Joppa, Peter went up on the roof of the house about noon in order to pray.

PETER DID KNOW (SAW) WORSHIPPED

He became hungry and wanted something to eat; while the food was being prepared, he had a vision.

PETER HEARD FROM GOD IN TWO WAYS:

a) Had/saw a vision – **v 11**

b) Heard God's voice – **v 12**

WHAT DID HE SEE? **v 11-12** ... He saw heaven opened and something coming down that looked like a large sheet being lowered by its four corners to the earth. In it were all kinds of animals, reptiles, and wild birds.

WHAT DID HE HEAR? **v 13** ... A voice said to him, "Get up, Peter; kill and eat!" WHAT WAS PETER'S REACTION? **v 14** ... But Peter said, "Certainly not, Lord! I have never eaten anything ritually unclean or defiled."

If Peter had a living relationship with God, why did he refuse God?

What hinders us that we sometimes disobey God?

- 1. My own preferences: When I choose what I want and do not want.
- 2. My ______ I do not have to listen to anybody else.
- 3. Tradition **v 14** ... I did not grow up like that.
- 4. Religious Spirit My forefather (ancestors) / church never did it or approved it.

WHAT IS GOD'S ANSWER TO OUR EXCUSES? v 15

... "Do not consider anything unclean that God has declared clean."

The fact that God did not withdraw from Peter the first time, speaks of His grace. God is gracious to us and patient with us because He wants us to share in His great redeeming plan.

IF GOD GIVES or ASKS ME SOMETHING then I will NEED IT in the near future. **v 17**

4. WORKS – THE IMPLEMENTATION

Pray that God will help you that nothing will hinder you from hearing his voice.

Take a piece of paper and wait on the Lord; write down what your vision is for your cell group. Ask the Lord to show you His plan for you, get together and compare notes.

Definition of a prophet

The Greek word is "prophetes" which literally means "to speak directly". "Nabi" is the Hebrew word which means "someone who reveals something to someone else". Another Hebrew word is translated into titles like "the prophet", "a watchman", and "messenger of the Lord", etc.

Prophecy is from God

1 Cor 12: 28 And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily <u>prophets</u>, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues.

Why did God give this gift/ ministry?

Eph 4: 12 – 13

(a) To equip the saints

(b) To build up the body of Christ – Eph 2: 19 - 22

- (c) Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God
- (d) unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ:

<u>Jesus as Prophet</u> Deut 18: 15 – 18; Jn 12: 47 – 48

The Holy Spirit speaks prophetically Jn 16:13

<u>Us, as Prophets</u>

Read: Ex 7:1 – 2; 2 Pet 1:21 "inspired by the Holy Ghost, the saints spoke of God ... **Jer 1: 7 -**9

The ministry of a prophet = called and appointed by the Lord Jesus Christ to be His spokesperson to the church and to the nation.

Prophetic utterance = to speak and make known the will and intention of the Lord to the heathen, to warn and give direction, as well as to tell of future events. To motivate the body, and to exhort in situations where there is distrust, hopelessness and lethargy.

The characteristics of a prophet

- Prophets are called by God and not by man Eph 1: 18; Eph 4:1; Heb 3:1
- Prophets are anointed they are not ordained **1 Kings 19:16**
- They are holy men Separated for God 1 Thess 4:7
- They have a vision for the church and for the nation Dan 9:24
- They are intercessors Ezek 13:4
- They are subject to judgement 1 Cor 14: 29

Read also: Acts 21:9; 1 Cor 14: 1 – 6; 22; Rev 1:3



- c) and salute no man by the way. Keep focused on the goal the goal is to win souls. Acts 1:8; Mt 28:19
- d) v 5 6 ⁵And into whatsoever house ye enter, first say, Peace be to this house. ⁶ And if the son of peace be there, your peace shall rest upon it: if not, it shall turn to you again Bring a message of PEACE
- e) **v 7** <u>Go not from house to house</u>, make sure that every soul is 1. Saved; 2. Baptised; 3. Plugged in to a local church or cell group to learn. (Mt 28:18-20)
- f) v 7 8 ⁷ And in the same house remain, eating and drinking such things as they give: for the labourer is worthy of his hire. Go not from house to house. ⁸ And into whatsoever city ye enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you: accept the manner in which God provides for your needs.

- b) What is a STRONGHOLD? The word means : castle, fortress, = the wrong castle!

Differentiate between = INABILITY and a STRONGHOLD:

- **Inability** = Something that I **cannot do** no matter how hard I try e.g. 100 m race.
- **Stronghold** = Something that I **can do** but **do not want to do** or do not know how to do. E.g. temper/ smoking/ drinking/ pornography/ television/ gossip/ lust

c) HOW IS A STRONGHOLD DEVELOPED?

- It first appears in one's thoughts (by suggestion) e.g. **Gen 3:1-3**; (Did God say?)
- It becomes a contradiction of God's word Gen 3:4-5
- Becomes an imagination: Gen 3:6

d) What do our weapons look like?- <u>They are not carnal weapons</u>...Eph 6:

Motto of the French Legion: = FOR US IS NOT TO QUESTION WHY, FOR US IS BUT TO DO AND DIE.

- e) Who makes our weapons effective?- God 2 Cor 10:4
- f) What do we do with these weapons? We tear down strongholds

g) HOW? –

- Take our thoughts captive in obedience to: James 1:12-14: Eph 2:3; Heb 4:12; 2 Thess 3:5; Col 3:2; Phil 4:7-8; Eph 4:23-24
- Destroy every attack of pride: Know your Bible and do it
- Destroy every imagination: **<u>Do not justify your actions</u>**

Zerubbabel had been commanded to rebuild the temple – his natural reaction was to build it in the only manner that he knew how.

What does the angel teach him? How is it possible? – Not with (my) strength (weapons and equipment). Also not with my power (authority). But by **the Spirit of God** (His power and might)

According to Ps 44: 3, also, the victory is

- a) Not with the sword (power)
- b) Not in their own strength (authority)

But (1) in His strength , (2) His power and (3) His presence

Why?because He loves you. Read: Is 41:8-11; Is 43:4-6; Dan 10:11-12; Jn 14:21-23; Rom 8:37-39

Now read : Acts 19:13-16

- a) Did the sons of Sceva know Paul? (Yes) / and the demon? (Yes) "Paul I know"
- b) Did they know Jesus? (No; they speak of the Jesus whom Paul preached)
- c) What about the demon? (v 15 yes) "Jesus I know (Perhaps it had previously been cast out) **James 2:19** The evil spirits also believe but not unto salvation ...
- d) Why could the sons of Sceva not do what Paul could? Do => Hear => Worship => Know(See) You can do nothing for God – if you do not know Jesus personally (Even if you grew up in the church – N.B. – the seven were sons of a Jewish high priest)
 e) Did the demon recognise them? - No – "but who are you?"
- f) Has the devil noticed you?

Are you destroying his works? Is he afraid of you or are you afraid of him?

What is the result if you try to fight the devil in your own strength?

v 16 And the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, and overcame them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded. (KJV)
