CHAPTER 01

Today, as we live in the last days on earth, Satan does two things to people, as there are two kinds of people on this earth. First let us check who the two kinds of people are according to the word of God;

- 1. The believers.
- 2. The non-believers.

The two things that Satan will do to these two kinds of people are:-

a). Making the believer a non-believer. Simply making salvation null and void so the moment you die you will reach Hell for good. Though you have lost salvation, sometimes you do not know about it until you reach the gates of hell. May be I am too bold to write here what I said, as many Christians do think and believe that they will reach heaven the moment they die even they do not practice God's commandments and as they do not have a personal relationship with Jesus our saviour and Lord.

The second thing he does is;

b). Making the non-believer confirmed in non-belief. Simply bringing a non-believer to a situation of never believing. Because of the believers and servants have lost salvation, the non believer will never see Jesus in them due to lack of testimony through one's own life. The non-believer will never come to know or experience Jesus Christ.

Though we are very much interested in the second category of people, as Christians and servants of God, in this book I am going to show you of one very very important side of, how Satan will make us believers loose salvation and make a believer a non-believer. The moment we correct this situation we have the answer to the second kind too.

While reading this book please pray that God the Holy Spirit will open your Spiritual eyes to see what He is talking about. There are many who are going through situations like what you will read in this book in this world today. Please pray so that they will also get a chance to overcome similar situations. Today there are many Christians who are born again or saved by the grace but have not become new creatures. They still indulge in their old sins. Therefore at this point let us identify the true Christian.

I personally take someone as a true Christian when he or she fulfils the following 3 points.

1st Point

Believing in Christ

1. You must know and believe Jesus Christ as your personal saviour and as the only begotten son of living God.

(While repenting for the sins committed so far and by asking Jesus to come in to one's life). You should be born again). (Salvation of Justification).

Acts 2:36-38

- **36** "Therefore let all Israel be assured of this: God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ."
- 37 When the people heard this, they were cut to the heart and said to Peter and the other apostles, "Brothers, what shall we do?"
- **38** Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

John 3:5-7

- **5** Jesus answered, "I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit.
- 6 Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit.
- 7 You should not be surprised at my saying, 'You must be born again.'

* Dear reader this is it; you need to be born again.

Matt 16:13-17

- **13** When Jesus came to the region of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, "Who do people say the Son of Man is?"
- **14** They replied, "Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, Jeremiah or one of the prophets."

15 "But what about you?" he asked. "Who do you say I am?"

16 Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

17 Jesus replied, "Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah, for this was not revealed to you by man, but by my Father in heaven.

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In this particular passage, you will notice that after coming to Caesarea Philippi, Jesus Christ asking a simple question from His disciples. He is asking, "Who do people say the Son of Man is?"

The disciples of Jesus answered correctly by telling Him exactly what people said about Him. Then after hearing that, Jesus is asking another question and that is, "But what about you? Who do you say I am?" *Verse 16* was Peter's answer.

You see here, Peter gives not one but two answers. When Jesus heard the two answers, Jesus is explaining a spiritual truth to His disciples. He is saying unless His father in heaven reveals this to Peter, no man with his intellectual capability cannot do it. (The two answers are;

- 1. You are the Christ, which means Saviour,
- 2. Son of the living God),

Please note that Jesus says very clearly that flesh and blood (man) cannot give this answer regarding who He is.

Dear reader you do the following test. Take ten of your best friends and ask them who Jesus is? Their answer will be one but not both or something else. Any man on this earth will give at least one answer about Jesus Christ if you ask them, (even if they are non-Christian) but not both. Unless you are really born again your answer will be different to the biblical answer Peter gave.

2nd Point

Thirst for word

2. When you have thirst for the word of God, where obedience comes automatically. (Salvation of Sanctification).

Ps 119:9. How can a young man keep his way pure? By living according to your word.

Ps 119:11. I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.

Ps 119:105-106

105 Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path.

106 I have taken an oath and confirmed it, that I will follow your righteous laws. (from The Holy Bible: New International Version. Copyright (c) 1973, 1978, 1984, by International Bible Society)

Without thirst for the word no one could be called a Christian. Today in this world there are many who say "I love Jesus". But if one loves Jesus, they will spend a lot of

time with Him. Just for an example take a young couple who are in love. They will spend as much as time together so that they will know each other better. It is the same with Jesus. The one who wants to be the bride of Jesus will want to spend time as much as he can to know Jesus better. When one knows Jesus better he or she will adjust life accordingly so Jesus will be happy. If anyone wants to know Jesus better, he or she will read His word, who became flesh to live among us.

3rd Point

Thirst to serve

When you are bride of Christ, there are certain things you will fulfil as your part to remain as bride/wife. You will fulfil the day-to-day requirements of your husband. With Jesus, the most important of them is the great commission.

Matt 28:18-20

- **18** Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.
- 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,
- **20** and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

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To fulfil the great commission we need to spend time at His feet for constant guidance. We need to be well nourished with the word. We should be attached to a spirit filled local church, where fellowship with those people is appreciated at all times by you and your family. We need to have good testimony, which will touch people.

In the Kingdom Of God There are no spiritual civilians. You get only spiritual soldiers. Anyone who decides to fight for Christ is a soldier and he or she is serving the living God. Therefore if you do not want to serve I do not recon you as a true Christian. Some one might wonder if all become servants, where will one find people to be served. Dear reader the word of God is very clear in saying that even on the day of the Lord there will be unbelievers on this earth.

For an example take a big company in this world. They will recruit and recruit until the company is full of workers and then they will announce that there are no more vacancies. But in God's kingdom we always have vacancies as God tells us to pray that many will become farmers to gather the harvest specially during the end of times.

Satan does not like to see someone getting saved by the blood of Jesus. The moment you do so you become the enemy of Satan and he will start attacking you. If you do not get trained to fight, and wants to remain as a civilian in the Kingdom of God you are sure to loose the battle.

God the Holy Spirit advice all children of God to wear God's armour. Armour is worn by soldiers not civilians. Even in the secular world it is war rules to wear armour before fighting or else the civilians will get killed if you fight in civilian clothing. In the modern world we see a few

wars are being fought in civilian clothing. Men have become so inhuman they do not mind civilian deaths during a war. But remember Our God Almighty don't like to see His fighters fighting in civilian clothing, and that is why He wants us to wear His armour before fighting.

1 Peter 2:9

9 But you are a *chosen people*, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

See! This scripture tells us that all of us are His chosen people, all of us are His royal priesthood and all of us are His holy nation (one nation). That means if we all are priests, we are serving God in some way. I received salvation in 1986. I learnt this principle of becoming a soldier in God's army much more lately but still God taught me to become one.

You see, all who sail are not swimmers but when we sail the thought comes automatically "why didn't I learn to swim?", because only when you sail you get to think whether the ship will sink due to some problem. Though it is so in the secular world, God does not want us to be like that in His kingdom. That is why He has a five-fold system of ministry established where one ministry is for the teachers. The teacher is able to teach with the guidance of God The Holy Spirit, how to fight the spiritual battles victoriously.

God the Holy Spirit is the third person of the Trinity who lead us in to all truth. Therefore when I teach, I would pray that God the Holy Spirit will use only my mouth to speak what He desire as He is the teacher of all teachers.

Eph 6:13-17

- 13 Therefore put on the full armour of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand.
- **14** Stand firm then, *with the belt of truth* buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place,
- **15** and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace.
- **16** In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one.
- 17 Take the helmet of salvation and the *sword of the Spirit*, *which is the word of God*.

In God's armour I have highlighted two articles for your observation. In the olden days the belt used to hold the sword in the armour of soldiers. Without the belt you cannot carry the sword. In God's armour the belt is called the truth. The fight between God's kingdom and Satan's kingdom is between truth and lies. God is the giver of truth, where Satan is the father of all lies.

If we are not wearing the belt of truth, that means we are not on God's side but we are fighting for Satan army. Because only God is truth.

Further if we do not wear the belt of truth, which means we cannot wear the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

What is God the Holy Spirit talking to us here? If we think for a moment, even a non-believer can know the word of God if they study and memorize? Here, the word of God means, the revelation word of God the Holy Spirit, which is also called Rhema word. Anyone who reads the word can know the written meaning of it without any difficulty. But if one wants to know the purpose of the word, then, only God The Holy Spirit can reveal it to us. Without knowing the purpose of the word, even if we speak the good news to hundreds of people, even one wouldn't come to accept Christ.

Therefore if you are not wearing the belt of truth, I am convinced that you do not know the purpose of the word of God. You will be a person who is trying to nourish your flock with processed food (a word revealed to someone else) not the oven fresh (a word revealed to you direct). Or if you are a believer, you will be learning a lot from others than learning direct from God The Holy Spirit.

The armour of God is amazing. When you are a believer, you are to wear them for your protection because you are at war at all times. We can wear all the armour only when we allow God The Holy Spirit to sanctify us fully. You might think this is impossible but the moment we come to read the chapter regarding holiness in this book, you will know it is possible.

Therefore dear reader to me a true Christian will have three aspects in his walk with the Christ and that is 'To be born again, thirst for the word and thirst to serve.

CHAPTER 02

A FEW DEFINITIONS

Adultery

Wilful sexual intercourse with someone other than one's husband or wife. (Nelson's new illustrated Bible dictionary).

Fornication

Sexual relationships outside the bonds of marriage. The technical distinction between fornication and adultery is that adultery involves married persons while fornication involves at least one unmarried person. (Nelson's new illustrated Bible dictionary).

Lasciviousness

Having, manifesting or arousing sensual desires, Lustful. (Funk & Wagnall's Standard Dictionary).

Simply, Looking Sexy.

Incest

Sexual relations with one's relatives, a sin expressly forbidden by the Law of Moses. Intercourse was forbidden with one's mother, father, step mother, step father, sister, brother, grand daughter, grand son, step sister, step brother, aunt, uncle, daughter in-law, son in-law, step daughter, and step son.

Bestiality

Having sexual activity with any kind of beast.

Homosexuality

A male having sexual relationship with another male.

Lesbianism

A female having sexual relationship with another female.

This standard applies as mentioned above to both physical and, spiritual family too. In a lot of passages in the Bible, God speaks about His spiritual family. Let's read one such passage for us to get a good understanding of it.

Ex 20:4-6

Society)

- **4** "You shall not make for yourself an idol in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below.
- 5 You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the fathers to the *third and fourth generation* of those who hate me,
- 6 but showing love to a thousand [generations] of those who love me and keep my commandments. (from The Holy Bible: New International Version. Copyright (c) 1973, 1978, 1984, by International Bible

Here God is talking about our physical generations as well as spiritual generations. When He says that He will punish people who hate Him up to the third and fourth generation, He is talking about the physical generations.

But in verse 6, when He is talking about a thousand generations, He is talking about the spiritual generations. I will tell you why? According to the word of God, a generation is 40 years.

Num 32: 13

13 The LORD's anger burned against Israel and he made them wander in the desert *forty* years, until the whole generation of those who had done evil in his sight was gone.

(from The Holy Bible: New International Version. Copyright (c) 1973, 1978, 1984, by International Bible Society)

From Adam to this day is only 6000 years. If we count them in generations it is 150. For a thousand physical generations to pass there should be at least another 34000 years.

From Adam to Abraham = 2000 years, or 50

Generations.

From Abraham to Jesus = 2000 years, or 50

Generations.

From Jesus to 2000 AD = 2000 years, or 50

Generations.

A thousand Generations = 40,000 years.

As up to date only 150 generations have occupied this earth, for another physical 850 generations will take

another 34000 years. As we are already aware that we are living in the last days, we know this promise should be fulfilled only spiritually.

If that is so, how could it happen?

As the main object of Jesus Christ today in us is that we make disciples of all nations, it is possible that I have a spiritual son or a daughter. It is possible my spiritual son/daughter will have a spiritual son/daughter. It is possible that they will have their own spiritual off spring. Likewise if I serve God according to His plan and purpose, my disciples will have spiritual off spring up to a thousand generations in few years or it could be more too. HALLELUJAH!

Let us see a biblical example of this system as it is God ordained.

In Exodus 18: 13 onwards we see Moses trying to settle problems of the chosen people of God all by himself. The queue to meet Moses is so long and big where Moses don't have time to spend with God as he is tired in the evening. Here we see that God speaks to his father in law and give advise to Moses, how to run his affairs more fluently and systematically. God wants Moses to appoint a leader for every 10 people. Then a leader for every 50. Then a leader for every 100. Finally a leader for every 1000.

If any pastor or a leader of a church is going to follow this principal that church will be a very successful one as it practices God's principals in church building. Also many people who serve in the church will have their spiritual offspring up to a thousand generations within a short period.

CHAPTER 03

Introduction to my writing of this book.

In this present world, there are many demon-possessed people. But there are fifty times more who are demon influenced. You may say you don't believe or you do not agree. The very excuse you will think of is, because all temptations are demon influenced. My answer to this excuse is all temptations do not lead you to sin but what I am writing here will lead you to sin again and again as you have a door opened for demons to attack you. Therefore please keep on reading.

Even if you are demon-possessed or demon influenced the end result is same and that is you will not inherit the Kingdom of God. But the danger and difference in these two are, if you are demon possessed, the demons could be chased out in the name of Jesus. You can come to know Jesus by believing in Him and receive salvation and become a true Christian, so that some day you will be with Jesus Christ forever as He promises eternal life.

The moment you are in to a Spirit filled service, the demons will start manifesting and they will come out in the name of Jesus. The moment you meet some **true** believers who have the power and authority of Jesus Christ and the supernatural gifts of Holy Ghost, with His guidance and command, demon spirits will flee in the name of Jesus.

When you are demon influenced, nothing like this happens because you are not possessed by demons to manifest. The only manifestation you yourself will experience at all is that you will be disobedient to the word of God and even in the secrecy you will harbour sin in your heart. You may be serving or just a believer but simply you are in a position where your mouth says something and your heart says something else. Most of the time your words and heart do not agree. The secular world calls them double minded. When you are demon influenced you need to come out of it.

See! A situation like this no one knows except God. While continuing a long time in the same manner, will bring you to a situation where it is very difficult to deliver you, as it will become a part of your day-to-day life. Though you have received the salvation of justification, as you have not allowed God The Holy Spirit to take you in the paths of Salvation of Sanctification, still you will go to hell when you die. Do you think it is too much to stomach? Dear brother/sister in Christ this is the truth.

I would like to add a personal note to what I said about salvation here as many of you wouldn't know or have not learnt what real salvation is. Salvation divides in to 3 parts.

1st Part

1. SALVATION OF JUSTIFICATION.

Rom 3:23

23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, (from The Holy Bible: New International Version. Copyright (c) 1973, 1978, 1984, by International Bible Society)

At this stage one will acknowledge the sins committed and repent for the sins and will ask Jesus Christ to come in to his or her life.

2nd Part

2. SALVATION OF SANCTIFICATION.

1 Peter 2:1-2

- 1 Therefore, rid yourselves of all malice and all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and slander of every kind.
- **2** Like newborn babies, crave pure spiritual milk, so that by it you may *grow up in your salvation*,

Phil 2:12-15

- 12 Therefore, my dear friends, as you have always obeyed-not only in my presence, but now much more in my absence-continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling,
- **13** for it is God who works in you to will and to act according to his good purpose.
- 14 Do everything without complaining or arguing,
- 15 so that you may become blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a crooked and depraved generation, in which you shine like stars in the universe (from The Holy Bible: New International Version. Copyright (c) 1973, 1978, 1984, by International Bible Society).

At this stage one will allow God the Holy Spirit to work with in you to sanctify you and to make you ready as bride of Jesus Christ. As man cannot change one's character, only God The Holy Spirit will change your character, which will please God.

3rd Part

3. SALVATION OF GLORIFICATION.

1 Cor 15:39-44

- **39** All flesh is not the same: Men have one kind of flesh, animals have another, birds another and fish another.
- **40** There are also heavenly bodies and there are earthly bodies; but the splendour of the heavenly bodies is one kind, and the splendour of the earthly bodies is another.
- **41** The sun has one kind of splendour, the moon another and the stars another; and star differs from star in splendour.
- **42** So will it be with the resurrection of the dead. The body that is sown is perishable, *it is raised imperishable*;
- **43** it is sown in dishonour, it is raised in *glory*; it is sown in weakness, it is raised in power;
- **44** it is sown a natural body, *it is raised a spiritual body*.

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At this stage with the Rapture of the church God will give you a glorified body so that your salvation is complete in glorification.

CHAPTER 04

HOLINESS

Lev 11:44-45

44 I am the LORD your God; consecrate yourselves and be holy, because I am holy. Do not make yourselves unclean by any creature that moves about on the ground.

45 I am the LORD who brought you up out of Egypt to be your God; *therefore be holy, because I am holy.*

1 Peter 1:13-16

13 Therefore, prepare your minds for action; be self-controlled; set your hope fully on the grace to be given you when Jesus Christ is revealed.

14 As obedient children, do not conform to the evil desires you had when you lived in ignorance.

15 But just as he who called you is holy, so *be holy in all you do*;

16 for it is written: "Be holy, because I am holy."

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The key factor of being in constant contact with God is holiness. If we are not holy, God cannot do anything in our lives. Becoming holy is a daily process where sometimes the price you pay is very high. Just to explain how holiness

works in our lives, I would like to give you the following examples from the word of God.

2 Kings 1:1-15

- 1 After Ahab's death, Moab rebelled against Israel.
- 2 Now Ahaziah had fallen through the lattice of his upper room in Samaria and injured himself. So he sent messengers, saying to them, "Go and consult Baal-Zebub, the god of Ekron, to see if I will recover from this injury."
- **3** But the angel of the LORD said to Elijah the Tishbite, "Go up and meet the messengers of the king of Samaria and ask them, 'Is it because there is no God in Israel that you are going off to consult Baal-Zebub, the god of Ekron?"
- **4** Therefore this is what the LORD says: `You will not leave the bed you are lying on. You will certainly die!'" So Elijah went.
- **5** When the messengers returned to the king, he asked them, "Why have you come back?"
- **6** "A man came to meet us," they replied. "And he said to us, `Go back to the king who sent you and tell him, "This is what the LORD says: Is it because there is no God in Israel that you are sending men to consult Baal-Zebub, the god of Ekron? Therefore you will not leave the bed you are lying on. You will certainly die!" "
- 7 The king asked them, "What kind of man was it who came to meet you and told you this?"
- **8** They replied, "He was a man with a garment of hair and with a leather belt around his waist."

The king said, "That was Elijah the Tishbite."

- **9** Then he sent to Elijah a captain with his company of fifty men. The captain went up to Elijah, who was sitting on the top of a hill, and said to him, "Man of God, the king says, 'Come down!"
- 10 Elijah answered the captain, "If I am a man of God, may fire come down from heaven and consume you and your fifty men!" Then fire fell from heaven and consumed the captain and his men.
- 11 At this the king sent to Elijah another captain with his fifty men. The captain said to him, "Man of God, this is what the king says, 'Come down at once!"
- 12 "If I am a man of God," Elijah replied, "may fire come down from heaven and consume you and your fifty men!" Then the fire of God fell from heaven and consumed him and his fifty men.
- 13 So the king sent a third captain with his fifty men. This third captain went up and fell on his knees before Elijah. "Man of God," he begged, "please have respect for my life and the lives of these fifty men, your servants!
- 14 See, fire has fallen from heaven and consumed the first two captains and all their men. But now have respect for my life!"
- 15 The angel of the LORD said to Elijah, "Go down with him; do not be afraid of him." So Elijah got up and went down with him to the king.

We see in this story that God commanded Elijah to go and meet the crowd first and also gave a message for them. If Elijah was not holy at that particular time, God cannot call him for service. Also if Elijah was not holy and if he were acting on flesh, he would have gone to meet the king when the first captain and the fifty came to fetch him up taking in to consideration that the king wants to see him and it is an honour. Or he will still call fire from heaven even on the third time.

As this did not happen, we see that Elijah was living a holy life and ready to receive any command or instruction from the Lord and he was in a position to identify when the Lord spoke.

This whole thing would have taken at least half a day. When the first captain and the fifty were destroyed the news should go to the king for him to send another captain and his fifty. So on and on it would have taken at least half a day. The best part is Elijah was tuned perfectly for half a day to receive revelation and instruction from the Lord continuously throughout this whole episode.

Let us see another passage.

Acts 7:55-60

55 But Stephen, full of the Holy Spirit, looked up to heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God.

56 "Look," he said, "I see heaven open and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God."

57 At this they covered their ears and, yelling at the top of their voices, they all rushed at him,

- **58** dragged him out of the city and began to stone him. Meanwhile, the witnesses laid their clothes at the feet of a young man named Saul.
- **59** While they were stoning him, Stephen prayed, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit."
- **60** Then he fell on his knees and cried out, "Lord, do not hold this sin against them." When he had said this, he fell asleep.

In the book of ACTS we see Stephen is been selected to serve at the tables.

Acts 6:5

Though he was serving at the tables in the local church, as he was living a holy life, God did much more through him and also gave him immense wisdom so that no one could stand against him.

Acts 6:8-15

8 Now Stephen, a man full of God's grace and power, did great wonders and miraculous signs among the people.

- **9** Opposition arose, however, from members of the Synagogue of the Freedmen (as it was called)-Jews of Cyrene and Alexandria as well as the provinces of Cilicia and Asia. These men began to argue with Stephen,
- 10 but they could not stand up against his wisdom or the Spirit by whom he spoke.
- 11 Then they secretly persuaded some men to say, "We have heard Stephen speak words of blasphemy against Moses and against God."
- 12 So they stirred up the people and the elders and the teachers of the law. They seized Stephen and brought him before the Sanhedrin.
- 13 They produced false witnesses, who testified, "This fellow never stops speaking against this holy place and against the law.

What a wonderful promise, and what an appropriate time for God to fulfil it to teach us how true He is and how He expects us to live our lives.

I would like to include one of my favourite passages in the word of God to conclude my examples regarding holiness. Whenever I read this passage I get filled in the Holy Spirit because it is so precious, so awesome and so wonderful.

Rev 1:9-11

- **9** I, John, your brother and companion in the suffering and kingdom and patient endurance that are ours in Jesus, was on the island of Patmos because of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus.
- **10** On the Lord's Day *I was in the Spirit*, and I heard behind me a loud voice like a trumpet,

11 which said: "Write on a scroll what you see and send it to the seven churches: to Ephesus, Smyrna, Pergamum, Thyatira, Sardis, Philadelphia and Laodicea."

I believe when John received this revelation he was an old man. More than 80 years of age. He was in exile in the isle of Patmos awaiting God's call to go home. But see what happens to him. He was living a holy life even in a situation of unofficial imprisonment. God is ready to give the revelation of last days where it will benefit the whole mankind until the return of our Lord Jesus as King of Kings and Lord of Lords.

Hallelujah! I am filled, I am crying, how wonderful my God Is? Because God in His word says what happens to a man when he gets old. I know that too.

Eccl 12:1-7

- 1. Remember your Creator in the days of your youth, before the days of trouble come and the years approach when you will say, "I find no pleasure in them"-
- 2 before the sun and the light and the moon and the stars grow dark, and the clouds return after the rain;
- 3 when the keepers of the house tremble, and the strong men stoop, when the grinders cease because they are few, and those looking through the windows grow dim;
- 4 when the doors to the street are closed and the sound of grinding fades; when men rise up at the sound of birds, but all their songs grow faint;
- 5 when men are afraid of heights and of dangers in the streets; when the almond tree blossoms and the grasshopper drags himself along and desire no longer is stirred. Then man goes to his eternal home and mourners go about the streets.
- **6** Remember him-before the silver cord is severed, or the golden bowl is broken; before the pitcher is shattered at the spring, or the wheel broken at the well,

7 and the dust returns to the ground it came from, and the spirit returns to God who gave it.

In this passage God speaks about a man's old age. He will loose sight, his teeth will fall, his legs will not have strength, he will have no sleep, and he will experience lack of memory and no desire for anything he had in his younger days.

But JOHN? What a contrast? Why? And how?

31 But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint

What a beautiful promise? How do you wait upon the Lord? Holiness is the key. I am sure that all of you who read this book will agree that revelation to John took more than one day. For him to put this on paper it would have taken many days or months because, remember God The Holy Spirit is the author. You have to write according to His plan. As it is written that way, even after 1914 years later still the reader will understand the message and still it is oven fresh and is better than tomorrow's news paper. Hallelujah!

There is a danger for all Christians in this world including all God's servants right throughout their walk with Christ. Most believers and servants of God say, though they are saved, when all sin and weaknesses are gone after becoming a new creation, only one sin or weakness remained. When questioned in detail most of the time they cannot explain why and how?

Most of the time it is the temptation of opposite sex. The attraction is so strong they commit adultery, fornication, incest, they fall, they sin, they crucify Jesus again and again, they enter the road of destruction and they loose salvation, still in the outside they call themselves Christians and identify themselves with Jesus who gave His life on the cross so we may receive forgiveness and believe in Him so we may not perish but inherit eternal life.

The servants who fall into this situation will start doing a lot of worldly things to keep the flock together. The churches will experience spiritual blindness and barrenness. The messages, which come from, the pulpit is no more oven fresh but processed. The church will stop growing, as the Lord cannot bring His people to this kind of carnal atmospheres.

The believers would not have any more significant testimonies to glorify God. When they see a new face once in a blue moon, they will be very happy as they have forgotten how God added people to His first church in the book of **ACTS**. The gifts of the Holy Spirit are dying off as they start talking in the flesh and making a lot of errors. Most servants are used to having pre-service briefings to know the weaknesses and requirements of the flock so when they come behind the pulpit they will talk as God had revealed them. This will cause stirring of emotions and spiritual blindness of the flock.

The closest church members will start leaving the church as a result. The servants the believers who face situations like this cannot find the answer to this type of weakness. How much ever they pray it doesn't work right. How much ever they repent and renounce the sin, still they continue. It has become a part of life and they also do not know why?

Dear brother / sister in Christ or without Christ at the moment, God The Holy Spirit has new revelation and new message for you. Hear it from the Lord! If you are experiencing a similar situation in your walk with Christ, this is for you. The moment you finish reading this book, come out of it.

CHAPTER 05

THE BOMB

How many times you have seen a man or a woman for the first time and thought that this man or woman could be organized or capable of having sex with if approached correctly? I am sure your answer will be "Many a times", if you are talking your heart out. If you are a lady who is reading this book, I like to forward the same question in a different way to you. How many times you have looked at a man and thought "This man fancies me and if I like I can have him?"

Now my next question is who told you that is so? You might say "First impression". As a Christian who will look at people with the eyes of Jesus, will Jesus give you an impression like that on someone you meet for the first time? My answer is NO. How about yours? Then how did you sense this? If you are a non-believer you also might say "First Impression", but as human beings, are we to look at people and come into conclusions like that?

Let me say a few things about first impression here before going in to biblical details.

If first impression is something which is correct or taken as at least more than 50% right always, I believe no one will be taken for a ride in this world. You will identify liars. You would not give your precious vote to the wrong politicians and then repent of doing so. You will identify the false teachers and run away from them. You will find the correct churches always and won't be deceived by many cults in this world today. Many divorces could be

avoided by finding the correct partners always with correct first impression. Your children will always be friendly with the correct companions and they would not go astray. There won't be any kind of crimes in your country. No drugs trade, no violence in schools, simply no one will take you for a ride in anyway. But, the big BUT is this happens all the time. This teaches us that first impression is always does not prove that our conclusions are right.

Let us see what the word of the Lord says about it.

2 Cor 5:16-17

16 Therefore from now on we recognize no one according to the flesh; even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know Him in this way no longer.

17 Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.

As born again Christians we all know that this passage is talking about the aftermath of a born again experience. Though we know the verse 17 by heart we give very little attention to verse 16.

Still if we are trying to figure out or recognize people according to the flesh, do you think we are born again? My answer is no. May be we are thinking and believing that we are, but we would not know until we reach the gates of hell that we were not born again. A born again experience in somebody's life means a 180 degrees turn and return to holiness in Christ Jesus who gave His holy life on that

cross, and receiving salvation and receiving redemption by His Holy blood and not a 179 degree turn, which all sins are gone except one.

Let's take a look at another beauty:

2 Cor 11:3

3 But I am afraid that just as Eve was deceived by the serpent's cunning, your minds may somehow be led astray from your sincere and pure devotion to Christ.

The word of God is very specific in telling us about the cunningness of the serpent (Satan). It says that our minds may somehow be led astray from our sincere and pure devotion to Christ. How would he do that? By possessing you or by influencing? I believe influencing does just that.

If we go to the book of GENESIES the incident where Satan persuade Eve to eat from the tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil, we see what exactly happens there. Satan is trying to find a way to tempt and deceive Adam and Eve. How did he get that opportunity? When Eve pronounces the first ever innocent lie or exaggeration from her mouth, Satan proceeded from there onwards. Let's go to this scenario and find out what happened.

Gen 2:15-17

15 The LORD God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work it and take care of it.

16 And the LORD God commanded the man, "You are free to eat from any tree in the garden;

17 but you must not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for when you eat of it you will surely die." (from The Holy Bible: New International Version. Copyright (c) 1973, 1978, 1984, by International Bible Society)

Here we see what God told Adam and commanded him to do. Now let's look at what Eve did.

Gen 3:1-3

1 Now the serpent was more crafty than any of the wild animals the LORD God had made. He said to the woman, "Did God really say, 'You must not eat from any tree in the garden'?"

2 The woman said to the serpent, "We may eat fruit from the trees in the garden,

3 but God did say, 'You must not eat fruit from the tree that is in the middle of the garden, and *you must not touch it*, or you will die.'"

Do you see what happened? Eve exaggerated what God commanded and by doing so she lied saying that God asked them not even to *touch* the fruit. This opened a door to Satan so he may take charge of the situation. Here we see that Eve was not demon possessed, (or otherwise they wouldn't meet God Almighty everyday for fellowship) but demon influenced to be disobedient to God. Here we see

that Eve made the first mistake by exaggeration of what God asked them to do. This exaggeration of words used made opportunity to Satan to influence Eve's husband too in to disobedience.

Getting back to where we are, why Apostle Paul gave this word to the church of Corinth by the divine revelation of God The Holy spirit in the first place? When Apostle Paul first visited Corinth it was a place of chaos. Prostitution, adultery, fornication, incest, rape, homosexuality, lesbianism, temple prostitution, witchcraft, mythology, and Caesar worship was practiced in abundance. When people came to know Christ, Paul had to advice the brethren by the guidance of God the Holy Spirit, not to identify people in the flesh and also not to deviate from their true connection with the Lord due to demonic influence. Why? There are two reasons for that.

- 1. People in Corinth knew each other and what they were up to before receiving salvation and if influenced, had a chance of tempting them to fall back to their former lives. Please note that this happens to most of the ministries/churches even today.
- 2. Traces of all these sins that deserve death were still traceable because they are not fully erased from their lives. All these sins carry demonic influence so that at any given time these believers could be tempted by these influences and they could fall spiritually. They could loose their salvation.

I have a beauty for you from the word of God.

PS 50:18

18 When you see a thief, you join with him; you throw in your lot with adulterers.

(from The Holy Bible: New International Version. Copyright (c) 1973, 1978, 1984, by International Bible Society)

Is the Lord really talking about thieves here or, is He trying to give us a message or is He trying to make us identify ourselves with divine revelation so that we will know us better? In this world when thieves meet thieves do they identify each other unless they have shared the same prison cell? Without identification can they join together? Unless they have robbed together they would not. The end result of this meeting is not robbing but committing adultery. But here, what is that the Lord revealing to us? Now let's open our spiritual eyes here.

It is, when you see someone who has a secret life (a thief), if you also have a secret life like that or had a life like that, (like a thief), (yet to repent, confess and come out to be free) you will join hands and will start doing same with them. What you would do is committing adultery. Did you get it? Now how do you identify each other just like that? The answer is by demonic influence. When demons who are in the same plane and category see each other and who have influence over the people who meet, they influence their victims to identify each other the way that they want them to identify each other. Do you get it?

Now you may wonder, "How come this happen? I am a born again Christian. I have repented for all those sins in my past life. I have repented for masturbation, fornication, incest and being gay. I have repented for committing adultery; I have repented for all that I have done in secret. When I have Christ living in me how come that demonic influence come in to play a part in my life?"

This is exactly what we are going to talk about and learn with this book and also how to overcome situations like that.

CHAPTER 06

A FEW DEFINITIONS

Semen/ Sperm (also called SEMINAL FLUID)

Fluid that is emitted from the male reproductive tract and that contains sperm cells, which are capable of fertilizing the female eggs. **Semen** also contains other liquids, known as seminal plasma, which help to keep the sperm cells viable. (ENCYCLOPEDIA BRITANICA)

A fluid filled with sperm and secreted by the male reproductive organs

(Lev 15:16-18,32; 22:4; seed of copulation, KJV). Semen is mentioned in the section of Leviticus that deals with bodily discharges.

Female egg

When coupled with semen cell will produce an embryo, which will produce offspring. In humans this will bring forth children.

In the word of God, semen and female egg stand a significant place as God created Adam and Eve, so that they can multiply. God created Adam and Eve and commanded them to multiply. To obey the multiplication procedure He created semen for man on his reproductive

system and the female egg in the female reproductive system. Therefore a cell of semen also called sperm and the female egg coupled can produce off spring. Also God inserted pleasure, which will last a few seconds, which is most desirable for all living beings when the male and female engage in the act of sex. In His word God never allowed misuse of semen and the female egg at any given time as they carried life.

Gen 1:27-28

27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.

28 God blessed them and said to them, "Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it. Rule over the fish of the sea and the birds of the air and over every living creature that moves on the ground."

When Cain killed Abel God did not condemned Cain with death but when you commit sin where semen and the female egg is involved see how God gives His judgement on those.

I have a beautiful story to tell you regarding the importance of semen and female egg from the word of God.

Gen 38:8-10

9 But Onan knew that the offspring would not be his; so whenever he lay with his brother's wife, he spilled his semen on the ground to keep from producing offspring for his brother.

10 What he did was wicked in the LORD's sight; so he put him to death also.

Wow! What a story, and what a revelation? Now before I explain this situation to you let me explain something. God gave us a free will of doing good or bad. Still we continue in that same manner. Though sometimes we go against the word of God and His will by doing certain things He is not in a hurry to punish us or to kill us as He knows we will have the free will of deciding what we want even out of His will for our lives. Also before I explain this story to you, let me give you another passage of scripture.

2 Sam 11:2 onwards

2 One evening David got up from his bed and walked around on the roof of the palace. From the roof he saw a woman bathing. The woman was very beautiful,

3 and David sent someone to find out about her. The man said, "Isn't this Bathsheba, the daughter of Eliam and the wife of Uriah the Hittite?"

- 4 Then David sent messengers to get her. She came to him, and he slept with her. (She had purified herself from her uncleanness.) Then she went back home.
- **5** The woman conceived and sent word to David, saying, "I am pregnant."
- **14** In the morning David wrote a letter to Joab and sent it with Uriah.
- **15** In it he wrote, "Put Uriah in the front line where the fighting is fiercest. Then withdraw from him so he will be struck down and die."
- **16** So while Joab had the city under siege, he put Uriah at a place where he knew the strongest defenders were.
- 17 When the men of the city came out and fought against Joab, some of the men in David's army fell; moreover, Uriah the Hittite died.

After this happened the prophet Nathan confronted King David and see what happened:

14 But because by doing this you have made the enemies of the LORD show utter contempt, the son born to you will die."

Dear reader let me ask you a question here. According to your judgement, that is if you are given a chance to judge, who committed the bigger sin/crime? Naturally your answer will be King David. Do we agree on that? Then in that case why did God killed Onan and not David? According to the law (Torah) if a man dies, his next to kin will marry the widow so that the off spring will be called after by his brother's name. Onan failed to do just that. Onan just filled the obligation by taking his brother's wife to be his wife after the demise of his brother. He was good enough to have sex with her as I believe Onan enjoyed it. Further he decided that though he took the widow as his wife, he does not want to have any children from the lady in question. In front of God's eyes this crime was punishable with death. Why?.......

In King David's case it is law that thou shall not commit adultery. King David not only broke the law but he committed murder also to fulfil his fleshly desires. If so why did God killed Onan? Only reason I see here is because Onan spilt life (semen) on the ground. Why this kind of a thing brought a so severe punishment from God?

The reason for this kind of punishment is semen carry life. When it is spilt where it does not belong, because it carries life, demons will take over and will start to influence people involved. Today in the modern world of science, we know that semen or any cell from the human body carry the DNA code of that individual. Satan knows very well that

dropping semen anywhere else other than God's permitted place is sin, which carry a punishment tag of death according to God's kingdom values. Any young man or woman who does that opens a door to demonic influence to attack them at any given time. As the individual concerned violates holiness, God simply cannot do anything because the person involved has wilfully given authority to Satan to make advances of influences of destruction of their lives. Let's read a scripture regarding this nature.

Deut 22:22

22 If a man is found sleeping with another man's wife, both the man who slept with her and the woman must die. You must purge the evil from Israel.

This particular scripture warns us to purge the evil out from Israel. Why? An adulterer will not spill his semen inside a woman's vagina because of the fear of getting her pregnant. During biblical times no condoms were available. He will wipe the semen on many things including clothing and under clothing. Sometimes on other people's clothing or on bed linen. If one uses a condom we do not know where it will end up. If the woman is on contraception I do not find any scripture which forbids contraception but God is the one who should plan how many children we should have and not us doing family planning.

In the modern world you will go to a guesthouse with your partner when you want to have sex in secret, out of marriage. Do you know what you get in those places and rooms and beds you lie on? A lot of semen, sometimesfemale eggs and tears of pain and hatred. Spilt on different occasions, different times, and different purposes. This would include honeymoon, adultery, fornication, incest, rape, homosexuality lesbianism and also masturbation.

The moment you enter a place like that, you are in danger of getting caught to that kind of influences. Naturally there are a lot of demonic influences awaiting you in places like that unless you are free of those influences. (Unless you have come out of your situation of secret life as a thief).

Let's read another scripture to enhance ourselves with what we are talking here.

Prov 2:16-19

16 It will save you also from the adulteress, from the wayward wife with her seductive words,

17 who has left the partner of her youth and ignored the covenant she made before God.

18 For her house leads down to death and her paths to the spirits of the dead.

19 None who go to her return or attain the paths of life.

Here the word of God says when you commit adultery; you create a path to the spirits of the dead. I hope and wish by now you are beginning to understand what the Spirit of the Lord is getting at.

If you happen to break this covenant at any given time to have your carnal desires fulfilled by another other than your husband or wife, with knowledge or without knowledge you are guilty of breaking that covenant with God and God can punish you at any given time according to His word. God says with the above scripture that the moment you are in to it, you are giving control over your paths to the spirits of the dead. Here the spirits of the dead does not mean the spirits of the human beings that are dead. It means that you are giving control of your life to the spirits who will lead you to eternal death as you start your secret life from that moment onwards

Did you notice verse 19 of the above passage?

Prov.2:19

19 None who go to her return or attain the paths of life.

Why God is saying something so strong like this here? The moment you commit adultery, that day you start your own secret life. Do you think we human beings would like to share our personal secret lives and the experiences of it even with our spouses? I couldn't and my wife also couldn't until Lord taught us. Thank God today we are free of our secret lives and have started living new and holy lives for him and him alone.

I would like to quote a very special bible verse here.

James. 5:14-16

14. Is any sick among you? Let him call for elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

- 15. And prayer of the faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he hath committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.
- 16. Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

The Lord through James is very clear in saying, if a brother is sick in my church, the sick should call the elders of the church to anoint oil and pray over where Lord will heal the sick. This is of course very good and we do this always but we give very little thought on the verse 16 where it says the sick person as well as the elders should confess their sins together and pray for one another 's weaknesses so that the sick will be healed. In our churches this part is missing today and most of the time the sick are being healed of medicine than prayer.

How many of us would like to harbour sinful desires in our hearts? How many of us would like to see an eye full of things, which will please our eyes even though we don't see them with the eyes of Jesus? How many of us would like to hear sinful things in detail though they are filthy? Do we practice what we preach? Outwardly yes, but inwardly?

Why God is saying that we will never return to the paths of life again? Because the moment we start a secret life within us, we create a path and open a door to Satan who will attack us at any given time. Most of the Christians have secret lives or had secret lives, which we have not dealt so far. Later we will learn how to deal with them.

According to the word of God, the paths of life contain many areas of our lives, which will go through a changing process by the power, and conviction of The Holy Spirit. It really depends upon how much we will open ourselves to The Holy Spirit.

The sanctification process might take six months, a year or two, or even years and years. Some people will never come to the place of sanctification at all. Though they will identify themselves with Lord Jesus Christ, until they reach the gates of hell they wouldn't know about it.

Today no one living in this world is capable of saying about one's own holiness and righteousness. Daily we need to make an evaluation in the presence of the Lord to know where we stand.

Isa 64:6

6 All of us have become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous acts are like filthy rags; we all shrivel up like a leaf, and like the wind our sins sweep us away.

(from The Holy Bible: New International Version. Copyright (c) 1973, 1978, 1984, by International Bible Society)

Today we are living in a world where people decide what is good and what is bad. Sometimes we decide what is good for God also. As Christians if we try to decide the works that will please God, we are in for trouble because the verse we read before is very clear on that. Today we try to do things for God out of holiness. There is no way that God will take a liking to it. Without holiness we cannot know the will of God for our lives because He will not communicate direct. Without holiness we cannot serve, as He cannot communicate we will take our own decisions to please Him, which is impossible. Without holiness we

cannot raise our hands towards heaven in submission because God wants our holy hands to be lifted towards heaven. We need to stop our outward showing of holiness and start purifying our inner being. By the time you finish reading this book, you will see as an individual, as husband or wife or as a youth the price that is there for you to pay so that you will be holy. I wonder how many of you will heed this word from the Lord.

Therefore we cannot boast about our lives before God or man. We need to take an evaluation everyday before God to see whether we are living holy lives.

CHAPTER 07

A WARNING TO ALL CHRISTIANS

If you are a Christian, God wants you to know and also to teach people who do not know about two things. That is the difference between CLEAN & UNCLEAN also HOLY & UNHOLY.

Lev 10:10-11

10 that you may distinguish between holy and unholy, and between unclean and clean,

11 and that you may teach the children of Israel all the statutes which the LORD has spoken to them by the hand of Moses."

(from The New King James Version. Copyright (c) 1982, by Thomas Nelson, Inc.)

Today who are the children of Israel? The one who accepted Jesus Christ as his Saviour and as the son of living God.

Ezek 44:23

23 And they shall teach My people the difference between the holy and the unholy, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean.

(from The New King James Version. Copyright (c) 1982, by Thomas Nelson, Inc.)

We, Christians are commanded by the Lord to teach all His people about these things of what is Holy and Unholy and also what is Clean and Unclean. Why? If we are unholy or unclean we cannot come to the presence of the Lord to communicate with him. This does not apply for a person who is coming to a fellowship of Christians for the first time as it is given to the people who know God already and who identify themselves with Jesus Christ. Even the new comer should be taught about it as fast as possible.

Dear reader if you are identifying yourself with Jesus as a born again, your life should be holy. If you do not know His word enough to become holy I encourage you to join a Spirit filled Bible study immediately as you are in danger of giving opportunity to demons to influence you and your family in many ways.

Rom 6:1-4

- 1 What shall we say, then? Shall we go on sinning so that grace may increase?
- **2** By no means! We died to sin; how can we live in it any longer?
- **3** Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?
- **4** We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.

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Some Christians would like to believe that when they are born-again they have received the visa to go to heaven.

They hardly follow the secular system of immigration when it comes to salvation and going to heaven someday. In the world though you receive visa to go to a certain country, you need many more things to reach the destination. You need to buy a flight ticket. You need to book your flight date with the relevant airline. You need to pass through airport formalities. You need to pass through security systems. Your baggage should be checked. They should be properly labelled showing the destination. After all that you need the boarding pass to get in to the flight. The flight should reach the destination safely for you to disembark. Do you see how many things one should be doing to get to the destination? Then how about going to paradise when you die or heaven at the return of Jesus Christ on the day of the rapture? Just have a closer look at the above verses from Romans. Do you think after receiving salvation if we continue to sin, we will reach heaven someday? If you are a person who thinks that way, you are already deceived. You will never know until you reach the gates of hell, where you will spend your eternity.

Let's take a few examples to check whether we are talking truth here.

Num 14:26-35

26 The LORD said to Moses and Aaron:

27 "How long will this wicked community grumble against me? I have heard the complaints of these grumbling Israelites.

28 So tell them, `As surely as I live, declares the LORD, I will do to you the very things I heard you say:

- 29 In this desert your bodies will fall--every one of you twenty years old or more who was counted in the census and who has grumbled against me.
- **30** Not one of you will enter the land I swore with uplifted hand to make your home, except Caleb son of Jephunneh and Joshua son of Nun.
- **31** As for your children that you said would be taken as plunder, I will bring them in to enjoy the land you have rejected.
- **32** But you--your bodies will fall in this desert.
- 33 Your children will be shepherds here for forty years, suffering for your unfaithfulness, until the last of your bodies lies in the desert.
- **34** For forty years--one year for each of the forty days you explored the land--you will suffer for your sins and know what it is like to have me against you.'
- **35** I, the LORD, have spoken, and I will surely do these things to this whole wicked community, which has banded together against me. They will meet their end in this desert; here they will die."

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When I read this passage my heartbeat quickens. Here we see that the chosen people of God who are brought back from Egypt after lots and lots of trouble going to fall short of their destination. We know what went through before all Israeli people depart from Egypt. There were signs and

wonders, pain and agony, they had to hurry, still they had the doubt of Pharaoh changing his decision and most important of all, God's command for them to depart immediately. All of them obeyed at first and bear up all difficulty. After seeing and experiencing many miracles they saw the biggest when the red sea parted and shown the dry land for them to cross over.

What happens next is disobedience. Due to disobedience God decides to wipe out a few generations of those chosen people before taking the balance of them to the Promised Land.

If that is so with God Almighty, what happens to you and me today when we disobey him after receiving salvation? (After coming out of our fleshly Egypt to go to the spiritual Promised Land to spend our eternity with our Lord and saviour Jesus Christ?) Do you think because it is the time of grace God will take it easy?

In the twenty first century we like to take God very lightly but God won't buy it. He has set apart His rules, regulations and values and they won't change. The only exception we have in the time of grace (Today) is the blood of Jesus. The blood of Jesus is sufficient to cleanse us from anything but it depends upon whether we are ready to do so. If we are not 100% ready and yielding to be cleansed then even the blood of Jesus cannot do anything. You will identify yourself with Jesus while living on this earth. The day you die, when you reach the gates of hell only, you will know that your much spent Christian life on earth was a hoax.

At this moment I would like to show you a passage from the time of grace to make you understand that our God Almighty have not changed. Also read **MALACHI 3:6**

Acts 5:1-11

- 1 Now a man named Ananias, together with his wife Sapphira, also sold a piece of property.
- 2 With his wife's full knowledge he kept back part of the money for himself, but brought the rest and put it at the apostles' feet.
- 3 Then Peter said, "Ananias, how is it that Satan has so filled your heart that you have lied to the Holy Spirit and have kept for yourself some of the money you received for the land?
- **4** Didn't it belong to you before it was sold? And after it was sold, wasn't the money at your disposal? What made you think of doing such a thing? You have not lied to men but to God."
- **5** When Ananias heard this, he fell down and died. And great fear seized all who heard what had happened.
- **6** Then the young men came forward, wrapped up his body, and carried him out and buried him.
- 7 About three hours later his wife came in, not knowing what had happened.
- **8** Peter asked her, "Tell me, is this the price you and Ananias got for the land?"

[&]quot;Yes," she said, "that is the price."

- **9** Peter said to her, "How could you agree to test the Spirit of the Lord? Look! The feet of the men who buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out also."
- 10 At that moment she fell down at his feet and died. Then the young men came in and, finding her dead, carried her out and buried her beside her husband.
- 11 Great fear seized the whole church and all who heard about these events.

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This is an incident, which took place after the day of Pentecost. Now the church of Jesus Christ is established and growing day by day. The day of Pentecost comes after the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus Christ; we know that we are living in the time of grace. Why God killed Ananias and Sapphira? He had to purge evil out from the church. On this particular day, after receiving salvation, when you are supposed to be holy, Ananias and Sapphira started their secret lives inside the church of Jesus Christ. Though it was everything to do with their wealth, if these two were not purged out by the Lord, their off spring also will become robbers and Christian Church of Jesus Christ would have been closed down long time ago.

Even today some of the ministers and evangelists are trying to make money out of people by selling many things. They sell what God the Holy Spirit revealed to be told to people. They sell their appearance on television. They want people who watch these programs and read their material to pay them money for doing that. They want money from people to continue their television programs without financial

difficulty. Though I do not fully agree with this kind of service, I have no problem as they will answer God someday.

God does the same thing today. When a servant of God is dishonest He will close that ministry. The servant will be exposed. God the Holy Spirit only, will touch people who love Jesus and not because of the service of the servant. You will find stagnated churches. Demons will influence many to do things to make the congregation happy and God unhappy.

Man made laws will be prominent than God's law. Many are thieves who have secret lives. Once in a blue moon you will hear someone giving a message in tongues but most of the time the interpretation will be in the flesh. The church will experience spiritual blindness. As the bible records in the book of REVELATION 3: of the letter sent to the church at Sardis this church will be simply dead. Why? Because even today God purges evil out from His church slowly but surely.

CAPTER 08

Marriage

It does not matter who conducts a marriage service or who makes you repeat the vows of marriage. The word of God is very specific about marriage as God initiated it for the first time in all history at the time of creation. God Himself saw marriage as a very important event as He created Eve for Adam and commanded them to subdue the earth and multiply in number. Therefore whoever is getting married, whether you are a believer or non-believer you should know that God is the witness to your taking of vows and the promises you made towards each other.

God Almighty will be the judge to observe how we treat and love our spouses. If we are living in obedience to His word He will help us to have a beautiful married life. If not He will be the judge of the vows we took on the day of the marriage. Let us observe the following Bible passage.

Prov 2:16-19

16 It will save you also from the adulteress, from the wayward wife with her seductive words,

17 who has left the partner of her youth and *ignored the* covenant she made before God.

18 For her house leads down to death and her paths to the spirits of the dead.

19 None who go to her return or attain the paths of life.

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As I have quoted this scripture earlier too this passage very clearly tells us that we have made a covenant with God on the day of our marriage. God can definitely claim this, as He is the initiator of the marriage. The saying goes as "THE MARRIAGES ARE MADE IN HEAVEN". Even the non-believers are using this term, but it is true. Though the modern world does not value marriage so much, still God values it so much. Let's read a few scriptures about marriage and virginity.

Ex 22:16-18

16 "If a man seduces a virgin who is not pledged to be married and sleeps with her, he must pay the bride-price, and she shall be his wife.

17 If her father absolutely refuses to give her to him, he must still pay the bride-price for virgins.

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Deut 22:13-20

13 If a man takes a wife and, after lying with her, dislikes her

14 and slanders her and gives her a bad name, saying, "I married this woman, but when I approached her, I did not find proof of her virginity,"

- 15 then the girl's father and mother shall bring proof that she was a virgin to the town elders at the gate.
- **16** The girl's father will say to the elders, "I gave my daughter in marriage to this man, but he dislikes her.
- 17 Now he has slandered her and said, `I did not find your daughter to be a virgin.' But here is the proof of my daughter's virginity." Then her parents shall display the cloth before the elders of the town,
- **18** and the elders shall take the man and punish him.
- 19 They shall fine him a hundred shekels of silver and give them to the girl's father, because this man has given an Israelite virgin a bad name. She shall continue to be his wife; he must not divorce her as long as he lives.

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Deut 22:28-29

- **28** If a man happens to meet a virgin who is not pledged to be married and rapes her and they are discovered,
- 29 he shall pay the girl's father fifty shekels of silver. He must marry the girl, for he has violated her. He can never divorce her as long as he lives.

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When God values virginity and marriage so much, can we find men and women who are virgins today? In the western world this will be laughing matter. But we need to remember, with God, He is serious about it and He does not make concessions.

WHY?

Because a virgin young man is a person who has never spilt life on the ground. A virgin young lady most of the time has never been touched by any man. The Bible records that Mary was a virgin when angel Gabriel appeared to her. Also the Bible records that she was betrothed to be married to Joseph. When Bible says that she was a virgin, this means though she was engaged to be married to Joseph, he never even touched her in any way that will ignite sexual desire. Also referring to Joseph, the Bible says that he was a righteous man. Now righteousness does not come by doing good works, biblically it only come by obeying God's word. What an amazing story of purity?

We will read the following and see whether we could distinguish what God is talking here.

Why God is so interested to see a virgin man getting married to a virgin lady? It is simply because of the demonic influences that would come and take control of their lives.

A young man or woman in his or her youth will start masturbation, which is against the word of God. According to the New Testament standard, which is much greater than the old, you cannot look at a woman with lust. The moment you do that you are guilty of committing adultery.

Matt 5:27-28

- 27 "You have heard that it was said, `Do not commit adultery.'
- 28 But I tell you that anyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her in his heart.

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CHAPTER 09

Masturbation

We all know that masturbation is action upon thought. First you harbour a sinful thought about a man or a woman in your mind and when you nourish it for long you go in to a quick release by masturbation.

As the New Testament standard Jesus put before us is very much higher than the old, this is total sin. Most of the time semen (life) will be spilt in many places. This will make room for demonic influences to attack you at their will.

Remember what happened to Onan? God's penalty for this is death. But as we live in the time of grace the blood of Jesus is always there for us to have forgiveness for the sins we have committed. Dear brother/ sister we need to remember that these sins will give room for demonic influences to take over our lives. Overcoming situations like this is purely depending on how holy our lives are going to be in front of God.

I hope that you will understand that extended practice of masturbation will lead one to perversion and partially impotence as this act searches for a quick release. When the real thing is in need many will fail to satisfy their spouses due to this kind of weakness.

Fornication

Young couples like to make light sex, or some, husband and wife sex before marriage. In the western countries the mothers are very particular about their daughters as they just attend their age they use to put them on contraceptives to prevent unnecessary pregnancies.

In the Old Testament times there were no contraceptives. God decided how many children a couple will have. This is the very reason the people got married very young those days. Today that system has changed and many people want to control having children on their own. They like to have more sex and fewer children. The very reason for them to do this also demon influenced.

The word of God tells us the ruler of the world today is Satan. Satan ignites many political, economical, environmental, situations where couples who get married will have to forego many things in life. Specially having God's planned number of children. Look at China's one child per couple policy. They control saying it as family planning. To control they abort. I read a book recently about illuminatis' which tells us that every abortion we do is making an offering of human being to Satan. I fully agree with this theory.

As the young ladies do not like to get conceived, the young men will get used to spill semen (life) on many things. Sometimes they want to take their penis out before orgasm. Sometimes they misfire and the ladies get pregnant and they go for abortions. This is murder. Though many countries are considering the legalisation of abortion, whether they give legal right or not this is murder.

Therefore fornication could lead you to demonic influence extended up to murder. Through abortions Satan receive many human sacrifices because pregnancy out of wedlock is purely due to demonic influence.

Rape

Young men and women who are used to masturbation and fornication are more vulnerable to be raped by someone. The term is, a thief knows and identifies a thief. The thief knows even if he does it by force, the other party will be very silent about it, because the other party is also a thief who has a secret life. In the Asian countries only 3% of rape cases come before the law and all the others are hushed up by the parties involved. In the 21st century it is common occurrence that little children getting raped. This happens mainly due to generational curses, which, are there upon the parents.

Today the world is fast changing and Satan is deceiving many with his influence in sexual appetite as people are having secret lives of their own even if they call themselves Christians. Many who will not have other relationships after marriage or after getting engaged, still could get raped by a rapist because of early secret lives they had.

Gang Rape

Gang rape normally takes place due to an advance state of perversion and also due to curses, which are placed upon rapists and also victims. I highly recommend you to read "UNBROKEN CURSES" by Rebecca Brown M D for further knowledge of curses. Most of the time the victim of a ganged rape situation won't live to tell the tale as the rapists will kill the victim. These things take place due to demonic destructions and demonic influences. As I will be outlining many things of sexual activity here I would also like to mention that any activity out of the bonds of marriage is sin and will have unavoidable repercussions on one's own life even if you are Christian until you come out of it the proper biblical way.

Adultery

The people who are used to masturbation and fornication most of the time fall in to adultery also. As they are already thieves, the thieves recognize each other and they will continue their old lives. Adultery could bring someone in to a situation of hatred, divorce, murder, mental disorders and rape due to too much of demonic influence. The person who commits adultery will not reason out situations before committing them. There is a saying with adulterers and that is "even your 90 year old grand mother is not safe vice versa". God hates adulterers. He does not have any other penalty for adultery other than death. The very reason for it is, as the word of God says that our bodies are the temple of the Holy Ghost, and if we defile the temple He will destroy us.

(1 COR. 3:16).

When you get in to habit of adultery, it is very difficult to stop you from doing it because it is demonic influenced. Some times a man or a woman might commit this sin with more than two three hundred people. All their children will carry those curses up to the third and fourth generations. Sometimes the children of the adulterers will also become adulterers. By that a whole nation could become all adulterers. That is why God commanded to purge that sin and the sinners out of Israel the chosen people of God.

Deut 22:22

22 If a man is found sleeping with another man's wife, both the man who slept with her and the woman must die. You must purge the evil from Israel. (from The Holy Bible: New International Version. Copyright (c) 1973, 1978, 1984, by International Bible Society)

I would like to give you a fine example of adultery and the consequences of that sin from the word of God. Earlier we saw that king David committing adultery with Uriah's wife Bathsheba. (2 SAM.11:2 onwards). Let's find out what happened to King David's family.

2 Sam 13:1-29

- 1 In the course of time, Amnon son of David *fell in love* with **Tamar**, the beautiful **sister of Absalom son of David**.
- **2** Amnon *became frustrated* to the point of *illness* on account of his sister Tamar, for she was a *virgin*, and it seemed impossible for him to do anything to her.
- **3** Now Amnon had a friend named Jonadab son of Shimeah, David's brother. Jonadab was a very *shrewd* man.
- **4** He asked Amnon, "Why do you, the king's son, look so *haggard* morning after morning? Won't you tell me?" Amnon said to him, "I'm in love with Tamar, my brother Absalom's sister."
- **5** "Go to bed and pretend to be ill," Jonadab said. "When your father comes to see you, say to him, `I would like my sister Tamar to come and give me something to eat. Let her prepare the food in my sight so I may watch her and then eat it from her hand.""
- **6** So Amnon lay down and pretended to be ill. When the king came to see him, Amnon said to him, "I would like my

sister Tamar to come and make some special bread in my sight, so I may eat from her hand."

- **7** *David sent word* to Tamar at the palace: "Go to the house of your brother Amnon and prepare some food for him."
- **8** So Tamar went to the house of her brother Amnon, who was lying down. She took some dough, kneaded it, made the bread in his sight and baked it.
- **9** Then she took the pan and served him the bread, but he refused to eat.
- "Send everyone out of here," Amnon said. So everyone left him.
- 10 Then Amnon said to Tamar, "Bring the food here into my bedroom so I may eat from your hand." And Tamar took the bread she had prepared and brought it to her brother Amnon in his bedroom.
- 11 But when she took it to him to eat, he *grabbed her* and said, "Come to bed with me, my sister."
- 12 "Don't, my brother!" she said to him. "Don't force me. Such a thing should not be done in Israel! Don't do this wicked thing.
- 13 What about me? Where could I get rid of my disgrace? And what about you? You would be like one of the wicked fools in Israel. Please speak to the king; he will not keep me from being married to you."
- **14** But he refused to listen to her, and since he was stronger than she, *he raped her*.

- **15** Then Amnon *hated her with intense hatred*. In fact, he *hated her more than he had loved her*. Amnon said to her, "Get up and get out!"
- **16** "No!" she said to him. "Sending me away would be a greater wrong than what you have already done to me." But *he refused to listen* to her.
- **17** He called his personal servant and said, "Get this woman out of here and bolt the door after her."
- **18** So his servant put her out and bolted the door after her. She was wearing a richly ornamented robe, for this was the kind of garment the virgin daughters of the king wore.
- 19 Tamar put ashes on her head and tore the ornamented robe she was wearing. She put her hand on her head and went away, *weeping aloud* as she went.
- **20** Her brother Absalom said to her, "Has that Amnon, your brother, been with you? *Be quiet now*, my sister; he is your brother. Don't take this thing to heart." And Tamar lived in her brother Absalom's house, a desolate woman.
- 21 When King David heard all this, he was furious.
- **22** Absalom never said a word to Amnon, either good or bad; *he hated Amnon* because he had *disgraced* his sister Tamar.
- 23 Two years later, when Absalom's sheepshearers were at Baal Hazor near the border of Ephraim, he invited all the king's sons to come there.

- **24** Absalom went to the king and said, "Your servant has had shearers come. Will the king and his officials please join me?"
- 25 "No, my son," the king replied. "All of us should not go; we would only be a burden to you." Although Absalom urged him, he still refused to go, but gave him his blessing.
- 26 Then Absalom said, "If not, please let my brother Amnon come with us."

 The king asked him, "Why should he go with you?"
- 27 But Absalom urged him, so he sent with him Amnon and the rest of the king's sons.
- **28** Absalom ordered his men, "Listen! When *Amnon is in high spirits from drinking wine* and I say to you, `*Strike Amnon down,' then kill him*. Don't be afraid. Have not I given you this order? Be strong and brave."
- 29 So Absalom's men did to Amnon what Absalom had ordered. Then all the king's sons got up, mounted their mules and fled

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Dear reader, do not think that I am filling this book with bible passages. I need you to read the word, know what it means and to heed it.

We know that God speaking of King David said that he is a man after His (God's) own heart. I have a question here. Though King David was a man after God's heart, did God take out the curse, which came upon his family because of the sin committed by him? No! Never.

Here we see the son of David, Amnon falling in love with his half sister Tamar. I have highlighted special words for your observation.

Here before we go through this story, I would like to tell you that young men and women, when they say that they have fallen in love, most of the time there is lust more than love. So in this story also we see that lust overtaking love to the point of Amnon getting frustrated and ill. (Some may call it love sick). When Amnon went in to a situation of frustration I believe he had already fallen in to masturbation at this point. As masturbation brings you in to a state of perversion, he became sick and he wanted to have sex with Thamar at any cost. He fulfilled his desire by deceiving his own father the man who was after God Almighty's heart. WoW! What a story.

Now his friend Jonadab was a shrewd man. As he can plan illegal activity I believe Amnon did not have God-fearing friends. Jonadab noticed that Amnon looks haggard and offered help the best way he could though it is against God's supreme law.

So Tamar is tricked to come to Amnon's house. Dear reader how many of you have been tricked by people to this kind of activity in your life? Do you think that any man/woman would like to get raped? No one would like that. But I am asking you, did that happen in your life? Did you loose your virginity to a liar who never wanted to get married to you unless you are so westernised that you did not care? Or you do not value dignity?

Do you see how King David is getting deceived, as he never suspected of a situation like this from his own son and daughter? Verse 11 tells us that Amnon forcing Tamar by grabbing her. Tamar knew God's law and she refuses to the advancement of Amnon in verse 12. She tries to explain her plight to Amnon if she commits fornication and incest in verse 13. As in the history of biblical Israel Tamar advises her half brother not to become one of wicked fools like their ancestors. She further says if King David is informed, she will marry him. But just as Tamar said, Amnon becomes the fool and rapes her.

According to divine law in one shot Amnon becomes guilty of three sins, which deserves death penalty. He commits RAPE, FORNICATION, and INCEST. Also Amnon started hating Tamar more, than loving her after this incident. In most of the dictionaries in the world definition of rape is forcible sexual relations and not necessarily total intercourse. I am sure for Amnon to hate Tamar after this incident, something was not right with what happened during rape and Amnon was disappointed.

Now the word of God says that Tamar was a virgin. As she was a virgin she comes out with the story and the authorities are informed. As she was weeping loud, her brother Absalom noticed her sudden state and ask her what happened. He advises her to be quiet of it as it happened in the family. Though Absalom advises his sister to be silent of what happened he started hatred towards Amnon from that day.

Now King David also came to know about it. Though he was furious we do not see him taking any action regarding this incident. May be he knew in his heart how it happened and why it happened. May be a family curse could be broken only by total repentance by the whole family and

not by a few of the family. Or King David should have repented and broken this curse before having children so that the children will be free of this curse. When you are in the curse I believe a whole family should go on their knees and faces in front of God's presence to break the curse.

Today we have the blood of Jesus our saviour to cleanse ourselves from all iniquity. I am sure both King David and Bathsheba repented and offered the sin offering needed by them for cleansing but their children did not know about it, as they cannot reveal their private lives to even their children. The satanic influences, which came through this incident and door, attacked the children of King David.

Also the lukewarm attitude of King David gave absolute confidence to Absalom to dispose Amnon the day he planned. We see the time Amnon got killed he was drunk and that paved the way for the assassins to attack and kill him.

Here in this story we see when adultery and murder took place in father's life, the children's lives were full of rape, fornication, incest, hatred, murder and drunkenness in one shot. Now do you understand why God said to purge evil out of Israel?

INCEST

Lev 18:4-18

- 5 Keep my decrees and laws, for the man who obeys them will live by them. I am the LORD.
- 6 "No one is to approach any close relative to have sexual relations. I am the LORD.

- 7 "Do not dishonour your father by having sexual relations with your mother. She is your mother; do not have relations with her.
- 8 "Do not have sexual relations with your father's wife; that would dishonour your father.
- 9 "Do not have sexual relations with your sister, either your father's daughter or your mother's daughter, whether she was born in the same home or elsewhere.
- 10 "Do not have sexual relations with your son's daughter or your daughter's daughter; that would dishonour you.
- 11 "Do not have sexual relations with the daughter of your father's wife, born to your father; she is your sister.
- 12 "Do not have sexual relations with your father's sister; she is your father's close relative.
- 13 "Do not have sexual relations with your mother's sister, because she is your mother's close relative.
- 14 "Do not dishonour your father's brother by approaching his wife to have sexual relations; she is your aunt.
- 15 "Do not have sexual relations with your daughter-inlaw. She is your son's wife; do not have relations with her.
- 16 "Do not have sexual relations with your brother's wife; that would dishonour your brother.
- 17 "Do not have sexual relations with both a woman and her daughter. Do not have sexual relations with either her son's daughter or her daughter's daughter; they are her close relatives. That is wickedness.

18 "Do not take your wife's sister as a rival wife and have sexual relations with her while your wife is living.

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The list of God's law goes on and on like this. I do not need to remind you of what happened to Sodom and Gomorrah. The sin was in such a high state, God could find only one man who was living a holy life and God saved Lot and his family. If you do a thorough study on Sodom and Gomorrah you will find the major sin in those lands those days were sex related.

We know when we are sexually aroused what happens. If we are married we have our spouses to satisfy ourselves. If not, there is a 100% chance of falling in to sin. Just imagine when two cities are sexually aroused 24 hours of the day? There was adultery, fornication, incest, homosexuality, lesbianism, rape, bestiality, and you name it, and they were in it.

Within minutes God purged out the evil out of the two cities never to be inhabited again in this present age. What a scenario and what a decision? Mind you, God saw all they used and all they lived on as evil even for someone else to live there anymore at all again. Why? The demons that were influencing people of Sodom & Gomorrah were still hovering around even after God destroyed the cities. If people are going to live there again the same thing will happen to those people also as demons will start influencing those who gonna live there. What a purging out!

When Moses led the Israelites out of Egypt there were many wars fought by Israelites against many nations on their journey to reach the Promised Land. During these wars, most of the time God commanded both Moses, and after Joshua, his successor, to destroy the lands and all people who lived in those lands along with what they were using.

As a very young infant in the Lord, 16 years ago I wonder why God wanted the lands, belongings, and people destroyed when the chosen people of God were moving towards their promised land and though God did not plan for them to live in those lands?

When I was getting nourished with the word of God one day God illuminated this passage to me from His word.

Please read once again the Leviticus 18 from verse 1 to verse 23 and observe from the verse 24.

Lev 18:24-30

- 24 "Do not defile yourselves in any of these ways, because this is how the nations that I am going to drive out before you became defiled.
- 25 Even the land was defiled; so I punished it for its sin, and the land vomited out its inhabitants.
- 26 But you must keep my decrees and my laws. The nativeborn and the aliens living among you must not do any of these detestable things,
- 27 for all these things were done by the people who lived in the land before you, and the land became defiled.

- 28 And if you defile the land, it will vomit you out as it vomited out the nations that were before you.
- 29 "Everyone who does any of these detestable things-such persons must be cut off from their people.
- 30 Keep my requirements and do not follow any of the detestable customs that were practiced before you came and do not defile yourselves with them. I am the LORD your God.'"

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Do you see what God is saying here? Due to a lot of sex related sin and perversion God Commanded Moses and Joshua to destroy everything.

As we are living in the 21st Century we observe a lot of these types of sins are repeated all over the world. This is one of the very reasons that we all say that we are living in the end times. And mind you this is one of the major signs of the last days.

Matt 24:11-13

12 Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of **most** will grow cold,

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What happens when wickedness increases? Jesus said love of **most** will grow cold. For a moment, just take the word

most, for evaluation. When Jesus says most, I believe He is trying to tell us that more than 50% or some will evaluate it as more than 75%. Jesus is simply telling us during the last days more than 50% of the world's population will be wicked and has no love. When there is no love, as love is something that we share, one will automatically starts loving self. When one starts loving self only, he only thinks about himself only. This makes someone selfish. When one is selfish, one will not think whether it is your wife, mother, sister or daughter you are in to sin. This is happening all over the world today in a very rapid speed.

Homosexuality & Lesbianism

Rom 1:18-32

- 18 The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of men who suppress the truth by their wickedness,
- 19 since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them.
- **20** For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities-his eternal power and divine nature-have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that men are without excuse.
- 21 For although they knew God, they neither glorified him as God nor gave thanks to him, but their thinking became futile and their foolish hearts were darkened.
- 22 Although they claimed to be wise, they became fools

- 23 and exchanged the glory of the immortal God for images made to look like mortal man and birds and animals and reptiles.
- **24** Therefore God gave them over in the sinful desires of their hearts to sexual impurity for the degrading of their bodies with one another.
- 25 They exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator-who is forever praised. Amen.
- **26** Because of this, God gave them over to shameful lusts. Even their women exchanged natural relations for unnatural ones.
- 27 In the same way the men also abandoned natural relations with women and were inflamed with lust for one another. Men committed indecent acts with other men, and received in themselves the due penalty for their perversion.
- **28** Furthermore, since they did not think it worthwhile to retain the knowledge of God, he gave them over to a deprayed mind, to do what ought not to be done.
- 29 They have become filled with every kind of wickedness, evil, greed and depravity. They are full of envy, murder, strife, deceit and malice. They are gossips,
- **30** slanderers, God-haters, insolent, arrogant and boastful; they invent ways of doing evil; they disobey their parents;
- **31** they are senseless, faithless, heartless, ruthless.
- **32** Although they know God's righteous decree that those who do such things deserve death, they not only continue to

do these very things but also approve of those who practice them.

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Some reader might wonder whether I am filling this book with Bible verses. Please remember, I am writing this book for the believer as well as for the non-believer. Some of the non-believers might not have a bible with them, and therefore I need to print the Bible quotations exactly for their observation.

See! Our God is very clear in saying that homosexuals and lesbians deserve death. Why? Even during the New Testament times still God do not change. Here I would like to explain a few things in case you are a homosexual, bisexual or a lesbian.

This particular passage speaks about how one becomes Gay. **V** 18. Says people are keeping truth suppressed by their own wickedness. Now if you do not understand this verse let me explain it to you.

Here God the Holy Spirit says, because of the wicked hearts we have, and because we think the decisions we take are always right, though God's truth is available to all of us, we do suppress the truth so that our desires are met.

V 20. Says since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities-His eternal power and divine nature-have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so the men do not have any kind of excuse.

V 21-23 Says that they took God very lightly or like someone who is not worthy of giving glory and thanks. Their hearts became frivolous and their already foolish hearts became some more darkened or simply they became nuts. And the result was they exchanged Creator's glory with creation.

From V 24 onwards God says what happened to them.

Dear reader you could be gay. If so I have good news for you. You can reverse what has happened in your life and make it a normal one. You only have to reverse what you have been reading just now.

I have heard and read through many servants of God, how a man could fall from God's grace. It is lust. When God gives unconditional love (Agape) Satan gives unconditional lust. I can give you three areas of being lustful in our nature.

- 1. Lust for wealth.
- 2. Lust for sex
- **3.** Lust for pride.

We know that God has given us a few desires for us to enjoy our time in this world. They are;

- **1.** Desire to eat when we are hungry.
- **2.** Desire to drink when we are thirsty.
- **3.** Desire to sleep when we are tired.
- **4.** Desire for sex with our spouses only.
- **5.** Desire to be appreciated by others.

You will notice out of the 5 points I have written, 3 could be done alone. To eat to drink and to sleep we can do it alone. But the other two, we need company of at least one more person. Because they contain give and take policy. The moment we misuse these two we are directly disobedient to God's plan and purpose. The moment we are disobedient to God we become fools and our hearts will be further darkened.

The very essence of God's plan and purpose for our lives depend upon how we adhere to His word. The principals and laws of our God.

In His word He says a man could own the whole world but if his soul is lost, that is if he didn't know who Jesus is, owning the whole world is in vain.

We all know that peace, joy and happiness is a gift of God to believers and it is vital ingredients of the fruits of The Holy Spirit. With influences of destruction, we will never experience these blessings in our lives. All peace, all joy, and all happiness will be temporary.

The biggest amount of sins are done in our hearts. We harbour sin in our hearts before committing them. There are five ways we learn the word of God and they are;

- 1. Hearing the word.
- 2. Reading the word.
- 3. Studying the word.
- 4. Memorizing the word.
- 5. Meditating the word.

The last two points will give us a great opportunity to stop sinning with our hearts. Specially meditating upon the word. When meditating of the word increases sinful thoughts will decrease.

CHAPTER 10

HOW DO WE COME OUT OF ALL DEMONIC INFLUENCES

Before we discuss how we should overcome this problem, I would like to quote a few verses to you from the book of Isaiah just to have an understanding of our saviour.

Isaiah. 52:14

14. As many were astonished at thee; his visage was so marred more than any man, and his form more than the sons of men; (KJV Bible)

Here we see that the prophet Isaiah referring to Jesus Christ saying, that Jesus Christ did not have beauty in him. Regarding this verse most of the bible teachers will disagree with me saying that here the prophet is talking of Jesus after he was ridiculed, after he was crowned by force with a crown of thorns, after receiving 39 slashes behind his back and after the Roman soldiers played havoc over Jesus, this is the appearance of him just before his crucifixion.

As Isaiah 52 finishes in 15 verses now I would like to quote another scripture from the beginning of Chapter 53

Isaiah. 53:2

2. For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root of a dry ground; he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty we should desire him. (KJV Bible)

This verse also speaks of Jesus Christ. The word of god is very specific in saying as Jesus had no beauty in him, no desire was found in anybody for him as it could lead the other party to sin though Jesus was without sin. God never allowed the opposite sex to fall in to sin in any way by looking at Jesus when He sent His only begotten son to die for us on the cross. (Today we see so many beautiful pictures of Jesus all over but sometimes I wonder how this happened as the word of God is very clear saying that Jesus had no beauty in him).

Today when we serve the Lord we need to look good. We apply make up. We consult beauticians. Before going in front of cameras we first get the help of makeup artists. We hardly think whether the opposite sex will be tempted by doing that. This is understandable as long as you do not have a secret life. Some of the opposite sex might fancy you but with proper guidance they will come out of it too. If not even if you are serving or you are a believer your church will have a problem.

We see when the woman who got caught at committing adultery was brought to Jesus, how He handled that situation. Even after solving her sure stoning to death situation, Jesus said only one sentence to her while sending her off, "SIN NO MORE". Did it work? Yes. Why? Here, this woman meeting a man (Jesus) who did not have a secret life for the first time in her life. Most of the time the men she met all had secret lives and all of them were double minded thieves. It was simply easy for her to turn back and do what she is good at and to continue in a life style more convenient to her. But Jesus said "SIN NO MORE". These three words convicted her of, committing adultery, having a secret life and identifying people who have secret lives through the influencing of the demonic spirits.

I believe by now you understand well why this book is necessary. God has separated 144000 young people from the 12 tribes to serve Him during the great tribulation. God says they were Holy and He could not find any lie in them. Further God says they were not defiled by any women. (This means they are virgins) Dear brother and sister this is talking about a young crowd of people most likely in the 21st century. If that is so, we also could come out of our double minded lives and start living holy lives to our Lord.

When Peter preached the Gospel on the day of Pentecost the people asked only one question; "What do we do now?"

I am sure at this point you also have the same question.

What shall I do now?

Repentance is the key, but with repentance we need to take authority over all demonic forces that have been influencing us to commit sin with the opposite sex. As all sins are premeditated in our hearts we need to have more meditation of the word in our hearts, than having evil thoughts.

Our constant prayer should be that God will give us the eyes of Jesus to look at things and people because the word of God is very clear in saying that if one of our eyes are sinful, it is better to pluck it out and reach heaven with one than loosing salvation.

If you are serving share your problem with the elders of the church and ask their constant prayer upholding so that God will bring a lot of healing to your church.

How do you know that you are free of demonic influence? God the Holy Spirit will start manifesting in your family, day to day life and in your church with power and you will see your church grow day by day. The messages we make and hear behind the pulpit will be oven fresh.

Even when new people come to your church, though they have been having secret lives, they will be delivered for good in the name of Jesus Christ as there is no one to identify them with demonic influence. When the new comers are identified with the eyes of Jesus, they will also will be like the woman who got caught at committing adultery but convicted by God the Holy Spirit of their sin.

The whole congregation should be free of demonic influence. Get your intercessory prayer team to pray constantly rebuking this kind of influence. Get the believers to learn the word with love and desire so that they will also nourish their spiritual flock with that same attitude.

Always remember the difference between God and Satan.

- 1. God is omnipresence where Satan can stay in one place at a time. (Read book of Job).
- 2. God knows our hearts but Satan does not. Satan put a thought/temptation to us and looks at our face to see whether we got hooked.
- 3. God is the creator of all things while Satan is the illusionist.
