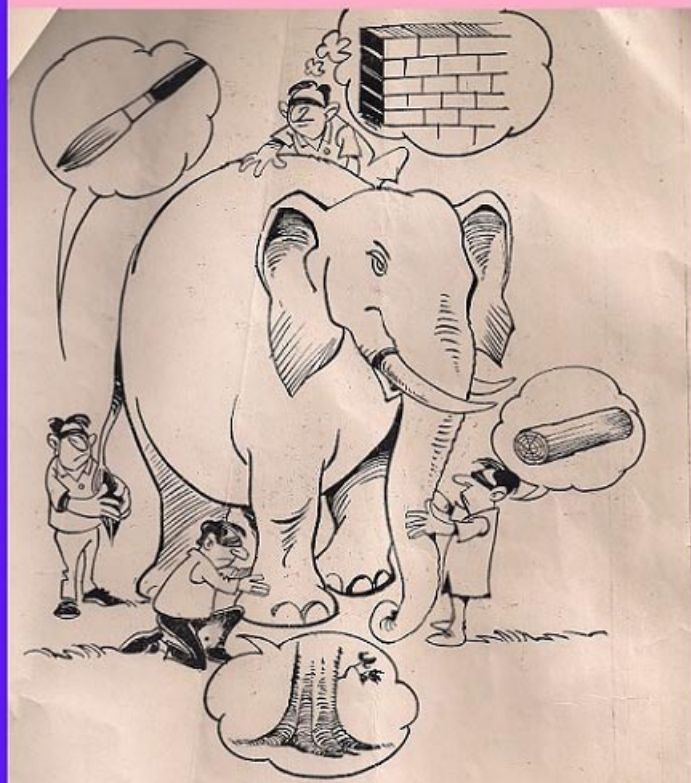

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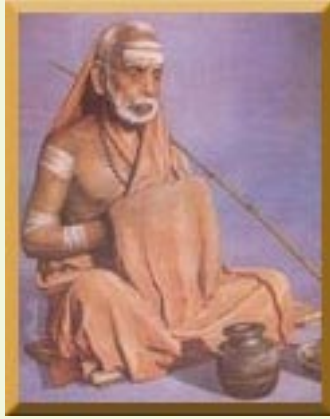

Chapter 1

Life in Universe!

The Man and Mystic

There are several life forms in the universe. Each of which has different **life-spans** and occupy various extents of space in the universe.

The man is just one among the many.

What do the lives do in the **universe**?

There are two types of people **Man** and **Mystics**.

Metaphorically, the lives **run** for their creator!

The creator has created every one of the specie for a definite purpose. The lives are provided with knowledge & skills.

For the reasons of effectively controllinthoseg the lives, created a force that limit the knowledge and abilities to the extent that is required from time to time.

There are two types of people among us. The bulk of it, are those who under the spell of **Maya**.

There are the others, a few among us who are known as seekers! They, become mystics in their course of search for the Truth!

The mystics can be thought of as rebels among us! They defy the control or influence of Maya in order to know the truth. The true form of universe is revealed to these lives in the universe. Those who seek stop their (**metaphorical**) "running" for their creator.

Chapter 2

Maya the force

The universe has an engine or a power source called Maya!

ke us **blind** to the true form of Universe.

The mystics tell us that the Maya hides the truth from every one of the lives in the universe.

What is that truth that the Maya hides from the lives?

The true form and nature of the universe is hidden from the lives. (Allowing merely a partial, limited and distorted perception of the universe)

The lives, further, are influenced by Maya with falsehood so that they serve the needs of the creator.

A book titled Illusion - Maya explains a
few most significant tricks of Maya.

Maya can be compared to the **Horse-
blind**.

Maya defiers!

There are a few, among us who pursue the
Science, for a living. There are the few
who can realize that the **Sense Perceived
world** is an insignificant of the True
Universe. These few could benefit from

vedic scriptures.

There are always a class of people all over the world, all the time known as seekers. They knew that there is a world larger than what the eyes could perceive. They know that the **Veil of Maya** hide the true universe from them. They are busy learning the ways of tearing the Veil of Maya.

Maya a veil or Wall?

For most of us, to every common man, Maya is felt as a strong impenetrable wall.

Chapter 3

Chapter 2

Grandma Science

"the persecution of the Italian astronomer and physicist for proving the Earth moves around the Sun".

There was a time when religious leaders were considered as the most knowledgeable in the society. The common man approached them to clear his doubts and to that which sought he know. With very little to no knowledge these religious people spread distorted truth and persecuted those who spoke the truth.

The history has it that religious men considered men-of-science as anti-god and anti religion. Men of Science were persecuted by Religious men for telling the truth.

Spiritualists also use Grandma Science intentionally in order to satisfy an inquirer in their opinion, is not yet ready to understand the real answer to questions asked.

In every culture there are explanations about God.

These would often remind me of a boyhood experience that my father told me in later years.

I asked my dad, an engineer, to tell me about rain. Perhaps a rain would have come in the way of a plan for an outing or what ever.

My father started explaining me in great detail. The way the sea water evoporate due to heat from the Sun and becoming a rain bearing cloud. Then the wind that moves places. Subsequently condensation making the rain.

Obviously, all these explanations would have

confused me rather than answering my question.

My grandma, who never had a formal education must have watched me and understood my trouble.

She call me close to her and explained the process or reason for the rain in absolutely simple terms.

She explained, " There is the God, up above the cloud and deep into the sky. So deep you cannot see him. When he urinates, it rains". At that age the Grandma's explanation would have convinced me than the explanation of my father, a learned person.

Subsequently we will refer this story as Gradma science. This refers to any over simplified explanation for expressions in both Scientific and Spiritual

Chapter 3

Models



Models are used by Scientists extensively.

It may be surprising for most of us to note that the Spiritualists too use them.

Most of what the scientists and spiritualists explore, (knowledge about nature or a phenomenon) lie outside of our **human sensory organ** set limits.

That results in enormous difficulty in visualizing the findings and also getting a total or complete view with several perspectives of a single research work..

We relay of **indirect** perceptions often. We use instruments to measure and record.

Every phenomenon, has several dimensions. Scientists , discover one after the other over a long period of time.

When you put together on to a structure, there are two benefits:

(1) one gets a better understanding of whatever discovered.

(2) Then you can find **gaps** or **unknown**.

Researchers, take these gaps for further investigation.

I am repeating below, the advantage of models, a little more in detail :

The models are representation of unfamiliar pieces knowledge / information with familiar tools. The tools could be one or more of the following: mathematical equations, graphical representation, theoretical statements statistical distribution.

Often we, have a huge information or knowledge gathered over a long time on a research topic. They need not be available In an orderly way. Such a collection of knowledge will be useful if it is put into a right sequence. The good example is "solving

a Jig-saw puzzle”.

It is also true that any Learning happens in bits and pieces. Often what we learn are **disjoint**. We might forget them, with time. Only if these are related to one another, it would give a clear picture before our mind's eye.

So such disjoint pieces of knowledge is required to be integrated into one single large or a few concepts encompassing several related information we gather.

A learner need to organise them in a way these pieces of knowledge merge with one other.

The tool, is **MODEL**. The model helps integration and consolidation of the learning so as to have a full view of what is learnt and what more needs to be learnt.

This is a tool used both by **Scientists** and **Saints**.

(A) Components in the model the disjoint knowledge are **validated** first through available **scientific evidence**. Alternate to scientific proof is validation through

logical thinking. (Ancient men-of-knowledge, achieved logical validation of new knowledge through **debates**).

(B) One can find knowledge everywhere. Source of knowledge. Search for knowledge is not new. Knowledgeable among our ancestors were building Models. It is prudent to use them effecting necessary changes instead of starting from scratch every time.

Models of Universe

Universe is too large and complex to comprehend. The mystics who learnt the mysteries of the universe documented them. There were scholars who explained them. But yet, the contents of scriptures are far from common man's grasp.

The models are useful scientific tools.

Model explain complex knowledge that are far from our comprehension with the knowledge that is within our reach.

Model contain these knowledge, which are arbitrary and disjoint, nicely organised in such a way that one can have a clearer view

of the whole.

It is possible to know the from the model that perspective or piece of knowledge that is not known.

Chapter 4

Normal people & Seekers

There are two type of people who live on earth, any time.

(1) Normal People:

- First type, the vast majority.
- They are controlled by Maya.
- They live within the limits of Sensory Perception. (They believe that there is nothing in the universe that can know with their five sensory organs - eyes - ears - nose - tongue - touch)
- Possessions and positions give them a sense of safety and security.
- Bulk of them live by faith. This faith includes, faith in god.

(2) Seekers

- Very small number of people.
- They suspect / believe / realize that what we perceive with our sensory organs are limited. The world is larger and more interesting that the "sense limited world".

- They are not interested in the life of material chasing possessions and positions.
- They defy the control of Maya.
- They seek to cross the sense barrier to explore the universe, Gods, deities through astral travel.
- They read spiritual texts like Veda, Upanishads (which describe such issues like such as, how the universe is created, the age of our creator, the Brahma) that common man is not interested in.
- The seekers, along their life journey called Spiritual journey, acquire knowledge and abilities which anyone would love to possess.

Chapter 5

Life forms are trapped inside a

Virtual Capsules

What this really mean?

There is no distinction between the Life of an ant or elephant when they are not placed inside the capsule. The mystics achieve the feat of breaking free from the virtual capsule and get into another capsule.

An ant can perceive what an elephant perceive by merely getting out of its own capsule and enter that of an elephant's.

Each and every life is **trapped** into a virtual capsule and we can call them the **Space-time capsule**.

A life entrapped into a capsule:

(1) Has a finite life-time applicable that specie the capsule represent.

(2) They occupy a small and finite space in the universe, relevant to the specie the virtual capsule represent.

Why is this done so?

The universe is designed in such a way that every one of life forms remain active within that single large space.

They interact with each other but yet unharmed.



The act of placing the lives within the virtual capsule is explained by our knowledgeable ancestors as an act of **Goddess Maya**. That is because they could not explain it in any other way. Today, we can take the technology to help us.

We can take a few examples from our life and gadgets that we use today.

Take the Electromagnetic waves all around

us. The TV, Radio, Communication systems, satellite Mobile phones emit a large amount of these waves.

Each one of them is put inside a large virtual capsule in a way, that we don't see them. The encapsulation also helps that they do not interfere with each other.

A collection of TV signals are bunched together and put in another virtual capsule within another large virtual capsule. They can be broken and put to use in Televisions only. The Collection of Mobile Phone signals are encapsulated if a different way.

When required, the capsule is broken in such a way that so that it is put to use without adversely affecting rest of the Electronics and communication systems.

The role of virtual capsule!

Now the virtual capsule ensures that the **signals** from different devices do not get **mixed up**.

The signals remaining totally isolated and staying within the virtual capsule also do not benefit us.

So, the technology of communication, opens the virtual capsule at the right-time at the right place for the desired effect.

Chapter 6

Life is a script

What does this mean?

Life is "prerecorded" played.

We use music CD. The music is embedded or prerecorded in the disk. All that is required to listen the music is to energise (play) it. It plays the same music time and again whenever it is energised.

One may ask:

1. Am I not thinking?
2. Am I not taking decisions?
3. Am I not responsible for my efforts?
4. Yes! you do! But yet, all these are part of the script.
5. Every move in the life is preprogrammed.

One of our mistaken notion is that, we think that **"I do"**! Such a notion is created by, the all powerful **Maya!**

The mystics suggest that there are 6 Crores 60 million tricks that Maya plays. We know

the few that we will discuss.

Is it that the human life alone that is Scripted?

Perhaps no!

Every life form, known and unknown, including the **Universe**, is a life and is scripted.

The English Translation of **Creation of Universe** as explained in **Rig Veda** is available on the inter-net. **These** explain that the universe itself goes through the cycle like lives in it.

(1) Born (2) Goes through four (Yugas) phases of life and (3) finally shrinks and fully destroyed.

Universe

(as per Hindu Cosmology)!

Vedic knowledge on Universe suggests.

- The universe is cyclically created and destroyed in the time span of 8.64 billion human years.
- It is believed that the time is divided into **four epochs** or **Yuga**, of which we occupy the final - Kali yuga.
- The span of the yugas:

Satya Yuga is 1,728,000 human years,
Treta Yuga is 1,296,000 human years long,
Dwapara Yuga 864,000 human years and
Kali Yuga 432,000 human years

- Kali yuga is roughly 432,000 (human) years the final Avatar Kalki will end time. Narayana destroys all this existence while creating a new existence.
- According to Aryabhata, the Kali Yuga began in 3102 BC, at the end of the Dvapara Yuga.

- According to the Padma Purana, there are 8,400,000 life-forms or species,
 - 900,000 are aquatic ones;
 - 2,000,000 are trees and plants;
 - 1,100,000 are small living species, insects and reptiles;
 - 1,000,000 are birds;
 - 3,000,000 are beasts
 - 400,000 are human species.
- Every universe is covered by seven layers — earth, water, fire, air, sky, the total energy and false ego — each ten times greater than the previous one. There are innumerable universes besides ours,

This work make certain assumptions!

1. Saints , scriptures & Scientists Do not lie.
2. Some times their messages get distorted when it is transferred from word of mouth.
3. Sometimes, it is diluted (so, distorted) to make sense to common man, with good

intentions. *Grandma Science*)

3. We will trace the truth we seek and build a model in this part.

4. It is possible what one read here may sound unimaginable or difficult to digest, as long as we keep our mind to confined to "sense perceptible world" alone.

5. There are two ways to look at it:

Chapter 8

Universe

One large space

Both scientists and spiritualists agree that the Universe is a single large space. There are universes within the universe.

Every life form is said to exist in that space.

We observe that mostn plant lives become food for the people and animals. Most animals (herbivores) become food to wild animals. That calls for both existing in the same space.

The TV channels on animals show that both the **tigers** and **deer** drink water from the same water body and live in the same forest.

The hunted animals run for their lives only when their attacker is on a hot chase.

How such a peaceful coexistence is possible in a hostile situation?

This can be explained in two ways. First he Invisible barriers between the lives around them.

(1) Citizen of Universe.

Murli was on a pilgrimage, travelling by train from Bangalore to **Varnasi**.

The guy sitting next to him was a foreign tourist, He is touring in India to understand the Culture of India.

The tourist saw several religious symbols decorating the fellow traveller Murali and desired to understand Religion and culture from him.

Tourist: Do you belong to South India?

Murli: Yes, I do.

Tourist: There are many languages spoken even within Southern India.

Murli: You are right. These languages form Communication barriers. Communication barriers create logical division of the land and the people living there.

They do good to preserve their cultural heritage.

Tourist: Does the barrier affect the social

structure?

Murli: The design of the nature is great. Let us not bother about, "**Who did it**"?

The earth is a vast land inhabited by different specie including plant specie. They live everywhere - the land air and water. Some are wild and many are not.

One specie becomes **food for the other**. But yet the universe is not exhausted of any one or more species. The earth is always brimming with life.

Tourist: Coming back to the question, to which place do you belong ?

Murli: There is no one answer to it. There are several answers with a narrow view and the other.

We are individuals born and lived in a small piece of land divided by several physical snf logical boundaries and cultural barriers.

The other, the citizen of the undivided universe.

I belong to a particular village in this southern region. Some identifies me as a

villager in a remote district of this state of Karnataka.

I can be identified by my place of birth, the village, the district, the state, region of India, as Indian, Asian, and so on.

The encapsulation into Time - Space.

Every specie in the universe is encapsulated in the Time-space. If this concept is internalized, understanding the remaining pages will be easy.



The story book with the title Gullivar's Travel can be found in the Internet space. I read it when I was some 10 year old.

The concept one get after reading that story is "perception about life and objects around us vary with perceiver's own physical dimensions".

(1) The Physical Dimensions of life and

objects that we perceive has a strong relationship to our own Physical dimensions.

Many of the readers who could recall their boyhood days might have memories that I have.

During my boyhood, I was sent to a small village, where my grand parents lived.

I remember that the distances between my house and the railway station appeared too long. The village looked to be so large that children cannot trace their home, when moved about all alone.

When I visited that village, some 25 years latter, I found the same village to be too small. It took just five minutes to reach the rail station.

(2) Time, (also one of the dimensions like height weight, length) also varies with the age / growth

Every life form has its own **time-space**.

They live their life typically for 100 years in their world. A Mosquito's 100 years may equal to one day of human years.

Typically the dogs 100 years equal six to 10 years.

Smaller the life-time, the life occupies

Time is one of the Greatest illusions of time.

The story:

Lord vishnu a celestial divine entity perhaps several trillion times our own SPACE-TIME number.

Narad muni is one who is allowed to go anywhere at anytime that's why is a trylokya-ramani or the one who can roam or is roaming in 3 worlds viz **heaven, hell, mrutuloka** (earth or physical universe).

One day, the sage asked Vishnu to explain to him all about Maya.

Lord Vishnu offers the Sage Narada, a live demonstration rather than an explanation.

The word **Script**, has a few meanings listed in the dictionary.

Here we take this word scripts to mean:

(1) A dialogue, action sequences written for a movie / stage play.

For those who watch a movie feel that the character in the movie / play is performing on the stage on his own. A good direction and skill of the performer hides the script writer.

(2) Some of computer programs are called

Scripts.

The universe can be thought of a very large program (Script) consisting of several thousand small and big Scripts as its part.

In this chapter, the reader can consider.

both the definitions (1) and (2) above.

The Scripts, whenever it is run, produces the same sequence of events.

Not only our lives, but the **Universe** and **every life** in it are seen as scripted.

Let us see some evidence to the above belief. The Epic Mahabharatha explains that the life and tin it he events is a mere script. We are all like actors on the stage. We

(1) BARBARIKA

Story of Barbari in Mahabharat

Barbari or Barbarika has been a less written but important character of Mahabharat. He has been the illustrious son of the great warrior Ghatotkacha. Ghatotkacha has been

himself the son of great Bhima and Hidimba.

Lord Shiva has granted him three infallible arrows which had the power to conquer the whole world. Agni god has bestowed him with a bow.

Before the Mahabharata war began, Lord Krishna queried the warriors how many days he would take to finish Mahabharat war alone. Bhishma answered that he would take 20 days to finish the war. Dronacharya said 25 days. Karna said he would take 24 days. Arjuna told Krishna it would take 28 days for him to complete the battle.

Khatu Shyam jee or Barbari (Mahabharat)

Then he asked Barbari as how many days he would require? Barbari replied that he would take only a minute. Krishna baited Barbarika by mocking him for going to the great battle with only three arrows. In reply, **Barbari proved to Krishna that he indeed would require only a minute.**

Krishna then asks the boy whom he would favour in the war of Mahabharat. Barbarika reveals that he intends to fight from the weaker side. Krishna explains consequence

of his word to **Barbari's mother**.

Krishna tells that whichever side Barbari supports will only make the other side weak due to his power.

Nobody has the skill or power to defeat him. Hence, he is forced to support the other side that has become weaker due to his word to his mother.

(The problem!)

Thus, in an actual war, he (Barbari) will keep switching between the two sides, thereby destroying the entire army of both sides and eventually only he survives. Subsequently, none of the side is victorious as **he will be the only lone survivor**. Hence, Krishna avoids his participation from the war by seeking his head in charity.

As a true **Kshatriya**, he offered himself to be sacrificed, but he did have a condition. The condition was that he had left his home with a singular desire to witness the epic battle, so could Lord Krishna use some of his divinity to grant him that ability.

So it is said that after the **sacrifice**,

Barbareek's head was installed atop a hilltop from where he witnessed the entire battle and thus he is also referred to as 'Barbari - the silent witness'.

He is also known as Teen Baandhari and Khatu Shyamji. He is one of the persons who saw **Shri Krishna's vishwaroopa form**.

To this Krishna suggests that Barbarik's head should be allowed to judge this since it has watched the entire war. Barbarik's head suggests it was Krishna alone who was responsible for the victory in the war.

Krishna's advice, his strategy and his presence was crucial in the victory.

The original story contains a different expression. That states that:

While the warriors on both sides were busy using their arms against each other, the soldiers on both sides were killed by the "**Chakra**" of Vishnu.

But every one of the soldiers believed that they did.

Essence: The essence of this story is that:

Chapter 11

Occult sciences

Why do we discuss occult sciences?

If one's future events in the world around you can be predicted accurately, then are we not to conclude that the world is a script . If the events in the life of an individual can be predicted accurately are we not to accept that our life, from birth to death. is nothing but a script.

One of the few common features of various cultures in the world is the occult science.

There are different methods used to predict what lies ahead for one.

There are various levels of accuracy of these predictions. Some vague to very accurate in every detail.

How can one predict a future unless the events in life is fixed and merely played out.

1. I had consulted some astrologers during my active days with stunning predictions and they came true.

2. There were a few occasions when I had premonitions. That is, I could see well in advance of certain mishaps, certain accidents. But that information did not help me prevent that mishap.

A present a few instances when I witnessed the prediction of the astrologers (Occultists) coming true.

This has convinced me that life of every one is scripted. (Imagine, a CD playing-out a movie) from birth to death.

There are several branches of occult science. Each one use different methods for telling us about what the future holds for us.

Some are accurate and many are partially so.

I will list a few for the readers to ponder.

(1) The Hyderabad experts near Charminar, in the old city.

A close friend's son pursuing higher education in a far away city was found missing.

The cops in India are very efficient. They investigatged and announced that the boy

is not in the town where he is supposed to be. He had no friends who could give a clue about the boy's whereabouts or reason for. Suddenly he stopped attending classes. The parents did not receive his weekly calls.

I spoke to a great astrologer I knew. He just asked for the boy's name and birth star. He asked us to call him by noon on the following day. He will figure out the details in his morning prayers.

Next day, he said, the boy is safe. He is currently travelling south India visiting popular temples. Heading towards north. He would return home safe and sound on 17 th of next month.

He gave a detailed description about the boy's appearance.

My friend did not have the patience to wait for close to a month.

Our search for local occultists continued.

We found a Muslim gentleman, who could do our job.

The prayed for a while. Took a fresh **betal leaf**. Applied some **black paste** on the leaf.

Held it at eye level and started to speak.

He was seeing the boy on his betal-leaf Gadget!

Described the boy. His where abouts. They gave a date for his joining his family that was the same date given by my astrologer friend.

Nearly after a month, on 17 th of the following month, the boy appeared before his parents,

(The reason for his disappearance was consistent with his age - love failure).

(2) My own experience with astrology.

Real Life stories

(A) Predicting my future

I was introduced to a powerful astrologer. In those days his services were available to elite such as top corporate executives political leaders. He was quite powerful with his predictions. He looked highly religious.

The astrologer was, sought after by top bureaucrats in Government, ministers and rich businessman, some 35 years ago. Even

without his asking only such clients can shower huge money, comforts of air travel, five star accommodation wherever he goes.

Even though I donot belong to that class, I was lead to him by an important person.

He predicted me a few future events that was impossible in the situation then.

(1) My friend cum business partner will desert me. (This I could not believe because I offered to quit business and he could have readily agreed. I knew he felt he cannot run it alone).

(2) I will leave Delhi lock-stock and barrel in six months. (I dont see any employment option outside Delhi)

(3) move to a job in Southern India. (There was no known openings in south by then.

(4) Another prediction was more bizarre than the others.

I would own a house in a particular year.

It is not just that, he said when I go up to the terrace of that house I would see air planes lined-up at a distance, just as the

Elephants stand in a row in a Palace!

(I could not believe it because, I never intended to own a house any time in my life.

I was drifting from one city to another and enjoyed. I feared that when I own a house my movement might get restricted to one city,

To me every one of his predictions sounded crazy and impossible.

But all his prediction proved accurate both in terms of the events and its timing.

I approached the same astrologer a decade later thrice.

Every time, his prediction was 100% accurate.

I was in touch with him for a long time.

(B) The Astrologer seated under a tree!

At the age of 21, I was selected for a dream job but certain events and news stood in the way of quitting the present employment.

Typically, in India, (especially at junior levels of employment) a job in government is like a

tooth paste. It is Unidirectional. One Need to get through a tough competition to get a job in Government departments.

Once one quit that job, there is no way of getting back to the same job again.

A friend took me to an astrologer sitting under a tree in front of a nearby temple. I

I presented my **birth chart** which the astrologer looked into it and made some noting on a paper. He raised his head and demanded to know what my problem was.

I told him, it was the job. He became red faced and threw the chart back to me telling I was wasting his time.

He said, I was in employment for 3 years 3 months and 15 days! I face no problem about that job.

That was pretty accurate. I agreed and said my problem is about quitting the job and taking up another which is not a job in Government job. He took a second look at the chart and made some more noting.

He then said, I was moving to a new job on a particular day of the coming month. My

work place will be very close to a huge water body. It could be a lake, river or sea. From my present job dealing with Electrical I will be moving into Mathematics. (My New job was in a computer centre).

I tried to prove him wrong by attempting to join the new job **two days earlier** than the day he predicted. That was possible, but yet his science proved me that his science was infallible whereas the human effort is (fallible).

(He gave some other predictions and those did not come true at all).

Story 3

Universe as A collection of conscious entities.

The fact that the "lives in universe are scripted" had been fairly established in the previous pages.

Now we will create a Model of the universe with nothing other than **conscious entities**.

Chapter 12

Conscious entities.

In this chapter, we will look at the Universe as a collection of **conscious entities**.

That, there is nothing in the universe other than conscious Entity or Elements.

Some readers may not have come across such a term used in the context of Universe.

So I am giving a few similar things that we are familiar in our world around us.

(1) **Computer as an example:**

Universe can be thought of like a multi-tasking multi user computer.

Conscious entities are like a Computer Code that are executed by a processor.

The Codes are executed in small portions at a time.

Each time a code is executed, it produced results. We compare it lives that are born and live.

When the processor stops execution of a code, the life faces extinction.

When all the codes in the computers are completely executed, the computer is shut

down.

(2) Electrical Gadgets:

The **conscious elements** can be thought of design templates of innumerable electrical and electronic gadgets. They have different behaviour, such as rotating, cooling, heating, producing images, copying machines, printers etc.

The conscious elements produces **Gadgets** and when the Electrical power applied to it, it gets life and behave as designed.

Atma And Paramatma

The **Atma** is like the power. Atma is also like water and air.

A ocean is a huge water body. Even if some water is removed from the ocean into a cup , the ocean is still said to contain water.

The cup is also known to contain Water.

This is true of every energy forms, the heat, electricity, gravity.

The master of the Universe is known as **Paramatma**. The **Paramatma** energizes the entire universe.

The universe has several lives created using templates that is known as **conscious entities**.

- No two different lives are identical.
- No two lives from different species perceive the world around them, a line.
- No two lives from the same species also perceive the world around them, alike.
- The Eastern mystics suggests that such an arrangement is ensured by Maya, a consort of the God of Creation - Brahmma.
- Every specie is equipped to perceive an insignificantly small portion of the universe.

- Every Atma is a small part of the larger entity called **Paramatma**.

Am I not in the universe?

No life in the universe appear to be a part of the universe.

Every **life** exist in universe for a limited time. That must be the reason that some of the mystics choose to Call **life** an illusion.

Every objects, including the lives in the universe that we perceive with our sensory

organs are transient, lasting only so long as the interaction between "two permanent entities continue".

How do I understand the life in the universe?

(A) Lives compared to aroma of food.

When food is prepared in the kitchen by an expert cook, the aroma spreads to the living room and also to street.

The aroma is felt by everyone. It is real. It represents food. But that could not be consumed. So, it is a reflection or image of food. The result of interaction of Heat and food ingredients.

(B) Lives as waves in the ocean

Chapter 14

The Structure of Universe

(A) Universe modelled as a earth, that we live in.

(B) Universe modelled as a Conscious tree

The universe is filled with the lives projected by the conscious entities. They are all in one space. But are organised in a structure.

It can be thought of as a two dimensional structure or a tree structure, (a three dimensional).

(A) Two dimensional model of universe.

Let us go back to the Chapter titled Universe. Then the topic **Citizen Of Universe**.

There is a vast land (and ocean) that by itself does not restrict your movement from one place to other. Something else do restrict.

What are they?

The invisible boundaries. The linguistic, cultural that block a person from moving into its space. The Language spoken becomes another boundary.

The modern Society as such have establishments that selectively allow some people for some time.

We have Governments, visa policy that further restricts migration of people.

The idea that invisible boundaries restricting the conscious entities to function within the given space, is applicable to **universe as well**.

So, for several generations, people lived in small geographical area.

Imagine, Universe as a tree.

Tree as one life!

Mystics, all over the world have attempted to catch a glimpse of God but ended-up getting an idea about universe.

Mystics and scientists learn through processes that are unfamiliar to common man. Even the description of what they find is beyond our understanding.



But, there are several events and lives around us that compare the description of the universe.

The essence is:

- Universe is like one large life.
- The largest of the **Space-time** entities.
- That in turn, contain or made-up of, several **Space-time** entities, which are large and small **Space-time** entities.
- A tree is one of Several such examples of how the universe is made of lives that have **micro-organisms** with very short Space-time compared to the humans.

We see a tree as a single life.

- With this as a model, we can explore perceived the how the mystics perceived the Universe.

Each plant species has a typical life-time. But, we hardly observe ac plant life is composed of several lives. Also that each such life with different **life-times**. More precisely, different **Space-times**. In a tree there is one large trunk.

From the trunk, several Branches grow-out. Typically the branches become progressively smaller.

Finally every branch of the tree have the leaves- flowers - fruits.

Let us stop the discussion here for a while to get an idea about Conscious element & its working.

Conscious Element / entity

Example 1

Universe in a very large conscious entity.

Take for example, any of the transport vehicles that we use to day.

A car, an aircraft, ship, locomotive engine.

They are just one entity. They perform a well defined functions.

But it is built using several thousand parts. There are very very small screws, nuts, electronic part to large wheels. Some move in two dimension, some rotate, some others stationary.

Each one of the parts in such devices are positioned in such a way that

- They remain in the same position until it is worn-out and discarded.
- They are interconnected.

- Every part need to perform in co-ordination with the rest of the parts - big and small.
- Together they perform as a single entity.

The relation between the universe and the lives in it can be compared to a transport vehicle and the thousands of small and big parts with which it is built.

Example 2

Take an enterprise or a Government.

There are several individuals in one entity called Government.

It is not just one person. But millions of them.

There are leaders, various officials, with capabilities such as knowledge, skills differing from one another. There are a large variety of equipment and working place,

They all work together to deliver the objective called Governance.

Rebirth

I always felt, from the way the life and rebirth were explained there is something wrong with our understanding.

Imagine that Universe, the largest Entity as a very **large computer program**. This code consists of several small and big codes within it.

It appears that each small and big code described above is not executed in one go.

They are executed in several **small steps**.

Each one code is a process with a unique **process ID**. Each code is executed in co-ordination with the rest of the Codes.

Each execution step is a life - **rebirth** followed by **death**.

When the code is executed till the end, the **process ID** is removed and there is no rebirth subsequently.

- In Coomputer program execution, the current execution has a strong influence on the past and also in future executions.
- Eastern mystics call such dependence of current situation to past as **Causation** or

Karma.

What could be purpose of lives produced in the universe?

To feed the hungry **eagle!** Or *Garuda!*

The **Shaman Mystics** talk about the *Great Eagle!* The *Garuda!* The *Eastern Mystics* talk about the eagle hungry for knowledge.

When any life dies, the eagle devour the knowledge that the live gathered.

Chapter 15

Chapter 15

Out of body Experience

An out-of-body experience (OBE or sometimes OOBEx) is an experience that typically involves a sensation of floating outside one's body and, in some cases, perceiving one's physical body from a place outside one's body (autoscopy)

Several instances when people experienced what is known as "Out of body experience".

My father Late T.S.Nagarethinam, an Electrical Engineer by profession was one such person.

He never practised Yoga, meditation or any other Spiritual practices. He has very high blood pressure, compared to others, from birth. That did not affect him in anyway. (He was denied insurance policy for this reason).

In his early 20s, during British Rule in India he was excommunicated from the princely state of Pudukkottai, for a period of two years, by British to Hyderabad under

Nizam.

(I skip the details or reason for excommunication has no relevance here).

He was escorted by cops and put on a train to Hyderabad. It was a pretty long journey in summer.

He was received and accommodated by some relatives settled there.

He was tired and slept.

In the middle of the night, he suddenly woke-up. To his utter dismay, he found himself standing near his body. He thought he was dead.

He panicked. He tried to wake up his relatives and friends who were sleeping in the large room.

He did not succeed/ He thought he would go out and get some help. He went close to the door and tried to open it. But he was already outside the house.

He found the street bright as though it was a day time. He walked along the road to find a sign board that read, **Medical practitioner.**

He walked through the door. Reached a

bedroom where a old man was sleeping. A little girl, his grand daughter was sleeping by his side. A flask and a book was found on a table nearby.

His effort to wake-up the old man, failed.

He was desperate. That is what he remembered,

Suddenly he wokeup, normally, like he did on anyother day.

He tried to explain his room mates. No one believe him. He talked about his visiting the **medical practitioner, in his house.**

The description matched with the reality.

That was the first and last time, my father said, he experienced out-of-body. That was involuntary and can be traced to stress and strain of train journey coupled with his high level of hyper tension.

It was a summer, some 40 year latemy familyr. My parents lived in a small beautiful village. I visit him with my wife and children and spend some good 20 days.

I discuss a lot about Science and Spirituality during these days.

My father has a large fan following in that village. A farmer approached my father on one of those days. He wanted my father to demonstrate OBE for his relative who has come all the way to witness. After some initial hesitation, he agreed. The two villagers went away without a word. I did not understand then, what is happening.

After a few minutes, my father instructed me not to panic for he will appear dead for a while.

Then suddenly his body became still, eyes struck in one position and half open.

Within some 30 seconds he became normal and we continued the discussion where we had stopped.

The twosome came to my father after some 15 minutes.

My father explained them where they went and what transpired in the scene that was far away from where we were.

The visitor jumped-up and asked my father if he could teach him the technique. The local villager forcibly took him away telling it was OBE and gave his own explanation why

every one cannot have OBE.

That was the only time I witnessed OBE, a live demo.

Medico legal cases involving OBE.

Awareness during surgery is a very serious problem for the anaesthetist and the patient as well. Such incidents are the cause for 2% of the legal claims against anesthetists while patients with intra-operative awareness experience describe it as the worst thing they have ever suffered from. Pain, anxiety and inability to react due to muscle paralysis often lead to the situation called post traumatic stress disorder which demands psychiatric support. The fact that there are patients who report intra-operative experience, even several days after surgery, raises questions about the way the anesthetic drugs interfere with the mechanisms of memory and consciousness while, in bibliography, there are studies proving that even deeply anesthetized patients can be influenced by auditory stimuli without being able to recall them. Intraoperative monitoring of the anesthesia depth is important for the prevention of this problem. From all the available devices only

the Bispectral Index Monitoring (BIS) has been proven to be effective for this purpose but the high cost per person and the low specificity in preventing awareness episodes do not allow its everyday use. The surgeon and especially the anesthesiologist must be aware of the risk factors, the prevention measures and the actions that must be taken after an awareness incident in order to minimize the unfortunate complications for both the patient and the doctors.

Conclusion

There is sufficient evidence in life that the life in the universe (for that matter, even the Universe, as a whole, is scripted). We have in our culture, such terms as Fate, and Destiny which convey the same meaning.

We all act into the world and believe that we have the knowledge and ability to achieve our goals.

We are happy that we succeeded and unhappy with each failure.
