

Mr. N. Voy. . . "



I had fallen for one of those weaknesses. I had done certain things that I am not proud of and prefer not recount here.


I had cheated someone, but I could not rectify it as it involved the reputation of someone else.

Could you clarify that to us, as religious blindfolds are often the instigator of many of the world's troubles?"

The Lord Justice hands the notes back to the scribe.

"Your Honour, I am no authority on the world's troubles. All I know is that I was a young man, I enjoyed and loved life. I lived for the weekends and disco's, loved dancing and meeting new girls, and if crucial I would not run from a fight.


When he came to earth he kept that direct union with his Father and his energy, the energy that restored the broken and sick mass in people's minds and bodies, that same energy that raised people from the dead.


The universe is immaterial – It is mental and spiritual' says Richard Conn Henry. ¹

"Karl, let me read more of the interview of Professor Scheizle. I thought this might be interesting for you as this person is also German.



GENEVA - CERN

'German nuclear physicist and professor at the Department of Physics at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology in Zurich (ETHZ), Gunther Scheizle, surprised his colleagues this week when he revealed his faith in God.¹ . . forcing him to reconsider his "previous

understanding of life and the universe."

"I can understand my coworkers' surprise, I have always been known as somewhat of a no-nonsense, anti-religious atheist, I once threw a heavy physics book at one of my students just because he even mentioned the possibility of Intelligent Design in the universe.

I guess he was right after all," he acknowledged with a grin.

The 57-year-old experienced a heart attack during one of the most powerful tests to be done on the <u>large hadron collider</u> yet, last January.

"We tried to push the hadron collider's limits that day and beat our record of 6.5 teraelectronvolts (TeV) per beam and that is when I started to feel uneasy and eventually lost consciousness," he recalls.

Although I was unconscious and my body lay paralyzed on the floor, I felt like I was outside my body and could hear and see all the commotion my heart failure had caused around me," he explains.

"That is when beings of light came and comforted me.

They did not say anything, but I knew I was going to survive and that my mission on earth had not yet been accomplished. I knew I was not dead. All I remember after that, is waking up in the ambulance in excruciating pain.

All my preconceived notions of reality were permanently destroyed.

How could I face my fellow coworkers and family with such an incoherent story?"

He wished to tell his story to others because he could no longer live with this burden on his shoulders,

"All I hope now is that my fellow coworkers respect my beliefs and newly-found understanding of the world and <u>may God help us find</u> the true meaning of life, be it through prayer or science," he concluded.""

CHAPTER 4

HINDUISM



"Hi, I am Ayesha, I am from India and I was invited by the educational board to sit in with the Jury of this court. It was a great honour for me and my family.

My family is devoutly Hindu. Different times in the day we go to the prayer or puja room and ask the gods for help. My parents think that Christians are out to convert others to their religion and their beliefs. Is that true?"

"That I don't know, Ayesha, I cannot vouch for Christians, but I can vouch for my client. He is not interested in religious converts, because like I said he is not religious himself. He only works with the heart of people and how sincere and honest they are.

He is not interested how long and noisy our prayers are, or how loud we can clang our bells and chant 'Hari Krishna', nor how loud we can shout 'Praise God!', 'Allah Akbar!', nor how many times we can spin our prayer wheels.



My client sees past this religious fervor and looks at our heart. Do we desire to worship him, or do we worship ourselves, our fervour and our places of worship?

He is not interested in our religious goodness, but in the sincerity of our heart.

In our human four-dimensional framework, we classify; Atheist, Muslim, Hindu, Christian, Jew or Buddhist.

This division in religious worship is often used to set people or populations against each other, which I am sorry to say, will profit those who seek to accumulate power.

My client wants <u>no religious converts</u>. Jesus did not come to start a new religion, he said,

'unless you convert (change your ways) and become like a little child, you cannot enter the Kingdom of God.' 1

He wants us to become like little children, who love and trust, and if they fight they are quick to forgive, so we can be part of his Kingdom where the citizens are loving and forgiving people with childlike faith. Jesus lifts us high above our religious divisions in order to connect us back to our creator, to my client, to love itself.

Jesus was not a Christian, he was not interested in religion, as I explained earlier to the honourable Justice, he showed us how to live and love others.

Ayesha, the first Hindu writings are the four Vedas: Rig Veda, Yajur Veda, Sama Veda, Athava Veda.

Presently we are taught by our gurus and pundits that there is no such thing as sin, only



positive and negative karma. However the original writings of the Vedas and Upanishads teach us differently.

They teach about sin, about heaven, hell, salvation from hell (Mukti) and one exclusive way of salvation through the Purush Prajapati.

The theme in the Rig Veda the Upanishads is the nature and purpose of the <u>Purush Prajapati</u> and his supreme sacrifice. – Purush meaning Man and Prajapati meaning Supreme Creator -

Purush Prajapati translated from Sanskrit is, '<u>the Lord of all creation</u> who became man' (Sathpathbrahmana 10.2.2.1_2; Rg Ved Purushasukta 10:19)

The Purush Prajapati is 'the one and only way to eternal life' "Nanyah pantha vidyate-ayanaya". (Yajur Veda 31:18)

The Supreme Creator took a perfect human body and 'offered it up as a self-sacrifice'. "Nishkalanka Purusha" (Brihad Aranyak Upanishad 1.2.8)

He is the only sinless human being, and 'only in knowing him does one obtain immortality'. (Chandogya Upanishad 1.6:6,7)

After giving Himself as the ultimate sacrifice '<u>He resurrects</u>'. (Brihad Aranyak Upanishad 3.9.28.4-5; Kathopanishad 3:15)

By his resurrection, 'the Purush Prajapati conquered death and released sin's stranglehold on mankind'.

We are delivered from 'karma' and the 'Mouth of Death'.

'He will return to earth only once more'.

Acknowledging the sacrifice of the perfect Purush Prajapati '<u>imparts</u> <u>eternal life</u>'. (Kathopanishad 1,3.8,11)

He was symbolized by 'a spotless lamb', which was the often sacrificed animal. (Maddyandiniya Sathpathbrahmana III)

The people place their sins on the lamb or goat and the lamb dies in their place.

This form of sacrifice is still a regular occurrence in many Hindu villages and temples throughout India.

In most religions, we find traces of the doctrine that,



'without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins.' 1


People sacrifice a lamb or goat as atonement or reparation for their sins.

From the Vedas we can summarize the nine ways to recognize the sacrifice of the Purush Prajapati:

1. The sacrifice should be blameless, free from all sins -

(Chantokia Upanishad 1.6-6.7)

- 2. He has to be rejected by his own people -(Itareya Brahmana 2.16)
- **3. He seeks no release** (Rigveda 5.46.1)



Na varute yapaat pasum alabhate kadachana (Satapata Brahmana III-7.3.1)

- **5. Blood comes out of sacrificial Purusha who is cut -** (Brhad Aranyaka Upanishad 3.9.28.2)
- **6. Its bones should not be broken -** (Itareya Brahmana 2.6)

7. After the sacrifice it should return back to life -

"Yad Vruksho vrukshano rohati, mulannavatharah punah, martyah svinmrutyuna vruknah, kasmaanmulaat prarohati, Retasa iti maavocata, jivatastat praja yate, dhanaruh a iva vai crau vruksho, anjasaa pretya sammbhvha" (Brhad Aranyaka Upanishad) The last part translates,

"Remember this man is dead. But this man comes alive on his own"

8. Its meat should be eaten by his saints - (Satpata Brahmana 5.1.1.1,2)

9. His sacrifice fulfilled all the scriptures -

"Tasmaad yagnat sarvahuta, nucha samaari jagnire, Chandaamsi jagnine, tasmaad yajustas naada jaayatah."

Through that sacrifice Purusha offered everything that he had, including the Rig, Sama, Yajur Vedas and the Chandas, the sacred writings. - (Purusha Sukta verse 9)


If we can discover which person in history gave himself as a self-sacrifice and afterwards came back to life, according to these nine points of sacrifice, then we discover who this Purush Prajapati is.

Subsequently, according to our Hindu scriptures, we have found the only true way of salvation: **Mukti and freedom from the Samsara**, the endless cycle of death and rebirth.

Looking across history among all the greats, from Buddha to Swami Vivekananda, from Alexander the Great to Genghis Khan, from Ashoka to Gandhiji, from Bahaullah to Mother Teresa, we find only one person with a striking similarity to prophecies found in the Vedas and that is Jesus Christ described in the Bible.

1. THE SACRIFICE SHOULD BE BLAMELESS

"he was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin." (Hebrews 4:15) Jesus' judge said, "I find no fault in him." (John 19:4)





- 3. <u>HE SEEKS NO RELEASE</u> "his judge said, Why do you not speak to me? Don't you know that I have power to crucify you, or to release you?" (John 19:10)
- 4. IT SHOULD BE TIED TIGHT TO THE SACRIFICIAL PILLAR "when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered him to be crucified." (Matthew 27:26) First tied for scourging and then crucified.



5. BLOOD COMES OUT OF SACRIFICIAL PURUSHA WHO IS CUT - "a soldier with a spear pierced his side, and at once came there out blood and water." (John 19:34) "this is my blood which is shed for many for the remission of sins." (Matthew 26:28)



- 6. <u>ITS BONES SHOULD NOT BE BROKEN</u> "He keeps all his bones: not one of them is broken." (Psalms 34:20) "when they saw he was dead already, they brake not his legs." (John 19:33)
- 7. AFTER THE SACRIFICE IT SHOULD RETURN BACK TO LIFE "The angel answered, 'I know that ye seek Jesus, which was crucified. He is not here: for he is risen, as he said... go quickly, and tell his disciples that he is risen from the dead;" (John 19:28-30; Mark 16:6)



8. ITS MEAT SHOULD BE EATEN BY HIS

SAINTS - "and the bread that I will give is my flesh



(John 6:51) . . . Jesus took bread,. . and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me."
(1Corinthians 11:23,24)

9. <u>HIS SACRIFICE FULFILLED ALL THE SCRIPTURES</u>. "Knowing that all things were now accomplished <u>that the scripture might be fulfilled</u>,... he bowed his head and gave up the ghost." (John 19:28-30)


* 'THAT THE SCRIPTURE MIGHT BE FULFILLED'
THIS REFERS TO ALL THE SCRIPTURES OF THE THREE
MAJOR RELIGIONS AT THAT TIME: JUDAIC, HINDU AND
BUDDHIST SCRIPTURES.

Lord Jesus fulfilled all the nine characteristics for the sacrifice of the Purush Prajapati as summarized from the Vedas and Upanishads. Hence, only in Him is **Moksha or Mukti**, and according to our original scriptures, **He is the core**, the heart and soul **of our Hindu religion**. He is freedom from the **Samsara**, the cycle of death and rebirth.

Lord Jesus is not Christian, nor does he represent any particular religion. He is and represents Truth and Love.

He is the Purush Prajapati:

"the Lord of all creation who became man- who gave himself in self



The Purush Prajapati

sacrifice for our Mukti, our Moksha, our Salvation.

Ayesha interrupts, "Sir, there are so many gods and is Jesus not just one of the six million gods?"

"Ayesha, like I explained there is <u>only one</u> <u>Supreme Creator, the Purush Prajapati</u> and we have just learned that Jesus fulfilled all the prophecies pertaining to the Lord of all creation.

However concerning the many gods and deities it states in the Vedas:



"gods came later, after the creation of this universe." Nasadiya Sukta (Rig Veda 10.129.6)

Consequently the Lord of all creation who created the universe, the Purush Prajapati, should be worshipped above all other gods as the other gods came after the creation of the universe.

Jesus taught us to love others as ourselves,¹ to not look at people's social standard, but their heart. ²

Ayesha, are you ready for another shock?

Did you know that we learn in the Vedas that there was no cast system and that all men are born equal?

I quote,

'Among these men **there are <u>no superiors or no inferiors</u>**, no middle ones either. .. By birth they are <u>all highborn</u> because they are <u>all children of Mother-Earth</u>. - Te ajyesthaa akanisthaasa udbhido amadhyamaaso mahasaa vi vavridhuh | sujaataaso janushaa prishnimat

These men are without superiors and without inferiors. They are <u>mutually</u> brothers. They march onwards for prosperity. -

Ajyesthaaso akanislliaasa ete sam bhraataro vaavridhuh saubhagaaya|yuva pita swapaa rudra eshaam sudhughaa prishnih sudinaa marudbhayah' (Rig Veda: 5-60-5)

Yet, in our lack of knowledge of the original Hindu scriptures, we have created the cast system with Brahmins at the top and Dalits cut off at the bottom.

Furthermore we learn that,

"God has no image and his name is Holy."

Seeing God has no image, 'he seeks those who worship him in spirit, and truth.' He will then help us and answer our following prayer from the Brhad Aranyaka Upanishad,

From the unreal lead me to the real, From darkness lead me to light, From death lead me to immortality.

"Sir, I am very surprised how much you know, sir, about my religion. Are you not a Christian then, are you Hindu?"

"Ayesha, I am one of God's children and a devotee of the Purush Prajapati, the Supreme Creator who became man, the Lord Jesus. I have made an extra copy of my study notes, if you like." The Justice interjects,

"Could you please pass your notes and studies to the recorder, as I would like this all to go on record. Thank you. Each juror here will receive a word-for-word report from Mr. Peters.

I think it is time for our lunch break, shall we go to the canteen and start again in an hour's time?"



CHAPTER 5

CHRISTIANITY

After lunch - "May I go next, Your Honour?"

The Justice nods, as if in thought.

"Mr. N. Voy, good afternoon, I am Joanna and I was raised in a Christian home and my parents are bornagain Christians. They often read my brother and me the Bible.

Although I started studying Theology, I switched to Law. You can understand my surprise when I was chosen as a representative by my University to be a juror on this case.

Several things are still not clear to me, so I thought to ask your opinion.

One thing that is not clear to me is about the gender of the Holy Spirit, whether it is a he or she, a male or female, or just spirit?

Could you give your views on sexuality, divorce, same-sex and predestination? And last, what happens to those that commit suicide and why did God tell some of the 'good' kings to destroy whole nations?"

Mr. N. Voy chuckles, "Okay Joanna, let's take these one at the time. You ask me, but my answers might not be in line with the social standards or morals of our Western society.

If everyone is okay with that, then I will gladly answer your questions from my personal viewpoints and what I have observed and learned living in different Eastern cultures. I am sorry to say that this might not be to everyone's liking"

"Please give us your point of view, sir."

THE HOLY SPIRIT

I will start with the Holy Spirit. A concept that is difficult for us to grasp in our limited four-dimensional thinking is that God is three and is yet one - Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

My client is the Father, and he counsels and shares his total energy with the other two. Their unity is strong and although they are three completely different individuals, they are united in one and each is in total unity with the others.

So what happened? Did the Holy Spirit change gender between the Old and the New Testament?

I doubt it.

As you might know, the Jews of Jesus' day and <u>Jesus himself spoke</u> Aramaic.

Spirit in Aramaic is '<u>Paraclete</u>' and is <u>female gender</u>, just like '<u>Ruach</u>' in Hebrew. The Gospels were written in the Greek language. Spirit in Greek is '<u>Pneuma'</u> and is <u>neuter</u> in the Greek language.



Then more than a thousand years later came the Bible translators, who translated it from Greek.

Men that had studied, important men, male chauvinists, and of course for them the Holy Spirit was not neuter. "No, the 'it' was a 'he', a 'male'."

When we read the qualities that the New Testament gives to the Holy Spirit, then you can decide whether it sounds like they are describing a <u>mother or a father</u>, a female or a male?

Jesus said, it is 'a comforter' that will teach you all things and will remind you. Paul describes that the fruits of the Spirit are; love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, self-control.

Who does this sound like to you, Joanna? A father or a mother?"

"It sounds to me like a mother, but are we not doubting God's word then?"

"No. We are not doubting God's word. We are not doubting what Jesus said, we are only correcting a translation mistake.

To our limited understanding my client seems to advocate male-female relationships. Seeing we are made in his/their image, male and female, then this male-female relationship should also apply to the Godhead.

I think sometimes we try to over spiritualize my client, like he is so far away. I think we might be surprised at how much he is like us.

SEX

You asked about sex.

My client created it and honestly I think it is his ultimate gift to show his love for mankind. Yet, we in our religious piety say, 'Oh! That is not for me. No, I am above that. I am holy.'

Here, I am talking about happy, fun-filled, clean sex, not the perverted and weird sadistic stuff.

Once I was once asked by an elder couple in their eighties, to bring a gift to a friend of mine who was also in her eighties.

The couple had gone out of their way to purchase a nice box of chocolates, as they knew that was what my friend liked. They were going to bring it themselves, but my friend was busy that day for some unexplained reason.

So I took the parcel to her and she took it happily. However when I told her who it was from, she pushed it right back into my hands and said, 'Why don't you give that to someone else?' I was surprised and hurt by her reaction when she refused the gift, as I knew how much the couple wanted to show their love for her.

My question is, is that how my client feels when we push his most beautiful gift away, by saying, 'Please give that to someone else, I don't want it.'

Of course sexuality is also our personal freedom of choice when we have come to the age of adulthood.

But in my personal opinion I disagree with a man whom I greatly admire, Mahatma Gandhi, concerning his teaching on 'Brahmacharya' of self restraint, which states, 'Life without Brahmacharya appears to me to be insipid and animal-like' and that sex is 'for the purpose only of procreation.'

That means that sex can only take place once a year for a man that is married to a beautiful wife, as she will be pregnant nine months and then he should wait another few months for her to get her bodily strength back.

To me this does not make any sense and will most likely ruin their relationship.



When my client launched the world it keeps saying, "and God saw that it was good."
Only one time he said "it is not good."
What was it that was not good?

"It's not good that man should be alone." 1

He has got to have someone to enjoy life with, so he made him a woman, or a 'Wow man'. My client knows what men like, because we are made in his image.

Also Saint Augustine felt that vows of sexual abstinence would be pleasing to my client. My client gave sex as a gift to mankind and we push the gift right back and say, 'You give this to someone else? Give it to the sinners, because I am better than to enjoy that.'

Remember the old saying: 'When a marriage goes on the rocks, the rocks are often in bed.'

If we have sex with our partner, little resentments are erased and we overlook the idiosyncrasies, because there is something spiritual about sex that relaxes us and puts us in a frame of mind to overcome our little four-dimensional squabbles and cover it all under a blanket of love.

I am not saying that it is the only remedy, but it certainly helps.

Saint Augustine seemed to think that sex had something to do with the original sin in the garden. I am sorry, but the very first thing that my client said to them in the garden is,

"be fruitful and multiply" 2

and you cannot multiply without sex.

It is the same thing as saying that my client is at war with science, while he is the pinnacle of science, as is proven in the biological data storage of our DNA.

My client does not hate sex; he created it along with all the body parts that make it feel so good.

I repeat, please know that I am talking about clean, loving, fun-filled, enjoyable sex, not the weird, sadistic and perverted stuff.

People think Religion and Sex don't go together. This might be true, BUT MY CLIENT IS NOT RELIGION.

He is not Christian, He is not Muslim, He is not Hindu, He is not Buddhist, nor Jewish. He is the Creator of us all.


God is love in every form. He is agape, eros, philia & storge.

<u>Storge</u>, natural love between parents and offspring.





own greedy desires, with **no concern** for the other party or victim, or to be loving and concerned for the other and their situation, **yielding to their wishes**, not forcing ourselves upon them.

My client gave us the joy of sex, for the same reason that he put gold and diamonds in the earth's crust and it is all to test our character. Will I be loving, considerate and giving, or selfishly seek to satisfy my personal obsession and self-indulgence?

If someone has an unnatural desire for perverted sex, or feels like preying on innocent little children, then Jesus gave a very sober warning,

"whosoever shall offend one of these little ones that believe in me, it is better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he were cast into the sea." 1

Unless that person beseeches my client to radically change him and there are definite signs that his prayer is answered, I personally believe that it is better for this person to become a eunuch and allow himself to be castrated. Jesus said,

"If your hand offends you, cut it off: it is better for you to enter into life maimed, than having two hands (or testicles) to go into hell" 1

My client said to the children of Israel,

"You will remember how I led you these forty years in the wilderness, to humble you, to test you, to see what was in your heart, if you would keep my commandments or not." ²

His commandment is not a bunch of laws and 'Don'ts'. It is simply,

"that you love each other."³

This is the very most important thing that we can learn on this earth, to love each other.

We might not think much of it, but these tests of our character are the main reason for the whole existence of mankind on earth.

Our spiritual life, which quantum physics has proven time and again, is so much more important than our physical four-dimensional life.

Loving is caring, giving, kindness, gentleness and self-restraint and is diametrically the opposite of lust, greed, and selfish grabbing. Lust does not care if you ruin someone else's happiness as long as you can gratify your own gluttonous sexual desires.

This applies to all the different aspects of our life, whether it is money, sex, driving, and any interaction with others.

For it is <u>in giving that we receive</u>, and it is in dying (to ourselves) that we are born again to eternal life and happiness."

SAME-SEX

"Sir what do you think about gay or same-sex relationships?"

"Joanna, I don't think that there is any person in today's world that has not at some time in their life been tempted with the thought of, "Could I also have gay tendencies?"

This is especially in the Western society where we are almost confronted with LBGT rights (Lesbian, Bisexual, Gay, Transgender) on a daily basis via TV newscasts, interviews, documentaries, educational programmes and movies.

When we get tempted with a thought like that, then it is <u>our reaction to</u> <u>it that determines what we will become</u>.

If I reject that thought and say, "No thanks, that is not for me", then the thought will not take root in my mind.

If however I dwell on the thought and the possibility that because of this and that, and the other, I could also be gay, then that thought will take root in my mind. Thoughts become <u>actual physical roots</u> that spread like weeds throughout our brain.

Although they will not immediately take over, the roots are there and they will grow in our subconscious, from where these thoughts will surface from time to time. Any neuroscientist will tell you this.

When these thoughts resurface we have a limited amount of time to kill the thought and clearly state, "No thanks, that is not for me!"

However, if I just try to push it aside, as if it does not exist, then it will linger and the roots will go stronger, and the thoughts will resurface stronger and stronger.

Then it will come to the point that I cannot resist these growths or thought patterns in my mind any longer as they have taken over, and I finally accept that these thoughts are part of me, or are me, and that I also must be LBGT. Now that we no longer make the effort to resist these thoughts, we feel liberated, as we have surrendered and the war, or our inner-struggle is over.

For this reason, I don't agree that children, who are more vulnerable, should be questioned in school at early age about what they feel is their sexual identity, as it is <u>planting thoughts in their mind</u> that are not for them.

Children should be allowed to be children, as puberty will come around soon enough.

Our mind is the hub where it all starts. Neuroscientists will tell you that ninety percent of what happens in our body is psychosomatic and starts in our mind, i.e. chronic stress, hurt feelings, depression, etc., are fertile ground for negative roots to grow. The mind sends out different signals throughout the body, which affect our social behaviour, our health, our sexual attractions, etc., etc.

I can totally understand that men can be more at ease with other men, as men think alike and like to do similar activities, etc. The same is true of women who enjoy each other's company.

However male and female are known as the opposite sex. They are not only opposite in sex but also in mindset.

As we know "Men are from Mars and Women are from Venus."

I believe my client made men and women so different or even opposite to help us develop our character and to become more <u>forgiving and understanding</u>, as no marriage will survive if we don't learn to embrace these qualities.

Therefore in today's selfish society, so many marriages go on the rocks, as we feel it is too much for our pride and selfishness to adapt these divine qualities, so it is totally understandable why people like to relax with those of the same sex."

"What is your opinion on same-sex marriage?"

"A marriage is taking vows before each other. We also like to take in these vows in the church, as then we take for granted that my client is included and the marriage is "blessed".

I don't think that we can assume that my client, who is <u>not politically correct</u>, is included in these vows, as he might not want to be included, seeing that he created us male and female: Adam and Eve, not Adam and Steve, nor, Madam and Eve.

I have some acquaintances that are gay. They are nice people, and they do not purposely exhibit their sexual orientation to me.

I love them as a person, but the sexual aspect and concept of gay intimacy and intercourse I prefer not to comment on. Jesus said clearly,

'Judge not lest you be judged' 1

I don't want to be condemned for my personal behaviour, and although it might not be to my personal liking, why should I condemn someone else for their behaviour?

Jesus was clear about our judgmental attitude,

'why do you look for the mote (wood particle) that is in your brother's eye, but don't consider the beam that is in your own eye?' ²

PREDESTINATION

"Joanna, shall we go on, you asked about predestination, this all becomes a lot <u>simpler with quantum physics</u>.

As we have learned during the court case; <u>outside of our four dimensions time does not really exist and it goes backwards and forwards</u>. In a way my client, who is from a much higher dimension, can see which personal decisions we will make in the future. In the light of these future decisions that we personally make, <u>we predestine</u> ourselves.

Because of the decisions we will make in the future my client will help us and protect us up to a certain point, so we can eventually arrive at the point where we can make those decisions.

Aristotle said, 'It is not because we are strong in character that we make the right decisions, but it is because we make the right decisions that we become strong in character.'

My client absolutely does not predestine us, because that will take away our free will of decision making with which we ourselves determine our future. It says,

'For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate' ³

He foreknows, or **knows beforehand**, what decisions we will make, as he sees the future, but **the decisions are 100 percent ours**.

One example that we just had is professor Scheizle. My client knew that professor Scheizle was going to make the right decision.

With this in mind he allowed this particular situation to occur where professor Scheizle's character could be tested, and he could make this important decision to explain his spiritual experience to the scientific community.

My client does not predestine us, but because he can see the future and knows what decisions we will make, he sets things into motion, so that we can make these decisions.

We are the only ones shaping our own destiny and predestining ourselves and our future. My client has no say in this whatsoever. He will try to influence us for good, but <u>he cannot and will not make the decisions for us.</u>

DIVORCE

"Very interesting, could you give us your views on divorce?"

"Recently my views on divorce have changed. I have lived a good 25 years in different cultures, the Hindu and Buddhist, the Muslim and Sikh culture and I have good friends in all of them.

Honestly, I don't think that my views will go down well in our emancipated, present-day, Western society.

So Joanna, I am rather reluctant to express my opinion, as you, being a girl, might not like me anymore after this."

"No sir, please give your opinion as they are interesting and show us a different aspect on things, and we are mature enough to make our personal choices."

"Joanna, believe me, divorce is heart-breaking, gut-wrenching and devastating, and it takes years of healing, fighting discouragement, rejection and despondency, especially if children are involved.

The strain will probably estrange you from having a close bond with your children.

Why are the suicides increasing? Why are there so many, especially children, with mental health issues? Why do children turn to self-harm?

The main reason being is, that the family has lost its importance. In the family we find security, no matter how many flaws or arguments, there is a certain stability.

The **blood bond** with the father and mother is only one-of-its-kind, special and unique, which we should not try to replace.



The parents were known to sacrifice for the children and the children for the parents.

But nowadays, we think that we have to take care of 'Number-One' first and that is the <u>very poison</u> that destroys our marriages.

Divorce statistics are going through the roof. Broken homes, out-of-control parents, hysterical children, is the sad tale of today.

During divorce, emotions can run very high and there are a lot of sides to consider, with so many rights and wrongs. In a case like that I can only go by what my client wrote.

Jesus told us that we should not divorce. I think the reason he said that was because he wants us to take care of the children that we have brought in this world.

Some parents abort their children before birth, so as not to have the responsibility of being a parent.

Some governments and cultures had schemes and training centres organized, where parents could relinquish their children, so the children could be educated in the older generation's ideology.

However my client gave the children to the parents and not to the state or institution, as it was and is the job of the parents to see that their children grow up with love and an education to develop their qualities that they are endowed with at birth.


No matter how tough it is, or how important our work, we have to take care of our children. That is why they have a father and a mother.

In the B.C. era, or during the Old Testament times, there was very little

divorce and quite a few people seemed to have several wives. When the men wanted to add someone new that was fine, but they always honoured the first wife.

She remained in charge of the household, no matter how many wives they added.

They did not dump or divorce them, nor their children, nor did the first wife run away. No, they braved the storms of life together.



Look at Jacob, who was later named Israel; he had four wives and 12 sons, the heads of the twelve tribes of Israel.

Gideon had many wives and 70 sons.

King David had many wives.

King Solomon might have gone overboard with 700 wives and 300 concubines. ¹

Definition of concubine: a woman who is not legally a wife, but lives with the man and she has a recognized position in his household. Usually the man would seek out a concubine to add extra spice to his life.

My client did not mind that about Solomon, as he enjoys seeing us happy.

What he did mind however, was that Solomon started worshipping the gods of his wives, while it was my client that had given him everything; the throne, wisdom and abundant wealth.

Yet Solomon turns around and starts thanking handmade idols of wood and stone for what my omnipotent, omniscient and omnipresent client had given him.

Well, that went down sideways with my client and as a result Solomon was the reason that his son caused the state of Israel to be broken into two parts ¹: Judah and Ephraim.

WHAT CHANGED IN THE CHRISTIAN ERA?

Paul wrote:

'Nevertheless, to avoid fornication*, let every man have his own wife, and let every woman have her own husband. . .

But I speak this by permission, and not of commandment.' ²

In other words Paul says, 'But I take the liberty to speak this and this is not the commandment of the Lord. This is my personal doctrine.'

We like Paul's personal doctrine as it is right in line with women equal rights and emancipation. So in our western society and culture we have built our marriages on Paul's personal interpretation. However Paul continues saying,

'unto the married <u>I command, yet not I, but the Lord</u>, Let not the wife depart from her husband: But and if she depart, let her remain unmarried or be reconciled to her husband: and let not the husband put away his wife'. ³

Here Paul says, 'Look, this is from the Lord and no longer me, you are not allowed to divorce, you have to take care of each other and the children.'
Jesus said,

'he that puts away his wife or divorces her and then marries another is committing adultery'* 4



Very clear words. However Jesus never said that you cannot add a second wife or a third. We added that in our cultural and moral, religious interpretation, building on Paul's personal doctrine.

Jesus himself had planned for <u>ten brides</u> ¹ on his wedding night, however only five made it. Of course he was metaphorically speaking in a parable, but all of Jesus' parables were based in reality and wholesome truths, and <u>there was nothing immoral</u> about them.

What we have done in our western, Christian culture is building on Paul's personal views and we threw out what Jesus had commanded. Hence we've ended up with a big mess on our hands of broken hearts, broken families and hurt feelings.

My question is, 'If you want a second wife and decide to stick with your first family and everyone is willing to deal with the fall-out, wouldn't that be better for all involved, especially the children?' I doubt very much if my client will have any objections.

On the positive maybe several wives will have an easier time to keep hubby in line.

Joanna, I am happy with the wife that I am blessed with, but I don't



think that I can confine my client and others to my personal morals and western standards. I'll give two examples and let you decide. Jesus said,

'by their fruit you shall know them' 2

Henry the eight lived in the Western culture and had two of his six wives beheaded, so he could marry the next one, and the next one, to try to get a male heir for the throne.

Then in the African culture, there was Nelson Mandela.

He was the son of his father's third wife Nosekeni.

His father had four wives and 13 children. Nelson admired his father, who was the wise chief of the Kwembu tribe.

Gadla H. Mphakanyiswa, 1880-1928



Little Nelson watched his father and copied his style of leadership and

was able to lead South Africa through an extremely volatile transition period.

Do you think that little Nelson would have respected his father, if his father had divorced Nosekeni for his next and fourth wife?

I doubt it and I think little Nelson might have ended up a confused young man with little, or no respect for his father, who died when Nelson was in his early teens.

In divorce, don't we need to take a more objective look from the <u>viewpoint of the children</u>, who are the main ones to be considered, and shouldn't we be <u>less quick to condemn</u> our Muslim kinfolk and others who practice polygamy?

In the <u>Indian culture</u> till less than a century ago, the Maharajas had quite a few wives.

It was quite common for them to have 12 to 18 wives.

Some had over a hundred wives along with hundreds of concubines. The <u>first wife</u> always remained the <u>honoured</u> one. She was the **Maharani** (the Great Queen) while the others were **Ranis**, or Queens.

For the rest I would say, 'Try to respect each other. Accept that men and women are different and give each other room to breathe.'

However when there is <u>DOMESTIC VIOLENCE</u> and bodily harm involved, then of course it becomes a different story. It says,

'Make no friendship with an angry man; don't go with a furious man.' 1
'a violent man entices' 2

Be careful for his enticing words and trying to smooth things over. You should invoke my client's help to get you out of that situation.

'you have delivered me from the violent man.' 3

Whatever you do, try to keep your children free from the resentment and bitterness that has built up between you and your partner. Let the children be children and don't burden them with adult problems.

One thing is definite concerning marriage; we need to come down to reality and be aware that <u>after the honeymoon comes laundry day</u>.



We need to come off the Hollywood-dream pedestal about marriages. Some people, when their marriage has a difficult time, have even committed suicide, because their dream marriage turned out not so rosy after all.

SUICIDE

If I remember correctly you also asked about suicide. All I can say is that I have never tried it, so I can only go by what I have learned from others.

Some people do it to spite or hurt others, but they end up hurting only themselves.

The late actor <u>Robin Williams</u> said, 'Suicide is a permanent solution to temporary problems.' But is it?



The following was told by Sandy Rogers who could not handle life anymore because of the difficulties and pain she faced.

One day she took her pistol and shot herself in the heart.

She committed suicide.

However, she encountered an interesting turn of events that after she had left her physical body, she communicated with a loving female being, who spoke with her.

Sandy explains, "There was this unconditional love. I was told, 'you can stay here or go back.

If you stay, you are going to have to go through everything that brought you to this point.'

I knew that I did not want to go through that again.

There is no way to escape that if you try to kill yourself and you succeed, then somehow you will have to go back and live your life from the beginning and you will have to go from the point where you killed yourself also, so you are not escaping.

In other words; life has its lessons and we just have to learn them, there is <u>no copping out</u>, <u>or we have to do it all over again until we learn</u>.

Joanna, this testimony along with her medical reports, convinced me that she was speaking the truth about suicide.

This makes me want to stay away as far as possible from the idea of suicide, or assisted suicide.

Although I love my life very much, I do not want to live my life again. I'd like to go on to the next grade to see what's new and there to learn.

We have been given this life and along with it we have received the strength to live it. Let's be brave and face life's challenges with a smile on our face."

"Thank you for clarifying this. I have one last question. May I, Your Honour, or am I taking too much time?"

"Go ahead, Joanna, we have the afternoon."

"Mr. N. Voy, how can you say that your client, or God, is love, while he told the so-called 'good' kings to <u>annihilate complete nations</u>, mothers and children included?"

"Joanna, I must say that seems like a very hard judgment on these people, but in order to explain that question I need to give you a quick overview of history.

Away with the rules, for tomorrow we die.

This was the case again shortly after the flood. Absolutely no law. Anarchy. Kill whoever you like.

It is the survival of the fittest, the strongest and most ruthless characters.

My client was concerned and realized how much mankind needed

laws. Although he tried to get people's attention, no one was even interested to listen to him.

Finally he found a true man with an honest heart, Abraham.

He told Abraham, 'Look, I will make of you a great nation because you love me.'

After his children had multiplied in Egypt he led them out. My client gave Abraham's children a set of laws to go by.

It was a beautiful masterpiece piece of art. My client made it special


and put a part of his glory between the two angels.

Others would <u>kill their firstborn son</u> and make of the skull an object that could tell the future.


It was total anarchy and without laws or morals, along with <u>human</u> <u>sacrifices</u>, people doing what their evil hearts inspired them to do.

He said, I hate this kind of filth and your sons and daughters are not to intermarry with them. I don't want this filth entering into the heart of the children of Abraham that I have chosen.


Actually I want you to totally wipe them out, because I know you guys

'Have you seen what Israel has done? She is gone up upon every high mountain and under every green tree, and there has she played the harlot. 3

You have made your beauty to be abhorred, and have opened your feet to everyone that passed by, and have multiplied your whoredoms.' 4

Yet he always said,

'Return and I will not be angry with you, for I am merciful' 5

He told them, 'Look, I am your husband and the minute that you come back to me, I will love you again.' My client is the utmost and ultimate in forgiveness and unconditional love. Unbelievable, to have that much love and forgiveness for a wife like that.

Many of the children of Israel stayed somewhat faithful to my client and for this he gifted them with smart brains and beautiful talents of art, music, science, mathematics and comedy.

You can see it, even recently, from Houdini to Arthur Rubenstein, from Albert Einstein to Steven Spielberg, from Chagall to George Gershwin to Harrison Ford, etc., etc.

However some of the big financiers and industrialists went over to the dark side and they have given bad reputation to the children of Israel.

CHAPTER 6

ISLAM



After coffee - "Mr. N. Voy, My name is Abdullah Mohammed Kassis, I am from Egypt and was chosen to attend the court hearing by the Ministry of Education.

There are many things that I agree with in your presentation, however there remain two fundamental and vital differences in our views of Allah or God.

First of all, why do you keep referring to the Almighty as your client, as the court case is finished?

You explaining that Allah or God is three in one, is considered blasphemy in my religion as Allah is one.

My last point is Allah has no sons and Jesus or Isa (Peace Be Upon Him) was a prophet and Mohammed (Peace Be Upon Him) was the last and final prophet. These erroneous doctrines should not be allowed as they lead people astray."

"Mr. Abdullah, as-salam alaykum. Thank you for bringing these points out, as they have been points of difference, so much so that wars have been fought over these points.

Let me explain, Mr. Abdullah, about me still saying 'my client' after the court case. During the case I realized how God seems much more relatable when I refer to him as my client.

Throughout the years, I have come to the realization that God desires a very personal, intimate friendship with each of us and I would like to portray this in any way possible and to show how dear a friend he is.

I thought that continuing to refer to God as 'my client' was somehow a help. If you prefer that I call him God or Almighty, I will gladly do so."

"Yes, thank you."

"I can see that you value the word of Prophet Mohammed (Peace Be Upon Him).

Mohammed (PBUH) grew up watching the flocks of his uncle. Later the Prophet used to go often



into the desert around Mecca. He learned from the quiet and stillness of the desert.

When the world was created by the 'Kalimatullah', or the Word of God, the Almighty hid a lot of secrets and parallels in nature for us to discover.

For instance, we have our <u>life's parallel in the caterpillar</u> transforming into a butterfly. Right now we are like the caterpillar that feeds of things around us. Our life seemingly ends as we enter into our chrysalis, resembling our coffin. It is hard for us, as caterpillars, to see beyond this point and to grasp, depending on the decisions we made in our life, that we will metamorphose either into a beautiful, pollinating angelic-butterfly or an ugly, destructive demon-moth.

'Look deep into nature and you will understand everything better.' 1

Three years ago I was speaking to a Muslim lady from Iran, who had married a Christian man. This had brought its share of difficulties. She also could not reconcile with the idea of God being one and yet three. She said that one day at the breakfast table she had a revelation and suddenly it was perfectly clear. It was right in front of her:

The egg!!!

The egg symbolizes Creation, New Life, Spring and Hope and other life-bringing, Godlike qualities for mankind.

She explained, 'When we see the egg, we see One Egg, just like we see God/ Allah as One.

He is not two or three eggs; no, God/Allah is one, absolutely singular and not plural.

Yet when we take a closer look at the egg, we see that the egg is in three parts: The egg-yolk in the centre, the egg-white surrounding the yolk under the shell, and finally the egg-shell, which we see.'



Muhammad

All three are completely different from each other in composition and substance, yet <u>with one of the three components missing the egg</u> would not be complete to bring forth life.



The <u>egg-yolk</u>, symbolizes God the Father in the centre, from whom life springs forth and he is hidden from our sight.

The <u>egg-white</u> with its nutritional value signifies the Holy Spirit who feeds us, and yet, is also hidden from us.

The <u>egg-shell</u> gives form to the egg and is visible to us as humans. The shell denotes Jesus as he is

the outward manifestation to mankind of God's hidden, life-bringing qualities. The shell has to be broken in order for us to have access to the egg, so Isa was broken, or crucified, for us to have access to God. Isa wanted to be broken out of love for us so we, like him, could be in direct Isa-Jesus communication with the overwhelming love of the Almighty.

Muhammad (Peace Be Upon Him) received the Quran in the beginning of the 7th century.

Isa (Jesus) is mentioned 25 times in the Quran. Muhammad (PBUH) is cited 4 times.

Isa is referred to as 'Ruh Allah', meaning the Soul or the Spirit of God.



He is also called 'Kalimatullah' – meaning the Word of God. He was born of the virgin Miriam (Mary), who is the only woman mentioned by name in the Quran.

So for my Muslim brothers and sisters, Jesus represents the Spirit and Word of God, who came into the world through supernatural birth.

It is clear from the Quran that the world was created by the Word of God. It is not important whether we see Isa, as the Son of God, the Soul of God, or the Word of God.

Is my word not me? If I give my word, I should keep it or I am a cheat. The Almighty keeps his word as,

'He is not a man that he should lie' 1

My spirit or my soul and my word is me, just like <u>your soul or spirit</u> <u>and your word is you</u>, thus Isa, the 'Ruh Allah' and the 'Kalimatullah', the <u>Soul or Spirit of God and the Word of God</u>, is <u>God</u>.

We know that Allah or God, who is almighty and can do anything, is also capable to come to earth in the form of a human being.

If this is possible, then God, who has infinite love for us and is most merciful and kind, came to earth in the form of Jesus to show us his love and the way of salvation.

At Eid al-Adha, or Bakr-Eid, the Festival of Sacrifice, we remember Ibrahim being willing to sacrifice his son out of obedience to God. On this day we sacrifice something



dear to us like the

goat that we have taken care of for months and that ate at our table and we treated like one of our household. Our whole family and especially our children feel the pain as the goat was like their friend and playmate.

As Ibrahim was willing to sacrifice his son, so Isa was willing to sacrifice Himself out of pure love for us and that we could experience salvation. The gift of his life for us was a great sacrifice, because of the pain that he suffered, yet he did it willingly out of love for us.

Once when I was very discouraged this thought struck me.

When I go to the market and want to buy something, then I make sure that what I buy has more value in my eyes then what I pay for it, otherwise I will not buy it.

Then I realized that Jesus bought me. He



bought me with his life and blood, which shows that in his eyes, you and I have greater value than the value he puts on himself.

This much love is beyond our human, limited, four-dimensional comprehension, but if we can and will reach out our hand to accept that underserved gift, it will break our heart and we will want to change forever.



Mr. Abdullah, I see much bloodshed coming in the Final Jihad in order to establish 'Sharia Law' worldwide.

As you and I know, the Madhi will gather the followers of Allah to do battle with the 'Masih ad-Dajjal' (False Messiah) and his forces of kafirs (non-believers) and mushriks (polytheists). ¹

We can see it crystallizing.

The western nations will oppose the 'Sharia Law' implementation and everyone from both sides will see it as their '<u>righteous duty</u>' to fight for or against till the death.

In the end when all is totally hopeless, dark, devastated and beyond repair, then God will show us his ultimate mercy again and Jesus will return. Jesus will unite the remains of mankind and there will be a peaceful government. ²

No more military might, recruitment and training. The weapons shall be burned and be made into farming equipment. Imagine how we can use that military budget for development. Jesus taught us that,

'Blessed are <u>the meek for they shall inherit the Earth</u>, and the <u>peace makers</u> for they shall be called the children of God.' ²

Mr. Abdullah, let us hope and pray that some will take these words of Isa to heart."

Mr. Abdullah is in deep thought and points to Mrs. Cohen indicating that it is her turn to ask her question.

CHAPTER 7

JUDAISM



"Mr. N. Voy, I am Mrs. Cohen, I had my question prepared, but I would rather follow up on what you just told Mr. Abdullah. Although I am Jewish I have very little knowledge of what is prophesied in the different religions. My question is: Will the future unfold as is written, and if so, is there any hope or a way to avert these calamities?"

"Thank you Mrs. Cohen, that question has very much intrigued me. I think my client has made an escape hatch for everyone that wants a way out of the world's sinking ship, which is corroded by corruption and selfishness. the helm, through greed and lust for power, passing it from one weak helmsman to another.

All making empty promises to lead our ship to safety, while leading us further and further astray, straight into looming, imminent calamity.



Towards the end a new captain will appear on board. He will be heralded as the 'Mashiach' or 'Messiah'.

With strong words, charisma, and so called 'scientific' miracles will he do away with my client's navigational map and in a short time span will he lead the ship to total destruction.

- Concerning his clothes: "Part my garments, cast lots upon my vesture." ¹ 'They crucified him, and parted his garments, casting lots'.²
- <u>Concerning his execution</u>: "They have pierced my hands and my feet" ³ This remarkable prophecy was given by king David, who

lived around 1000 B.C. Crucifixion was invented more than 600 years later by the Persians circa 350 B.C. Later it was 'perfected' by the Romans.

• Concerning his death and resurrection: "God will not leave his soul in the grave, neither will he suffer his Holy One to see corruption and decay". "in the third day he will raise us up" 5



The exact year of his death was predicted:

"After the sixty-two 'sevens', shall the Messiah be cut off, but not for himself." 7 62x7= 434 years after the rebuilding of Jerusalem in 405 B.C., which is 29 A.D., the year that Jesus died, as his birth was 4 B.C. (further explanation on pages 50-55 of *The Little Book*)

The results of sin and karma are very great, heavier than the sky; thicker than the earth. . . '

The old priest asked further, 'So what should we all do?'

The old priest asked, 'What will the characteristics of the Holy One be like?'

Nobody will be able to destroy you.






If you die, you will not come back to be born in this world again. You will go to the highest heaven."

From this we see that the Holy One has done away with the Samsāra, the endless wheel of suffering and rebirths, so this does away with the idea that they are all reincarnations of each other.

The Buddha who lived five centuries before Jesus came, explained <u>how to recognize this Holy One</u>, when he comes, by <u>three specific kinds of wounds</u>.

In the palm of his hands and in the flat of his feet will be the design of a disk, He was nailed to the cross with roman nails that had large heads, so the person could not get free, these left a disk shape in his hands and feet. "When he had scourged Jesus, he delivered him to be crucified.- They pierced my hands and my feet." 1
- 2. <u>In his side will be a stab wound</u>, John, one of the disciples of Jesus records the following: "one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water." ²





3. <u>His forehead will have many scars</u>. - The Gospel of Mark records: "And they . . twisted together a crown of thorns, and put it about his head... And they struck him on the head with a staff" ¹



Besides these three type of wounds of the Holy One, the Buddha gave us the following instructions in his prophecy - he said clearly,

- 'Quit the old way' "Jesus said unto them, I am the way the truth and the life." ²
- The Buddha says, 'a new spirit like the light will live in your heart' "Then Jesus spoke to them .. 'I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but has the light of life." 3
- You will be victorious over all your enemies. Nobody will be able to destroy you' "Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you."
- 'You will go to the highest heaven' "And I give unto them eternal life; I go to prepare a place for you . . that where I am, you may be also" 5

"Mr. N. Voy, the Buddha talks about the heaviness of sin and the result of sin being very great, **could you explain what sin is?**"

"Sandi, the Holy One, Jesus, said,

"A new commandment I give you that you love one another." 6

Hence, we sin when we are unloving towards others. When we chose selfishness and hurt others and when we put ourselves above others. His word teaches us that we,

A FASCINATING ARCHEOLOGICAL FIND Ronald Eldon Wyatt was an adventurer and former nurse anesthetist, who became an independent archeologist, with the intend to find historical proof for the Bible.

A condensed Report:

Ron's Arabian helper, James, crawled into the chamber first, but with a horrified look on his face, rapidly exited, never to return.

Ron then extended the entrance to this chamber and crawled in . The chamber was about 22 feet long by 12 feet wide at one end with a with a flat ceiling about 8 feet high . It was filled to within 18 inches of the ceiling with fist sized rocks. . . He crawled across rocks . . uncovered some dry

candlestick, the Golden Altar of Incense, and the Golden Censer which all still remain there today. He brought out a very large sword, numerous oil lamps, a brass shekel weight, a brass ring, an ephod, and <u>an</u> <u>ivory pomegranate</u>.

Any item Ron would find in the excavation he would turn over to the <u>Israel Antiquities Authority</u>.

Today in the Israel Museum Jerusalem, you can see the ivory pomegranate . .



It is said to be the only item ever found from Solomon's temple.

The Israeli government after examining artifacts brought from the chamber, has confirmed to its satisfaction that the Ark has indeed been found. However, to its credit, the government has been very careful with the release of information . . and not without reason;

Misfortunes that occurred because of the ark finding:

- 1. A young tourist who called a press conference to announce the find was found by the press corps dead from a gunshot to the back of the head.
- 2. A doctor of archeology from the Israeli university, as he attempted to enter the chamber became totally paralyzed in his back and legs.

Ron explains, "Dry blood is dead blood. It does not seem possible to get a chromosome count from dead blood. You can


get a DNA but not a chromosome count, that is done by white blood cells.

I took the blood to a reliable laboratory to be analyzed.


They said we are going to reconstitute it and put it in saline for 72 hours gently swirling it.

They put it under a microscope and then the person called others in. They were talking in Hebrew a mile a minute.

Then they looked at me and said, 'Mr. Wyatt <u>this</u> <u>human blood has only 24 chromosomes in it.</u>'

(23 chromosomes from his mother's side, plus the Y chromosome. So he had all the physical characteristics from the autosomes of his mother's side of the family. His maleness was determined by the Y chromosome, that came from the source of a not human male.)




