Paul tell us in Romans 2: Two things are presented here with respect to God; His judgment against evil-the evil-doer shall not escape (the real difference of right and wrong would be maintained by judgment); and His mercy, patience, and long-suffering with regard to the evil-doer-His goodness inviting him to repentance. He who continued in evil deceived himself by trying to forget the sure judgment of God and by despising His goodness. The consequences, both of a life opposed to God and to His truth on the one hand, and of the search after that which is pleasing to Him, and thereby for eternal life on the other, were suretribulation and anguish in the one case, in the other glory and honour; and that without more respect to the Jews than to the Gentiles. God judged things according to their true moral character, and according to the advantages which the guilty one had enjoyed. Those who had sinned without law should perish without law, and those who had sinned under the law should be judged according to the law, in the day when God should judge the secrets of the heart according to the gospel which Paul preached. This character of the judgment is very important. It is not the government of the world by an earthly and outward judgment, as the Jew understood it, but that of the individual according to God's knowledge of the heart. God also would have realities. The Gentile who fulfilled the law was better than a Jew who broke it. If he called himself a Jew and

acted ill (chap. 2:17), he only dishonored God, and caused His name to be blasphemed among the Gentiles whilst boasting in his privileges. He then enlarges to the point that God requires moral reality, and that a Gentile who did that which the law demanded was better worth than a Jew who disobeyed it, and that the real Jew was he who had the law in his heart, being circumcised also in the spirit, and not he who had only outward circumcision. This was a condition which God could praise, and not man only.

Chapter 2

"Understanding the Transition Christians"

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Transition Christians are people who come to know Christ later in life, in adulthood. These are people who may not have been raised in a Christian house hold and / or not familiar with the ways of church. I want to encourage people to understand this. Many people like myself have not been raised to walk in Gods light or been disciple in the true way and end up drifting away for lack of understanding. Some come from broken, corrupted dysfunctional families and life styles, even from happy loving families but without God. I want to encourage people who come to Christ later in life and to help the church to understand this. Transition Christians are not a new Phenomenon. In fact first century church began with them; Paul himself was a transition Christian. While some early converts grew up in the Jewish faith, those who were Gentiles did not, so there was a division between the people because both had to over come that which they came from and one felt superior over the other because they were given the oracles of God that was suppose to lead the others to God, but they failed to do so, that is what our Lord Jesus Christ came to do. He came to bring people together in unity to God to one people. Many long term Christians and teachers tend to forget this and are unaware of there haughtiness toward a new convert or fail to see how they are being seen by them, forgetting the baggage they carry with them. As for the transition Christian they must not see the church as the savior because the church is made up of imperfect human beings they need to understand to make Jesus Christ the center of your life, not the church. God said look to him and into that which is perfect (Jesus) seek and follow after him, his teachings, and his ways, seek and you will find ask and you will receive. True disciples of Jesus remain faithful to his teachings and will know the truth and the truth will set you free. John 8:31-32. Transition Christians carry a life time of conditioned baggage with them that must be dealt with, many long term Christians are unequipped to serve their needs because they have not walked the road they did or fail to remember that they use to, so it is very hard for them to be of a understanding heart and understand the battles they face. Jesus said in Mark 2:17, healthy people don't need doctors sick people do, he did not come to call the righteous but those who know they are sinners, and many misguided church

groups miss that point completely and form a click, a private club so to speak fearing anyone else outside their ways, fear of corrupting their balance, casting them out if they don't conform to their rituals and traditions, ultimately causing the new Christian to feel like an outsider, unable to fit in. The devil looks for that in people then goes to work convincing the unlearned unstable person that God doesn't want them and they fall back into the pit from where they came. The church must understand that while random acts of kindness are well and good but to the unbeliever or new Christian that's all it is to them, it dose not send the message of Christ that God loves them and wants them and that they are precious to him and that Jesus sacrificial death was for sinners not the righteous. Righteousness comes over time in coming to Christ through growing and developing spiritually. The church must never look down their noses in placing themselves above anyone else, to realize them of great value to the church because in them holds a treasure of experiences that can help someone else along the way, the body of Christ is made up of different parts to make the whole thing work together. No one is better then anyone else, I like the bumper sticker that reads "Christians aren't perfect, just forgiven" this is a realization that all must come to understand no matter how long you have been walking with God or how long you have not. Jesus died and rose again for ALL people and we must not let anyone or anything take that away from us. We must not let ourselves be blinded by human failures in the church, or close our eyes from someone who is not like you. For every Paul that walks into the church there must be a Barnabas to take him by the hand and encourage him and show him the true way of Christ in love and forgiveness with feelings of acceptance. We all must realize Christianity is about Christ and developing our relationship with God in being Christ-like. We must be careful in making the church the center of our life; while it is good for us to have fellowship with other believers for sharing and caring and up lifting but beware it can turn into a trap causing a person to live for the church and their ways rather then the true way of Christ. That's why there are so many denominations because someone stepped out side of Christ ways and made up their own ways demanding their way is better then the other, thus we have a division among the people, the devil will do all he can to divide the people and separate them from Christ. We must take responsibility for our own spiritual growth; by turning to the Lord rather then relying on humans, it is tempting and foolish to expect other people to take care of our spiritual needs, it can lead to disappointment, confusion, and a false misguided zeal that is really for the church rather then for God, and it is foolishness and haughtiness for anyone should think they can take on the role of being a savior and lord it over people. There is only one God and one teacher that can change a person and it is to him

we must turn to and live for. No one can make a person grow; no one can make a person read the Bible or pray that is in the capable hands of God through the power of the Holy Spirit into the willing heart, the one who longs to seek the truth, and live Gods will. This is what needs to be shown to the new Christian even the unbelievers to not how good and wonderful and holy you are but in showing them all Gods children are through forgiveness and his grace. They don't need to be lorded over in showing how sinful and bad they are. The long term Christian must see and understand things through the eyes of the new Christian or even the unbeliever, because they carry the guilt of slavery to the condition of life they lived, the devil will try and make sure they hold on to that guilt rendering low self worth, even holding on to suspicions of God through mistreatment of false churches and false Christians. In my experience I've come to understand that in the case of most people, it's not really that they don't believe in God but rather the source of those who represents him then stand at a distant of God because of false representation of him. I believe this to be the rapid decline of church attendants, when the sheep aren't being fed they tend to wonder off, word of mouth spreads quickly among non church goers, and the sad thing I see in the church group is if they see a fellow member not coming back no one ever goes to them and find out why or try and see how they can fix the wrong, they simply let them fall by the wayside, why this happens I feel that the attitude of self-righteous pride, guilt and lack of true Christ love that stops them. In my writings I don't mean to sound as if I'm dogging all church groups but being inspired through the Holy Spirit and through my life experiences I'm compelled to address this issue. I've witnessed the damage that false religion, false churches and false Christians have done to me as well as a vast many others, and we are warned to beware of this through out the writings in the New Testaments and made clear in the letters from Paul to Timothy and Titus and from the letters of James, Peter, 1John and Jude. Jesus said in Matt.7:15-16 beware false prophets disguised as harmless sheep. That's why I say seek God first, Matt. 6:33, through reading for yourselves the truth of God and his ways, and when you have come to understanding then you can arm yourselves in true discernment in the wisdom of Christ, learning to separate spiritualism from humanism, then enjoy a life of walking in a one on one relationship with your Lord and savior in Gods light, this I pray for all people.

Chapter 5

THE SINNER'S NEED FOR CHRIST

Man was originally endowed with noble powers and a well-balanced mind. He was perfect in his being, and in harmony with God. His thoughts were pure, his aims holy. But through disobedience his powers were perverted, and selfishness took the place of love. His nature became so weakened through transgression that it was impossible for him, in his own strength, to resist the power of evil. He was made captive by Satan, and would have remained so forever had not God specially interposed. It was the tempter's purpose to thwart the divine plan in man's creation, and fill the earth with woe and desolation. And he would point to all this evil as the result of God's work in creating man.

In his sinless state, man held joyful communion with Him "in whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge." But after his sin, he could no longer find joy in holiness, and he sought to hide from the presence of God. Such is still the condition of the un-renewed heart. It is not in harmony with God, and finds no joy in communion with him. The sinner could not be happy in God's presence; he would shrink from the companionship of holy beings. Could he be permitted to enter heaven, it would have no joy for him. The spirit of unselfish love that reigns there--every heart responding to the heart of Infinite Love--would touch no answering chord in his soul. His thoughts, his interests, his motives, would be alien to those that actuate the sinless dwellers there. He would be a discordant note in the melody of heaven. Heaven would be to him a place of torture; he would long to be hidden from him who is its light, and the center of its joy. It is no arbitrary decree on the part of God that excludes the wicked from heaven: they are shut out by their own unfitness for its companionship. The glory of God would be to them a consuming fire. They would welcome destruction, that they might be hidden from the face of him who died to redeem them.

It is impossible for us, of ourselves, to escape from the pit of sin in which we are sunken. Our hearts are evil, and we can-not change them. "Who can bring a clean thing out of an unclean?--Not one." "The carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be." Education, culture, the exercise of the will, human effort, all have their proper sphere, but here they are powerless. They may produce an outward correctness of behavior, but they can not change the heart; they can not purify the springs of life. There must be a power working from within, a new life from above, before men can be changed from sin to holiness. That power is Christ. His grace alone can quicken the lifeless faculties of the soul, and attract it to God, to holiness. The Saviour said, "Except a man be born from above," unless he shall receive a new heart, new desires, purposes, and motives, leading to a new life, "he can not see the kingdom of God." The idea that it is necessary only to develop the good that exists in man by nature, is a fatal deception. "The natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned." "Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again." Of Christ it is written, "In him was life, and the life was the light of men," the only "name under heaven, given among men, whereby we must be saved."

It is not enough to perceive the loving kindness of God, to see the benevolence, the fatherly tenderness, of his character. It is not enough to discern the wisdom and justice of his law, to see that it is founded upon the eternal principle of love. Paul the apostle saw all this when he exclaimed, "I consent unto the law, that it is good." "The law is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good." But he added, in the bitterness of his soul-anguish and despair, "I am carnal, sold under sin." He longed for the purity, the righteousness, to which in himself he was powerless to attain, and he cried out, "O wretched man that I am, who shall deliver me from this body of death?" Such is the cry that has gone up from burdened hearts in all lands and in all ages. To all, there is but one answer, "Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world."

Many are the figures by which the Spirit of God has sought to illustrate this truth, and make it plain to souls that long to be freed from the burden of guilt. When, after his sin in deceiving Esau, Jacob fled from his father's home, he was weighed down with a sense of guilt. Lonely and outcast as he was, separated from all that had made life dear, the one thought that above all others pressed upon his soul, was the fear that his sin had cut him off from God, that he was forsaken of Heaven. In sadness he lay down to rest on the bare earth, around him only the lonely hills, and above, the heavens bright with stars. As he slept, a strange light broke upon his vision; and lo, from the plain on which he lay, vast shadowy stairs seemed to lead upward to the very gates of heaven, and upon them angels of God were passing up and down; while from the glory above, the divine voice was heard in a message of comfort and hope. Thus was made known to Jacob that which met the need and longing of his soul, a Saviour. With joy and gratitude he saw revealed a way by which he, a sinner, could be restored to communion with God. The mystic ladder of his dream represented Jesus, the only medium of communication between God and man.

This is the same figure to which Christ referred in his conversation with Nathanael, when he said, "Ye shall see heaven open, and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of man." In the apostasy, man alienated himself from God; earth was cut off from heaven. Across the gulf that lay between, there could be no communion. But through Christ, earth is again linked with heaven. With his own merits, Christ has bridged the gulf which sin had made, so that the ministering angels can hold communion with man. Christ connects fallen man, in his weakness and helplessness, with the source of infinite power.

But in vain are men's dreams of progress, in vain all efforts for the uplifting of humanity, if they neglect the one source of hope and help for the fallen race. "Every good gift and every perfect gift" is from God. There is no true excellence of character apart from him. And the only way to God is Christ. He says, "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life: no man cometh unto the Father but by me."

The heart of God yearns over his earthly children with a love stronger than death. In giving up his Son, he has poured out to us all heaven in one gift. The Saviour's life and death and intercession, the ministry of angels, the pleading of the Spirit, the Father working above and through all, the unceasing interest of heavenly beings; all are enlisted in behalf of man's redemption.

O, let us contemplate the amazing sacrifice that has been made for us! Let us try to appreciate the labor and energy that heaven is expending to reclaim the lost, and bring them back to the Father's house. Motives stronger, and agencies more powerful, could never be brought into operation; the exceeding rewards for right-doing, the enjoyment of heaven, the society of the angels, the communion and love of God and his Son, the elevation and extension of all our powers throughout eternal ages; are these not mighty incentives and encouragements to urge us to give the heart's loving service to our Creator and Redeemer?

And, on the other hand, the judgments of God pronounced against sin, the inevitable retribution, the degradation of our character, and the final destruction, are presented in God's word to warn us against the service of Satan.

Shall we not regard the mercy of God? What more could he do? Let us place ourselves in right relation to him who has loved us with amazing love. Let us avail ourselves of the means provided for us that we may be transformed into his likeness, and be restored to fellowship with the ministering angels, to harmony and communion with the Father and the Son.

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Chapter 6

"The 'IF' Factor

I choose to call this "The 'I.F.' Factor" because we as humans have {includes me} this simple thing ofwhen we make a stake we always say 'if' I would have done this, or 'if' I would have said this, and so on. If truly means that we question our action or statement but when we do these action or statements In Faith we will see all that God is trying to tell and show us {in the Bible} we would actually see that the word 'I.F." really means 'IN FAITH" so 'if' we do things 'IN FAITH' how can they go wrong. As everybody knows God don't create junk and were not junk, just humans {brothers and sisters} trying to live 'IN FAITH' to our Father in Heaven, and in fact this 'L.I.F.E.' we have is a gift from God and we should be 'L'iving 'I'n 'F'aith 'E'ver. Observe that religious worship of God is no new invention. It has been around from the beginning of time; it is the good old way, (Genesis 4:4-7). The offerings of Cain and Abel were different. Cain showed a proud, unbelieving heart {this is humanism}. Therefore he and his offering were rejected. Abel came as a sinner, and according to God's appointment, by his sacrifice expressing humility, sincerity, and believing obedience. Thus, seeking the benefit of the new covenant of mercy, through the Promised Seed, his sacrifice was given 'IN FAITH' and that's why God accepted it. Because Abel's offering was 'IN FAITH', and Cain did not, this would make it a absolute proof that if we do things 'IN FAITH' we achieve more then, if we just say 'if' I would of, which really means that were not taking the proper steps to do thing the way God wants us to learn, along with the fact we are allowing evil to come in to our lives, {example, 'if I would have}, really means that we are questioning or own intentions, {I am always doing things wrong or I can't say things right or I can't do anything right, and so on}. Leading one to the evil sections we need not go. I remember a little statement my mother told me that really brought this to life, I was pounding a neal in the wall and every time I went to hit the neal I would hit my thumb and I got angry each time and said 'gd' and after too much of this, my mother {that she was} said this; 'Why not bless it instead of damming it and God will do that for you' and ya know what's interesting is the fact that she waswrite. When I started saying God Bless it every time I hit my thumb, I did not hit it anymore, which shows that 'IN FAITH' we can do anything with God on our side. On his side we must be'FAITHFUL' in appear and actions. If we are under the influence of the Spirit, we shall desire to have our lot among them, and to declare ourselves on their side; 'IN FAITH' and love we embrace the cause of Christ, he will receive, employ, and advances us. When the throne of Christ is set up in a soul, there is a great joy in that soul; and provision are made, not as here, for a few days, but for the whole life, and for eternity. Happy are those who wisely perceive it to be their duty and interest, to submit to the Savior Jesus Christ. Our hearts are searching for that

connection with God. All our secret sins are known to God, and we must seek forgiveness, as God knows the secrets of our hearts, therefore judge our words and actions carefully, as our troubles do not drive us from our duty to God, we should not suffer them to drive us from our comfort in God. Let us take care that prosperity and ease do not render us careless. The Spirit of prophecy had reference to those who suffered unto death, for the testimony of Christ. In fact us the poor sinner's pleas. None that belong to Christ shall be cast off, but every one of them shall be saved, and that forever. The mercy of God, purchased, promised, and constantly flowing forth, and offered to believers, does away every doubt arising from our sins; while we pray 'IN FAITH', Redeem us for your mercies' sake ol Lord. We cannot look for too little from the creature, and not too much from the Creator. We may have enough from God, if we pray for it 'IN FAITH'. All the wickedness of the world is owing to man's willfulness. People are not religious, because they will not be so. God is not the Author of their sin, he leaves them to the lusts of their own hearts, and the counsels of their own heads; if we do not well and the blame must be upon us. ye abound in this grace also.

1Timothy 1:4

Neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly edifying which is in faith: so do.

1Timothy2:7

Whereunto I am ordained a preacher, and an apostle, (I speak the truth in Christ, and lie not;) a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and verity.

1Timothy2:15

Notwithstanding she shall be saved in childbearing, if they continue in faith and charity and holiness with sobriety.

Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity.

"prayer"

As this truly dose illustrate that 'Humanly' we can not 'See the Invisible, nor Believe the Incredible nor Receive the Impossible,' because all we see is right in front of us a bunch of trees that are in the way not the fact that the trees really do make the forest.

So how can we believe in God if we have never seen, heard, touched, tasted, or smell Him? Humans have been carving out different types of 'Human Faith' since time began, with different types if 'Idles' and other such things. The Bible tells us about 'Human Faith' and why not to have or entertain it,

"15. Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in them." 1 John 2: 15-17, Deuteronomy 29:19-27, Job 17:8, Isaiah 29:15-16, 30:1-5, 31:1-2, Daniel 9:13, Matthew 11:21-24, Matthew 16:1-4

Which all basically speak of those who rely on themselves, things and others, or buildings for there faith.

Only because you are reborn in the Spirit and have received fruit of the Spirit which is faith.

"3. For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the measure of faith God has given you." Rom.12:3-21, Psalm 1:1-3, Isaiah 30:18, Jeremiah 17:7-10, 2 Peter 3:3-9, 15-18

God has given us enough spiritual faith to have anything manifest in our lives. The reason why most of what we prayed for in the past did not manifest in our lives is because we blocked or cursed our prayers by human faith, operating out of the physical, earthly realm in stead of using the God given Spiritual realm.

We used to ask God for some miracle in our lives. We then "believed" it, supposedly accepted it, closed our eyes and then we looked to see if God really performed that miracle. Is that spiritual faith? Did we really and honestly believe that God has performed that miracle? We can even go further and say: "Oh good, no worries, God will probably still do it overnight." The first thing in the morning when we woke up we checked to see if God really performed the miracle as He promised...Bam....cursed... We slipped in our spiritual faith for that slightest moment and we wondered why our miracle didn't manifest. That is not spiritual faith, but human faith that operates through sense knowledge.

Spiritual faith on the other hand...

"Who his own self bare our sins in His own body on the tree that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed."

1 Peter 2:24

"Now faith is the substance of what we hope for, the evidence of things not seen." Heb. 11:1

Do you want to walk in human faith that operates in the sense knowledge realm, or do you want to have and live in spiritual faith, knowing that all we hope for is certain?

I encourage you to leave your thoughts of 'human faith'...To true 'Spiritual Faith'!!

Chapter 8

"THROUGH THE EYES OF A CHILD"

True spiritual faith {seeing the invisible, believing the incredible, and receiving the impossible} in the same way a child see' things, in fact a child believes all you tell them, as well as see' things differently, any child in the world would see shapes in all things just ask them while watching clouds go by, or why they see this instead of what you see. You see a child will see, here, receive no evil until they are told by us {the adult tells them so}, in fact if you put two children together to play they will play, but if you tell one that the other is bad then you have changed the play to no playing or fighting then you have went against God's design of even what we are to be like. {Matthew:1:1-5} Here Jesus is speaking to us and about the children as we are the children of the Father in Heaven, for you see children are innocent and this is the way God wants us to be with Him and our brothers and sisters.

At the same time came the disciples unto Jesus, saying, Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?

And Jesus called a little child unto him, and set him in the midst of them,

And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven.

Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

And whoso shall receive one such little child in my name receiveth me.

We really can learn more from children then we think. That is what God is telling us when He says to come to Him like a child and that is how we know we have an inter child to raise and take care of so we can always, {seeing the invisible, believing the incredible, and receiving the impossible}, because it is just that simple and is made very clear in several places in the Bible, along with the fact that the Bible is just that, 'How to connect with God and live the life God intended for us,' and not the way we want our life to be. I believe one of the best examples of true 'Spiritual Faith' is found in Matthew where the woman is waiting for

Jesus to come walking down the street. She believed that if she could just touched His garment she would be healed,

Matthew 9:20-22

20. Just then a woman who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years came up behind him and touched the edge of His cloak. 21. She said to herself, "If I only touch His cloak, I will be healed. 22. Jesus turned and saw her. "Take heart, daughter,' He said, "Your faith has healed you." And the woman was healed from that moment.

This is truly deep 'Spiritual Faith' because it touches on this fact by <u>seeing the</u>
invisible, by believing the incredible, and receiving the impossible, this is what's
talked about in the Bible, because it shows that the woman believed that she would be healed,
'Jesus said, believe in me with your whole heart, mind, and soul' now. If we look at the woman
{above} we see that {1} see seen herself being healed, {2} She believed with all her Heart, Mind,
and Soul that she would be healed when she touched Jesus' garment, {3} Truly she know she
would be healed through Faith which is in fact {seeing the invisible, believing the incredible, and
receiving the impossible} I the book "The Power of Positive Thinking" Norman Vincent Peale
points out that the human mind, heart, and soul work together in unison as one in fact we can
look at how the bible explains, Paul tells us about it in "Life through the Spirit"

Romans 8:1-4

- 1. Therefore there is no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.
- 2. Because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death.
- 3. For what the law was powerless to do in that it was weakened by the sinful nature, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful man to be a sin offering. And so He condemned sin in sinful man,
- **4.** In order that the righteous requirements of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the sinful nature but according to the Spirit?

There are also other places in the Bible where it's pointed out that we are all deferent parts of the same body of Christ Jesus. Yes there are a lot of places in the Bible where you can find not only examples of Spiritual Faith but where we as humans have and do take life and God for grant. We as humans are all the time trying to fix and do things on our terms not on God's terms, and yes we Christians are also trying to help God to fix or do thing for us, just like Abraham and Sarah did when an Angel of the Lord came to them and told them there prayer would be answered and the Lord was to give them a son, but they knew that Sarah could not have children and she was too old so they went to their Egyptian maidservant Hagar and she had a son named Ishmael, {this is found in}

Genesis 15:1-4

1. After this, the word of the Lord came to Abram in a vision: "Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield, your very great reward." 2. But Abram said, "O Sovereign Lord, what can you give me since I remain childless and the one who will inherit my estate is Believer of Damascus?" 3. And Abram said, "You have given me no children; so a servant in my household will be my heir." 4. Then the word of the Lord came to him: "This man will not be your heir, but a son coming from your own body will be your heir."

Genesis 16:1-2

1. Now Sarai, Abram's wife, had borne no children. But she had an Egyptian maidservant named Hagar; 2. So she said to Abram, "The Lord has kept me from having children. Go, sleep with my maidservant; perhaps I can build a family through her." Abram agreed to what Sarai

This illustrates the form of humans {Christian or none Christian} attempt to do what they think is meant or god's will for us. But as we find in,

Genesis 21:1-3

1. Now the Lord was gracious to Sarah {Sarai} as He had said, and the Lord did for Sarah what He had promised. 2. Sarah became pregnant and bore a son to Abraham {Abram} in his old age, at the very time God had promised him. 3. Abraham gave the name Isaac to the son Sarah bore him.

The Lord kept what He had promised to Abraham and Sarah and she bore a son his name was Isaac. Are we starting to see the different between being patent in allowing God to guide our live', and not allowing ourselves to try to guide it for God. So the question is, "Can we take a lesson from all this?"

Chapter 9

What We Receive as a Result of Being "In Christ"

Repeatedly, the New Testament refers to Christians as being "in Christ" or "in him." This phrase, often tacked on two statements, is referring to our position in Christ-- a position we receive as a result of spiritual baptism into Christ.

Romans 6:1-11

1. Well then, should we keep on sinning so that God can show us more and more kindness and forgiveness?

2Of course not! Since we have died to sin, how can we continue to live in it?

- 3. Or have you forgotten that when we became Christians and were baptized to become one with Christ Jesus, we died with him?
- 4. For we died and were buried with Christ by baptism. And just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glorious power of the Father, now we also may live new lives.
 - 5. Since we have been united with him in his death, we will also be raised as he was.
- 6. Our old sinful selves were crucified with Christ so that sin might lose its power in our lives. We are no longer slaves to sin.
 - 7. For when we died with Christ we were set free from the power of sin.
 - 8. And since we died with Christ, we know we will also share his new life.
- 9. We are sure of this because Christ rose from the dead, and he will never die again. Death no longer has any power over him.

10He died once to defeat sin, and now he lives for the glory of God.

11, so you should consider yourselves dead to sin and able to live for the glory of God through Christ Jesus.

1Corinthians 12:13-31

For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether *we be* Jews or Gentiles, whether *we be* bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

For the body is not one member, but many.

If the foot shall say, because I am not the hand, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?

And if the ear shall say, because I am not the eye, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?

If the whole body were an eye, where was the hearing? If the whole were hearing, where were the smelling?

But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.

And if they were all one member, where were the body?

But now are they many members, yet but one body.

And the eye cannot say unto the hand, I have no need of thee: nor again the head to the feet, I have no need of you.

Nay, much more those members of the body, which seem to be more feeble, are necessary: And those *members* of the body, which we think to be less honorable, upon these we bestow more abundant honor; and our uncomely *parts* have more abundant comeliness.

For our comely *parts* have no need: but God hath tempered the body together, having given more abundant honor to that *part* which lacked:

That there should be no schism in the body; but *that* the members should have the same care one for another.

And whether one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; or one member is honored, all the members rejoice with it.

Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular.

And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after those miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues. *Are* all apostles? *Are* all prophets? *Are* all teachers? *Are* all workers of miracles? Have all the gifts of healing? Do all speak with tongues? Do all interpret? But covet earnestly the best gifts: and yet shew I unto you a more excellent way.

When considering the impact of the blessings promised in this connection, one must conclude that the doctrine of our standing in Christ is one of the most important in the New Testament. Passages

{What is promised?}

Romans 8:1

There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. Who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit?

God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth. {Freedom from condemnation}

Now we can see a new outlook on where we are headed in our life and where not to go if it is presented to us in any other way then God's word. Above is a list of three words used to describe the effects of our beliefs, but if you will look very closely to the fact that in two of the words CHRIST is on top and one has CHRIST on the bottom what this shows is that if we put CHRIST first in our live we will not fall into the wrong ways instead we will follow Him anywhere as He asked us to come in the one true light, and if we don't put CHRIST at the head of our lives we find as in the third word that we fallow the evil one and that will only lead us to total unrest for all eternity. Always remember that they may us God's word for their interest so always ask God if it's His word or theirs and trust God to give you the correct answer believe me He will. Paul, tell us in Titus.

The grace and salvation in the Bible by the gospel, is for all ranks and conditions of humanity / humans. They teach us to forsake sin, it teaches to make conscience of that which is good. We must look to God in Christ, as the object of our faith and worship. A gospel conversation must be a godly conversation. See our duty in a very few words; denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, living soberly, righteously, and godly, despite all snares, temptations, corrupt examples, ill usage, and what remains of sin, with all their hindrances. It teaches us to look for the splendors

of another life. But in the glorious emerging in Christ, the blessed hope of Christians will be complete: To bring us to holiness and happiness was to the end of Christ's death. Jesus Christ, that great brother and our Savior, who saves us from our sins, much less as Man alone. He loved us, and gave himself for us; and what can we do less than love and give up ourselves to him! Redemption from sin and sanctification of the nature go together, and make up the children of God, free from guilt and condemnation, and cleansed by the Holy Spirit. All Scriptures are invaluable. Here is what will supply for all parts of duty, and the right release of them. Let us inquire to whether our whole faith is placed upon that grace which saves the lost, pardons the guilty, and sanctifies the unclean, yes further we are removed from boasting of fancied good works, trusting in them, so that we glorify in Christ alone, the more zealous should we be to abound in real works that are good.

Paul tells us of a very important fact we need to remember always that: In the presence of such grace they ought to be ashamed of sin. Nor can there be a more remarkable testimony than is here found of reckoning on the faithfulness of God towards His people. The relationship does claim holiness: in holiness alone it is enjoyed; but it reposes on the faithfulness of God. The Corinthians were walking, as we know, badly. The apostle lets none of the evil pass; but still he declares that God was faithful and would confirm them to the end that they might be-not safe, but-blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ, and then proceeds to blame them, what a wonderful testimony!

Colossians 3:1-4

If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God.

Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.

As we have risen with Christ, we are to set their affections on things above, where Christ sits at the right hand of God, and not on things on the earth. The two could not go together. To look, to have one's motives, above and below at the same time is impossible. Be tempted by things, have to resist them, we may; but this is not to have them as our object. The reason for this is however found in our position: we are dead, and our life is hid with Christ in God. It does not say, "We must die." Man cannot do this by will: There's one last point to be made and that is the last word above "Antichrist" "so let's look at it as it is presented in the bible. As we believe it to be is the first beast clearly represents governmental power since he is based on the four beasts of Daniel 7 that represent four world empires. The interpretation of the fatal wound which the beast receives (and yet lives on) has been very controversial. The tower of Babel, the fall of Rome, and the Reformation have been among the interpretations. We believe that best interpretation is the

first coming of Christ. At that time Christ became King of Kings with all power in heaven and in earth. (Compare Daniel 2 and the Stone which shatters the image of world empires.) Nevertheless, although fatally wounded by Christ's coming, the beast of government continues to persecute God's people throughout the New Testament era (the 42 months).

The second beast is called the "false prophet" in Revelation 19:20 so it is clear that he represents false teaching in the church. Like the man of sin in 2 Thessalonians he supports his teachings with counterfeit miracles. He oppresses all who will not obey him. Since all the numbers in Revelation have symbolic value, the beast's number 666 is very likely intended to symbolize "Triple Failure." He is the man who always comes up short of seven, the number of God's completed work.

We would like to point out that there is more proof of the evil one in American history, 'The Indians have long believed that the evil one is as the vulture it scavenges around for lost souls and feast on them never hunting down it meal but taking only that which is left behind by others', all the time waiting for us to walk off the right path and there the evil one is waiting for us.

Revelation 19:20

And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

These are Paul's words and we bring them to you now to read aloud so that you might also here God's word and believe and understand of His word and the power of Jesus Christ and His resurrection and spirit of holiness as declared to us in the scriptures, as it says in the scriptures "Faith come by hearing" yes hearing the word of God so we read out loud so you too can hear the word of God, as you read

aloud you hear yourself better and start to feel what you are reading as in all things, as Paul tells us

2Thessalonians 2:2-4

Grace unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is meet, because that your faith growth exceedingly, and the charity of every one of you all toward each other abounded;

So that we ourselves glory in you in the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that ye endure:

By whom we have received grace and apostleship, for obedience to the faith among all nations, for his name:

Among whom are ye also the called of Jesus Christ:

To all that be in Rome, beloved of God, called to be saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.

First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for you all, that your faith is spoken of throughout the whole world.

For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of his Son, that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers;

Making request, if by any means now at length I might have a prosperous journey by the will of God to come unto you.

For I long to see you, that I may impart unto you some spiritual gift, to the end ye may be established; that is, that I may be comforted together with you by the mutual faith both of you and me.

Now I would not have you ignorant, brethren, that oftentimes I purposed to come unto you, (but was let hitherto,) that I might have some fruit among you also, even as among other Gentiles.

I am debtor both to the Greeks, and to the Barbarians; both to the wise, and to the unwise.

So, as much as in me is, I am ready to preach the gospel to you that are at Rome also.

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, the just shall live by faith.

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who

hold the truth in unrighteousness;

Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath showed it unto them. For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:

Are we really happy with our life's, are we headed in the right direction well just maybe this can help. Lets conceder for a moment that the Bible was written based on actual events {people who were there} and inspiration of God, so if what we accept and believe then we must see that the truth is there and there's no other way. In fact in reading the Bible we find that the disciple John trusted Jesus so much he forsake a successful fishing business that had access to the house of the high priest {Caiaphas} and two servants {remember John was a Jew} and we must remember that John risk his very life for Jesus as he was the only disciple to witness Jesus' crucifixion knowing the whole time he could be killed as a result of being there, in his enterer gospel he never mentions himself by name. We see John as on example of the love and trust, that is the same as we should have in Jesus and God our Father as well as in each other, we will tell you more on this a little later in the book. We have been guided to Wright these words for all that need the light for a better life of Faith, Love, Understanding, and healing as Jesus says, "Let the dead bury the dead and follow me". Which means let the past take care of itself and start your life anew {from the time we start following Jesus our lives are anew in Him}, as He is our Lord and Savory and will forgive us of our sins and guide us in the one true light of Faith, Love, Understanding and Healing {past, present and future} for we are saved by grace. As God created L.I.F.E. for one purpose only and that is to Living In Faith Ever with Him at the center point of our lives, in Genesis God said let' create man in our own likeness and image.

There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death. For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any men have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.

And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness. But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelled in you.

Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.

For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. Source: King James 1611

2Corinthians 5:17-21

Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold all things are become new.

And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;

To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.

true way to live, Jesus told us long ago "That a house divided against itself would fall". Which simply means that if we continue on this avenue our life or none of us will stand at the end days because we will be so confused that no one will know the truth about anything let alone Jesus.

And when the sun was up, they were scorched; and because they had no root, they withered away. And some fell among thorns; and the thorns sprung up, and choked them:

But other fell into good ground, and brought forth fruit, some a hundredfold, some sixtyfold, some thirtyfold.

Who hath ears to hear, let him hear?

And the disciples came, and said unto him, Why speaks thou unto them in parables? He answered and said unto them, because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it is not given.

Then he called for a light, and sprang in, and came trembling, and fell down before Paul and Silas, and brought them out, and said, Sirs what must I do to be saved?

Some Christian children ask me what happens when we die! And if we don't believe in Jesus where do we go? We are reminded of the story Jesus told of "The Rich an and Lazarus" Well there is a lot said on this subject and it seems that most of us are of the thought that we either go to Heaven or hell well we hope that this will help us to understand and that is when we die we go to a place of Rest or a place of Torment {called Hades} where there is a Great Chasm, is defined as an Abyss, Gulf, Gorge, Ravine, split and opening. Jesus is telling the parable of the Rich man and Lazarus which show a place of waiting until the end of time, let's go there now.

<u>Matthew 8:10-13</u>

When Jesus heard it, he marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.

And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven.

But the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

As we read we also see that the Rich Man was talking to Abraham from across the {Chasm, Gulf} and Abraham told him that neither could cross and why.

Chapter 11

We are, "<u>AMBASSADORS of Christ Jesus</u>," we are to reach all people and all nations and teach each other like brothers and sisters of the coming of the Lord and the good news of His salvation through the death and resurrection, that through all we've gone through in this life is nothing compared to the wonderful and peaceful eternity will have with Jesus our brother, and to tell of the forgiveness and the love, understanding, and all the things God wants us to be for Him through His Son Jesus Christ. As John the Baptist told of the coming of Jesus now must we must tell of the second coming of Jesus but also like John we must tell of the repentance, excepting Jesus in to our hearts, and being baptized in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost, to study His word and to live like our brother Jesus did. Even Joel in the Old Testament has pointed to the need for repentance and the giving of your whole heart to God.

... we should not care about our own life' or material things here on earth, the most important thing is, that we love our brothers and sisters, that we teach them to do the same and to live on 'The other Side of Life' this is the work that the Lord Jesus gave us—to tell all people in all nations of the Good News about the Kingdom of God and that we are saved by grace. He loved us so much that He gave His only begotten Son so that we might be saved not only from our sins but from ourselves as well not only God's Good News but our own lives, too. Be ready at all times to answer anyone who asks you to explain the hope, love and understanding you have within you, and do it with gentleness and respect. Whatever a person is like, we try to find common ground with him or her so that he or she will let us tell them about Christ and let Christ save them. We do this to get the Good News to them and also for the blessing that we our self receive when we see them come to Christ. People who do not believe are living all around you and might say you are doing wrong. So live such good lives that they will see the good things you do and will give glory to God... Whatever you do, always work at it with all your heart, as you are working for the Lord and not for people. Remember that the Lord will give you as a reward the inheritance he has kept for his people. For Christ is the real Master we serve!

So that by the effort of our continued communication with our Father and our thoughts we may achieve the understanding this that no one can give us, but that we must reach for ourselves, together as brothers and sisters, for it is ours {all of ours}, and as Jesus has told us, it shall remain forever...Many generations have passed; countless material and cultural achievements have been attained as a result of the efforts of those, and these generations. Yet with all these achievements, we should know that we suffer {as all generations past, present, and future} under the same weaknesses and we have the same inner limitations as the people of Jesus' time suffered and limited themselves with...

Rom 1: 19-21

Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another.

For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any men have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.

And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.

But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the

dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.

Today, we and our society have much greater evidence, many more resources and much greater faith when we make decisions, and thus our responsibility is greater...As we should know that the evil that some of us hope will disappear upon Jesus' return, that only when we

ourselves are able to rid ourselves of the evil together as brothers and sisters and live as Jesus did in the one true light of God our Father with the love and understanding that we need.

I have written unto you, fathers, because ye have known him that is from the beginning. I have written unto you, young men, because ye are strong, and the word of God abideth in you, and ye have overcome the wicked one.

Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any men love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

But, beloved, remember ye the words which were spoken before of the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ:

how that they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts.

These be they who separate themselves, sensual, having not the Spirit.

But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost, Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. And of some have compassion, making a difference:

And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh. Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy,

Brothers and sisters, we know that we should treasure and study all these parables that were recorded in the scriptures, for each is a verse of that solemn poem that was Jesus' earthly life. We must stop wasting time in disputes over doctrines, principles, and views ...and go instead to the substance, of that which truly is the truth.

2Tim 2:23-26,

Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are his. And, Let every one that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity.

But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honour, and some to dishonour.

If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, and prepared unto every good work.

Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes.

And the servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient,

In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to

All we must do is listen closely with all our senses and pay due attention to its voice...but be aware that freedom entails the supreme responsibility of effort and faithfulness in seeking, each day, the right direction and in walking, each day, the distance that is given us to walk...

And Moses verily was faithful in all his house, as a servant, for a testimony of those things which were to be spoken after;

For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end; Source: King James 1611

And laziness is one of the enemies that must be conquered along that path. It is cunning and seductive, and we must meet it and conquer it, just as we meet and conquer the temptations that we face every day, the temptations to do evil. And to do this we must use our will and our conviction of faith so that it is right to act in this way, for it is to our own benefit to do so...And the ignorance, we must also conquer, and to conquer it, much effort and much sacrifice is needed. Ignorance is the harmful thing that holds us back and makes us stumble, and laziness is its best ally, for to conquer ignorance, we must perform the hard internal labor of instructing ourselves.

1 Thess 4:1, 17

Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and exhort you by the Lord Jesus, that as ye have received of us how ye ought to walk and to please God, so ye would abound more and more.

For ye know what commandments we gave you by the Lord Jesus.

For this is the will of God, even your sanctification, that ye should abstain from fornication: That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honour; Not in the lust of concupiscence, even as the Gentiles which know not God:

That no man go beyond and defraud his brother in any matter: because that the Lord is the avenger of all such, as we also have forewarned you and testified.

God hath not called us unto uncleanness, but unto holiness.

He therefore that despiseth, despiseth not man, but God, who hath also given unto us his holy Spirit. But as touching brotherly love ye need not that I write unto you: for ye yourselves are taught of God to love one another.

And indeed ye do it toward all the brethren which are in all Macedonia: but we beseech you, brethren, that ye increase more and more;

And that ye study to be quiet, and to do your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you;

That ye may walk honestly toward them that are without, and that ye may have lack of nothing. But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope.

For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.

For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.

For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

Thus we must be persistent and be constant, and the knowledge that we attain will provide us with the correct direction, the direction that we need in order to free ourselves from all the obstacles we will encounter on our path, for we must know that knowledge is the ally of love, and faith these are the tools that we shall need...they are our greatest allies in our daily pilgrimage.

Chapter 12

Long ago, with His life Jesus gave many examples of how we should live our lives and the struggles we would face. We would point out that Jesus had to struggle against those same enemies, and as He conquered them, so we can also conquer them through Him. Jesus or our Father would not give us any obstacles to overcome that He did not have, and we will have no pain or grief to suffer that He did not also have.

1 Pet 2:21-25

For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men: As free, and not using your liberty for a cloke of maliciousness, but as the servants of God.

Honour all men. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honour the king.

Servants, be subject to your masters with all fear; not only to the good and gentle, but also to the froward. For this is thankworthy, if a man for conscience toward God endure grief, suffering wrongfully.

For what glory is it, if, when ye be buffeted for your faults, ye shall take it patiently? but if, when ye do well, and suffer for it, ye take it patiently, this is acceptable with God.

For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps:

Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth:

Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously:

Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

For ye were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls.

1John 2:5-8

But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in

He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked.

Brethren, I write no new commandment unto you, but an old commandment which ye had from the beginning. The old commandment is the word which ye have heard from the beginning.

Again, a new commandment I write unto you, which thing is true in him and in you: because the darkness is past, and the true light now shineth.

For the gifts and calling of God are without repentance.

For as ye in times past have not believed God, yet have now obtained mercy through their unbelief:

O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! how unsearchable are his judgments, and his ways past finding out!

And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.

For as we have many members in one body, and all members have not the same office:
So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another.
Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of faith;

We must understand many things, and one of the most important is the importance of humility...By being humble we guarantee our greatness. Don't make ourselves great, and we shall be made great, Don't make ourselves wise and we shall be recognized as wise, Don't praise ourselves and we shall be praised.

<u>James 4:6-10</u>

But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.

Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.

Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and your joy to heaviness. Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.

Meekness is generous in just that way, and it is in the generosity that virtues offered to the brothers and sisters of the world that cultivate them where their virtue lays. There is no definitive list of virtues, but as I read from the Word of God {Bible} we find these virtues to be the constant of all Jesus tells us:

Titus 2:1-15

But speak thou the things which become sound doctrine:

That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in charity, in patience.

The aged women likewise, that they be in behavior as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given too much wine, teachers of good things;

That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children, To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.

Young men likewise exhort to be sober minded.

In all things showing thyself a pattern of good works: in doctrine showing uncorruptness, gravity, sincerity,

Sound speech, that cannot be condemned; that he that is of the contrary part may be ashamed, having no evil thing to say of you.

Exhort servants to be obedient unto their own masters, and to please them well in all things; not answering again;

Not purloining, but showing all good fidelity; that they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior in all things.

For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world; Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Savior Jesus Christ;

Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

These things speak, and exhort, and rebuke with all authority. Let no man despise thee. Source: King James 1611

<u>3:1-9</u>

Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work,

To speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, but gentle, showing all meekness unto all men. For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another.

But after that the kindness and love of God our Savior toward man appeared, Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior;

That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. This is a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, that they which have believed in God might be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable unto men.

But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and vain.

<u>Humility</u>

It is courage that gets us through, it is Justice that makes us right, it is Mercy that allows forgiveness, it is Generosity that allows us to help others, it is Faith that keeps us on the right path, it is Hope that gives us Strength, and it is Humility that leads us to ourselves as it is truth, and Faith that enriches the spirit and strengthens it. Cultivate the virtues greatly, for they ensure our prompt arrival at that destiny that waits for us. Paul tells us that these virtues are powerful allies...

1Tim 3:1-14

This is a true saying, If a man desire the office of a bishop, he desireth a good work.

A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behavior, given to hospitality, apt to teach;

Not given to wine, no striker, not greedy of filthy lucre; but patient, not a brawler, not covetous;

One that ruleth well his own house, having his children in subjection with all gravity;

(For if a man knows not how to rule his own house, how shall he take care of the church of God?)

Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he falls into the condemnation of the devil. Moreover he must have a good report of them which is without; lest he falls into reproach and the snare of the devil.

Likewise must the deacons be grave, not doubletongued, not given too much wine, not greedy of filthy lucre;

Holding the mystery of the faith in a pure conscience.

And let these also first be proved; then let them use the office of a deacon, being found blameless.

Even so must their wives be grave, not slanderers, sober, faithful in all things.

Let the deacons be the husbands of one wife, ruling their children and their own houses well.

For they that have used the office of a deacon well purchase to themselves a good degree, and great boldness in the faith which is in Christ Jesus.

These things write I unto them, hoping to come unto thee shortly: Source: King James 1611

Rom 5:3-5

Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; And patience, experience; and experience, hope:

And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.

For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.

For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die.

But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.

Source: King James 1611

But we should always be prepared to meet the dangers entailed by the unconsciousness of our own virtue, and never allow our ego to tempt us to pride ourselves on our own influence ... We must identify the ego as well, and always be alerted to its impulses and prepared to counter them, for it is supremely educated and its cunning tricks can make us fall into ordinariness. My brothers and sisters, we need to understand that the way to have more is to desire less. It is that simple... Constant desire is the cause of pointless anguish, and we should convince our self's that we would attain inner peace and harmony when we identify and appreciate that which we already have which is truly enough, those things that we already possess, materially we must come to understand the difference between ambition and the commendable need to prosper, for ambition is dictated by the ego while the need to prosper is the best of one's self.

James 1: 2-14

My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into diver's temptations;
Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience.
But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.
If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed.

For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord.

A double minded man is unstable in all his ways.

Let the brother of low degree rejoice in that he is exalted:

But the rich, in that he is made low: because as the flower of the grass he shall pass away. For the sun is no sooner risen with a burning heat, but it withereth the grass, and the flower thereof falleth, and the grace of the fashion of it perisheth: so also shall the rich man fade away in his ways. Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him.

Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man:

But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed. Source: King James 1611

Ambition constantly longs for the much easy, and rapid, while the need to prosper longs for improvement in moderation, no matter the time it takes or the effort that is needed or the risks that present themselves in obtaining this improvement.

Long ago Jesus commanded that we love one another, yet many of us still do not obey that commandment. It is, we who look at our brothers and sisters with suspicion, resentment, and animosity that we know we have baggage filled with excuses for being the way that we are: Have we been disillusioned, robbed, and victimized in countless ways. And with those reasons we justify ourselves when we do the same to our brothers and sisters...But when we act in that way we show our ignorance, we show how repressed within the depths of our heart we are instead of the seed of love which we were born with...and that is both the sin and its own repayment...But it is through the commandment to loving one's brothers and sisters that we shall wipe clean the sin the unhappiness and bitterness that always accompanies it... Jesus has told us not to strike back against the wrongdoer: if someone strikes you on your right cheek, you should offer him the left one also. Turning the other cheek to the person who strikes us means much more than words are able to show...

Matt 5:38-39

Ye have heard that it hath been said, An eye for an eye, and a tooth for a tooth: But I say unto you, That ye resist not evil: but whosoever shall smite thee on thy right cheek, turn to him the other also.

Source: King James 1611

It is control over our emotions, control over our instincts, yes it is to be human in its maximum expression, it is to disarm the aggressor without ourselves becoming the aggressors; it is to grow through adversity by not allowing the aggressor or that adversity to take control of us and thereby strip us of the most noble aspect of our being, and we must understand, that it is another step to take on that path chosen by us...But that does not mean that we should stand with

our arms crossed in the face of the dishonorable acts of other persons that we meet along our way. Remember Jesus' attitude when He met the money changers in the temple...He expelled them with all the severity that they deserved...

Micah 3:11

And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts.

Source: King James 1611

Matt 21:12-13

And Jesus went into the temple of God, and cast out all them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves,

And said unto them, It is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves.

We should know that from time to time we will have to use the authority required by the occasion and take the right action, and in doing that, our faith, belief, integrity and our intelligence must be our guide. We should also understand that we have to just remind ourselves of the fact that everybody is born with the seed of love planted in their hearts and we should not allow our mind to repress it, to keep it from growing. In fact you could say that we are born with an inner child and we must nurture and cultivate our inner child to raise him or her properly for this seed is our most precious inheritance that comes directly from our Father in Heaven. If we nurture it and cultivate it with passion and devotion it will help us open our perceptions wide enough to understand the miracle that is ourselves, to unlock the secrets that lie hidden in our own heart? We are the miracle of miracles...And when we understand this truth we will realize how blessed we really are from our Father in Heaven. The good works that Jesus performed long ago were necessary so that the people of His time and of all times would believe; they guaranteed His place in all generations, guaranteed that His gifts would endure as part of all memoirs forever, brothers and sisters, we are surrounded by miracles on each and every side of our lives; it is the very short sidedness of us that cause us to perceive them as everyday, common things...Yet if we could just open our eyes and our hearts we could see, {for how can we see without looking or how can we feel without touching}, so brothers and sisters lets truly open our eyes and hearts and look around us and marvel at the creation that we are a part of. Enjoy the divine feast to which we all have been invited, as this is one of the ways to honor our Father, Jesus tells us how not to be, if you say it and believe it follow your path don't be like these brothers and sisters and think you can bluff your way through.

Matt 15:8-9

This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart is far from me.

But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men. Source: King James 1611

We must work every day to open our eyes and hearts ever wider, to become more and more aware of our own existence and appreciate it more and more. As we see in today's world all we seem to be is destructive and we are in the process of destroying ourselves completely. Yet in all this we can still find the courage, faith, and love to get through it all, because we know that through Jesus Christ our lives will be better and peaceful no matter what happen around us or to

I Rev. Samuel Mack have come to give witness to you of His infinite love and to show you the way to become in touch of that love, so that you might give it to Him and our fellow brothers and sisters in return, for their happiness and our own...I had cancer this year and let me tell you that I had my fears cause they told me it was in stage 3 but I had to be brave for myself and my wife and family. I felt different like an outcast even though everybody was good and treated me nice, but I just felt different, not like them anymore. Then come the miracle of it all was when I woke up one morning after 4 weeks of radiation treatments and the voice told me you've done good Sam now it's time to stop and finish healing and I did. Let me tell you that just a few weeks before Christmas I had some blood test done and they reviled I have no sign of cancer in my body so far and we will know more when the rest of the test are done in June 2010 because I have to wait till all the kimo is out of my system before I can have any other scans for cancer. I thank our Lord Jesus and our Father in Heaven every day for this, and I would like to tell you that this is the prayer I prayed while I was in treatments,

Jesus has redeemed me from the curse of the law; Jesus has redeemed me from poverty; Jesus has redeemed me from sickness; Jesus has redeemed me from spiritual death;

We should always remember that medicine and our father in Heaven work together to help heal us so <u>please don't stop taking any medicine for any reason</u> unless your doctor tells you to). Also let me point to this little fact that if we,

Confess victory in the face of apparent defeat Confess abundance in the face of apparent lack

With this we have reached a mil stone in our lives and relationships not only with or Father and ourselves and with our brothers and sisters as well. I believe that we reach this because while all this was going on, I thought of the story of Joseph and Job and all the trials and troubles he went through from his teen year until he was 30 years {13 years in fact} we are shown here that God has a divine plan and purpose with our lives each and every one of us as it also teaches us a proper way to look, be like and hold our total attention and communication with God no matter what happens in our lives good or bad,

Genesis 37:1-36

And Jacob dwelt in the land wherein his father was a stranger, in the land of Canaan.

These are the generations of Jacob. Joseph, being seventeen years old, was feeding the flock with his brethren; and the lad was with the sons of Bilhah, and with the sons of Zilpah, his father's wives: and Joseph brought unto his father their evil report.

Now Israel loved Joseph more than all his children, because he was the son of his old age: and he made him a coat of many colours.

And when his brethren saw that their father loved him more than all his brethren, they hated him, and could not speak peaceably unto him.

And Joseph dreamed a dream, and he told it his brethren: and they hated him yet the more. And he said unto them, Hear, I pray you, this dream which I have dreamed:

For, behold, we were binding sheaves in the field, and, lo, my sheaf arose, and also stood upright; and, behold, your sheaves stood round about, and made obeisance to my sheaf.

And his brethren said to him, Shalt thou indeed reign over us? or shalt thou indeed have dominion over us? And they hated him yet the more for his dreams, and for his words.

And he dreamed yet another dream, and told it his brethren, and said, Behold, I have dreamed a dream more; and, behold, the sun and the moon and the eleven stars made obeisance to me.

Just think if we had 7 brothers and they did this to us would we be able to handle it in the same was? Or would we cave and loss or faith and connection with God! Well God wants us to be like Him and to handle it in the way Joseph did above, as I have thought long and hard of Job and all he had to go through.

It is apparent to me that Joseph and Job did not sin or charge God with any foolishness for their miss haps weather good or bad and that is what I was suffering was no greater then they suffered. As our Father in Heaven will not give us any more then we can handle, as this is an example of what we do to ourselves basted on our own actions, I was not going to let it get to me. Let me give you another example, if we were blind or deaf, how would our perception of our life be then, would we see our self as lonely, lost, alone or even forgotten, or would we see a brave new world to look in and to enjoy, being different is not bad it just means our perception of things would be different and in some sense better because it heightens our other senses, as our Father wants to heighten our senses to help us to see the truth that we are and that which is around us. We have had plenty of opportunities to witness the wonderful version of the Calvary walked by our Lord. I know that many of us have been profoundly moved by the visions of the punishment inflicted on Jesus and the blood running down His head form the crown of thorns...We have fell His pain, and experienced shame and anger at the dishonor of what He was subjected too. Many of us have wept and grieved by the horror of what we read and hear. Taking the story that up to now we have known only through words and today to take them same words and make them fully illustrative, which allowed us to share that Calvary with Jesus, and the greatest benefit, we can draw from that experience is that the over whelming faith that there is no pain that does not bring renewal...Jesus' sacrifice led to His resurrection, and with His sacrifice and resurrection, our Father in Heaven has increased our potential, sealed it forever... Today we know that if the physical pain was a heavy burden to our Lord, much more burdensome is that pain caused by the evil that we ourselves create, and sin that ignorance bring about, and still causes, in many brothers and sisters. Yet With His pain there also came His joy, and the devotion and compassion shown to Him by so many souls of yesterday and today has been and still is His greatest joy...My brothers and sisters, Jesus gave His life for us, and we can recover it...It is us, The virtuous and compassion, which are His greatest hope and His greatest delight. But we must know, as He knows,

That it is us who have the greatest need to help our brothers and sisters—and it is sinners, shameful and ignorant brothers and sisters who have the greatest need of Jesus and of virtue and compassion. And that those who are fruitful of heart, those who follow Jesus and love Him should be guides to the blind, deaf and teachers of the ignorant and of the shameful,

And in that day shall the deaf hear the words of the book, and the eyes of the blind shall see out of obscurity, and out of darkness.

That does not make us a bad people, but it does delay that which we must achieve, our growth is a mission that we cannot and must not shirk; for that we were born and for that we were given life, and that is law and at the same time the greatest grace that we have Received...And that knowledge is part of the truth that we so long to know and for which so many kind and generous souls have given their lives...

Chapter 13

Today we know that the commitment to help one's fellow brothers and sisters to understand and become aware of the reason for their existence, to value the best use of each second of their and our life's, is as blessed and worthy of all love and respect as Jesus' sacrifice for us all. May the emotions experienced by us in that communion that we partake with our brothers and sisters, in the body of Jesus and is a pillar for that commitment to grow in faith, love and understanding. May Jesus' punishment serve as a curb against the abuses that we ourselves may someday commit...May our outrage become the ability to consolidate principles and maintain the good judgment and honesty that should govern all our actions...May our love and faith, arise from His sacrifice. For our greatest challenge lies in the willingness to confront and deal with anything that comes in life, with constancy and love. Doing His will, will bring us the pleasure and the joy, which is the grace that we grant ourselves as all of this is part of the Fathers-creation that the miracle is our existence shall achieve, and at the same time, it is in our participation with your

Father in his great Work that we will find the purpose and energy necessary to go on, with joy and hope and Faith and with the certainty that each day we will be better, and that the future will be better too...Finally, we will rid ourselves forever of all fear and doubt...And we will smile at adversity, though our faces may be covered with tears. The chosen ones are all those who are willing to walk the path of life with the same devotion and the same love that Jesus walked it with, that devotion and love that so many kind souls have walked and given witness to. Remember that Jesus told us that any person who eats of His flesh, {remember that in doing so we must be like Jesus and have no sin in our hearts}, and drinks of His blood, {remember this is the added conviction of love and faith we have}, should have life eternal,

For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, that the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed took bread:

We must sharpen our senses; understand the parables of His words. To eat of His flesh and drink of His blood means to live with the same willingness and sacrifices that Jesus embraced; it means to accept our mission, as He had accepted His; it means to love our fellow brothers and sisters as He has and will always love them, and as He still loves all of us. But remember His words: Jesus said, My yoke is not heavy, and my burden is light, and that is true because the treasure that we will obtain is so immensely wonderful that in the end we will realize that all the effort was worthwhile, that meeting and overcoming all those changes that we have met with on the path of life was worthwhile...And that is to know the Father and love Him but it is also to begin to unlock the mystery of the parables that was His life. In order to truly know what that mission is. That Jesus had just spoken to us about, we must closely examine our heart and see what our true feeling is, what it is that truly motivates, and gives us pleasure. If we do this with honesty and follow that inclination with integrity and determination, He will ensure our inner gratification and bring added happiness to our lives. Pray over what He has told us. That is the only way that we will be able to enter through that narrow gate and walk that rugged road that He has been speaking of to us...the road that leads to our salvation.....

Jesus told long ago that the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth...

John 4:22-24

Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews. But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.

God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

<u>Living In Faith Ever</u> after all He created us. This is the only worship that yields fruit; it is the way in which the Father shall be honored...

Love life and we will be, loving Him; love our fellow brothers and sisters and we will be, loving Him...What we love and honor is what we know and is beneficial to us. For all time even unto the end our Father has been revealing Himself to us, and it was for that reason that Jesus was sent, for that reason He is speaking to us now, so that we may know Him and love Him and honor Him...Blessed are the fertile of heart that strive to understand His words. Jesus would have us know that His happiness lies in us; Jesus would have us understand that the universe is the visible fruit of that infinite love that creates everything at every moment; Jesus would have us know that everything around us is a creation that is renewing itself, by itself, at every moment. When we understand that the creation is the constant and ongoing work of the Father, we will be able to feel His constant presence and will be part of Jesus' and our Fathers own happiness as our vision of the universe and ourselves expands. We know that the material creation is vast, and that in it there is always some new secret to unlock, some new world to conquer. Know, then, too, that our inner universe is just that vast, and however much we get to know it, there will always be something new to discover, something new to conquer...Life, even after death, is an eternal challenge, and therein lays its richness and magnificence. we would feel delight, we think we know that we are as deep as we are capable of diving, as perfect as we are capable of becoming...there are no limits...

Everything we are able to dream, everything we are able to imagine, is within the realm of our possibilities, but first there are laws which must be obeyed, and goals to achieve. For just as God is generous, His ways are wise and straight. Now we are the sheep in Jesus' flock, those of us who keep our hearts clean. Jesus knows that we lovingly and devotedly cultivate the seed of love and Faith that we were born with, that our works are good, and that we walk on the path of righteousness. We are His joy and His hope, and He asks us to also be the shepherds of those sheep who become lost. Jesus tells us that the greatest responsibility of those persons who have cleansed their hearts is to aid those who have not yet done so, those who have held back...

2 Cor. 2:14-17

Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place.

do and the fields are filled with these lost sheep calling out for consolation and direction...The work is hard but our reward shall be the ability to ever more rapidly approach the source of love, to take delight in the blessed honey that only the prophets and His chosen ones are allowed to taste.

and faith that is planted in us by the Father and from that moment we were born can never be killed...The evil one will be able to deceive us, and he will be able to employ all sorts of tricks, we will be able to deny our own humanity and commit the worst of crimes. But we should know that although we are always going to have to pay the price of those acts, to suffer the consequences, we always are going to have the fount of love waiting for us, with the precious grace of forgiveness... And it will be then, in our repentance, when our tears will come forth like a torrent, when we finally understand the magnitude of our wrongdoing and realize the waste we have made of our lives love and faith...Listen, then and make our path straight...There is still time; Jesus and every fiber of our being encourage us. And those of us who look with mistrust upon our brothers and sisters who do not share our beliefs, and even come to see them as our enemies, Jesus tells us that we should always be alert to the temptation to judge our fellow brothers and sisters. Long ago Jesus told us that as we judge, so shall we be judged, and that its fruit knows the tree, He has also told us that there are as many paths as there are brothers and sisters among us, and that none among you can claim a monopoly on truth...Pray on the content of His words, and we will understand that just as the creation is immeasurably rich in its apparent mixture, so is it magnificent in the options that it gives us in achieving that for which we were born. It is that attainment through which we become participants, with our Father, in the miracle that we truly are, growing in love, faith and grace ... Re-creating ourselves through our clean actions and the realization and the reason for our own existence...When we understand this, our vision will grow and the opinion that we have of our brothers and sisters will be corrected...Value the fruits of those other good trees, {brothers and sisters} that grow in such abundance in our fields, {life}. Their roots are not planted in the same fertile, {life} soil as ours, but that the source of the abundance that we enjoy is the same source, {life} that has fertilized the soil where all those trees, {brothers and sisters} that give good fruit are planted...Working in this way for the Fathers glory. Know that just as we should not judge our brothers and sisters for their beliefs, we also should not judge any of our peers....

Chapter 14

We now know much more about the complexity of our minds and how the circumstances of life can affect us and change us in countless ways. Each of us has a personal history that makes us unique in our preferences, judgments, and beliefs, and although our similarities are much greater than we can ever imagine—for they are rooted in our exact essence—Creation itself, through our physical, emotional, and intellectual variety, mirrors the wondrous variety with which it manifests itself in all other ways, and this variety among us is, in turn, a confirmation and result of the free will that we were born with...It is in that complexity and that personal history that often makes it impossible for us to understand the deep springs of our own behavior—imagine, then, how much more difficult it is to understand the behavior of our brothers and sisters. To those of us whose carnal preference makes us feel different, those of us that social and cultural pressure makes us feel shunned and stripped of our dignity, yes Jesus loves us and bless' us with all His heart, and what your Father truly cares about the way we act

in our heart, whether we are able to rise above our bodies and achieve the spiritual communication with our Father Like that should be the fruit and guide of our relationship, and it should feather a relationship between us and God as that of the relationship of us with our mother or father, brother or sister and that of a friend as in any family member and with the same we act respect and honesty with our brothers and sisters, and with our peers—and that is what's called an intimate relationship with our Father in Heaven {for how can we love another until we love ourselves) as God is in us and around us we must see Him in ourselves as in our brothers and sisters so if we don't love ourselves we don't love God for God made us so let's do his will, and that's what counts, and it is what will allow us to hold our heads high no matter how we may be blamed? And reproached, no matter how much, certain sectors of society try to strip us of our dignity. And to those of us who take upon ourselves the role of moralists and insist on seeing certain types of behavior, certain preferences in those around us as changes and faults, and our actions are a representation of our self, understand that the fact that other people are different from us does not make them better or worse...As Jesus has told you, until we cast the log out of our own eye; we will not be able to see clearly enough to cast out the spec of our brother's eye. Sex is the supreme instrument of reproduction and our Father bless' those who make use of it in that way within the bonds of marriage. That true respect and mutual understanding that should exist between a couple and that is at the same time the solid pillar on which the structure of the family, and all of society, rests—this respect and understanding fully flowers within the fundamental and inspirational commitment of matrimony. Yet for those among us who makes use of sex to satisfy our needs and calm our passions, and yet Jesus say, for all men and women experience a moment when reproduction is not possible, let there not be condemnation by one of us against another, Neither ordinary casting of guilt, nor false pretense, for purity is demonstrated only through compassion and love, not recrimination. Let there be, rather, genuine commitment in each of us so that the most inspirational sentiments of our inner self may come forth and flower and be the complement of our lives, so that it is not just our physical needs that are satisfied, But at the same time those needs that exist in the most profound depths of our hearts....Look to be sure that each of us is a witness and governor of our self, so that in our behavior there is no trace of oddness. It is in dissipation, offensiveness, and meanness of spirit that true oddness lies....If our preferences lead us, through the exercise of the freewill with which we were born, to take part in marriage, so that free from demands, you may solidify your relationship with harmony, love and faith in each other as husband and wife...We must never allow sex to be imposed on or demanded of an innocent, for among all the types of victimization, that is the most dishonorable and aberrant, and divine justice is always vigilant, and shall be ruthless with the transgressor. We must look in our heart to be sure that our dignity is not stained by our actions and that does not cloud our vision of a union of emotions and mutual respect that leads us to value one another and complement one another, in both joy and sorrow, physically and spiritually, for we should make proper use of our time; do not waste it miserably in pointless blame casting and reproach...Be sure that if something arouses resentment in us, it is victimization...If something embarrasses us; it is our own weaknesses...If we have contempt for something, and it is our own banality... Do not be judges even of our selves Instead, be witnesses of our Lord and our Father in Heaven, and in this way we are more able to govern ourselves, and let compassion and love be our guides, and be sure that our words are always filled with consolation, hope, and guidance for our brothers and sisters,... Those who began the divine mission to be the people chosen by our Father to reveal Himself to humankind...Even though some of us did not recognize Him yesterday and do not recognize Him today, He is that

part of that divine mission and that His message was and continues to be of hope, faith and love for both us and all of our brothers and sisters of the world...And Jesus said long ago He did not come to change the Law or its commandments, for they are a sacred legacy given to us by our Father. He came instead to announce to us a new era and to announce to all the people of the world, and all the generations, that salvation comes through knowledge of the one true God, that God who chose us for his revelation and glory. today He's talking to those of us who are so busy with ourselves in keeping up appearances, the hypocrites whose actions have been objective only of feeding the ego and obtaining the riches of this world, those who use the temple for their own ends, those who exist today as they existed yesterday,

Jews and non-Jews...

To you Jesus preached in the synagogues, He made your blind See, your crippled walk, He cured your sick, and His words were and are a Comfort and hope for the humble and poor ...

These were His works, and all were done for love and to the glory of the Father who sent Jesus...He knows that we remain faithful to His Laws and His traditions; He knows all our pains and sufferings, our persecutions and the genocide of which we have been victims; He knows how much we have suffered and are still suffering, Jesus knows this because His tears have been our tears, He has suffered the same pains. And He knows that it is not easy for us to understand the reason for so much adversity...There is no human reason capable of explaining it or justifying it...To be able to understand, we should think long about the wisdom that dwells in our hearts. We know that these adversities have strengthened our character, but we should not allow that to be a reason to harden our hearts. It is in our hearts that our greatest treasure resides, and our greatest heritage. If we keep our hearts open, we could die a thousand times of pain, but Jesus said, that a thousand times too, we will be resurrected through the power of love...As a brothers and sisters, we should rejoice for having been chosen for this wondrous mission, and as an individual we should understand that although that mission has been and still is a heavy, painful burden for all our lineage, that should not be a reason for hatred or spite, but rather an incentive to develop our faculties and potentials. Brothers and sisters, we should pay close attention to all Jesus' words and allow our heart and our intelligence, deep within our selves, the opportunity to reflect on them. All of Jesus' words were and are spoken out of love and faith, and all that He asks is that they be given the attention and discernment that they merit. Grant Him, and grant ourselves, that opportunity, and to all of us, He said that the era and the kingdom that He announced began when, through His works and His words, He made possible the dawn of our faith and our conviction in the existence of that one for which He came to bear witness...our Father in Heaven, the only true God, is all love, but because He is love and also with infinite wisdom, He has been strict in his ways...The tragic events that history records, and those that constantly occur as the product of our ways, must occur as they do so that humankind can learn the proper use of the free wills that it enjoys, and so that it may rectify its path as everything will become revealed to us, as we grow more able to develop our own awareness and as we grow more able to act always rightly. Be always aware of this: it will aid us in our divine mission to constantly re-create our selves, for our own happiness and good fortune. There have been and still are many who commit atrocities in the name of God, Who in the shadows of the night plot ghastly plans of death and murder and Shield himself behind His Holy name. Those, too, shall be

known by their Fruits, which are fruits of death and desolation....They misuse the divine privilege of freewill with which they were endowed, and use that freedom of action to introduce pain and suffering and desolation among their fellow men and women...They nourish themselves on hatred and with their demagoguery they distort reality. They are the anti-Christ of which the scriptures speak, for they are judged with the severity that their own actions demand...God is life, and life can never be honored with death. Thus those who have committed and are now committing those crimes, Jesus ask that we listen to His words and correct ourselves, as the whole Bible is about getting to know our selves and God the Father this process in long and hard, {for if we don't know who we are, how can we know our brothers and sisters? and if we don't love our selves, how can we love our brothers and sisters? if we can't see ourselves how can we see our brothers and sisters? if we can't hear our selves, how can we hear our brothers and sisters?} The same goes for God the Father for if we do not know our selves, how know we expect to truly know Him or anything? And in doing so, we will meet divine justice, {that is the divine justice Adam and Eve meet when God put them out of the garden of Eden}, which is strict and powerful, though it can also be generous and kind. We who have been and are still victims; and those who suffered, and are still suffering from the immorality, of them anti-Christ's, stay firm, He has told us in His word and it still applies today, and there are those who have hunger and thirst for justice, for their hunger and thirst shall be full up...Amen. Something important that we should understand is that just as all creation constantly renews itself and transforms itself, so has the Father's relationship to us changed and renewed through time. In the early times of His revelation, it was necessary that He use His power, so that through fear those peoples whose ignorance and rebelliousness was rampant might begin to find the straighter path That was the need for the Flood, the Plagues, Sodom and Gomorrah, and the desolation that the wars of those times caused; that was necessity for the announcements of disasters made by the Prophets of all times, their calls for honoring the one true God...The use of punishment and the promise of salvation were important tools in the divine process of revelation...The eternal fires of hell, the prophesies of disasters, and strict laws to govern human behavior were necessary because of the widespread barbarism, slavery, and use of force and violence that prevailed in the ancient world...Jesus' mission was to fulfill the law and establish a new covenant with God based on our knowledge of His infinite love and on the harmony and love that we brothers and sisters should share with one another. He came to put an end to the fear and idolatry worship, the foolishness and double standards ... If we love one another, we will do unto our brothers and sisters as we would have our brothers and sisters do unto us. In that commandment we can then come together in all the other commandments; in that commandment lies the key to salvation...It will be when all of us applies it in our lives, {all the world 'all peoples and all Nations}, that all of those outbreaks of violence and atrocity that still, and most unfortunately, persist in our modern world will end. And Jesus called Himself the Son of Man because within Him He carried our needs and within Him our hopes flowered; and with His works He conquered the master of this world and within Him the helpless among us find consolation.

Chapter 15

Jesus is our most brilliant light and He is the path that we will follow. He called myself the Son of Man because He was a man of flesh, and He called Himself the Son of God because through His surrender, His works, and His sacrifice He came to save us from ourselves, and as He did so it was that we might understand that we ourselves shall be able to call ourselves the sons and daughters {children} of God as He did, when we have come to see this...Jesus told us "I am the Way, the Truth and the Life. No one goes to the Father unless it is through me"...Today, friends, Jesus have told us this message trough out time. Understand His words: "I am the way", the way of love, for everything He did and said was inspired by love and it is through love that we can get to our Father in Heaven." I am the truth" for all He said is true and only illuminated by the truth we will be able to walk the path to Him, getting over all the difficulties we may encounter," I am the life" for only living and armed with love and truth as it

is that we will be able to arrive to the final blessings with His divine presence. Our possibilities are infinite, the essence of our spirit is the same as He who created all things, and thus it is for His glory and His alone and we must understand we must rejoice Him that give it, for wonderful is our potential...Also we must understand that our earthly life is the bridge that we must cross in order to come to the enjoyment of the peaceful dwelling that awaits us it will be then that the full revelation will be complete: our Fathers revelation to us, and our revelation to ourselves... At last we will know the full greatness of our own potential and our own powers, but know that we will also discover other bridges to cross, for eternity is an infinite sequence of challenges, achievements, and goals to conquer, and therein lies its magnificence, therein consists the wonder of that eternal dwelling that awaits you, so that we may have an idea of what we will obtain if we remain firm in the path of light, the path that Jesus has spoken to us of so long ago, but we must always remember, too, that the true achievements are those that are reached through proper growth and proper re-creation of ourselves. It is a personal task and no one can do it for us...Today we are capable of forging in our sense of right and wrong, without view or threat, without fear and without adoration, based only on the FAITH that He is, and based on the knowledge that we have acquire gradually, day by day, and the full understanding of the reason for creation and the reason for everything that constantly occurs around us. This is a new stage in that new era that we announced to our selves. so that we will understand that the true worship of the Father is worship performed constantly in our hearts, in private and in secret, that is through our good actions that we will come to be worthy of developing the potential with which we were born, come to the enjoyment of the powers that we will obtain through this process...We need to understand as well that in this new stage of the revelation conditions now existing that make it possible and the convergence of all the many forms in which human thought has perceived its own divine nature, has perceived and known the one true God. Today we possess the instruments needed to bring together the noblest, most proper, and most inspiring achievements that humanity has been treasuring up through the many messengers of love that the Father has sent us and to unite those achievements in that supreme faith that we as brothers and sisters of Christ, Jesus are proclaiming, the faith, actions, commitment and flexibility of all those great masters made them worthy to unlock the most hidden secrets, which they had the faithful courage to proclaim openly on many occasions, even at the risk of losing their own lives...

Today we have the opportune now to tell our brothers and sisters of what we have learned, and history is filled with prophets, and each of us, now has the potential to become a prophet, too, and through the love, faith and abnegation of our actions to feel that infinite joy which, through their surrender, the martyrs also felt.

Today, we wish to give Jesus' words to you as a witness not just of the Father but also of ourselves, so that we will react, to urge ourselves to strive to fulfill the noblest and most genuine responsibilities that we have to ourselves and our brothers and sisters, to make the best use of the time that has been given us, we must urge ourselves to awaken our understanding and absorb Jesus' teachings; He came to show us the inexhaustible fountain of wisdom and love that dwells within our hearts...Find ourselves and value ourselves through the identification, and with the inspiration that exists within each and every one of us, and the peace and joy that we yearn for will come to us as a natural fountain ... Jesus' words and the words of other teachers that have lived and that will live in the future, are and will be a light that will guide us in that sacred

achievement that is crossing the bridge. And His words must also be a source of the energy needed to achieve that goal. But we must keep our ears and eyes open in order to overcome the obstacles and remain on the right path. We must have the conviction of faith that although we might stumble a thousand times, stray from the path a thousand times, { as we are human and are and will make mistakes, and do sins but } likewise a thousand times will that light give us the strength and faith we need to get up and find the right path again. And the creation of that supreme personal belief that we have proclaimed to ourselves consist in our faith and in the compendium that we ourselves are able to make of the inspirational beliefs and principles that the experiences of our lives have enabled us to develop and make part of our awareness. We will begin to identify these beliefs if we keep our minds open, sharpen our senses, and persevere in that task...Therefore, it is very important that we also identify our weaknesses, and that we be able to control our mind and our emotions. Life constantly presents us with situations that test the control we have over ourselves, yet those situations are at the same time valuable opportunities, for through the process of our decisions and actions we may come to identify both the strengths and the weak areas in our mind that we must work on in order to strengthen our character...so that we will be able to make our life a masterpiece and at the same time enjoy it for the marvelous adventure that it truly is. The satisfaction that we so dearly long for can be found through an appreciation of the wonders that surround us and the wonder that is our own life and our own being. And that strength of character is the thing that will never allow our emotions to dominate us, even in the most critical moments. We will be able to remain firm even when all around us are baffled and confused and out of control. Even when others cast false blame upon us...We will be able to remain firm when others mistrust us, for the truth we know about ourselves will be our strongest shield...As it will give us the lucidity we need to understand the behavior of others and to grow in the forgiveness and patience that understanding brings us...We will be able to remain firm even when we feel that everything around us is crumbling, that everything we have achieved is lost, for we shall have sufficient vision to understand that what is truly important in our lives cannot be destroyed by anyone or anything...And we will have sufficient strength to begin again, regardless of the risk or the effort required to reconstruct all that has crumbled, to regain all that has been lost... we will develop the virtue of being genuine, and of not being overcome by the glory of triumph when we triumph, not being depressed by the grief of failure when we fail... And that same truthfulness shall be our best introduction to others...We know all about these and now that we can see for ourselves the importance of the personal qualities that we must identify, develops, and value in ourselves as the essential elements in the formation of that supreme faith that Jesus has proclaimed to us...It is much more than doctrines, teachings and moneys; it is being without fault in all aspects of our personality and all our actions, combined with the firm commitment to grow in knowledge, faith and love of all creation, including ourselves...for to know that in the degree to which we are able to be grateful for our own life lies the key to achieving the growth of that love that we must profess for ourselves and our brothers and sisters, a love without selfishness or vanity, the same love that we must extend to all. Fellow brothers and sisters, and the world that what will bring to us all that we yearn for. It is through the exercise of faithlessness that we will be able to acquire the firmness that we need so that the opinions and actions of others will not be a cause for suffering or anguish in your spirit. Be always aware that the best guide will always be within our grasp, in the most inspiring part of our being. know that the words and actions of our fellow brothers and sisters are always determined by their limitations and their own perceptions of reality, and that the human mind generally twists those

perceptions to the benefit of the ego and the interests and desires of each of us... That is why it is so important that we keep our intelligence always awake, so that in each situation that presents itself, we are able to identify its true cause and thereby make the proper decisions... Remember Jesus' attitude when everyone around Him, struck Him, spat on Him, and cursed Him. We should know that although His pain and grief was infinite, His firmness was unshakable, for He possessed the faith, and it was their ignorance that motivated them, and thus His patience could be infinite as well, as His forgiveness, And His plea to the Father that He, too, forgive them...

Chapter 16

The full understanding of the factors that determine the actions of our fellow brothers and sisters will be another of our most important allies in achieving knowledge of the way our own mind functions and the measures we should take to control it and make maximum use of it...Our mind, our thoughts, is the magnificent instruments that make it possible for us to re-create. Us to put too much effort in reading treasured books, in listening to inspired sermons and wise speeches, but all that is not remotely enough...You must explore deep into that infinite inner universe, for it is only through proper reflection and self-analysis that we will be able to free our self from that false dependency that we cultivate for the outward things of the world...What we should cultivate is the constancy of exploring into the inward purpose and filling it with the awareness of the true our True Fathers words and that each of us is. When we do this, we will begin to obtain wisdom through our own life's experiences, and it will be then that we truly reap

the profit of those books, those sermons, and those speeches... For ourselves...And know that the paradise that we yearn for is within us, waiting to be discovered. All the outward things of the world, from our own body to the most distant star, has been created only to make possible our revelation to our one true Father, so that we may achieve the certainty of our own spirituality, and know also that all creation constantly conspires toward that end. All the events of our life's, all those situations that we call coincidences, all those contacts that we have had with our fellow brothers and sisters since we were born, every tear spilled and every moment of laughter is an essential part of that grand and solemn peace from within? Let all who have ears understand Jesus' words. If we do understand them, we will realize that the suffering or misfortune that we may be experiencing today, the problems or tragedies that arise in our livessome of those are the products of our own actions and others of the divine order of creation, and we to have the certainty that so it is, in one way or another, with all of us... Never feel singled out by life, for life neither privileges anyone nor is unforgiving to anyone. Remember that it is not possible to know with certainty what is happening in our brothers and sisters lives or what other persons are experiencing, and we all know this, so that we may grow and may achieve the inner peace that always accompanies that growth. We must also put aside all those pointless deliberations about whether life after death exists or not, and what it is like if it does. With the works that Jesus performed He proved the veracity of His words and of the eternal alliance between the one true God and ourselves, He conquered death on several occasions in order to give witness of the supreme power of our Father in Heaven, and today the only thing that truly concerns us is whether we have life and what we do with it before we die...For then physical death will become that which it truly is, just a word, for with the certainty of our own immortality we will manage to drive away the fear and mystery that has always accompanied death. And the only way to become fully aware of that immortality is by entering fully into repentances and acceptance of our Lord Jesus as our personal Saver, for that present is already life eternal that's planted in us and all we have to do is realize it for ourselves, and it is when we keep our mind alert and when we totally discard our past that we will perceive the present in all its fullness. We should understand that we should not allow the events of the past, no matter what they have been, to be a cause for suffering or distraction or anguish within us. It is on our present that we should concentrate; that is the key that will give us the proper perspective so that we may overcome all the obstacles that arise from day to day...And this is the key to that success that awaits us. All the things that Jesus has spoken about should help us to expand our vision. He has told us, and we should know that there are no limits; the only limits that bind us are those we impose on ourselves through ignorance and our own weaknesses. We should always remember that, it is through the formation of the personal faith that He proclaim to us yesterday and today that we will be able to expand our own possibilities. It will be us who have the supreme responsibility for guiding and directing ourselves, and supervising ourselves. understand that Christianity down through history have played a prominent role in helping to guide the paths of nations in a more spiritual direction, by spreading and encouraging knowledge of the scriptures and other various spiritual legacies of our Father's Words. There have been and still are many good souls within those faiths, whose dedication and praiseworthy labor have earned them the right to be called apostles of truth, but we know that some others have taken advantage of them, and are today still taking advantage of them, to achieve base personal objectives. They are Pharisees today as there were in the past; they are the wolves in sheep's clothing that Jesus told us of in the gospels. Friends, to the degree we mature our personal belief we will be safe from the teeth of those wolves. No one will ever be able to manipulate us, and at the same time we

ourselves will be an example to others, an achievement that which we will attain through the faultlessness of our actions every day and every hour. It is that faultlessness that will not allow us to go on issuing every sort of opinion on every sort of topic, as we have been doing up to now. Concentrate once and for all on what is truly profitable and meritorious...Focus on the positive and we will put an end to foolishness forever. We must also put an end to the sense of guilt and culpability, just as we must put an end to everything thoughtless that arises in our minds. We know that when we feel guilty we hat ourselves...And hatred is the most negative thing that we can cultivate. Its force is destructive, and it diminishes the best of our selves. So let's accept our responsibility when we sin, when we choose what is not right, but reflect honestly on the reason for that straying. That is the way to add firmness to our character. Understand, too, that just as we should be the best, indeed only, supervisors of ourselves, so we should be forbearing with ourselves. That behavior is only fair, and it is a behavior that will make our inner harmony flower-that inner harmony that is the foundation and at the same time product of that personal conviction of faith that we must create through our own life experiences, and cultivate charity; it is the virtue that will bring forth the sweetest fruits. Sharing, giving is the dwelling place of those white doves that shall be our guide through that infinite inner creation that is the most authentic essence of our selves. Understand that it is through giving to our fellow brothers and sisters the things that we possess, {of our selves, moneys, love and understanding}, that we will become wealthier, for by fulfilling their needs we will be fulfilling our own and will ensure ourselves more abundance, both materially and spiritually...And perceive our oneness with our Father in Heaven; know that everything that happens in one way or another affects us, just as everything that we do affects our relationship with our Father in Heaven. That is also the reason for the importance of always retaining with capacity for positive perception. If we are predisposed to the negative, everything will appear negative to us. That attitude is a negation of life and its wonders, and also limits and frustrates the very reason for our existence. Understand that one of the greatest responsibilities that God has assigned to us is to constantly communicate with our Father, ourselves and with the life that we are a part of, and that responsibility cannot be avoided; it makes the difference between delighting in the pleasures that love and faith provides to the person who cultivates it and suffering the consequences that follow upon negativism and disharmony...Understand also that life is not a constant battle, as many say it is. That perception is the direct result of not accepting the mission that has been assigned to us, It is true that sometimes we will have to struggle, but it does not have to be against life; the battles that must be fought should be fought to conquer ourselves, to beat back the opportunism our own minds sometimes impose on us as an alternative to our actions, so that we can easily and quickly obtain the spiritual things we yearn for...Friends, it is in the daily dealing with our material life, our desires and ambitions, our weaknesses and greatness's, our frustrations and achievements, that little by little we shape ourselves, and that is the importance of fulfilling that responsibility with which we were born with, the responsibility to communicate with our Father in Heaven, our self, to be aware of it, and the profit that awaits us when we faithfully fulfill it is the stimulus that will help us to achieve the rightness that should characterize all our actions, both toward ourselves and toward our fellow brothers and sisters... We know that many times we ask ourselves how it is possible for God to allow hunger, sickness, misfortune, and death, especially the death of children, as has always happened and will continue to happen in the world...Friends, we know that those misfortunes, as regrettable as they may be, are an integral part of the necessary process by which life makes it possible for us to grow and develop toward awareness of our own identity and our identity with our father. We must understand that many of those things that we call

misfortunes are the result of decisions and actions that we ourselves make, using the freewill that we enjoy; we know that death itself is part of that process that is life. It is ourselves, who, through our perceptions, call it abominable, Fearsome, and regrettable. But what is truly abominable, fearsome, and regrettable is the fact that some of us has caused, and continue to cause, Death to others...And there can be no divine interference to eliminate all that, For the same reasons that nothing and no one can grant us what we can only acquire through the faith that we accumulate through our constant communication with the Father and our own life experiences...

Chapter 17

We were asked about tithing the other day, as to what to do or not to do, as for ourselves we find this a very hard question to answer because, it's not in the new Testament we believe the best way to answer is only to respond with is this,

Tithing was practiced extensively in the <u>Old Testament</u>, as a means to supporting themselves, the church and members through the times

Leviticus 27:30-33

And all the tithe of the land, whether of the seed of the land, or of the fruit of the tree, is the LORD'S: it is holy unto the LORD.

And if a man will at all redeem ought of his tithes, he shall add thereto the fifth part thereof. And concerning the tithe of the herd, or of the flock, even of whatsoever passeth under the rod, the tenth shall be holy unto the LORD.

He shall not search whether it be good or bad, neither shall he change it: and if he change it at all, then both it and the change thereof shall be holy; it shall not be redeemed.

These are the commandments, which the LORD commanded Moses for the children of Israel in mount Sinai.

Source: King James 1611

Deuteronomy 14:22-29

Thou shalt truly tithe all the increase of thy seed, that the field bringeth forth year by year. And thou shalt eat before the LORD thy God, in the place which he shall choose to place his name there, the tithe of thy corn, of thy wine, and of thine oil, and the firstlings of thy herds and of thy flocks; that thou mayest learn to fear the LORD thy God always.

And if the way be too long for thee, so that thou art not able to carry it; or if the place be too far from thee, which the LORD thy God shall choose to set his name there, when the LORD thy God hath blessed thee:

Then shalt thou turn it into money, and bind up the money in thine hand, and shalt go unto the place which the LORD thy God shall choose:

And thou shalt bestow that money for whatsoever thy soul lusteth after, for oxen, or for sheep, or for wine, or for strong drink, or for whatsoever thy soul desireth: and thou shalt eat there before the LORD thy God, and thou shalt rejoice, thou, and thine household,

And the Levite that is within thy gates; thou shalt not forsake him; for he hath no part nor inheritance with thee.

At the end of three years thou shalt bring forth all the tithe of thine increase the same year, and shalt lay it up within thy gates:

And the Levite, (because he hath no part nor inheritance with thee,) and the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, which are within thy gates, shall come, and shall eat and be satisfied; that the LORD thy God may bless thee in all the work of thine hand which thou doest.

When there wasn't anything else and it was never practiced or taught within the first-century Church. Instead the <u>New Testament</u> scriptures are seen as teaching the concept of <u>"freewill</u> offerings" as a means of supporting the church:

In fact giving of your self will give you the same blessing as when you give money, but we are led to believe unless we give to support this or that we will not be worthy or good enough and that's wrong as that is not even in my Bible we don't believe anybody should give more than they are able if that is what is in your heart. Paul tells {see Romans 12:6-9} us that we were commissioned by God the Father to spread His word to all nations and all our brothers and sisters everywhere. I don't believe that meant more or all their money, so we have none and someone else has it all.

Paul is telling us here that, false teachers are described. Faithful ministers must oppose them in good time, that their folly being manifest, they may go no further They had a base end in what they did; serving a worldly interest under pretense of Christianity: for the love of money is the root of all evil. We should resist them, and put to shame, by sound doctrine from the Scriptures. Their actions are the reproach of heathens, should be far from Christians; falsehood and lying, envious craft and cruelty, brutal and sensual practices, idleness and sloth, are sins condemned even by the light of nature. But Christian meekness is as far from cowardly passing over sin, error, as from anger and impatience. Though there may be national differences of character, vet the heart of man in every age and place is deceitful and desperately wicked. But the sharpest reproofs must aim at the good of the reproved; and soundness in the faith is most desirable and necessary. To those who are defiled and unbelieving, nothing is pure; they abuse, and turn things lawful and good into sin. They many profess to know God, yet in their hearts, lives deny and reject Him. They have a form of godliness, but are without the power; yet let us not be so ready to judge others, be careful that it does not apply to ourselves. And all of this is image and likeness, as the scriptures tell us. And makes life the burden that it is, and that burden offers us the opportunity and the conditions for our own cleansing, the cleansing that we achieve through those life's experiences and those merits that the rightness of our actions brings to us and everything is part of the wondrous design of creation, whose reason for existence is to give us the means to re-create ourselves, developing our potential, growing in His likeness. The Father created us in His. Also see Matthew 19:16-24 and 17:24-27

Our Father is in Him as He is in our Father, and all of us are in Him as He is in us. The only author is that infinite and glorifying love that penetrates each of our fibers as it penetrates every atom of the universe, creating all and covering all with its soft mantle, giving consolation and joy to all of us, with no other purpose than that each of us become, in turn, a fountain of ever greater love and faith, may Jesus' peace dwell in our hearts forever with us.....Amen
