15 transmissions to both the Attorney General, and that actually  
16 goes back to Attorney General Barr, but particularly Janet Reno  
17 and obviously there are innumerable transmissions to federal FBI  
18 Director Louis Freeh and other federal agents, both in  
19 Connecticut as well as California and as well, Washington, D.C.
